Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will face off with a nationally-ranked opponent for the sixth time this season as the team makes its way to Notre Dame on Tuesday afternoon to battle the No. 8 Fighting Irish in midweek action. This marks the second of three matchups between the instate foes this season. Valpo will hope to carry the momentum garnered during a series win this past weekend into the nonconference tilt.

Last Time Out: Valpo opened its new field turf in memorable fashion, sweeping a doubleheader from Southern Illinois on Friday by winning both games in walk-off style. Jonathan Temple smashed a game-ending home run in the bottom of the ninth of the opener before Riley Dent walked it off with a single in the bottom of the seventh of Game 2. After dropping the Saturday game, Valpo clinched the series with a 4-2 triumph on Sunday behind a strong pitching performance from Zach Fricke.

On the Air: The game will be broadcast on ACC Network Extra. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com.

Series Notes: Notre Dame leads 77-21 in the all-time series, which dates all the way back to 1958. Each of the last three matchups have been tight with Notre Dame winning 6-3 on March 23 of this season, 4-3 on April 23, 2019 and 6-5 on April 25, 2018. Valpo has lost nine straight head-to-head meetings since a 7-4 triumph on May 2, 2012.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Entering the season, Schmack's win total of 136 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former bigleague pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

A Grand Opening

- Valpo debuted its new infield turf at Emory G. Bauer Field in style by sweeping a doubleheader from Southern Illinois on Friday, April 23. Valpo won both games in walk-off fashion, winning 7-6 behind a ninth-inning homer by Jonathan Temple in Game 1 before enjoying a 4-3 triumph on a Riley Dent walk-off hit in the bottom of the seventh of Game 2.

- The Temple walk-off home run was Valpo's first since Zack Leone drilled one on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley. Both came on special occasions as Leone's provided Valpo's first-ever Missouri Valley Conference win, while Temple's came in the first game on the new turf.

- Valpo swept a doubleheader for the second time this season after previously taking both from Middle Tennessee State on March 13.

- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.

Road Warriors

- When Valpo lifted the lid on its home slate on April 23, it became the final team in the nation to open the home portion of its schedule.

- The team snapped a stretch of 45 consecutive games away from home dating back to May 14, 2019, a 4-3 victory over Chicago State.

- Playing home games is always important in terms of results as Valpo has finished with a winning record at home in four of the last five seasons and 11 of the last 13 campaigns.

Walk-Off Wins

Valpo accomplished the rare feat of achieving two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of Southern Illinois. Here is the full list of walk-off wins during the Brian Schmack Era at Valpo. The Dent walk-off single in Game 2 on April 23 was Valpo's 10th walk-off victory under Schmack.

Pitching Prowess

- The Valpo pitching staff racked up 45 strikeouts in 34 innings of work during the series win vs. Southern Illinois (April 23-25).

2021

- Zach Fricke had a career-high nine strikeouts and did not allow an earned run over his six innings on Sunday, April 25. He earned his first win of the season while yielding just four hits and walking one.

- Jon Tieman made his first start of the year in Game 1 of the doubleheader on Friday, April 23 and tossed five frames while scattering six hits and racking up nine strikeouts against one walk.

- Easton Rhodehouse appeared in three of the four games in the series and totaled five innings while permitting just one earned run, walking two and striking out six. He garnered a win and a save in the series. The save was his first of the year and the ninth of his career, moving him into a tie with Adam Paetznick (2001-2004) for sixth in the program record book in career saves.

Probable Pitcher: Griffin McCluskey, Fr., RHP

- Has made five appearances spanning 7 2/3 innings this season.
- Will make his first start of the year on Tuesday.
- Enjoys playing the guitar.

- Qualified for state in golf in high school and finished in the top 10 in school history for 3-point field goals in basketball.

A Look Back at the First Matchup: Notre Dame 6, Valpo 3 (March 23)

- Valpo showed well against the Fighting Irish, who were ranked No. 14 nationally at that time. The Brown & Gold held a 3-2 lead through five, but the hosts scored two in the sixth and two in the seventh in a game where each team had seven hits.

- Jeremy Drudge had his first triple of the season.

- Zach Fricke made his first start of the season, allowing two runs on four hits and one walk in four innings. He received no decision.

Valpo vs. Ranked Foes: Valpo will take on a nationally-ranked opponent for the sixth time this season on Tuesday. The Brown & Gold previously matched up with the Fighting Irish on March 23 at Frank Eck Stadium on Notre Dame's campus. In addition, Valpo visited No. 23 Indiana State for a four-game conference series April 16-18, dropping all four. Prior to this year, Valpo last faced nationally-ranked competition on Feb. 21-23, 2020 at No. 3 Louisville. In recent years, the program has Top-25 wins over No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).

In the Other Dugout: Notre Dame

- Coming off a series win over Boston College, bouncing back with 5-2 and 13-9 victories after dropping the opener 10-0.

- Ranked sixth nationally by Baseball America, eighth by D1Baseball.com and 14th by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as those publications rolled out their latest polls on Monday.

- Led offensively by Carter Putz, who owns a .345 batting average. Niko Kavadas leads the team in the power categories with 15 homers and 36 RBIs in 28 games.

Tieman Strikeout Tracker

- Senior Jon Tieman became just the 11th pitcher in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts earlier this year.

The right-handed hurler became the second Valpo player to reach that milestone in the last decade, joining Dalton Lundeen (2013-2016).
Tieman ranks 24th nationally among active players with 227 career

strikeouts. He has climbed to seventh in program history, most recently surpassing Tom Starck (2001-2004, 222).

- Tieman led the team in strikeouts three straight years from 2017-2019.

Lengthy Streaks

A pair of lengthy individual streaks came to an end during Valpo's series at Indiana State (April 16-18). Freshman first baseman Kyle Schmack saw his 12-game hitting streak reach its conclusion. That marked the program's longest such streak since Nate Palace's 14 gamer in 2017. In addition, senior outfielder Steven Fitzsimmons saw his on-base streak end at 18. He became the first Valpo player to reach that number since Giovanni Garbella in 2018.

Notes Wrapping Up Indiana State (April 16-18)

- Valpo has now played five games against nationally-ranked competition this season – a midweek game at No. 14 Notre Dame on March 23 and the four-game set with the No. 23 Sycamores.

- Easton Rhodehouse started as an "opener" in the Friday game and went two scoreless frames while yielding three hits. The righty has allowed two earned runs or fewer in all 11 appearances this season, and he now has 29 strikeouts against just five walks in 22 innings.

- Valpo pitching issued just one walk against eight strikeouts in the series opener – a 5-0 setback – the fourth time this season the team allowed one walk or fewer.

- Jonathan Temple broke up a no-hit bid from Indiana State's Connor Cline in the seventh and final inning of Game 1 of the Saturday doubleheader. Temple dashed the no-hit hopes and shutout in one fell swoop with a pinch-hit, RBI double in the top of the seventh.

- Renfro walked in each of his three plate appearances in the first game of the Saturday doubleheader, while the Valpo bullpen marked a bright spot of the nightcap. Nathan Chasey and Nolan Lebamoff combined to go 4 1/3 innings without allowing an earned run in a 6-2 setback.

- Indiana State prevailed 12-1 in seven innings in the series finale, a game that saw Renfro homer to move into a tie for the team lead with three. He enjoyed a multi-hit output in the Sunday contest.

Twice is Nice

- Valpo pitcher Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second time in a three-week span on March 29.

- Fields became the first Valpo player to win two MVC weekly honors in the same season since the program joined The Valley. In addition, he became the first MVC player to win two weekly honors this season.

- The most recent accolade came after the junior yielded just two hits over seven shutout innings to propel Valpo to a 7-1 victory over Butler in Game 1 of a double-header on March 27. Fields scattered three walks and racked up 11 strikeouts, a total that set a season high and tied a career high. Coincidentally, his previous career high of 11 also came in a game against Butler during the 2019 season.

- Fields struck out the side in both the first and fifth innings and retired the first 10 men he faced.

No-No Notes

- Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.

- The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.

- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.

- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.

After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.
Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the third inning of the no-hitter was an "immaculate inning" with all three batters going down on three straight strikes.

- Fields is a Valpo baseball legacy student-athlete as his father Timm played for Valpo in the late 1980s.

Position Player Profiles – Projected Lineup Based on Recent Games - Steven Fitzsimmons, OF, Sr. (Golden Valley, Minn. / Robbinsdale Cooper)

- Was a member of the 2019 and 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team... Had a

breakout junior season in 2019, playing in 49 of the team's 50 games and making 45 starts after playing in 16 games and making three starts as a sophomore... Went from a career .195 hitter with one double over his first two seasons to batting .268 with nine doubles as a junior... ... Graduated in May 2020 with a 3.96 GPA in political science... Pursuing a master's in sports administration... Played in 13 games and made 12 starts during the 2020 season... Batted a team-best .308 over the opening series at UAB including a three-hit performance in the Feb. 19 victory. He posted his first game with three or more hits since mid-May 2019 while also scoring a career-high three runs and accounting for half of the team's hits in the season-opening triumph... Hit a team-best .444 in a three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27, going 4-for-9 with a .583 on-base percentage... Reached safely in all four games at DBU (April 1-3) to extend his on-base streak to 18, becoming the first Valpo player with such a streak since 2018. The on-base streak ended at 18.

- Kyle Schmack, 1B/OF, Fr. (Wanatah, Ind. / South Central) – After graduating from nearby South Central High School in 2019, Kyle joined his father Brian's program at Valpo... Is the first Valpo student-athlete to play for his or her parent as a head coach since Bryce Drew in 1998... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Reached base three times via a hit and two walks in the Feb. 21 series finale at UAB... Went 5-for-12 (.417) in the three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27... Hit safely in all four games at DBU (April 1-3) to bolster his hitting streak to 12, the program's longest since 2017. The hitting streak ended at a dozen games.

- Riley Dent, OF, Sr. (Long Beach, Calif. / Wilson) - Was a 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention recipient... Entered the 2019 season with a .207 career batting average, but had a breakout year that saw him hit .290 as a junior. Moved to the leadoff spot and transitioned to center field for his junior campaign... Tied for the 2019 team lead with 15 multi-hit outputs... Led the team in batting average at .311 while starting all 16 games in 2020 in addition to ranking second on the team with 11 bases on balls and leading the team in both slugging percentage (.410) and onbase percentage (.417)... Graduated in May 2020 with a degree in marketing and is now enrolled in Valpo's graduate school... Launched his first home run of the season in a March 20, 2021 victory at Western Kentucky, the second dinger of his career. Ironically, both of his career long balls have come at WKU in separate seasons as he launched the first of his career in a 2020 game in Bowling Green, Ky... Had two hits in each game of the March 27 doubleheader at Butler... Had the first four-hit game by a Valpo player this season, establishing a new career high in that area on April 2 at DBU in Game 2 of a doubleheader. Three of the four hits went for extra bases as he doubled twice and launched a home run... Posted a .308 batting average during Valpo's four-game series at No. 23 Indiana State (April 16-18)... Had a walk-off single to help Valpo beat SIU 4-3 in Game 2 of an April 23 doubleheader.

(West Terre Haute, Ind. / West Vigo) – In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, both of Valpo's starting corner infielders are the sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Civil engineering major... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Had a two-hit day in the Saturday game at UAB on Feb. 20, his first two collegiate knocks on a day where freshmen accounted for four of the team's eight hits... Ripped his first collegiate home run in the second game of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee on March 13... Led the team with two hits on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Damew... Had a career-high five RBIs in the first game of a doubleheader at Butler on March 27 and finished the day with five hits, three runs scored, three RBIs and three walks over the two games.
