**Next Up in Valpo Baseball**: For the third time in the first four series of the season, the Valparaiso University baseball team will visit a Conference USA foe this weekend. After strong pitching was on display throughout last weekend's set at Middle Tennessee State, Valpo will visit a familiar venue as it returns to the site of its 2020 season opener to once again clash with Western Kentucky for a three-game weekend series in Bowling Green, Ky.

Last Time Out: Valpo split last weekend's four-game tango with Middle Tennessee State thanks in large part to dominant pitching throughout Saturday's doubleheader, which was scheduled as a pair of seven-inning affairs. Colin Fields threw a no-hitter in the opener to propel the team to a 5-0 victory, then Trent Turzenski yielded two runs on just three hits in seven innings in the nightcap. That contest went extra innings as Riley Dent drove in the go-ahead run with a single in the top of the eighth before Jon Tieman came on to nail down the save. Middle Tennessee prevailed 5-2 in Friday's series opener and 5-0 in Sunday's finale.

**On the Air**: The first two games of the series on Friday and Saturday will have live video available via Facebook Live courtesy of Western Kentucky Athletics. All three games will feature a live radio broadcast. Links to live video, audio and stats will be available on ValpoAthletics.com.

**Series Notes:** Valpo dropped two of three in last year's visit to Western Kentucky, but salvaged the series finale 5-3 in 10 innings. Damon Jorgensen drove in the go-ahead run with a squeeze bunt in the top of the 10th, while Riley Dent launched his first collegiate home run. Easton Rhodehouse picked up the victory with three perfect innings of relief. Bowling Green, Ky. was also the site of the collegiate debuts for current fifth-year seniors Jon Tieman, Steven Fitzsimmons, Riley Dent and Easton Rhodehouse when Valpo opened the 2017 campaign at WKU. The Hilltoppers hold a 6-3 edge in the all-time set, which began in 1981.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Schmack's win total of 137 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former big-league pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to

receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

#### **No-No Notes**

Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.
The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a

doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.

- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.

- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.

- After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.

- Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the third inning of the no-hitter was an "immaculate inning" with all three batters going down on three straight strikes.

- Fields is a Valpo baseball legacy student-athlete as his father Timm played for Valpo in the late 1980s.

- After his March 13 no-hitter at Middle Tennessee, Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week.

- He became the first Valpo player to earn each of those honors since teammate Easton Rhodehouse did so in May 2019.

- He became the second Valpo pitcher (Rhodehouse) and the third Valpo player (Rhodehouse and Sam Shaikin) to earn an MVC weekly award since the program joined the conference prior to the 2018 season.

The milestone came in a significant moment as he struck out the final batter of the bottom of the eighth in a game that was scheduled for seven innings to preserve a 3-2 victory. The Blue Raiders had the potential tying run at third and winning run at second at the time of the strikeout.

#### **Closing Time**

- At the same time he achieved his 200th career strikeout, Jon Tieman nailed down his eighth career save in the 3-2, eight-inning win over Middle Tennessee on March 13.

- Tieman moved up a place on the program's all-time saves list, climbing into a tie with Chip Pettit (1993-1996) and teammate Easton Rhodehouse for seventh in Valpo history in career saves.

- The save marked Tieman's first save since his freshman season in 2017, when he served as the club's closer and nailed down seven saves before moving into the rotation late in the year. Tieman's save on March 13 marked his first since April 8, 2017 vs. Northern Kentucky, a span of 1,435 days.

#### Other Notes Wrapping Up Middle Tennessee (March 12-14)

Shortstop Damon Jorgensen returned to the Valpo lineup and didn't skip a beat after missing the previous series with an injury. He hit safely in all four games, compiling a team-high .375 series average to go along with a .563 slugging percentage against the Blue Raiders. He lashed two hits in both games of Saturday's doubleheader sweep. Jorgensen's home run in Game 1 on Saturday marked his first of the season and the third of his Valpo career.
Jorgensen has now reached safely in seven consecutive games, tying with Steven Fitzsimmons for the team's longest active on-base streak. Jorgensen, Fitzsimmons and Kyle Schmack are the three Valpo players with three multihit games this season.

Freshman Kaleb Hannahs ripped a home run in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, the first extra-base knock of his young collegiate career.
Valpo swept a doubleheader for the first time since May 13, 2017 at Milwaukee.

- The one-run win in the nightcap of the March 13 twinbill (3-2) was Valpo's

first victory decided by the slimmest of margins since topping Chicago State 4-3 on May 14, 2019.

- The extra-inning affair in Game 2 of the double dip was Valpo's first such game since beating Western Kentucky in 10 frames on Feb. 17, 2020.

- RHP Nathan Chasey worked three scoreless innings in relief in the series finale on Sunday, extending his scoreless innings streak to six over his four appearances this season. The junior college transfer has allowed just five hits and one walk while striking out 11.

#### In the Other Dugout: Western Kentucky

- Swept a four-game series from Bowling Green last weekend including a 17-16 slugfest in the finale before losing 7-3 to Bellarmine in a midweek game on Tuesday.

- Held a 10-6 record last season at the time play was halted due to the pandemic.

- Picked to finish fourth of six in the C-USA East Preseason Poll.

- Represented by DH/UTL Davis Sims on the preseason all-conference team.

- Western Kentucky hitting coach Ben Wolgamot spent five seasons on Valpo's staff before joining the Hilltoppers prior to the 2019 campaign.

- RHP Easton Rhodehouse (R-Sr., Gilbert, Ariz. / Gilbert) - Expected to start the Friday game in an "opener" role each weekend... Named 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention and to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team in 2017. Also received 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete Honorable Mention... Did not allow an earned run in any of his five conference outings in 2018 with opponents hitting just .211 against him in conference play... Finished the 2019 season with a team-best 3.82 ERA over 22 appearances out of the bullpen, grabbing two wins to go along with four saves... Secured 44 strikeouts while walking 13 in 35 1/3 innings in 2019... Was one of four players in the nation to start six games during the 2020 season, tying for the NCAA Division-I lead in that category. Ranked third on the team with a 3.45 ERA and struck out a team-high 20 while issuing just four bases on balls over 15 2/3 innings... 2020 Valparaiso University graduate with a degree in political science... Currently pursuing an MBA... Spent the 2018 summer doing grassroots volunteer work for a political campaign... Hobbies include skateboarding and mountain biking... Picked up the win by allowing one run on two hits over two innings in the Feb. 19 season opener at UAB, when he became the first Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen (2014, 2015) to start consecutive Opening Days... Went two innings and gave up one run on two hits while striking out four in his Feb. 26 start at Jacksonville State... Pitched two shutout innings of hitless ball in his start on March 12 at Middle Tennessee, striking out four and issuing no walks.

- RHP Ryan Mintz (So., Lombard, III. / Willowbrook) – Although not technically a starter this weekend, Mintz is expected to follow Rhodehouse in long relief on Friday... Set his high school's record for wins by a pitcher in the program's 60-year history... Was named West Suburban Gold Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for his work at Willowbrook... The Lombard, III. native is majoring in computer engineering... Hobbies include snowboarding and other extreme sports... Made five appearances and two starts during the COVID-19 shortened

season... Notched a season-high five strikeouts in just three innings on March 10 at Alabama State, his final outing of the year... Equaled a career high with five strikeouts over six innings of relief in Valpo's season-opening win at UAB on Feb. 19... Logged 4 1/3 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on two hits in 4 1/3 innings on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State... Took the defeat on March 12 at Middle Tennessee but issued just one walk against five strikeouts.

- RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) - Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2019 second on the team in strikeouts with 52... Made four starts during the 2020 season and ranked second on the team with 17 strikeouts, including a season-high six on Feb. 29 vs. Southern Miss... Carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning before taking a tough-luck loss in his first outing of the year on Feb. 21 at UAB. He permitted one hit and was charged with one unearned run that crossed the dish following his departure over his 4 1/3 inning start that featured eight strikeouts. That marked the third game in his career with eight strikeouts or more... Took the defeat in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three outs) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0.

- RHP Trent Turzenski (So., Burlington, Wis. / Burlington) – Ranked seventh in the MVC in ERA and 11th in opponents' batting average (.236) as a freshman in 2020... Ranked No. 18 on D1Baseball.com's 2020 list of the Top 50 freshmen pitchers in the nation based on analytics... Had a team-best 2.48 ERA in 2020 over four games out of the bullpen... Struck out 16 against just six walks over 19 innings, sharing the team's heaviest workload... Struck out 11 while walking just one in six innings on Feb. 28, 2020 at McNeese... Played in the Little League World Series Regional Tournament on ESPN twice, when he was 11 and 12 years old... Took the defeat after allowing two runs on just three hits in four innings in his first outing of the season on Feb. 20 at UAB... Allowed four runs (three earned) on six hits while striking out six over five innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... - Steven Fitzsimmons, OF, R-Sr. (Golden Valley, Minn. / Robbinsdale Cooper) – Was a member of the 2019 and 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team... Had a breakout junior season in 2019, playing in 49 of the team's 50 games and making 45 starts after playing in 16 games and making three starts as a sophomore... Went from a career .195 hitter with one double over his first two seasons to batting .268 with nine doubles as a junior... Graduated in May 2020 with a 3.96 GPA in political science... Pursuing a master's in sports administration... Played in 13 games and made 12 starts during the 2020 season... Batted a team-best .308 over the opening series at UAB including a three-hit performance in the Feb. 19 victory. He posted his first game with three or more hits since mid-May 2019 while also scoring a career-high three runs and accounting for half of the team's hits in the season-opening triumph... Hit a team-best .444 in a three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27, going 4-for-9 with a .583 on-base percentage.

- Kyle Schmack, 1B, So. (Wanatah, Ind. / South Central) – After graduating from nearby South Central High School in 2019, Kyle joined his father Brian's program

at Valpo... Is the first Valpo student-athlete to play for his or her parent as a head coach since Bryce Drew in 1998... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Reached base three times via a hit and two walks in the Feb. 21 series finale at UAB... Went 5-for-12 (.417) in the three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27. - Jeremy Drudge, OF/DH, Jr. (Plymouth, Ind. / Plymouth) - Spent the 2019 summer playing for the Normal CornBelters of the Prospect League... Came to Valpo as a rookie in 2019 after seeing limited action as a senior in high school due to a torn ACL... Raced go-karts during his youth...Appeared in 12 games and made 10 starts in 2020, collecting six hits including a triple and a home run... Launched his third career home run (one in each of his three seasons) on Opening Day at UAB, a three-run blow that helped Valpo beat the Blazers 6-2 on Feb. 19... Notched a triple on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State, his second career three-bagger and the first by a Valpo player this season. - Damon Jorgensen, SS, R-Sr. (Blair, Neb. / Blair [Coffeyville]) - Junior college transfer who started his career at Coffeyville before coming to Valpo for the 2019 season... Hobbies include hunting, snowboarding and wakeboarding... Hit his first home run (and extra-base knock) in a Valpo uniform on March 12, 2019 at Tennessee Tech... Drove in the go-ahead run with a bases-loaded squeeze bunt in the top of the 10th of Valpo's 5-3 victory at Western Kentucky on Feb. 17, 2020. That completed the first three-hit day of his Valpo tenure... Started all 14 games in 2020 and ranked second on the team in batting average at .264... Had two hits in the Saturday game at UAB on Feb. 20, his 10th career multi-hit output... Returned to the lineup and didn't miss a beat March 12-14 at Middle Tennessee after missing the previous series with an injury. He hit a team-high .375 in the four-game set to go along with a .563 slugging percentage. Launched his first home run of the season and the third of his Valpo career in Game 1 of the doubleheader on March 13.

- Riley Dent, OF, R-Sr. (Long Beach, Calif. / Wilson) – Was a 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention recipient... Entered the 2019 season with a .207 career batting average, but had a breakout year that saw him hit .290 as a junior. Moved to the leadoff spot and transitioned to center field for his junior campaign... Tied for the 2019 team lead with 15 multi-hit outputs...
