Next Up in Valpo Basketball: Fresh off a victory over Bradley on Thursday evening, the Valpo women's basketball team hits the hardwood Saturday in an effort to complete a 2-0 weekend when it welcomes conference-leading Illinois State to town. It will be the program's Play4Kay game, honoring cancer warriors in the fight against all cancers affecting women.

Previously: Valpo has made a habit of being able to rally from double-digit deficits to earn wins, and Thursday evening at the ARC was no difference, as the Beacons overcame a 12-point first-half Bradley lead and held off the Braves down the stretch to pick up an 86-84 victory and move back to .500 in MVC play. Shay Frederick set a new career best with 11 assists, recorded the first double-double of her career and moved into second place in program history in career assists.

Head Coach Mary Evans: Mary Evans is in her fourth year at the helm of the program in 2021-22 and owns a record of 45-64. Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first three years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Evans' preferred style of play has been a big part of the program's turnaround, as Valpo has led the MVC in 3-pointers made per game and in steals per game in each of the last two seasons.

Series Notes: Illinois State leads the all-time series 9-4 and owns a 6-3 advantage since Valpo joined the MVC. In a quirk of the scheduling due to last year's same-site series, the last four games of the series have all been played in Normal, with each team winning two. Earlier this season, the Redbirds used a big second-quarter run to pull away for a 65-49 win. Grace White led Valpo in that contest with 16 points and seven rebounds.

- Valpo has been picked to finish in sixth place in the MVC preseason poll, totaling 208 points - just one point shy of fifth place.

Valpo is in its fifth season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
The Valley was ranked seventh nationally in conference NET in 2020-21 and was eighth nationally in conference RPI in 2019-20.

...looking back at last year

- Valpo posted a 12-13 overall record during the 2020-21 season and went 7-9 in Missouri Valley Conference play.

Valpo finished the regular season in seventh place in the MVC standings.
Included among Valpo's 12 victories were wins at Illinois and at Purdue, the program's first Power Five wins since 2012-13.

- Valpo closed the season with a NET of 122 - the program's best final NET/RPI ranking since the 2003-04 campaign.

- Shay Frederick was a First Team All-MVC honoree as she led the Valley in assists and ranked sixth in scoring.

- Carie Weinman earned Honorable Mention All-MVC notice and repeated on the All-Defensive Team as she led the Valley in steals for a second straight season.

...versus Bradley

- The Braves led for most of the first half and their lead reached an apex of 12 points in the second quarter before Valpo battled back to within 46-44 at intermission.

- The Beacons gained their first lead since the game's opening minutes on a layup by Carie Weinman with 3:10 to play in the third quarter.

- The teams were tied 65-65 at the end of the third, and were still tied at 70-70 before Valpo forced three consecutive Bradley turnovers during a 6-0 spurt to take the lead for good approaching the midway mark of the fourth. - Valpo never relinquished the lead, holding off the Braves despite Bradley having four separate shot attempts in the final 2:30 with a chance to tie or take the lead.

- Valpo earned its first season sweep of Bradley since joining the Valley with Thursday's win.

- Grace White paced Valpo with an efficient 20-point effort off the bench — her third 20-point game of the season. White finished 6-of-9 from the field and was 4-of-7 from the 3-point line, matching a career high for 3-pointers made.

Coach Evans and requested players will be available following the game. - Weinman joined White with a strong effort off the bench as the Beacons out-scored the Braves in bench points, 46-4. Weinman went 8-of-11 from the field for 19 points.

- Frederick notched 17 points, two off her season best, in the win. The senior paced Valpo's effort on the glass with six rebounds as well.

- Frederick surpassed her career high with 11 assists — a mark which ties a season high by any MVC player. Not only did she set a career best in the category as half of her first career double-double, Frederick did so without committing a turnover.

- Valpo shot 51.7% from the field in Thursday's win, its second-best clip of the season from the floor. The Beacons were 20-of-30 from inside the arc, and also knocked down 11 3-pointers — their sixth time in MVC play hitting at least 10 triples.

- Valpo also hit at an 86.7% rate from the foul line (13-of-15) and was a perfect 8-for-8 from the stripe in the decisive final period.

...at UNI

- Valpo never led on Sunday, with the Panthers scoring the first five points of the game.

- The Beacons got to within 9-7 with 4:18 to play in the opening period on a 3-pointer from Carie Weinman.

- UNI ended the quarter on an 8-0 run and then scored the first five points of the second quarter to extend its lead to 15 points with 7:44 to play in the half. Valpo would not cut the deficit to single digits the rest of the way.
- Valpo's 38 points marked its second-lowest output of the season (South Dakota).

- The Beacons shot just 25% from the floor on Sunday, matched a season low with four 3-pointers and committed 17 turnovers.

- Weinman paced the Beacons with seven points, while Caitlin Morrison scored six and led Valpo with five rebounds.

...looking ahead

- The Beacons hit the road next weekend, traveling to Evansville for a Friday night game before playing at Indiana State on Sunday afternoon.

- Valpo then returns home for the final three games of the regular season, starting on Friday, Feb. 25 against Loyola.

... at the ARC

- Thursday is the sixth MVC home game of the season and the 10th of 13 home games in total this year for the Beacons.

- Valpo posted a 5-6 record at the ARC last season and is currently 5-4 at home this year.

@RedbirdWBB

- Illinois State enters Saturday's game at 14-9 overall and is atop the MVC standings with a 10-2 record in conference play.

- The Redbirds have won their last four games, including pulling out a 57-53 win on Thursday evening at Loyola.

- JuJu Redmond leads ISU in the scoring column, averaging 15.5 points/ game on 51.2% shooting from the field. DeAnna Wilson adds 13.6 points/ game and a team-high 7.8 rebounds/game.

A High-Scoring Affair

- Thursday's game at the ARC was jam-packed with action en route to an 86-84 final score.

- Valpo's 86 points were a season high and the most the team has scored since an 88-83 win over Xavier in December 2020.

- The Beacons hit 31 shots from the floor, their first time hitting 30+ field goals since an 88-66 win at Evansville in January 2020.

- Meanwhile, the 84 points Valpo surrendered in the winning effort are the most the program has given up in a regulation victory since a 92-89 win over Western Illinois in January 1997.

Rally Pros

- Each of Valpo's last three wins and four of six MVC victories have seen the Beacons overcome double-digit deficits at some point during the game to earn the win.

- Valpo has now rallied from down 10 or more to win 14 times in head coach Mary Evans' four-year tenure at the helm of the program.

- Most recently, Valpo overcame a 12-point deficit in the second quarter to earn the win over Bradley.

- Last weekend at Drake, the Beacons trailed by 10 in the first half before coming back for the victory.

- Valpo's home win over UNI featured a comeback from down 13 in the fourth quarter, tying the program's largest comeback in the final period since the move to quarters — Valpo previously rallied from a 13-point deficit in the fourth quarter in a 66-64 win over Loyola on Jan. 24, 2020.

- Against Evansville, the Beacons trailed by as many as 14 points before picking up the win - it was Valpo's largest comeback overall since the aforementioned Loyola game, which featured a 14-point deficit at one point.

Stellar Distribution

- Senior Shay Frederick reached another level with her distribution of the basketball in Valpo's win over Bradley on Thursday.

- Frederick surpassed her career high with 11 assists against the Braves, the second time this year she has reached double figures in the category.

- It also ties the season high for assists in a game by an MVC player.

- The assists comprised half of Frederick's first career double-double, as she also scored 17 points in the win.

- But even more impressively, Frederick tallied the 17 points and 11 assists without committing a single turnover.

According to HerHoopStats.com, Frederick is one of only eight players in D-I this season to record 11+ assists in a game without committing a turnover.
Drilling further down into the Her Hoops Stats data, Frederick is one

of only three D-I players this season to finish with a stat line of 17 PTS/6 REB/11 AST or better in those categories and also finish with 0 turnovers.

Ups and Downs

- Valley play over the last month for the Beacons has been a yo-yo in terms of results, a string Valpo will attempt to snap on Saturday.

- Starting with the Jan. 9 victory over Bradley, Valpo has alternated wins and losses in each of its last nine games - most recently taking down the Braves again on Thursday.

- This ties the program record for the longest stretch of alternating results - the 1998-99 team oscillated between losses and victories for nine consecutive games to open the campaign, while the 1982-83 squad alternated between wins and defeats for a nine-game stretch as well.

Big Quarters

- Four Beacons have combined for six big scoring quarters over the last five games.

- In Valpo's win over Evansville, Olivia Brown tripled the Purple Aces' second-quarter scoring output, scoring 12 points to help Valpo turn a nine-point deficit at the end of the first quarter into a nine-point halftime lead. - Then, in the third quarter, Grace White scored all 13 of her points consec-

utively in a three-minute stretch as part of a 15-0 Valpo run. - The 13-point stanza was White's highest-scoring quarter in the Valpo

uniform.

- The 13-point personal run is the largest by a Valpo player in at least five years - Carie Weinman (Western Michigan, Dec. 2020) and Meredith Hamlet (Loyola, February 2018) both had personal 11-0 runs.

- At Loyola, Shay Frederick dropped 11 points in the first quarter - the 16th time in her Valpo career she has scored 10+ points in a single period. - In the win at Drake, Weinman poured in 12 fourth-quarter points, just two points shy of the Bulldogs' team output of 14 points.

Last time out in the win over Bradley, White scored 10 points in the third quarter - her eighth time scoring 10+ points in a period in the Valpo uniform.
Weinman followed up with another huge fourth quarter, helping secure the win with 13 points in the final 10 minutes.

- It was Weinman's eighth time scoring 10+ points in a quarter at Valpo and was the highest-scoring quarter of her Valpo career.

Accomplishing Firsts

- Valpo has recorded a number of firsts in program history during conference play this year.

- The Beacons have registered their first road win over two MVC teams this season, winning for the first time both at Drake and at Bradley.

- Both Drake and Bradley were previously 6-0 at home versus Valpo before this season.

- The win at the Knapp Center completed Valpo's first season sweep of Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs.

- Prior to the Beacons' win at the ARC over Drake earlier this season, the Bulldogs held a 13-0 advantage in the all-time series.

- The win over Drake in January also gave Valpo its first sweep of the UNI/ Drake weekend in MVC play.

- It is Valpo's fourth sweep of a weekend set since joining the Valley. Valpo previously swept both the home and road Indiana State/Evansville weekends in 2019-20, and took down Southern Illinois twice on back-to-back days last season.

- Valpo completed its first season sweep of Bradley last time out with the home win over the Braves.

Reaching Milestones

- Valpo has had two players reach the 1,000-point milestone for their collegiate career already this season, with a third being within striking distance of doing so as well by season's end.

- Last weekend at UNI, Carie Weinman hit a shot on Valpo's first possession of the fourth quarter to reach the milestone.

- Weinman has now scored 1,021 career points - 191 in one season at Denver, and 830 in her three seasons in the Valpo uniform.

- Earlier this season, Shay Frederick surpassed 1,000 career points in Valpo's game at South Dakota.

- Meanwhile, Grace White comes into the Illinois State game with 960 career points, putting her on track to potentially reach the milestone as well this season.

- White scored 277 points in her two years at Denver and is at 683 points in her time at Valpo.

Top 100 Wins

- Valpo has made a habit of knocking off top-100 opponents in MVC play over the last few seasons and has done so three times this year.

The home win over UNI came over a team which entered the night ranked #46 in NET, and the home victory came over a Drake squad which was #65.
Most recently, the road win at Drake came over a Bulldogs squad which

entered the day at #84.

- Valpo now has eight top-100 NET/RPI wins in Valley action over the last three seasons.

- Prior to its Feb. 16, 2020 win at Illinois State - its first top-100 win in conference play since joining the Valley - Valpo had gone nearly seven years without a top-100 victory.

White Does It All

- Senior Grace White has continued to stuff the stat sheet in her final season in the Brown and Gold, and took it to another level in the victory at Drake.

- White finished the game with a team-high 20 points, a career-best 11 rebounds and six steals, also matching a career high.

- White needed just the first 20 minutes to record her third double-double at Valpo, entering halftime with 14 points and 10 rebounds - the first Valpo player since November 2016 to post a double-double in the first half.

- White again paced Valpo in scoring last time out with 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the win over Bradley.

- White leads the team in rebounding and steals and ranks second in scoring, assists and blocked shots.

- White leads the Valley in steals (2.5/game) and ranks eighth in rebounding (5.9/game).

- She currently ranks among the top-50 nationally in steals/game as well.

Frederick Moves On Up

- One season after leading the Valley in assists, Frederick again tops the chart this season as she's averaging 4.6 assists/game.

- Frederick is trying to become the first MVC player to lead the conference in assists in consecutive seasons since Caitlin Ingle of Drake did so three straight seasons (2014-15 through 2016-17).

- Last time out, Frederick surpassed Katie Boone for second place in program history in career assists, as she now has 454 career helpers.

One of 17 players in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone for her career, Frederick ranks 12th all-time at Valpo with 1,173 career points.
Frederick is one of just two players in program history with at least 1,000 career points and 400 career assists, and just one of three active MVC players above those marks (Brice Calip, MSU and Karli Rucker, UNI).

- Frederick also is just one triple away from cracking Valpo's top-five in 3-pointers made.

Notable Wins

- The last two seasons have featured a combined 29 wins for Valpo, including many notable victories.

- The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history.

- Entering the season without a win over a Power Five program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers.

- Valpo became the first women's basketball program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18.

- The 2019-20 Valpo squad had one of the top turnarounds in program history from the previous year and one of the best turnarounds in the nation. It more than doubled the win total from the prior season, as the 2018-19 team went 8-24 overall, while the 2019-20 squad went 17-12.

It was the second-largest improvement in the win column from one year to the next in program history, trailing only the 2001-02 team, which improved an astounding 19 wins from the previous season (7-22 -> 26-7).
Valpo's 10.5 game improvement ranked sixth nationally.

- Valpo's 17 wins in 2019-20 made it the program's winningest campaign since 2006-07.

- The wins in 2019-20 came in non-conference play, where Valpo posted an 8-3 record – the best pre-conference mark in program history.

- The wins came when the schedule shifted to MVC action, as Valpo finished 2019-20 9-9 in MVC play – its first .500 or better record in league play since 2008-09.

Raining Threes

- In her time at the helm of the Valpo program, head coach Mary Evans' teams have become known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers.

- Evans' first three seasons at the helm saw Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history.

- Valpo has ranked among the top-25 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.

- Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history.

- In her fourth season at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

- The style of play isn't a surprise if you follow the coaching tree. Evans coached under Bob Boldon at Ohio for five years before getting the head job at Valpo, and Boldon was a former assistant coach at FGCU under their legendary head coach, Karl Smesko, whose teams have ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 3-pointers made in each of the last 10 years.

Thievery Abounds

- As much as the offensive end has been highlighted by the 3-point numbers under Evans, the defensive side has seen prolific steal numbers over her first three seasons.

- Valpo has averaged at least 8.9 steals/game in each of Evans' first three seasons.

- Each of the last two years has seen Valpo rank among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game.

- Carie Weinman has led the MVC in steals in each of the last two seasons. She ranked 16th nationally last year, averaging 2.9 steals/game.

- Valpo tallied double figures in steals 12 times in 25 games in 2020-21, after doing so 16 times the previous season.

- With 300 steals, the 2019-20 squad finished the campaign eighth in program history in the category. The 2001-02 team (330 steals) is the only Valpo team in the last quarter-century to have registered more steals.

Same Alma Maters

- While there are 17 players on the 2021-22 Valpo women's basketball roster, there are only 14 high schools represented, as three high schools count a pair of Beacons as alums.

- Sixth-year Caitlin Morrison and redshirt senior Carie Weinman both graduated from Glenbrook South (III.) H.S.

- Senior Maya Dunson and freshman Lovie Malone both are alums of Wayne (Ohio) H.S.

- Sophomore Ava Interrante and freshman Katie Beyer were teammates at McHenry (III.) H.S.

#1 Grace White

- White scored a team-high 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, 10 of which came in the third quarter, last time out in the win over Bradley.

- White recorded a double-double in the first half - the third of her Valpo career - and finished with a team-high 20 points, a career-best 11 rebounds and matched her career high with six steals in the win at Drake.

- White scored 13 of her 18 points in the third quarter of Valpo's win over Evansville while also pacing the team on the glass with eight rebounds and tying career bests with four blocked shots and four 3-pointers.

- White set a career high with six steals to go with 12 points in the win at Bradley.

- White paced Valpo with 16 points and tied for team-high honors with seven rebounds at Illinois State.

- White led all players with 19 points, including four 3-pointers, in the win over Detroit Mercy.

- White started all 22 games she appeared in during the 2020-21 season, averaging 11.1 points, 5.9 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.1 steals per game.

- White led Valpo in rebounding and ranked second on the team in assists, steals, blocked shots (1.0/game) and free throw percentage (.772)

- White ranked fourth in the MVC in steals, seventh in free throw percentage, eighth in blocks and 10th in rebounding.

- White scored in double figures 11 times, including a season-high 23 points in Valpo's win over Xavier - her high in a Valpo uniform.

#2 Olivia Brown

- Brown led all players with 21 points, 12 of which came in the second quarter, in the win over Evansville.

- Brown posted 13 points and a career-best five assists versus Indiana State. - Brown was named MVC Newcomer of the Week Jan. 10 for her perfor-

mances in the wins over UNI and Drake.

- Brown tallied 11 points in the win over Drake.

- Brown led all players in the win over UNI, scoring 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting and 3-of-4 from 3-point range.

- Brown broke out at Missouri State, going 8-of-10 from the field and 5-of-6 from 3-point range for a game-high 21 points.

- Brown joins the Valpo program after spending her first two seasons at St. Bonaventure.

- Brown appeared in 51 games in her two years with the Bonnies, averaging 7.2 points/game over her two seasons.

- Brown scored in double figures 12 times over her two years at SBU.

- Brown hit 39 3-pointers on 38.2% shooting from deep last season, leading the Bonnies in both 3-pointers and 3-point percentage and ranking eighth in the Atlantic 10 in the latter category.

#3 Ava Interrante

- Interrante saw action in the first quarter last time out in the win over Bradley, grabbing an offensive rebound.

- Interrante made her 2021-22 season debut late in the game at Xavier, scoring on her only field goal attempt.

- Interrante appeared in 10 games in 2020-21 in her first season at Valpo, averaging 5.1 minutes/game and scoring 12 points.

- Interrante scored a season-high four points and dished out two assists in 15 minutes of action Feb. 19 against Evansville.

- Interrante was an Honorable Mention All-State honoree for McHenry (III.) H.S.

#4 Ilysse Pitts

- Pitts tallied three points and three rebounds in the win over Evansville.

- Pitts hit a 3-pointer and grabbed three rebounds in the win at Bradley.

- Pitts led all players with four steals and dished out two assists without a turnover in the win over Drake.

- Pitts put forth a tremendous shift off the bench in the win over UNI,

playing 20 minutes and tallying five points, five rebounds and three assists. - Pitts made her season debut at Morehead State, recording a rebound and a steal.

- Pitts returns to action this year after appearing in just one game last season.

- Pitts saw action in 28 games off the bench as a sophomore in 2019-20, averaging 15 minutes/game and 2.9 points/game.

- Pitts led Valpo in assists five times and in steals three times as a sophomore.

#5 Shay Frederick

- Frederick surpassed her career best with 11 assists while not committing a turnover last time out in the win over Bradley, also recording her first career double-double with 17 points and leading Valpo with six rebounds.

Mary Evans Head Coach 4th Season * Georgia Southern, 2000 45-64 overall and at Valpo

Hired as the eighth head coach in the history of the Valpo women's basketball program in April 2018, Mary Evans enters her fourth year at the helm of the program in 2021-22.

Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first three years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Through three seasons, Evans has a record of 37-49 at the helm of the Brown and Gold.

The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history. Entering the season without a win over a Power Five

program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers. Valpo became the first program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18. The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET. Valpo has five top-100 wins in MVC play over the last two seasons after going nearly seven years since its last top-100 win.

Individually, Shay Frederick earned First Team All-MVC honors after leading the conference in assists and finishing sixth in the MVC in scoring, becoming just the second First Team honoree for Valpo since joining the conference. Carie Weinman picked up Honorable Mention All-MVC recognition and repeated on the All-Defensive Team.

Evans led the Valpo program to a remarkable season across the board in 2019-20, one that concluded among the nation's top turnarounds from the season before. Valpo posted a 17-12 record in Evans' second season at the helm, the 17 wins the most by a Valpo team since the 2006-07 campaign and the 10th-most in a single season in program history. Valpo improved its record by 10.5 games over the previous season in 2019-20, tied for the sixth-best improvement in Division I. Even more impressively, Valpo jumped by 171 spots in the RPI in Evans' second season as head coach, the nation's largest RPI jump.

With the 17 victories came many notable accomplishments throughout the season. Nine of the 17 wins came on the road, giving Valpo its highest number of true road wins since the 2001-02 season. Valpo concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record, the best pre-conference mark by winning percentage in program history. That non-conference slate ended with seven straight wins, which was Valpo's longest winning streak since the 2001-02 team won 10 straight and was just the seventh winning streak of at least seven consecutive games in program history.

Conference play brought more of the same for Evans and the 2019-20 Valpo squad. Valpo posted a 9-9 record in MVC play, finishing the regular season with both its highest win total and its best conference finish (6th) since joining the MVC. Most impressively, this record came in a conference which finished the year ranked eighth among Division I leagues, matching its best-ever finish and trailing just the Power Five, the Big East and the Ivy League. The nine conference wins included victories at Illinois State and at home over UNI - the program's first wins over top-100 RPI teams since March 2013. In fact, the road win at Illinois State was the program's first true road victory over a top-100 program since March 2002.

Valpo was exceptional from the free throw line, setting a single-season record with a team free throw percentage of .792, a clip which was good for fourth in the nation. Individually, Grace Hales set Valpo's single-season mark with an .890 free throw percentage and ranked ninth nationally. Valpo also boasted the MVC's steals leader in Carie Weinman, a member of the conference's All-Defensive Team.

In Evans' first season in 2018-19, the program boasted a pair of 400-point scorers in Addison Stoller and Meredith Hamlet - the first time since 2007-08 two Valpo players reached the 400-point mark. Frederick was named an MVC All-Freshman Team honoree that year as well.

Upon her arrival, Evans immediately instituted a style of play on both sides of the ball which encourages aggressiveness. On the offensive end, her teams are known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers. Evans' first three seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history. Valpo has ranked among the top-25 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game. Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history. In the three seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns nine more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

Meanwhile defensively, Evans' teams have racked up steals at a high rate, averaging at least 8.9 steals/game in each of her three seasons. Each of the last two years has seen Valpo rank among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game, with the 2019-20 squad totaling 300 steals - the program's highest single-season total since 2002. Valpo has also boasted the conference leader in steals each of the last two years as well.

Evans brought 15 years of Division I experience with her to Northwest Indiana, spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Ohio before her arrival at Valpo. During her time on Ohio's staff under head coach Bob Boldon, Evans helped the Bobcats to three seasons of 22 wins or more, three postseason appearances and three Top 75 RPI finishes. The 2014-15 team established a school record with 27 wins, a 21-win improvement from two years earlier and an 18-win improvement from the previous season. The Bobcats won the 2014-15 MAC regular season and tournament titles and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Evans spent the 2012-13 season at Youngstown State University, where she helped the Penguins to a 23-10 record and a first-round win at Indiana State in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). She has also coached at Georgia Southern University (2007-2012), the University of South Carolina, Aiken (2005-2007) and Seton Hall University (2001-2005).

Evans was a two-sport athlete at Georgia Southern, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. She won four letters in basketball (1995-1999) and three in soccer during her time as a collegiate athlete. A native of Summerville, S.C., Evans was inducted into the Summerville High School Hall of Fame in 2008. She and her husband Daryl have two children, Keegan Thomas and Zoe Mae.
