Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valpo women's basketball team steps onto its home court at the ARC for the only times in December this week with a pair of contests in a 43-hour span. The Beacons will first host IU Northwest on Thursday evening in an exhibition game before turning around to take on Chicago State on Saturday afternoon.

Previously: Junior Olivia Sims surpassed her career best with a 14-point outing Sunday, tying for team-high honors as the Beacons fell at Purdue by an 83-56 final. Leah Earnest tallied 14 points as well and added a team-best five rebounds, while Valpo racked up 13 total team steals.

Head Coach Mary Evans: Mary Evans is in her sixth year at the helm of the program in 2022-23 and owns a record of 55-97. Evans has made an impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. The 2022-23 season saw Evans lead Valpo to the first win in program history over perennial MVC power Missouri State. The Beacons also won three consecutive road games in Valley play, the first time the program accomplished that feat against three different opponents since 2007.

Series Notes: Valpo and IU Northwest last met in exhibition action on Dec. 31, 2018, an 85-59 Valpo victory. Meredith Hamlet led five players in double figures with 16 points in that game, while Hannah Schaub tallied 11 points and eight assists.

Valpo enjoys a 39-6 advantage in the all-time series with Chicago State, the second-most common opponent in program history. On its home floor at the ARC, Valpo boasts a 20-1 record against the Cougars, including a 95-49 rout in the most recent matchup on Dec. 28, 2019. All 12 Valpo players who took the floor in that contest contributed on the scoresheet, led by 17 points and eight rebounds off the bench from Marlee Profitt.

- Valpo was picked to finish in 10th place in the MVC preseason poll, totaling 162 points, coming in ahead of Evansville and Bradley.
- Valpo is in its seventh season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The Valley was ranked 13th in conference NET last season. The MVC ranked 10th in conference NET in 2021-22, seventh in conference NET in 2020-21 and was eighth in conference RPI in 2019-20.
- ...looking back at last year
- Valpo finished last season with a 7-23 overall record and finished at 5-15 in MVC play, good for 11th in the Valley standings.
- The Beacons earned their first win in program history over perennial MVC power Missouri State.
- Valpo also won three consecutive road games in Valley play, the first time the program accomplished that feat against three different opponents since 2007.
- Ali Saunders was named to the MVC All-Freshman Team.

...at Purdue

- Valpo held Purdue to 34.6% shooting in the first half and forced 13 Boilermaker turnovers in the opening 20 minutes.
- Purdue led 17-12 at the end of the first quarter and scored the final five points of the second quarter to go up 33-25 at halftime.
- Leah Earnest scored the first basket of the second half to pull the Beacons back within six, but Purdue went on an 11-0 run over the next four minutes to gain separation.
- Purdue's lead was 54-38 at the end of the third period, and the Beacons were unable to get any closer than 14 points in the fourth quarter.
- Olivia Sims came off the bench to surpass her previous career high of 12 points with a 14-point afternoon. She also tied her career best with five field goals made.
- Sims shared team-high scoring honors with Earnest, who tallied 14 points of her own, including a 3-for-4 game from the 3-point line.

- For the fourth time this year, the Beacons reached double figures as a team in steals, racking up 13 thefts. Raeven Raye-Redmond led the way with a game-high four steals, while Ava Interrante posted a season-best three steals.
- Valpo shot just 34.5% (19-of-55) from the field, while the Boilermakers hit at a 49.1% (28-of-57) clip. Both teams connected on eight 3-pointers.

...at Western Michigan

- WMU led 18-17 at the end of the first quarter, but Valpo pulled ahead 24-18 at intermission.
- The Broncos used a 12-0 run to lead by as many as six in the third quarter, and WMU was ahead 46-45 with 10 minutes to play.
- WMU extended its lead to as many as eight points early in the fourth quarter, but Valpo rallied to retake the lead with 4:24 to play.
- The Broncos were back in front 64-60 with 2:40 to go before six straight for the Beacons capped by a 3-pointer from Nevaeh Jackson gave them a 66-64 lead with 1:39 to play.
- It was still 66-64 Valpo when Ava Interrante took a charge with four seconds remaining. The Beacons split a pair of free throws after an immediate foul on the inbounds to make it a 3-point game, but WMU's Kaiden Glenn banked in a 3-pointer at the buzzer to force overtime.
- Valpo never led in overtime, as its only field goal came on a triple by Olivia Brown with 2:06 to play which tied the game at 70-70. The Beacons had three possessions in the final 90 seconds with a chance to tie or take the lead, but they went 0-for-3 from the floor and committed a pair of turnovers on those possessions.
- The Beacons hit at a season-best clip from inside the arc, going 23-of-41 (56.1%) from 2-point range as they enjoyed a 46-28 edge in points in the paint. They were just 4-of-16 from 3-point range, however.
- Meanwhile, Valpo limited WMU to 38.7% shooting from the field, but the Broncos hit 10-of-23 from 3-point range.
- Leah Earnest paced Valpo with 22 points and added a game-high 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the year.

___ ...looking ahead

- Valpo will be off for 10 days following the matchup with Chicago State to allow for final exams.
- The Beacons will play their final pre-Christmas games down in DeLand, Fla., facing Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 19 and host Stetson on Dec. 20.

...at the ARC

- Valpo will play 12 regular season home games during the 2023-24 campaign, just two of those nonconference contests.
- The Beacons are 0-1 at home so so far this year and posted a 3-12 record at home last season.

- IU Northwest enters the week with a 5-4 overall record and a 2-1 record in CCAC play, with a Tuesday night game against Indiana Wesleyan on the docket before the RedHawks visit the ARC.
- Just five RedHawks players have seen action in all nine games to date, with Makayla Best leading that group, averaging 13.6 points/game.

@ChiStateWBB

- It's been a busy early-season schedule for the Cougars, who come into the ARC Saturday at 0-13 on the season.
- Saturday's game will be Chicago State's third against an MVC opponent this season, as the Cougars have fallen to Evansville (103-102, 30t) and Illinois State (102-47).
- Jacia Cunningham leads CSU with 13.8 points/game and has also dished out a team-best 25 assists.

A Challenging Early Schedule

- Valpo's early-season schedule has been deceptively strong.
- Five of the Beacons' six opponents to date have winning records, and the group as a whole (as of Tuesday) has a winning percentage this season of .667 (30-15).
- Included among that group is a 7-0 Southern Miss team which defeated then-#19 Ole Miss last weekend, as well as Western Illinois (7-1) and UAB (6-2) with winning percentages of .750 or better.

Homesick No More

- This week provides the lone chances to catch the Beacons at home this month, as the team is in the midst of a stretch where they play nine out of 10 regular season games away from home.
- Since hosting Western Illinois Nov. 18, Valpo played four consecutive true road games coming into this week.
- Then, after taking on the Cougars Saturday, the Beacons will play five more in a row away from home including their first three games of the MVC slate before finally returning home Jan. 12 against Drake.
- Do the math, and the game against Chicago State will be Valpo's lone regular season home game in a stretch of 55 days.

Career Days for Earnest

- Heading into Valpo's Nov. 25 game at UAB, senior Leah Earnest had a career high in the scoring column of 20 points.
- Earnest then outdid that mark in consecutive games.
- She smashed her previous career best at UAB, pouring in 26 points, including matching her career high with three 3-pointers.
- 12 of Earnest's points against the Blazers came during a 17-3 Valpo run spanning the third and fourth quarters, which cut a 17-point deficit to three points.
- Then t Western Michigan, Earnest scored 22 points on 10-of-16 shooting, setting a career best for field goals made. She also grabbed 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the year.

- Earnest has scored in double figures in each of Valpo's first six games of the season and is averaging 16.2 points/game, sixth in the Valley. She also is averaging 7.8 rebounds/game, sixth among Valley players, and is one of three players who ranks among the MVC's top-six in both scoring and rebounding.

I'll Take That

- Twice in the season's first four games, the Beacons had a player rack up eight steals in a game.
- At UAB, it was freshman Saniya Jackson coming off the bench to tally eight thefts one in the first quarter, three in the second quarter and four in the fourth quarter.
- Jackson matched the feat of fellow rookie Raeven Raye-Redmond, who posted eight steals of her own in her collegiate debut against Western Illinois Nov. 18.
- Jackson and Raye-Redmond are two of just 16 D-I players nationally to record eight or more steals in a single game so far this season.
- The duo are now tied for second on Valpo's single-game steals chart, just one off the program single-game record.
- Prior to this year, the last Valpo player to tally eight steals in a game was Jeanette Gray against Houston in the 2002 WNIT.
- Raye-Redmond was the first MVC player to record eight steals in a game since UNI's Ellie Herzberg did so against Indiana State on Feb. 19, 2017.

Stealing It All

- Led by Raye-Redmond's eight steals, Valpo tallied 18 total team steals Nov. 18 against Western Illinois.
- Leah Earnest (3) and Saniya Jackson (2) also registered multiple thefts, as eight Beacons in all recorded at least one steal.
- The 18 steals is the program's best single-game mark since tallying 21 steals at Evansville on Jan. 12, 2020, and is tied for the second-highest output in Evans' tenure as head coach.
- At UAB, paced by Jackson's eight steals, Valpo racked up 16 team steals.
- Seven different players picked up at least one theft, with Olivia Brown setting her best mark in the Valpo uniform with a three-steal afternoon.
- The Beacons were in double figures in steals both games last week as well, tallying 10 steals at Western Michigan and 13 steals at Purdue. They have now posted double-figure steals in four of six games this sesason.
- Per HerHoopStats.com, Valpo ranks 14th nationally in steal rate, while Raeven Raye-Redmond is one of just three players nationally playing at least 10 minutes/game with a steal rate of better than 8% (Notre Dame's Hannah Hidalgo; Minnesota's Niamya Holloway).

Approaching a Milestone

- Fifth-year guard Olivia Brown is approaching the 1,000-point milestone for her collegiate career.
- Brown scored eight points last time out at Purdue, giving her 976 career points.
- In her third season at Valpo, Brown has scored 610 of those points in the Valpo uniform.
- Brown's .397 career 3-point percentage at Valpo ranks third in program history.

Prolific in the Paint

- For those in tune with Valpo's offensive scheme, it probably doesn't come as a surprise that most of the Beacons' 2-point field goals come from inside the paint.
- So far this season, however, it has been even more pronounced.
- Through six games, Valpo has made 85 2-point field goals 83 of which have been registered as field goals in the paint.
- The only exceptions are a Leah Earnest shot at Eastern Illinois which was input as being shot from the block on the edge of the lane line, and an Ava Interrante runner to beat the shot clock last time out at Purdue.
- At Western Michigan, the Beacons enjoyed their most prolific game inside the arc to date this season, as they went 23-for-41 (.561) on 2-point attempts.

Strong Debuts

- Raye-Redmond's effort against WIU was the second straight strong collegiate debut by a Valpo player, as freshman Nevaeh Jackson enjoyed a nice start to her collegiate career in the season opener at Eastern Illinois.
- Jackson played 22 minutes off the bench at EIU, going 4-of-8 from the field including 3-of-6 from 3-point range for 11 points while also adding three rebounds and two assists.
- The 11 points is the best mark for a Valpo freshman in their first collegiate game since Bryce Blood scored 13 against IU Kokomo in the 2017-18 season opener.
- It is the best mark for a freshman in their first collegiate game against a D-I program since Dani Franklin kicked off her stellar career with 14 points in a win over Butler to start the 2014-15 season.
- Jackson went on to start at Southern Miss, the earliest a true freshman has started in her Valpo career since 2017-18.

- Earnest made 22 starts and appeared in all 30 games as a junior in 2022-23, finishing third on the team with 9.8 points/game and leading the team with 7.4 rebounds/game.
- Earnest also ranked third on the team with 28 steals.
- Earnest finished the year ranked sixth among MVC players in rebounding.
- Earnest reached double figures in rebounds nine times and paced Valpo in rebounding on 22 occasions.
- Earnest posted eight double-doubles on the season, most by a Valpo player since 2016-17.
- Earnest scored a career-high 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting and pulled down 10 rebounds in last year's season-opening win at Central Michigan.
- Earnest set her career high on the glass with 14 rebounds last season against Eastern Illinois.

#24 Kayla Preston

- Preston made her collegiate debut in the season opener at Eastern Illinois Nov. 12, scoring five points and grabbing five rebounds.
- Preston averaged a team-high 10.2 points per game as a senior to go with 2.9 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.5 steals per game.
- Preston shot at a 50% clip from the floor.
- Preston helped Millard North [Neb.] H.S. to 23 wins as the Mustangs advanced to the state semifinals.

#25 Ella Van Weelden

- Van Weelden grabbed four rebounds last time out at Purdue.
- Van Weelden scored five points in eight minutes of action at UAB.
- Van Weelden blocked two shots and picked up four rebounds at Southern Miss.
- Van Weelden grabbed five rebounds and tallied a pair of steals off the bench in season opener at Eastern Illinois Nov. 12.
- Van Weelden appeared in 17 games off the bench in her first season of action in 2022-23, averaging 1.6 points/game and 2.0 rebounds/game.
- Van Weelden set her season high in her collegiate debut, scoring nine second-half points while also grabbing six rebounds in win over Southern Miss.
- Van Weelden pulled down a season-best seven rebounds against UAB.

- Sims posted 12 points for the third time on the year in Valpo's win at Indiana State, while also tying her season high with four rebounds.
- Sims came to Valpo after playing her first collegiate season at Oakland.

#41 Jayda Johnston

- Johnston went 4-of-6 from the floor for eight points in just nine minutes of action Nov. 18 versus Western Illinois.
- Johnston appeared in all 30 games off the bench in 2022-23, averaging 3.8 points and 1.6 rebounds per game.
- Johnston led the team in scoring twice and scored in double figures three times.
- Johnston set her career best with a team-high 16 points (7-12 FG) at Western Illinois.
- Johnston went a perfect 5-of-5 from the floor in a team-best 14-point effort, 13 of which came in the fourth quarter, in home game against Illinois State.
- Johnston reached double figures with 10 points at Illinois State.

Mary Evans Head Coach 5th Season * Georgia Southern, 2000 55-97 overall and at Valpo

Hired as the eighth head coach in the history of the Valpo women's basketball program in April 2018, Mary Evans enters her sixth year at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Through five seasons, Evans has a record of 55-91 at the helm of the Brown and Gold.

The 2022-23 season saw Evans lead Valpo to the first win in program history over perennial MVC power Missouri State. The Beacons also won three consecutive road games in Valley play, the first time the program accomplished that feat against three different opponents

since 2007.

Evans led the 2021-22 Valpo squad to a number of firsts en route to a 9-9 mark in MVC play and a sixth-place finish in the conference standings, both of which match the program's bests since joining the Valley. The Beacons registered the first win at Drake and the first win at Bradley in program history. Valpo swept the season series over Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs. The Beacons also tallied four top-100 wins within Valley play.

The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history. Entering the season without a win over a Power Five program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers. Valpo became the first program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18.

The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET. Valpo has five top-100 wins in MVC play over the last two seasons after going nearly seven years since its last top-100 win.

Evans led the Valpo program to a remarkable season across the board in 2019-20, one that concluded among the nation's top turnarounds from the season before. Valpo posted a 17-12 record in Evans' second season at the helm, the 17 wins the most by a Valpo team since the 2006-07 campaign and the 10th-most in a single season in program history.

Valpo improved its record by 10.5 games over the previous season in 2019-20, tied for the sixth-best improvement in Division I. Even more impressively, Valpo jumped by 171 spots in the RPI in Evans' second season as head coach, the nation's largest RPI jump.

With the 17 victories came many notable accomplishments throughout the season. Nine of the 17 wins came on the road, giving Valpo its highest number of true road wins since the 2001-02 season. Valpo concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record, the best pre-conference mark by winning percentage in program history. That non-conference slate ended with seven straight wins, which was Valpo's longest winning streak since the 2001-02 team won 10 straight and was just the seventh winning streak of at least seven consecutive games in program history.

Conference play brought more of the same for Evans and the 2019-20 Valpo squad. Valpo posted a 9-9 record in MVC play, finishing the regular season with both its highest win total and its best conference finish (6th) since joining the MVC. Most impressively, this record came in a conference which finished the year ranked eighth among Division I leagues, matching its best-ever finish and trailing just the Power Five, the Big East and the Ivy League.

The nine conference wins included victories at Illinois State and at home over UNI - the program's first wins over top-100 RPI teams since March 2013. In fact, the road win at Illinois State was the program's first true road victory over a top-100 program since March 2002.

Upon her arrival, Evans immediately instituted a style of play on both sides of the ball which encourages aggressiveness. On the offensive end, her teams are known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers. Evans' first four seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history. Valpo has ranked among the top-35 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.

Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history. In the four seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

Meanwhile defensively, Evans' teams have racked up steals at a high rate, averaging at least 7.8 steals/game in each of her three seasons. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 teams ranked among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game, with the 2019-20 squad totaling 300 steals - the program's highest single-season total since 2002. Valpo has also boasted the conference leader in steals each of the last three years as well.

Evans brought 15 years of Division I experience with her to Northwest Indiana, spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Ohio before her arrival at Valpo.


Evans was a two-sport athlete at Georgia Southern, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. She won four letters in basketball (1995-1999) and three in soccer during her time as a collegiate athlete. A native of Summerville, S.C., Evans was inducted into the Summerville High School Hall of Fame in 2008. She and her husband Daryl have two children, Keegan Thomas and Zoe Mae.
