Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will open up Missouri Valley Conference play this weekend with a trip to Dallas to match up with Dallas Baptist University in a four-game, holiday-weekend series. The set will commence on Thursday evening with sunshine and high 60s anticipated throughout the weekend in the Lone Star State.

Last Time Out: Valpo dropped two of three at Butler in the final weekend series prior to the start of Valley action (March 26-27). The Brown & Gold fell 5-4 in 10 innings in Friday's opener before prevailing 7-1 in the first game of Saturday's twinbill. The series finale and nightcap of Saturday's double dip resulted in Butler outslugging Valpo 13-10. Colin Fields pitched a gem to earn the win in the middle game of the series, while Kaleb Hannahs led the way in the doubleheader with five hits, three runs scored, three walks and three RBIs over the two games.

Series Notes: Valpo dropped all three in its most recent series with DBU, which took place in March 2019 at Horner Ballpark. Valpo has lost four straight matchups to slip to 3-9 in the head-to-head series, but the all-time set with the Patriots does feature some memorable moments for the Brown & Gold. Valpo's most recent win over DBU came in the first round of the 2018 MVC Tournament, a 13-10 Valpo triumph on the Patriots' home field. The two teams met again on May 25 in the double-elimination tournament, and DBU edged Valpo 7-5 as the Patriots went on to earn an NCAA at-large berth. The two teams also met in 2016 in a nonconference series prior to Valpo's arrival in The Valley, and Valpo did pick up a win against a DBU club that was nationally ranked at the time of those matchups.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Schmack's win total of 137 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former big-league pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to

receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Twice is Nice

- Valpo pitcher Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second time in a three-week span on March 29.

- Fields became the first Valpo player to win two MVC weekly honors in the same season since the program joined The Valley. In addition, he became the first MVC player to win two weekly honors this season.

- The most recent accolade came after the junior yielded just two hits over seven shutout innings to propel Valpo to a 7-1 victory over Butler in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 27. Fields scattered three walks and racked up 11 strikeouts, a total that set a season high and tied a career high. Coincidentally, his previous career high of 11 also came in a game against Butler during the 2019 season.

- Fields struck out the side in both the first and fifth innings and retired the first 10 men he faced.

- The righty is up to 36 strikeouts this season, fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. He crossed the 100-career strikeout mark in the win at Butler as he has fanned 105 in 92 1/3 career innings. Opponents are hitting just .141 this season against Fields, who has reached double figures in strikeouts in two of his last three starts.

- Fields has allowed two hits or fewer in three of his five starts this season. He leads the MVC and ranks 25th in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings at 4.50.

- His previous MVC Pitcher of the Week nod came on March 15 following his March 13 no-hitter at Middle Tennessee. Fields also earned Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Pitcher of the Week following the no-no.

Valpo in Conference Openers

This marks the second consecutive Missouri Valley Conference slate that starts with Valpo visiting DBU. The Brown & Gold started the conference docket in the same location on March 29-31, 2019, dropping all three games including a 10-5 setback in the opener.
Valpo will attempt to win its first conference game of the season for the first time since joining The Valley. The last time Valpo prevailed in a conference opener was a 5-4, 10-inning victory at Northern Kentucky on March 18, 2016.

- Valpo will also aim to win its first league-opening series for the first time since sweeping the Norse in the aforementioned March 2016 set in Highland Heights, Ky.

Steven's Streak

- Valpo outfielder Steven Fitzsimmons has reached base safely in 14 consecutive games, the team's longest such streak this season.

- If he reaches safely in Thursday's game at DBU, Fitzsimmons will own Valpo's first 15-game on-base streak since Riley Dent in 2019.

- Valpo's last 20-game on-base streak came courtesy of current volunteer assistant coach Sam Shaikin (23 in 2017), while its most recent 30-game streak occurred when Nolan Lodden reached in 34 straight in 2016.

Hannahs is Hot

- Valpo freshman Kaleb Hannahs posted a .545 batting average (6-for-11) to go along with a .667 on-base percentage in the March 26-27 series vs. Butler, far and away leading the team in both areas during the three-game set.

- Hannahs scored three runs and drove in three while drawing four walks and striking out just once over four games against the Bulldogs.

- All three RBIs came in Valpo's 7-1 victory in Game 1 of the March 27 doubleheader.

He set a career high in RBIs and became just the second Valpo player with a three-RBI game this season.

- Hannahs, who is tied for the team lead with six multi-hit games this season, is the son of Indiana State head coach Mitch Hannahs and will play against his father on April 16-18 in Terre Haute.

- The rookie is hitting .452 with a .564 on-base percentage over his last nine games after starting his collegiate career with a .161 average through his first eight contests.

Offensive Uptick

- Valpo collected 23 hits during the March 27 doubleheader vs. Butler, 11 in the opener and 12 in the nightcap. That marked the first time this season Valpo accrued double-figure hit totals in consecutive contests.

- This marks the first time Valpo has had double-figure hit outputs in consecutive games since the final two dates of the 2019 regular season at Missouri State.

- The 10 runs in the 13-10 defeat in Game 2 of the twinbill marked Valpo's season high. The team's last double-figure run total was 11 on Feb. 29, 2020 vs. Southern Miss. Valpo had allowed more than 10 runs just twice in the first 16 games of the season, but happened to do so during the team's first double-figure scoring output of the year.

Bonus Baseball

- Valpo's 5-4, 10-inning defeat in the March 26 series opener at Butler marked the third straight weekend Valpo has played an extra-inning affair. The Brown & Gold beat Middle Tennessee 3-2 in a game that was scheduled for seven innings but required eight as part of a March 13 doubleheader. Valpo won 8-6 in 11 innings on March 20 at Western Kentucky.

- The team has already tied for the most extra-inning games in a season during the Brian Schmack Era with three. The team has had three extra-inning affairs in multiple seasons but never four in one year under Schmack.

- Valpo's one-run loss marked its second setback by the slimmest of margins this season, with the first also coming by a score of 5-4 on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State.

In the Other Dugout: DBU

- This series features both the reigning MVC Pitcher of the Week (Valpo's Colin Fields) and the reigning MVC Player of the Week, DBU outfielder Austin Bell, who hit .500 and drove in seven during a series win over UT Rio Grande Valley.

- The Patriots dropped the finale 5-4 in their most recent game on Sunday, March 28, but had won the first three in a home series against UT Rio Grande Valley.

- The Patriots own a ranked win this season over then-No. 25 Oklahoma on March 7 and also swept two games from Missouri in early March.

- DBU is the unanimous preseason favorite to win the Missouri Valley Conference based on a survey of the league's head coaches. Jeffrey David and Ryan Wrobleski represented the Patriots on the preseason all-conference squad.

Tieman Cracks Top 10: Jon Tieman earned the win in the March 20 extra-inning victory at Western Kentucky by virtue of 3 2/3 innings of scoreless relief. He yielded two hits and no walks while striking out five. He passed Jim Pomeroy (202, 1996-1999) for 10th on Valpo's all-time strikeout list, and later added two more on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Dame to boost his career total to 207, then added one more during the series at Butler (March 26-27).

The 200 Club

- Valpo fifth-year senior Jon Tieman became just the 11th pitcher in Valpo history to reach the career 200-strikeout milestone on Saturday, March 13 at Middle Tennessee. The milestone came in a significant moment as he struck out the final batter of the bottom of the eighth in a game that was scheduled for seven innings to preserve a 3-2 victory. The Blue Raiders had the potential tying run at third and winning run at second at the time of the strikeout.

- The right-handed hurler became just the second Valpo player to reach that milestone in the last decade, joining Dalton Lundeen (2013-2016).

- Tieman ranks in the top 15 nationally for career strikeouts.

- Tieman led the team in strikeouts three straight years from 2017-2019.

No-No Notes

- Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.

- The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.

- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.

- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.

- After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.

- Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the

third inning of the no-hitter was an "immaculate inning" with all three batters going down on three straight strikes.

Closing Time

- At the same time he achieved his 200th career strikeout, Jon Tieman nailed down his eighth career save in the 3-2, eight-inning win over Middle Tennessee on March 13. - Tieman moved up a place on the program's all-time saves list, climbing into a tie with Chip Pettit (1993-1996) and teammate Easton Rhodehouse for seventh in Valpo history in career saves.

- The save marked Tieman's first save since his freshman season in 2017, when he served as the club's closer and nailed down seven saves before moving into the rotation late in the year. Tieman's save on March 13 marked his first since April 8, 2017 vs. Northern Kentucky, a span of 1,435 days.

- RHP Easton Rhodehouse (R-Sr., Gilbert, Ariz. / Gilbert) - Expected to start the first game of each series in an "opener" role each weekend... Named 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention and to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team in 2017. Also received 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete Honorable Mention... Did not allow an earned run in any of his five conference outings in 2018 with opponents hitting just .211 against him in conference play... Finished the 2019 season with a teambest 3.82 ERA over 22 appearances out of the bullpen, grabbing two wins to go along with four saves... Secured 44 strikeouts while walking 13 in 35 1/3 innings in 2019... Was one of four players in the nation to start six games during the 2020 season, tying for the NCAA Division-I lead in that category. Ranked third on the team with a 3.45 ERA and struck out a team-high 20 while issuing just four bases on balls over 15 2/3 innings... 2020 Valparaiso University graduate with a degree in political science... Currently pursuing an MBA... Spent the 2018 summer doing grassroots volunteer work for a political campaign... Hobbies include skateboarding and mountain biking... Picked up the win by allowing one run on two hits over two innings in the Feb. 19 season opener at UAB, when he became the first Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen (2014, 2015) to start consecutive Opening Days... Went two innings and gave up one run on two hits while striking out four in his Feb. 26 start at Jacksonville State... Pitched two shutout innings of hitless ball in his start on March 12 at Middle Tennessee, striking out four and issuing no walks... allowed one run on three hits in two innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky, then absorbed the loss on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Dame after allowing two runs on just one hit in 1 2/3 innings... Struck out seven and allowed one hit over 4 1/3 shutout innings in two appearances during the three-game series at Butler March 26-27.

- RHP Ryan Mintz (So., Lombard, Ill. / Willowbrook) – Although not technically a starter this weekend, Mintz is expected to follow Rhodehouse in long relief in Game 1 of the series... Set his high school's record for wins by a pitcher in the program's

60-year history... Was named West Suburban Gold Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for his work at Willowbrook... The Lombard, Ill. native is majoring in computer engineering... Hobbies include snowboarding and other extreme sports... Made five appearances and two starts during the COVID-19 shortened season... Notched a season-high five strikeouts in just three innings on March 10 at Alabama State, his final outing of the year... Equaled a career high with five strikeouts over six innings of relief in Valpo's season-opening win at UAB on Feb. 19... Logged 4 1/3 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on two hits in 4 1/3 innings on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State... Took the defeat on March 12 at Middle Tennessee but issued just one walk against five strikeouts... Took the defeat after striking out five in 4 2/3 innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky.

- RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) - Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2019 second on the team in strikeouts with 52... Made four starts during the 2020 season and ranked second on the team with 17 strikeouts, including a season-high six on Feb. 29 vs. Southern Miss... Carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning before taking a toughluck loss in his first outing of the year on Feb. 21 at UAB. He permitted one hit and was charged with one unearned run that crossed the dish following his departure over his 4 1/3 inning start that featured eight strikeouts. That marked the third game in his career with eight strikeouts or more... Took the defeat in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three outs) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0... Allowed just two runs on six hits and one walk while striking out five in his five-inning start on March 20 at Western Kentucky... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27. - RHP Trent Turzenski (So., Burlington, Wis. / Burlington) -Expected to serve as Valpo's Saturday starter... Ranked seventh in the MVC in ERA and 11th in opponents' batting average (.236) as a freshman in 2020... Ranked No. 18 on D1Baseball.com's 2020 list of the Top 50 freshmen pitchers in the nation based on analytics... Had a team-best 2.48 ERA in 2020 over four games out of the bullpen...
