**Next Up in Valpo Baseball:** The Valparaiso University baseball team will enjoy another home weekend beginning on Friday afternoon as Illinois State comes to town to kick off a four-game set. Valpo will attempt to sustain the positive momentum generated during last weekend's series victory over Southern Illinois and a solid midweek performance at No. 8 Notre Dame.

**Last Time Out:** Valpo gave the nation's No. 8 team all it could handle on Tuesday night near South Bend, but host Notre Dame prevailed 8-7. Kyle Schmack drilled a go-ahead, bases-clearing double to highlight a four-run fifth for the Brown & Gold, who also received three hits from Kaleb Hannahs and two from Alex Thurston. Valpo outhit Notre Dame 9-7. Schmack's three RBIs marked a career high, making him the third Valpo player with a three-RBI game this season. Notre Dame entered the matchup ranked eighth by D1Baseball.com, sixth by Baseball America, 13th by the NCBWA, 14th by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and ninth by the USA Today Coaches' Poll.

**On the Air:** Radio coverage throughout the weekend will be available on the Valpo Sports Network, 95.1 FM WVUR. Links to live audio and stats can be found on ValpoAthletics.com.

**Series Notes:** Valpo is 9-23-1 in a series that dates back to an NCAA College Division Playoff game in 1969. Valpo won the most recent matchup between the two teams 4-2 on April 6, 2019, but the Redbirds took two of three in the series. Since joining The Valley, Valpo is 2-4 against Illinois State.

**Schmack in the Record Book:** Entering this weekend, Valpo head coach Brian Schmack owns 144 career victories. He is within striking distance of tying or passing Rick Ferchen (1982-1987) for fourth in program history during the weekend set against the Redbirds.

**Head Coach Brian Schmack:** Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his eighth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2021 season, he has served as the head coach for 336 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into a tie for third in program history for number of seasons coached with eight, matching Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Schmack has now been at Valpo longer than his predecessor Woodson, whose seven-year run lasted from 2007-2013. Entering the season, Schmack's win total of 136 ranks fifth in program history, with Rick Ferchen fourth at 147. The former big-league pitcher led Valparaiso to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. He followed that up with a 22-win season in 2015, then guided the team to its first winning record since 2013 in 2016. In 2017, Schmack continued his success despite managing a youthful roster that featured 11 freshmen and 15 total newcomers. He led his team to 24 wins, including a strong finish to the regular season that saw them win eight of their last 11. The 2018 season saw Valpo transition to the Missouri Valley Conference. The Brown & Gold made an immediate splash in the highly-respected baseball league, putting together a strong showing in the 2018 MVC Tournament, including a 13-10 victory over host Dallas Baptist, a team that went on to receive an at-large NCAA Regional berth. During the 2019 season, Schmack's squad equaled its win total from the year prior despite playing in a conference that was ranked

sixth nationally in RPI and sent three teams to NCAA Regionals. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

## Who's Hot?

- Riley Dent is hitting a team-best .375 over the last 15 games after starting the season with a .155 average over the first 15 contests.
- Dent hit .429 during the Southern Illinois series, one of four Valpo players to bat .400 or better.
- Matt Olive went 5-for-9 in the series, while Parker Johnson (.462) and Angel DiFederico (.455) had robust weekends at the plate as well. Johnson and DiFederico drove in four runs apiece during the set.
- Brady Renfro has reached base in 18 consecutive games, tying with Steven Fitzsimmons for Valpo's longest on-base streak this season. Prior to this season, Valpo's last 18-game on-base streak was Giovanni Garbella in 2018. The last Valpo player to reach in 19 or more games consecutively was current volunteer assistant coach Sam Shaikin, who reached in 23 in a row in 2017.

## A Grand Opening

- Valpo debuted its new infield turf at Emory G. Bauer Field in style by sweeping a doubleheader from Southern Illinois on Friday, April 23. Valpo won both games in walk-off fashion, winning 7-6 behind a ninth-inning homer by Jonathan Temple in Game 1 before enjoying a 4-3 triumph on a Riley Dent walk-off hit in the bottom of the seventh of Game 2.
- The Temple walk-off home run was Valpo's first since Zack Leone drilled one on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley. Both came on special occasions as Leone's provided Valpo's first-ever Missouri Valley Conference win, while Temple's came in the first game on the new turf.
- Valpo swept a doubleheader for the second time this season after previously taking both from Middle Tennessee State on March 13.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzwow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.

## Walk-Off Wins

Valpo accomplished the rare feat of achieving two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of Southern Illinois. Here is the full list of walk-off wins during the Brian Schmack Era at Valpo. The Dent walk-off single in Game 2 on April 23 was Valpo's 10th walk-off victory under Schmack.

## Road Warriors

- When Valpo lifted the lid on its home slate on April 23, it became the final team in the nation to open the home portion of its schedule.
- The team snapped a stretch of 45 consecutive games away from home dating back to May 14, 2019, a 4-3 victory over Chicago State.
- Playing home games is always important in terms of results as Valpo has finished with a winning record at home in four of the last five seasons and 11 of the last 13 campaigns.

## Pitching Prowess

- The Valpo pitching staff racked up 45 strikeouts in 34 innings of work during the series win vs. Southern Illinois (April 23-25).
- Zach Fricke had a career-high nine strikeouts and did not allow an earned run over his six innings on Sunday, April 25. He earned his first win of the season while yielding just four hits and walking one.
- Jon Tieman made his first start of the year in Game 2 of the doubleheader on Friday, April 23 and tossed five frames while scattering six hits and racking up nine strikeouts against one walk.
- Easton Rhodehouse appeared in three of the four games in the series and totaled five innings while permitting just one earned run, walking two and striking out six. He garnered a win and a save in the series. The save was his first of the year and the ninth of his career, moving him into a tie with Adam Paetznick (2001-2004) for sixth in the program record book in career saves.

## In The Other Dugout: Illinois State

- Coming off a 12-0 victory over SIUE in midweek action after taking three of four from Evansville last weekend.
- Bring a four-game winning streak with them to Emory G. Bauer Field.
- Earned an NCAA Regional at-large berth in 2019 and won two regional games, beating Indiana and host Louisville.
- Picked to finish second behind only DBU in the Missouri Valley Conference Preseason Poll.
- Led offensively by Tyson Hays, who is hitting .375 in 31 games. Ryan Cermak has team highs in doubles (8), triples (4) and home runs (5), while Jack Butler leads the way in RBIs with 28.
- Both teams in this weekend's series are under the direction of former Major League Baseball players as Illinois State head coach Steve Holm played in the big leagues with the San Francisco Giants (2008-2009) and Minnesota Twins (2011) and Valpo head coach Brian Schmack did so with the Detroit Tigers (2003).

## Tieman Strikeout Tracker

- Senior Jon Tieman became just the 11th pitcher in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts earlier this year.
- The right-handed hurler became the second Valpo player to reach that milestone in the last decade, joining Dalton Lundeen (2013-2016).
- Tieman ranks 24th nationally among active players with 227 career strikeouts. He has climbed to seventh in program history, most recently surpassing Tom Starck (2001-2004, 222).
- Tieman led the team in strikeouts three straight years from 2017-2019.

## Lengthy Streaks

A pair of lengthy individual streaks came to an end during Valpo's series at Indiana State (April 16-18). Freshman first baseman Kyle Schmack saw his 12-game hitting streak reach its conclusion. That marked the program's longest such streak since Nate Palace's 14 game in 2017. In addition, senior outfielder Steven Fitzsimmons saw his on-base streak end at 18. He became the first Valpo player to reach that number since Giovanni Garbella in 2018.

## Twice is Nice

- Valpo pitcher Colin Fields was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second time in a three-week span on March 29.
- Fields became the first Valpo player to win two MVC weekly honors in the same season since the program joined The Valley. In addition, he became the first MVC player to win two weekly honors this season.
- The most recent accolade came after the junior yielded just two hits over seven shutout innings to propel Valpo to a 7-1 victory over Butler in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 27. Fields scattered three walks and racked up 11 strikeouts, a total that set a season high and tied a career high. Coincidentally, his previous career high of 11 also came in a game against Butler during the 2019 season.
- Fields struck out the side in both the first and fifth innings and retired the first 10 men he faced.

## No-No Notes

- Colin Fields threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo baseball history and first since 1992 in a 5-0, seven-inning victory at Middle Tennessee State in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Saturday, March 13. The previous Valpo no-no came courtesy of Eric Spillers in a 7-0 victory at Eastern Illinois on March 28, 1992. While it was the eighth no-hitter in program history, it was just the sixth no-no as two of the previous no-hitters were not shutouts.
- The junior right-hander became just the second pitcher in the nation to throw a no-hitter this season, joining Ohio's Joe Rock, who tossed seven no-hit frames as part of a doubleheader vs. Morehead State on Feb. 26. Fields' no-hitter is the third overall in the nation this season as Mississippi State had a combined effort in a nine-inning no-no vs. Kent State on March 7.
- Fields notched the first complete game of his collegiate career and the first by a Valpo pitcher since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois. It was the first shutout by a Valpo pitcher since Ellis Foreman

on April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State, and the team's first shutout since an 8-0 win at SIUE on April 19, 2019.

- Fields racked up 10 strikeouts on his way to Valpo history, his highest single-game strikeout total since his career high of 11 on March 23, 2019 vs. Butler.

- After walking the leadoff batter in the bottom of the first, Fields sent down 19 straight Blue Raiders until the bottom of the seventh. He walked three in the final frame but worked out of the bases-loaded jam to cement the slice of Valpo history.

- Fields accomplished two rare baseball feats in the same game as the third inning of the no-hitter was an "immaculate inning" with all three batters going down on three straight strikes.

- Fields is a Valpo baseball legacy student-athlete as his father Timm played for Valpo in the late 1980s.

## Pitching Profiles – Projected Starters

- **RHP Ryan Mintz (Fr., Lombard, Ill. / Willowbrook)** – Set his high school's record for wins by a pitcher in the program's 60-year history... Was named West Suburban Gold Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2019 for his work at Willowbrook... The Lombard, Ill. native is majoring in computer engineering... Hobbies include snowboarding and other extreme sports... Made five appearances and two starts during the COVID-19 shortened season... Notched a season-high five strikeouts in just three innings on March 10 at Alabama State, his final outing of the year... Equaled a career high with five strikeouts over six innings of relief in Valpo's season-opening win at UAB on Feb. 19... Logged 4 1/3 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on two hits in 4 1/3 innings on Feb. 26 at Jacksonville State... Took the defeat on March 12 at Middle Tennessee but issued just one walk against five strikeouts... Took the defeat after striking out five in 4 2/3 innings on March 19 at Western Kentucky... Allowed just one run on five hits over 3 2/3 innings of relief on April 1 at DBU... Is projected to make his first start of the season and the third of his career on Friday, April 23 against Southern Illinois... He pitched 3 2/3 innings or more in all seven long relief appearances including a pair of six-inning outings, usually following opener Easton Rhodehouse in the first game of each weekend series... Worked five innings and allowed three earned runs while scattering seven hits and issuing no walks in Valpo's eventual series-opening victory vs. Southern Illinois on April 23.

- **RHP Colin Fields (So. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)** – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2019 second on the team in strikeouts with 52... Made four starts during the 2020 season and ranked second on the team with 17 strikeouts, including a season-high six on Feb. 29 vs. Southern Miss... Carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning before taking a tough-luck loss in his first outing of the year on Feb. 21 at UAB. He permitted one hit and was charged with one unearned run that crossed the dish following his departure over his 4 1/3 inning start that featured eight strikeouts. That marked the third game in his career with eight strikeouts or more... Took the defeat in Game 2

of a doubleheader on Feb. 27 at Jacksonville State... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three outs) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0... Allowed just two runs on six hits and one walk while striking out five in his five-inning start on March 20 at Western Kentucky... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27... Reached double figures in strikeouts with 10 while yielding four runs on six hits in five innings in his first home start of the year on April 24 vs. Southern Illinois.

- **RHP Zach Fricke (Jr., Arlington Heights, Ill.)** – The right hander made his way into the weekend rotation as a freshman in 2019. He put together a string of three straight wins late in the season in starts against Evansville, Bradley and Southern Illinois, going 3-0 with a 2.14 ERA and opponents hitting .214 against him... That stretch late in the 2019 campaign was highlighted by a complete game victory on May 11 vs. Southern Illinois... Fricke played four years of baseball at Buffalo Grove High School while also playing basketball (three letters) and golf (two letters)... His younger brother Tyler is a freshman walk-on for the Valpo men's basketball program... Limited the Fighting Irish to two runs on four hits in four innings in his first start of the season on March 23 at No. 12 Notre Dame... Made his first weekend start of the season on April 3 at DBU... Racked up a career-high nine strikeouts while permitting no earned runs (just one unearned tally), four hits and only one walk on April 25 vs. Southern Illinois, earning his first win of the season.

- **Steven Fitzsimmons, OF, Sr. (Golden Valley, Minn. / Robbinsdale Cooper)** – Was a member of the 2019 and 2020 MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team... Had a breakout junior season in 2019, playing in 49 of the team's 50 games and making 45 starts after playing in 16 games and making three starts as a sophomore... Went from a career .195 hitter with one double over his first two seasons to batting .268 with nine doubles as a junior... Graduated in May 2020 with a 3.96 GPA in political science... Pursuing a master's in sports administration... Played in 13 games and made 12 starts during the 2020 season... Batted a team-best .308 over the opening series at UAB including a three-hit performance in the Feb. 19 victory. He posted his first game with three or more hits since mid-May 2019 while also scoring a career-high three runs and accounting for half of the team's hits in the season-opening triumph... Hit a team-best .444 in a three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27, going 4-for-9 with a .583 on-base percentage... Reached safely in all four games at DBU (April 1-3) to extend his on-base streak to 18, becoming

Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Reached base three times via a hit and two walks in the Feb. 21 series finale at UAB... Went 5-for-12 (.417) in the three-game series at Alabama State on Feb. 26-27... Hit safely in all four games at DBU (April 1-3) to bolster his hitting streak to 12, the program's longest since 2017. The hitting streak ended at a dozen games... Had a career-high three RBIs on April 27 at No. 8 Notre Dame, becoming the third Valpo player this season with a three-RBI game. All came on one swing – a go-ahead, bases-clearing double in the fifth.

- **Riley Dent, OF, Sr. (Long Beach, Calif. / Wilson)** – Was a 2019 All-MVC Honorable Mention recipient... Entered the 2019 season with a .207 career batting average, but had a breakout year that saw him hit .290 as a junior. Moved to the leadoff spot and transitioned to center field for his junior campaign... Tied for the 2019 team lead with 15 multi-hit outputs... Led the team in batting average at .311 while starting all 16 games in 2020 in addition to ranking second on the team with 11 bases on balls and leading the team in both slugging percentage (.410) and on-base percentage (.417)... Graduated in May 2020 with a degree in marketing and is now enrolled in Valpo's graduate school... Launched his first home run of the season in a March 20, 2021 victory at Western Kentucky, the second dinger of his career. Ripped his first collegiate home run in the second game of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee on March 13... Led the team with two hits on March 23 at No. 14 Notre Dame... Fletcher was an outfielder in college before moving to catcher in the professional ranks. His father Darrin played in the big leagues from 1989-2002 with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Philadelphia Phillies, Montreal Expos and Toronto Blue Jays. His grandfather Tom also reached the big leagues with the Detroit Tigers in 1962 and his great grandfather Glenn spent 10 seasons in the minor leagues.

- A familiar name to Valpo fans took over as the volunteer assistant coach prior to the 2020 season. Sam Shaikin spent the previous four years on the left side of Valpo's infield while earning a degree in business management from the University in 2019. He clubbed 21 home runs and drove in 106 over 187 career games. Shaikin finished ninth in program history in runs scored with 133, while his home run total ranks tied for ninth. He had a propensity for drawing walks during his playing days, ranking third all-time with 104 bases on balls. Shaikin, who ranks fifth in program history with 392 assists, is the team's infield coach.
