Next Up in Valpo Softball: Valpo heads to the 2019 MVC Tournament this week in Peoria, Ill. As the tenth seed, Valpo opens tournament play against seventh-seeded Evansville on Wednesday evening. The Brown and Gold will have to win five games in a row in the single-elimination bracket to claim the tournament title.

Previously: Despite two strong pitching performances from junior Jenna Edwards and another from freshman Taylor Knight, Valpo dropped all three games of its final regular season series to Illinois State last weekend at home, falling by final scores of 1-0, 6-4 and 1-0.

Following Valpo Softball: Every game from the 2019 MVC Tournament will be broadcast live on ESPN+, with R.C. McBride and Laura Leonard on the call. Live stats for all Valpo's tournament games will also be available via ValpoAthletics.com.

Head Coach Kate Stake: Kate Stake was hired as head coach of the Valparaiso softball program on July 23, 2014 and is in her fifth season as head coach in 2019. Stake, who is 104-146 at Valpo, led the Crusaders to the 2016 Horizon League Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament - the third in program history. Stake arrived at Valpo with eight seasons of assistant coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently serving as an assistant at mid-major power Hofstra. She played her collegiate softball at fellow MVC member Illinois State and is a 2005 graduate of ISU.

Valpo In Conference Tournaments: In Coach Stake's first four seasons at the helm of the Valpo program, the Crusaders own a 7-5 record in conference tournament play. In that stretch, Valpo is 5-4 as the lower seed and 2-1 as the higher seed. Notably, this is the fourth straight year Valpo has opened the conference tournament against a team which swept it in the regular season - in each of the previous three instances, Valpo has won its opener.

Edwards Ends Strong: Junior pitcher Jenna Edwards put together perhaps her two best outings of the year in the final weekend of the regular season, resulting in her earning MVC Newcomer of the Week honors. Edwards got the start in the circle in the series opener against Illinois State, who entered the final series of the year averaging nearly six runs/game in conference play, and tossed a gem, surrendering just one run on three hits while striking out 10 Redbird batters. Edwards matched her season high for strikeouts, and also tied her season low for hits allowed in a start. She then started the series finale and was nearly as strong, giving up one run while scattering six hits and striking out seven. For the week, she posted a 1.00 ERA in 14 innings of work, striking out 17 batters and allowing Illinois State to hit just .180 off of her.

Raking in Hardware: Edwards became the fourth Crusader to earn a weekly honor from the MVC office this year. Freshman Peyton Moeder was named Newcomer of the Week April 22 after going 8-for-15 with four runs scored over four games the previous week. Freshman Jaina Westphal was the April 1 Newcomer of the Week following a homer against IUPUI the previous week. Junior Kelsie Packard earned Pitcher of the Week honors March 11 after earning wins over NC State and Lipscomb, posting a 0.47 ERA in 15 innings of work while striking out 15.

Tough-Luck Losses: Edwards was the tough-luck loser in the circle in two 1-0 decisions against the Redbirds last weekend despite throwing two of her best games of the season. Edwards allowed just one run in three of her complete-game efforts in MVC play this year, but went 0-3 in those games. Meanwhile, Valpo lost multiple games in the same series by a 1-0 final for the first time since April 13 and 14, 2001, when the Crusaders dropped 1-0 decisions in consecutive games to Western Illinois.

Knight Strong as Well: Edwards wasn't the only Crusader pitcher with perhaps her best effort of the year to close the regular season, as freshman Taylor Knight delivered a strong performance in the circle against Illinois State in the middle game of the series. Knight needed exactly 100 pitches to toss 6.2 innings, surrendering just three runs – only two of which were earned – while scattering seven hits and walking just one.

Celebrating the Seniors: Valpo's two-member senior class of Carly Trepanier and Jaymee Lawton were honored Saturday on Senior Day prior to their final home games. Trepanier is one of the best players in program history, ranking fourth all-time at Valpo in triples, sixth in hits, sixth in total bases, seventh in on-base percentage, ninth in batting average, ninth in walks and tenth in total bases. Meanwhile, Lawton in just three years ranks eighth all-time at Valpo with 21 career homers, as well as 10th in both career slugging percentage and walks, as well as eighth in assists.

A Freshman Shall Lead Them: Freshman Jaina Westphal finds herself in a position to potentially lead Valpo in batting average as a freshman, something that only two Crusader rookies have accomplished in the last 18 seasons. Current senior Carly Trepanier paced Valpo in average in her freshman year in 2016, while four-year standout Sara Strickland led Valpo in batting average as a rookie in 2009 to kick off a career which she ended as the program's career leader in hits, runs scored and doubles.

Crusader Tidbits

#1 Addi Burke (So., IF)

- Has made 21 starts at third base and six at designated player this season
- Scored game-tying run in seventh inning in win over WMU
- Had pair of multi-hit games in MVC-opening series at Bradley, going 4-for-9 over the three games
- Made highlight-reel play as defensive replacement in March 5 win at NC State, snagging a line drive at third base and doubling up the runner at third for a game-ending double play; play was @NCAASoftball #4 Play of the Week

#2 Jenna Edwards (R-Jr., P)

- Named MVC Newcomer of the Week after throwing a pair of complete games against Illinois State last weekend, allowing just one run in both games
- Surrendered just three hits and tied season best with 10 K's in opener
- Picked up consecutive complete-game wins over WMU April 17 and Indiana State April 19, and added a save in middle game of ISU series
- Tossed a gem in nightcap against Drake April 6, taking a tough-luck 1-0 loss in a three-hitter, striking out seven
- Threw a complete-game five-hitter with a season-best 10 K's in the nightcap win April 1 vs. Missouri State, and followed with five innings of three-hit ball, giving up just one run, to earn the win at UIC April 3
- Had her longest scoreless performance in a Valpo uniform March 10 against Buffalo, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout relief with six strikeouts
- Pitched last season at Chattanooga State C.C., where she was an All-Conference honoree, recording 17 wins and tallied 154 strikeouts in 148 innings of work

#4 Morgan Matalin (Jr., OF)

- Has started all 45 games in the outfield this year - 37 in left field and eight in center field
- Has homers in MVC play at SIU and at Evansville
- Picked up hits in all three games of Indiana State series, going 4-for-9 with three runs; kicked off four-run rally in bottom of 6th of middle game with leadoff triple
- Went 2-for-3 with two doubles and two RBIs in March 2 win over College of Charleston

#5 Ashley Barker (So., IF)

- Has made six starts at third base and seven at designated player this year
- Went 2-for-3 with a run scored in middle game of Illinois State series
- Reached base three times in middle game of series with Indiana State, going 2-for-3 with a walk, a double and a run scored
- Drew a walk to lead off eventual five-run inning in nightcap win over Missouri State April 1

#8 Taylor Knight (Fr., P)

- Earned first collegiate victory in opener April 20 against Indiana State, closing out a six-inning start with four consecutive scoreless frames
- Threw 1.2 shutout innings in opener April 1 against Missouri State
- Tossed two shutout innings in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree for Elkhorn South [Neb.] H.S., helped team to four state title game appearances and was the winning pitcher in the 2016 state title game

#9 Addie Pixley (Jr., OF)

- Has started three games in right field and two at DP this year
- Came off the bench with an RBI double and scored a run on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

#10 Jaina Westphal (Fr., OF)

- Picked up three hits in six at-bats in season-ending twinbill against Illinois State last Saturday
- Went 4-for-8 in three-game series at Evansville, including her first career three-hit game in the series finale
- MVC Newcomer of the Week April 1
- Has hit three home runs this year, most recently connecting on a two-run shot against IUPUI March 27
- Owns a team-best 13 stolen bases on the year; has stolen multiple bases three times this season
- Has started all 45 games this season in one of the corner outfield spots (34 in right field; 11 in left field)
- First Team All-State honoree as a senior at Burlington [Wis.] H.S., helping team to berth in state title game

#11 Carly Trepanier (Jr., IF)

- Went 4-for-10 with two runs scored and three RBIs in series against Indiana State; scored walk-off run in series opener
- Capped 2-for-4 performance with walk-off two-run single April 17 in win over WMU
- Ranks fourth in program history in triples (10), sixth in hits (192), sixth in total bases (268), seventh in on-base percentage (.390), ninth in batting average (.315), ninth in walks (63) and 10th in stolen bases (28)
- Has started 190 consecutive games for the Crusaders
- Leads Valpo with nine multi-hit games on the year and also had a team-best 13-game on-base streak (snapped March 16 G2 at Bradley)
- An MVC All-Defensive Team selection a season ago
- NFCA Third Team All-Midwest Region as a sophomore in 2017

#13 Brittany Anderson (So., UT)

- Has started all 45 games this season - 36 games at first base, six games at third base and three games in right field
- Recorded hits in five consecutive games April 24-May 3
- Has walked three times in one game twice this year, matching a Valpo season high - most recently reached base in all four PAs in middle game of Indiana State series, going 1-for-1 with three walks and two runs scored
- Hit fourth home run of the season April 14 at UNI, a three-run homer in the third inning
- Scored at least one run in seven consecutive games Feb. 22-March 2, including three two-run games
- Two-sport star at Valpo; an MVC First Team All-Conference honoree on the Crusaders' volleyball team in the fall of 2018, helping to lead team to postseason appearance in the NIVC

#16 Hannah Dybalski (Jr., C)

- Has started 16 games at catcher and five games at DP this year
- Kicked off seventh-inning rally April 17 against WMU with a leadoff double, eventually scoring a run as well

- Hit 11 home runs last season, tied for second in the MVC and tied for fourth in a single season in Valpo history

#23 Peyton Moeder (Fr., OF)

- Missed opening weekend due to injury; has started each of the last 40 games (38 in center field, 2 in right field)
- Earned #6 spot on SportsCenter Top 10 April 27 with highlight-reel catch in the right-center gap at Evansville
- MVC Newcomer of the Week April 22
- Posted Valpo's first three-hit games of the year, going 3-for-4 in back-to-back games in the first two games of the Indiana State series; also scored a Valpo season-high three runs in the series opener
- Led way for Valpo offensively in March 17 win at Bradley, going 2-for-3 with a run scored and three RBIs
- Stole a base in all three games of the series against the Braves after swiping just one in her first 11 appearances
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree at Mill Valley [Kan.] H.S.; helped team win regional titles and finish fourth in state each of her final two seasons

#28 Kelsie Packard (R-Jr., P)

- Suffered injury while warming up for fifth inning April 1 against Missouri State and has been sidelined since
- Earned mid-week win over IUPUI March 27 with five innings of two-hit work
- Named MVC Pitcher of the Week March 11 after posting a 0.47 ERA in 15 innings of work over two wins, striking out 15 and allowing opponents to hit just .137 against her
- Threw five shutout innings of relief in March 5 win over NC State, just the third win over an ACC team in program history
- Threw 11th no-hitter in program history March 1 against Wagner - game was suspended after three innings and resumed March 3, when she threw the final two innings
- MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-MVC selection in 2018 in her first season as a Crusader
- Went 6-3 with a 1.78 ERA and struck out 78 batters over 67 innings in conference action last season

#32 Maddie Henry (Fr., C/UT)

- Has made six pinch-hit appearances this year
- Knocked a single back up the middle April 3 at UIC
- Connected on her first collegiate hit in resumption of suspended game against Wagner March 3, an RBI double
- Played travel ball for Team Glory Fastpitch, where she was coached by former Crusader Maggie Seidel

#33 Taylor Herschbach (Fr., IF)

- Has appeared in 44 of 45 games in her rookie season, including 43 starts
- 22 at shortstop, 13 at designated player, 6 at 1st base and 2 at 3rd base
- Picked up two hits in series-opening win over Indiana State; scored a pair of runs in win in middle game of series
- Reached base in 4 of 5 plate appearances in April 3 win at UIC, going 2-for-3 with two walks, two runs scored and two RBIs
