**Next Up in Valpo Baseball**: At long last, the Valparaiso University baseball team will host home games this weekend. For the first time since May 14, 2019, Valpo will play on its home field as Southern Illinois comes to town for a four-game, Missouri Valley Conference series. The series will begin with a doubleheader on Friday starting at noon. That will mark the first games on the new Emory G. Bauer Field turf.

Last Time Out: Valpo dropped all four games in a road series at No. 23 Indiana State. Brady Renfro batted a team-best .333 during the series and launched a home run. Riley Dent posted a .308 average over the four games.

**On the Air**: Games will be broadcast on the Valpo Sports Network (95.1 FM Valparaiso, TuneIn Radio app) over the course of the weekend. Links to live audio and stats will be available on ValpoAthletics.com.

**Series Notes**: Valpo holds a 6-3 lead in the all-time series with Southern Illinois and a 4-2 mark in Missouri Valley Conference matchups. The Brown & Gold swept all four from the Salukis in the most recent series between the two clubs, May 10-12, 2019 at Emory G. Bauer Field. Valpo won the opener of that set 5-4 in 14 innings behind a stellar relief outing by Easton Rhodehouse, who did not allow a hit or run over six dominant innings of relief while striking out eight. Rhodehouse earned conference and national Pitcher of the Week honors for that effort. Valpo went on to take the final two games of the series 7-1 and 4-1. The all-time set began in 1966 when the two teams faced off in an NCAA University Division Playoff Game in Columbus, Ohio, a 4-3 Valpo victory.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Schmack's win total of 137 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former big-league pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

### **Road Warriors**

Valpo will finally play its first home game of the season on Friday when Southern Illinois comes to town. Head coach Brian Schmack's group is the only team in the nation that has not played a home game in 2021. Indiana State was the second-to-last team nationally to play at home when it hosted Valpo last weekend. Valpo has played 45 straight games away from Emory G. Bauer Field since its last home date, a 4-3 victory over Chicago State on May 14, 2019. Valpo's last home series was against these same Salukis on May 10-12, 2019.

### **Turf** Time

The Valpo home opener will mark the debut of the new-look Emory G. Bauer Field, which now features synthetic infield turf. The project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.

### Lengthy Streaks

A pair of lengthy individual streaks came to an end during Valpo's series at Indiana State (April 16-18). Freshman first baseman Kyle Schmack saw his 12-game hitting streak reach its conclusion. That marked the program's longest such streak since Nate Palace's 14 gamer in 2017. In addition, senior outfielder Steven Fitzsimmons saw his on-base streak end at 18. He became the first Valpo player to reach that number since Giovanni Garbella in 2018. Valpo's longest active on-base streak now belongs to Brady Renfro, who enters this weekend's series against the Salukis having reached in 13 straight.

#### **Dent Doing Damage**

- Riley Dent has been the team's biggest offensive bright spot during conference play as he owns a .370 batting average over eight MVC games, by far the team leader.

- Dent is hitting a team-best .378 over the last 10 games after starting his senior season with a .155 average over his first 15 appearances.

- Dent enjoyed a career performance in Game 2 of the April 2 doubleheader at DBU, posting a four-hit game that featured three extra-base knocks. One of those extra-base hits was his third home run of the season, part of his career-high four hits. He became the first Valpo player with a four-hit output since March 2019. Dent totaled 12 bases over the four games, driving in three runs and drawing three walks while four of his six hits went for extra bases.

- Dent led the team with a .311 batting average during the shortened 2020 season and batted .290 in 2019, a breakout season after he entered that year with a .207 career average through his first two collegiate campaigns.

### Notes Wrapping Up Indiana State (April 16-18)

- Valpo has now played five games against nationally-ranked competition this season - a midweek game at No. 14 Notre Dame on March 23 and the four-game set with the No. 23 Sycamores.

- Easton Rhodehouse started as an "opener" in the Friday game and went two scoreless frames while yielding three hits. The righty has allowed two earned runs or fewer in all 11 appearances this season, and he now has 29 strikeouts against just five walks in 22 innings.

- Valpo pitching issued just one walk against eight strikeouts in the series opener – a 5-0 setback – the fourth time this season the team allowed one walk or fewer.

- Jonathan Temple broke up a no-hit bid from Indiana State's Connor Cline in the seventh and final inning of Game 1 of the Saturday doubleheader. Temple dashed the no-hit hopes and shutout in one fell swoop with a pinch-hit, RBI double in the top of the seventh.

- Renfro walked in each of his three plate appearances in the first game of the Saturday doubleheader, while the Valpo bullpen marked a bright spot of the nightcap. Nathan Chasey and Nolan Lebamoff combined to go 4 1/3 innings without allowing an earned

run in a 6-2 setback.

- Indiana State prevailed 12-1 in seven innings in the series finale, a game that saw Renfro homer to move into a tie for the team lead with three. He enjoyed a multi-hit output in the Sunday contest.

### Notes Wrapping Up DBU (April 1-3)

- Brady Renfro and Parker Johnson hit back-to-back home runs in the eighth inning of Saturday's series finale, becoming the second Valpo tandem to go back-to-back this season. Damon Jorgensen and Jeremy Drudge turned the trick on March 19 at Western Kentucky.

Valpo had five doubles in the nightcap of the Friday doubleheader, the team's first game with five or more doubles since May 8, 2018 at Western Michigan.
Valpo had 14 hits in Game 3 of the series, outhitting the Patriots 14-10. That hit total marked the team's second-highest of the season behind 15 on March 20 at Western Kentucky.

- The one-run setback (9-8) in Game 3 of the series marked Valpo's third defeat by the slimmest of margins in 2021.

- Nolan Lebamoff allowed no earned runs on two hits and no walks while striking out three over 3 2/3 innings in two relief appearances at DBU.

### In the Other Dugout: Southern Illinois

The Salukis started the season 14-0 and cracked top-25 national rankings.
The team has incurred three straight setbacks, dropping three of four in last weekend's series at Bradley.

- SIU is under the direction of second-year head coach Lance Rhodes, who previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Missouri. - Brad Hudson holds the team's top batting average at .388 with two home runs and 14 RBIs in 26 games. Tristan Peters has started all 34 games and owns a .372 average, 12 stolen bases, two home runs, 30 RBIs and a .490 OBP. - Noah Farmer leads the pitching staff with a 3.00 ERA and 4-2 record in 13 appearances, 11 of which have come in relief.

### **Tieman Strikeout Tracker**

- Senior pitcher Jon Tieman became just the 11th pitcher in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts earlier this year.

- The right-handed hurler became the second Valpo player to reach that milestone in the last decade, joining Dalton Lundeen (2013-2016).

- Tieman ranks 24th nationally among active players with 218 career strikeouts. He has climbed to eighth in program history, most recently surpassing Richard Beumer (1959-1962, 217).

- Tieman led the team in strikeouts three straight years from 2017-2019.

### Twice is Nice

- Valpo pitcher Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second time in a three-week span on March 29.

- Fields became the first Valpo player to win two MVC weekly honors in the same season since the program joined The Valley. In addition, he became the first MVC player to win two weekly honors this season. - The most recent accolade came after the junior yielded just two hits over seven shutout innings to propel Valpo to a 7-1 victory over Butler in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 27. Fields scattered three walks and racked up 11 strikeouts, a total that set a season high and tied a career high. Coincidentally, his previous career high of 11 also came in a game against Butler during the 2019 season.

- Fields struck out the side in both the first and fifth innings and retired the first 10 men he faced.

- The righty is up to 36 strikeouts this season, fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. He crossed the 100-career strikeout mark in the win at Butler as he has fanned 105 in 92 1/3 career innings. Opponents are hitting just .141 this season against Fields, who has reached double figures in strikeouts in two of his last three starts.

- Fields has allowed two hits or fewer in three of his five starts this season. He leads the MVC and ranks 25th in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings at 4.50.

- His previous MVC Pitcher of the Week nod came on March 15 following his March 13 no-hitter at Middle Tennessee. Fields also earned Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Pitcher of the Week following the no-no.

### **No-No Notes**

- Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.

- The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.

- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.

- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.

- After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.

- Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the

#### **Closing Time**

At the same time he achieved his 200th career strikeout, Jon Tieman nailed down his eighth career save in the 3-2, eight-inning win over Middle Tennessee on March 13.
Tieman moved up a place on the program's all-time saves list, climbing into a tie with Chip Pettit (1993-1996) and teammate Easton Rhodehouse for seventh in Valpo history in career saves.

- The save marked Tieman's first save since his freshman season in 2017, when he served as the club's closer and nailed down seven saves before moving into the rotation late in the year. Tieman's save on March 13 marked his first since April 8, 2017 vs. Northern Kentucky, a span of 1,435 days.

#### **Pitching Profiles – Projected Starters**

- RHP Ryan Mintz (So., Lombard, Ill. / Willowbrook) - Set his high school's record for wins by a pitcher in the program's 60-year history... Was named West Suburban Gold Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for his work at Willowbrook... The Lombard, Ill. native is majoring in computer engineering... Hobbies include snowboarding and other extreme sports... Made five appearances and two starts during the COVID-19 shortened season... Notched a season-high five strikeouts in just three innings on March 10 at Alabama State, his final outing of the year... Equaled a career high with five strikeouts over six innings of relief in Valpo's season-opening win at UAB on Feb. 19... Logged 4 1/3 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on two hits in 4 1/3 innings on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State... Took the defeat on March 12 at Middle Tennessee but issued just one walk against five strikeouts... Took the defeat after striking out five in 4 2/3 innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky... Allowed just one run on five hits over 3 2/3 innings of relief on April 1 at DBU... Is projected to make his first start of the season and the third of his career on Friday, April 23 against Southern Illinois... He pitched 3 2/3 innings or more in all seven long relief appearances including a pair of six-inning outings, usually following opener Easton Rhodehouse in the first game of each weekend series.

- RHP Easton Rhodehouse (R-Sr., Gilbert, Ariz. / Gilbert) – Named 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention and to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team in 2017. Also received 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete Honorable Mention... Did not allow an earned run in any of his five conference outings in 2018 with opponents hitting just .211 against him in conference play... Finished the 2019 season with a teambest 3.82 ERA over 22 appearances out of the bullpen, grabbing two wins to go along with four saves... Secured 44 strikeouts while walking 13 in 35 1/3 innings in 2019... Was one of four players in the nation to start six games during the 2020 season, tying for the NCAA Division-I lead in that category. Ranked third on the team with a 3.45 ERA and struck out a team-high 20 while issuing just four bases on balls over 15 2/3 innings... 2020 Valparaiso University graduate with a degree in political science... Currently pursuing an MBA... Spent the 2018 summer doing grassroots volunteer work for a political campaign... Hobbies include skateboarding and mountain biking... Picked up the win by allowing one run on two hits over two innings in the Feb. 19 season opener at UAB, when he became the first Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen (2014, 2015) to start consecutive Opening Days... Went two innings and gave up one run on two hits while striking out four in his Feb. 26 start at Jacksonville State... Pitched two shutout innings of hitless ball in his start on March 12 at Middle Tennessee, striking out four and issuing no walks... allowed one run on three hits in two innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky, then absorbed the loss on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Dame after allowing two runs on just one hit in 1 2/3 innings... Struck out seven and allowed one hit over 4 1/3 shutout innings in two appearances during the three-game series at Butler March 26-27... Started as an "opener" in the Friday, April 16 game at Indiana State and went two scoreless frames while yielding three hits.

- RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) - Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2019 second on the team in strikeouts with 52... Made four starts during the 2020 season and ranked second on the team with 17 strikeouts, including a season-high six on Feb. 29 vs. Southern Miss... Carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning before taking a toughluck loss in his first outing of the year on Feb. 21 at UAB. He permitted one hit and was charged with one unearned run that crossed the dish following his departure over his 4 1/3 inning start that featured eight strikeouts. That marked the third game in his career with eight strikeouts or more... Took the defeat in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three outs) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0... Allowed just two runs on six hits and one walk while striking out five in his five-inning start on March 20 at Western Kentucky... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27. - RHP Zach Fricke (Jr., Arlington Heights, Ill.) - The right hander made his way into the weekend rotation as a freshman in 2019. He put together a string of three straight wins late in the season in starts against Evansville, Bradley and Southern Illinois, going 3-0 with a 2.14 ERA and opponents hitting .214 against him... That stretch late in the 2019 campaign was highlighted by a complete game victory on May 11 vs. Southern

Illinois... Fricke played four years of baseball at Buffalo Grove High School while also playing basketball (three letters) and golf (two letters)... He had a propensity for drawing walks during his playing days, ranking third all-time with 104 bases on balls. Shaikin, who ranks fifth in program history with 392 assists, is the team's infield coach.
