Next Up in Valpo Baseball: After having last weekend's scheduled nonconference series at Oakland canceled due to COVID-related concerns within Oakland's program, the Valparaiso University baseball team will resume its Missouri Valley Conference slate this week. A short trip south to Terre Haute is in store as Valpo begins a four-game series with nationally-ranked Indiana State on Friday.

Last Time Out: Valpo dropped all four games to MVC preseason favorite Dallas Baptist at Horner Ballpark in Dallas in the first series of conference play, though all four matchups were decided by five runs or fewer against a quality foe with the final two decided by three or fewer. The tightest game in the series was the nightcap of the Good Friday doubleheader, as the host Patriots prevailed 9-8 in a seesaw battle.

On the Air: All four games in the series will air on ESPN3 with Luke Martin (play-by-play) and Tyler Ward (analyst) describing the action. Links to live video, audio and stats for all four contests can be found on ValpoAthletics.com.

Series Notes: Valpo is 30-46-1 all time against Indiana State, a matchup that dates all the way back to 1947. The Brown & Gold dropped all three in Terre Haute in the most recent series, which occurred April 12-13, 2019. Indiana State is a perfect 6-0 against Valpo in Missouri Valley Conference matchups. All told, Valpo has dropped 11 straight head-to-head meetings with the Sycamores dating back to an 11-2 victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 31, 2007.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Schmack's win total of 137 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former big-league pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

All in The Family

- This weekend's series between Valpo and Indiana State will pit father against son as Valpo freshman Kaleb Hannahs is the son of Indiana State head coach Mitch Hannahs.
- Valpo's starting corner infield provides a unique juxtaposition as one player chose to play for his father and the other chose to play against his father. Valpo sophomore first baseman Kyle Schmack is the son of Valpo head coach Brian Schmack.
- Kaleb's older brother Derek started his collegiate career at Ohio State before transferring to Indiana State when his father took over the Sycamore program.

Extending Streaks

A pair of noteworthy individual streaks were extended during Valpo's series at DBU (April 1-3). Sophomore first baseman Kyle Schmack hit safely in all four games in the series, upping his hitting streak to 12. That marks the program's longest such streak since Nate Palace's 14 gamer in 2017. In addition, a ninth-inning hit by pitch in the series finale helped fifth-year senior outfielder Steven Fitzsimmons extend his on-base streak to 18. He became the first Valpo player to reach that number since Giovanni Garbella in 2018.

Who's Hot?

- Riley Dent posted a .429 batting average over four games against Missouri Valley Conference preseason favorite Dallas Baptist, pacing Valpo hitting in that series. He also slugged a team-best .857 while posting a .529 on-base percentage, leading the team in both categories.
- Dent enjoyed a career performance in Game 2 of the April 2 doubleheader, posting a four-hit game that featured three extra-base knocks. One of those extra-base hits was his third home run of the season, part of his career-high four hits. He became the first Valpo player with a four-hit output since March 2019. Dent totaled 12 bases over the four games, driving in three runs and drawing three walks while four of his six hits went for extra bases.
- After hitting just .161 over his first eight games, freshman Kaleb Hannahs has heated up to the tune of a .370 average and .463 on-base percentage over the last 13 games. He leads Valpo in both categories during that stretch.
- Over the last 10 games, Kyle Schmack holds a .326 batting average, second on the team behind Hannahs during that stretch.

Other Notes Wrapping Up DBU (April 1-3)

- Brady Renfro and Parker Johnson hit back-to-back home runs in the eighth inning of Saturday's series finale, becoming the second Valpo tandem to go back-to-back this season. Damon Jorgensen and Jeremy Drudge turned the trick on March 19 at Western Kentucky.
- Valpo had five doubles in the nightcap of the Friday doubleheader, the team's first game with five or more doubles since May 8, 2018 at Western Michigan.
- Valpo had 14 hits in Game 3 of the series, outhitting the Patriots 14-10. That hit total marked the team's second-highest of the season behind 15 on March 20 at Western Kentucky.
- The one-run setback (9-8) in Game 3 of the series marked Valpo's third defeat by the slimmest of margins in 2021.
- Nolan Lebamoff allowed no earned runs on two hits and no walks while striking out three over 3 2/3 innings in two relief appearances at DBU.

Valpo vs. Ranked Foes: Valpo will take on a nationally-ranked opponent for the second time this season in Friday's series opener after facing No. 14 Notre Dame in a midweek game on March 23 at Frank Eck Stadium on Notre Dame's campus. Valpo held a 3-2 lead as late as the sixth inning, but fell 6-3. Prior to that, the Brown & Gold last faced nationally-ranked competition on Feb. 21-23, 2020 at No. 3 Louisville. In recent years, Valpo has Top-25 wins over No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016),

No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).

In the Other Dugout: Indiana State

- The Sycamores are ranked No. 23 by D1Baseball.com, Baseball America and the National Baseball Writers Association. They are also receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll.
- Head coach Mitch Hannahs' squad won three of four at Illinois State last week, picked up a series win at No. 20 Florida Atlantic and split a series at No. 16 Tennessee.
- Max Wright leads the team in batting average at .315, home runs with seven and RBIs with 18. He also tops the squad in on-base percentage at .455.
- Indiana State was picked to finish fourth in the MVC Preseason Poll. The Sycamores are the defending MVC Tournament champions after winning the 2019 tournament and going on to win two NCAA Regional games.

Twice is Nice

- Valpo pitcher Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second time in a three-week span on March 29.
- Fields became the first Valpo player to win two MVC weekly honors in the same season since the program joined The Valley. In addition, he became the first MVC player to win two weekly honors this season.
- The most recent accolade came after the junior yielded just two hits over seven shutout innings to propel Valpo to a 7-1 victory over Butler in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 27. Fields scattered three walks and racked up 11 strikeouts, a total that set a season high and tied a career high. Coincidentally, his previous career high of 11 also came in a game against Butler during the 2019 season.
- Fields struck out the side in both the first and fifth innings and retired the first 10 men he faced.
- The righty is up to 36 strikeouts this season, fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. He crossed the 100-career strikeout mark in the win at Butler as he has fanned 105 in 92 1/3 career innings. Opponents are hitting just .141 this season against Fields, who has reached double figures in strikeouts in two of his last three starts.
- Fields has allowed two hits or fewer in three of his five starts this season. He leads the MVC and ranks 25th in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings at 4.50.
- His previous MVC Pitcher of the Week nod came on March 15 following his March 13 no-hitter at Middle Tennessee. Fields also earned Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Pitcher of the Week following the no-no.

Tieman Cracks Top 10: Jon Tieman earned the win in the March 20 extra-inning victory at Western Kentucky by virtue of 3 2/3 innings of scoreless relief. He yielded two hits and no walks while striking out five. He passed Jim Pomeroy (202, 1996-1999) for 10th on Valpo's all-time strikeout list, and later moved into ninth during the series at DBU by surpassing Chuck Donley (1991-1995, 212).

The 200 Club

- Valpo fifth-year senior Jon Tieman became just the 11th pitcher in Valpo history to reach the career 200-strikeout milestone on Saturday, March 13 at Middle Tennessee. The milestone came in a significant moment as he struck out the final batter of the bottom of the eighth in a game that was scheduled for seven innings to preserve a 3-2 victory. The Blue Raiders had the potential tying run at third and winning run at second at the time of the strikeout.
- The right-handed hurler became just the second Valpo player to reach that milestone in the last decade, joining Dalton Lundeen (2013-2016).
- Tieman ranks in the top 15 nationally for career strikeouts.
- Tieman led the team in strikeouts three straight years from 2017-2019.

No-No Notes

- Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.
- The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.
- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.
- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.
- After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.
- Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the third inning of the no-hitter was an "immaculate inning" with all three batters going down on three straight strikes.
- Fields is a Valpo baseball legacy student-athlete as his father Timm played for Valpo in the late 1980s.

Closing Time

- At the same time he achieved his 200th career strikeout, Jon Tieman nailed down his eighth career save in the 3-2, eight-inning win over Middle Tennessee on March 13.
- Tieman moved up a place on the program's all-time saves list, climbing into a tie with Chip Pettit (1993-1996) and teammate Easton Rhodehouse for seventh in Valpo history in career saves.
- The save marked Tieman's first save since his freshman season in 2017, when he served as the club's closer and nailed down seven saves before moving into the rotation late in the year. Tieman's save on March 13 marked his first since April 8, 2017 vs. Northern Kentucky, a span of 1,435 days.

Pitching Profiles – Projected Starters

- RHP Easton Rhodehouse (R-Sr., Gilbert, Ariz. / Gilbert) Expected to start the first game of each series in an "opener" role each weekend... Named 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention and to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team in 2017. Also received 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete Honorable Mention... Did not allow an earned run in any of his five conference outings in 2018 with opponents hitting just .211 against him in conference play... Finished the 2019 season with a teambest 3.82 ERA over 22 appearances out of the bullpen, grabbing two wins to go along with four saves... Secured 44 strikeouts while walking 13 in 35 1/3 innings in 2019... Was one of four players in the nation to start six games during the 2020 season, tying for the NCAA Division-I lead in that category. Ranked third on the team with a 3.45 ERA and struck out a team-high 20 while issuing just four bases on balls over 15 2/3 innings... 2020 Valparaiso University graduate with a degree in political science... Currently pursuing an MBA... Spent the 2018 summer doing grassroots volunteer work for a political campaign... Hobbies include skateboarding and mountain biking... Picked up the win by allowing one run on two hits over two innings in the Feb. 19 season opener at UAB, when he became the first Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen (2014, 2015) to start consecutive Opening Days... Went two innings and gave up one run on two hits while striking out four in his Feb. 26 start at Jacksonville State... Pitched two shutout innings of hitless ball in his start on March 12 at Middle Tennessee, striking out four and issuing no walks... allowed one run on three hits in two innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky, then absorbed the loss on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Dame after allowing two runs on just one hit in 1 2/3 innings... Struck out seven and allowed one hit over 4 1/3 shutout innings in two appearances during the three-game series at Butler March 26-27.
- RHP Ryan Mintz (So., Lombard, Ill. / Willowbrook) Although not technically a starter this weekend, Mintz is expected to follow Rhodehouse in long relief in Game 1 of the series... Set his high school's record for wins by a pitcher in the program's 60-year history... Was named West Suburban Gold Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for his work at Willowbrook... The Lombard, Ill. native is majoring in computer engineering... Hobbies include snowboarding and other extreme sports... Made five appearances and two starts during the COVID-19 shortened season... Notched a season-high five strikeouts in just three innings on March 10 at Alabama

State, his final outing of the year... Equaled a career high with five strikeouts over six innings of relief in Valpo's season-opening win at UAB on Feb. 19... Logged 4 1/3 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on two hits in 4 1/3 innings on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State... Took the defeat on March 12 at Middle Tennessee but issued just one walk against five strikeouts... Took the defeat after striking out five in 4 2/3 innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky... Allowed just one run on five hits over 3 2/3 innings of relief on April 1 at DBU.

- RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the

Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2019 second on the team in strikeouts with 52... Made four starts during the 2020 season and ranked second on the team with 17 strikeouts, including a season-high six on Feb. 29 vs. Southern Miss... Carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning before taking a toughluck loss in his first outing of the year on Feb. 21 at UAB. He permitted one hit and was charged with one unearned run that crossed the dish following his departure over his 4 1/3 inning start that featured eight strikeouts. That marked the third game in his career with eight strikeouts or more... Took the defeat in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three outs) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0... Allowed just two runs on six hits and one walk while striking out five in his five-inning start on March 20 at Western Kentucky... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27. - RHP Trent Turzenski (So., Burlington, Wis. / Burlington) -Expected to serve as Valpo's Saturday starter... Ranked seventh in the MVC in ERA and 11th in opponents' batting average (.236) as a freshman in 2020... Ranked No. 18 on D1Baseball.com's 2020 list of the Top 50 freshmen pitchers in the nation based on analytics... Had a team-best 2.48 ERA in 2020 over four games out of the bullpen... Struck out 16 against just six walks over 19 innings, sharing the team's heaviest workload... Struck out 11 while walking just one in six innings on Feb. 28, 2020 at McNeese... Played in the Little League World Series Regional Tournament on ESPN twice, when he was 11 and 12 years old... Took the defeat after allowing two runs on just three hits in four innings in his first outing of the season on Feb. 20 at UAB... Allowed four runs (three earned) on six hits while striking out six over five innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Followed the Fields no-hitter with a strong pitching performance of his own in Game 2 of a the March 13 doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, going seven innings to pick up the victory while allowing two runs on three hits and one walk

with eight strikeouts... Took the defeat on March 21 at Western Kentucky.
