**Next Up in Valpo Basketball:** The Valpo women's basketball team returns to action following the Christmas holiday with the start of Missouri Valley Conference play this weekend, opening up the conference slate Friday afternoon with a matinee at Southern Illinois. The Beacons enter conference play coming off back-to-back wins.

**Previously:** Valpo closed out non-conference play with a bang Dec. 21 at the ARC, as seven different Beacons combined to connect on 14 3-pointers in a 69-57 victory over Detroit Mercy. Grace White led the way, hitting four triples on her way to a game-high 19 points.

**Head Coach Mary Evans:** Mary Evans is in her fourth year at the helm of the program in 2021-22 and owns a record of 39-58. Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first three years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Evans' preferred style of play has been a big part of the program's turnaround, as Valpo has led the MVC in 3-pointers made per game and in steals per game in each of the last two seasons.

**Series Notes:** It's a brief series between SIU and Valpo, as the two programs did not meet prior to Valpo joining the MVC in 2017-18. The Salukis claimed victories in each of the first five meetings, but Valpo has won each of the last three matchups, including 75-64 and 70-63 wins on Feb. 27-28 last season in Carbondale. The former game saw Valpo go 15-for-20 from 3-point range, led by a 6-for-6 effort from Shay Frederick, while the latter featured a comeback from an 11-point deficit to win in overtime.

#### ...and @ValleyHoops

- Valpo has been picked to finish in sixth place in the MVC preseason poll, totaling 208 points - just one point shy of fifth place.

- Valpo is in its fifth season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference in 2021-22.

- The Valley was ranked seventh nationally in conference NET in 2020-21 and was eighth nationally in conference RPI in 2019-20.

#### ...looking back at last year

- Valpo posted a 12-13 overall record during the 2020-21 season and went 7-9 in Missouri Valley Conference play.

Valpo finished the regular season in seventh place in the MVC standings.
Included among Valpo's 12 victories were wins at Illinois and at Purdue, the program's first Power Five wins since 2012-13.

- Valpo closed the season with a NET of 122 - the program's best final NET/RPI ranking since the 2003-04 campaign.

- Shay Frederick was a First Team All-MVC honoree as she led the Valley in assists and ranked sixth in scoring.

- Carie Weinman earned Honorable Mention All-MVC notice and repeated on the All-Defensive Team as she led the Valley in steals for a second straight season.

#### ...versus Detroit Mercy

- A back and forth first half saw Valpo take the lead for good on a 4-point play from Cara VanKempen with 2:30 to go in the second quarter.

- The Beacons led 31-27 at halftime and held a slim 48-47 edge with 10 minutes to play.

- Valpo's defense and rebounding carried the way in the fourth quarter, as it allowed just two field goals and one offensive rebound to the Titans over the first eight minutes of the period.

- Shay Frederick connected on a 3-pointer on Valpo's first possession of the final quarter, and two trips later, Grace White converted on a 3-point play to extend the lead to seven points.

- White, Carie Weinman and Olivia Brown all knocked down 3-pointers over the next few minutes, Brown's with 3:04 to play all but icing the game as it gave Valpo a double-digit lead it would not relinquish.

- Valpo made a season-high 14 3-pointers on Tuesday and connected at a season-best .438 clip (14-for-32) from behind the arc. Seven different players combined to knock down the 14 triples, with four players making multiple 3-pointers.

Coach Evans and requested players will be available following the game. - White led the way for the Beacons, hitting on four 3-point attempts en route to a game-high 19 points. White added three steals as well.

- Weinman's three triples accounted for her nine points. She also tallied a season-best four steals, leading the way as Valpo registered a season-high 11 thefts as a team.

- Valpo continued its strong recent effort at the foul line, going 11-for-13 (.846) from the stripe. Over the last three games, the Beacons have hit at an .884 clip from the foul line.

- After the Titans shot .529 from the field in the first three quarters, Valpo limited UDM to .267 shooting (4-for-15) over the final 10 minutes.

#### ... at Morehead State

Valpo shot 70% from the field in the first quarter, capped by a backdoor layup from Shay Frederick to give it a 20-12 lead at the end of 10 minutes.
Morehead State got to within three with 2:40 to play in the first half, but Valpo scored four of the half's final five points — including a Frederick layup — to take a 32-26 lead into intermission.

- Neither team could gain control in the third quarter. Valpo's lead never exceeded the six-point margin from halftime, but the Beacons also did not allow the Eagles to close to closer than two points in the period. Valpo entered the fourth quarter with a 42-38 lead.

Morehead State got within two points three times in the fourth quarter, but all three times, the Beacons held them off - twice thanks to 3-point plays.
A 9-2 spurt just past the midway point of the final quarter proved to be

the decisive run to secure Valpo's win, highlighted by a triple from Olivia Brown which extended the lead to eight points with 3:29 to play.

- Valpo shot 50% from the field Sunday, its second-best effort of the season, thanks to great efforts in the opening and closing periods. The Beacons went 7-of-10 (70%) from the floor in the first quarter and 8-of-11 (72.7%) in the fourth quarter.

- Valpo also enjoyed a significant advantage from the foul line, going 17of-20 (85%) from the stripe as compared to Morehead State's 1-of-6 effort from the free throw line.

- Carie Weinman led Valpo on Sunday with 17 points, her seventh double-digit scoring effort of the season.

- Frederick was just behind Weinman with 15 points, while Grace White needed just four field goal attempts to score 11 points.

### ...looking ahead

- The Beacons continue the longest road trip of the conference schedule on Sunday as they play at Missouri State.

- Valpo then returns home to the ARC to host UNI on Friday, Jan. 7.

#### ...on the road

- Friday marks the eighth of 16 road games in all for Valpo this season.

- Valpo has finished at or above .500 in each of the last two seasons in true road games, going 6-6 on the road last year and 9-5 in 2019-20.

### @SIU\_WBasketball

- Southern Illinois enters Valley play with a 5-5 record on the year, most recently falling 70-37 at Indiana on Dec. 23.

- The Salukis earned a 66-51 victory over Illinois four days prior to their matchup with the Hoosiers.

- Abby Brockmeyer and Makenzie Silvey both average better than 15 points per game for SIU, with Brockmeyer also pulling down 10.3 rebounds per game.

### From Way Downtown

Valpo made a season-high 14 3-pointers in the win over Detroit Mercy and connected at a season-best .438 clip (14-for-32) from behind the arc.
Seven different players combined to knock down the 14 triples, with four players making multiple 3-pointers.

- The 14 made 3-pointers are tied for eighth-most in a single game in program history.

- Valpo has more games with 14+ 3-pointers in the four-season tenure of head coach Mary Evans (10) than it did in the entire program history prior to her arrival (nine).

### **Entering Conference Play With Momentum**

- Valpo enters MVC play coming off back-to-back victories over Morehead State and Detroit Mercy to close out non-conference action.

- It is the third time in five seasons in the Valley that Valpo has closed the non-conference with at least two straight wins.

- The 2017-18 squad carried a four-game winning streak into the MVC slate, while the 2019-20 team won its final six non-conference games.

### Winning the Opener

- With a win over SIU, Valpo would start MVC play 1-0 for a second straight season.

- Last year's squad kicked off conference action with a 63-56 win over UNI.

- Prior to that, the last time Valpo opened league play with a victory was the 2015-16 season.

- Valpo has not opened league play with a 2-0 record since 2007-08.

### Frederick Reaches 1,000

- Senior guard Shay Frederick became the 17th player in Valpo women's basketball history to reach the 1,000-point milestone for her career earlier this month at South Dakota.

- Frederick passed Carrie Forsman for 16th place in program history at Morehead State and now owns 1,028 career points after scoring 10 against Detroit Mercy.

- Next up for Frederick would be Suzie Hammel, who sits 15th in program history with 1,077 career points.

- Frederick also has 396 career assists, good for fourth in program history as she passed Laura Richards on Valpo's all-time chart last time out.

- Frederick is one of just two players in program history with at least 1,000 career points and 300 career assists.

### Another 1,000 Approaching

- It won't be long until this year's team has a pair of 1,000-point scorers on the court at the same time.

- Carie Weinman enters Friday's game at Southern Illinois with 966 career points after a nine-point effort against Detroit Mercy.

- 191 of Weinman's points came in one season at Denver, with the other 775 coming in her three seasons at Valpo.

- Weinman is averaging 12.0 points/game in her time at Valpo, tied for sixth-best in program history.

### Suiting Up Again and Again

- Sixth-year forward Caitlin Morrison cracked Valpo's career top-10 for games played earlier this season at UIC.

- Morrison made her 123rd appearance in the Valpo uniform last time out against Detroit Mercy, moving into a tie for second place in program history with Grace Hales and Meredith Hamlet.

- She is just two games shy of reaching Kathryn Knoester's program record of 125 career games played.

- Morrison has started in 119 of her 123 appearances, two games shy of Hamlet's program record of 121 career games started.

#### Notable Wins

- The last two seasons have featured a combined 29 wins for Valpo, including many notable victories.

- The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history.

- Entering the season without a win over a Power Five program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers.

- Valpo became the first women's basketball program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18.

- The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well last season, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET.

- The 2019-20 Valpo squad had one of the top turnarounds in program history from the previous year and one of the best turnarounds in the nation. It more than doubled the win total from the prior season, as the 2018-19 team went 8-24 overall, while the 2019-20 squad went 17-12.

It was the second-largest improvement in the win column from one year to the next in program history, trailing only the 2001-02 team, which improved an astounding 19 wins from the previous season (7-22 -> 26-7).
Valpo's 10.5 game improvement ranked sixth nationally.

- Valpo's 17 wins in 2019-20 made it the program's winningest campaign since 2006-07.

- The wins in 2019-20 came in non-conference play, where Valpo posted an 8-3 record – the best pre-conference mark in program history.

- The wins came away from home, as Valpo went 9-5 in true road games – the most road wins since the 2001-02 team won nine true road games.

- The wins came when the schedule shifted to MVC action, as Valpo finished 2019-20 9-9 in MVC play – its first .500 or better record in league play since 2008-09.

### **Raining Threes**

- In her time at the helm of the Valpo program, head coach Mary Evans' teams have become known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers.

- Evans' first three seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history.

- Valpo has ranked among the top-25 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.

- Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history.

- In the three seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns nine more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

- The style of play isn't a surprise if you follow the coaching tree. Evans coached under Bob Boldon at Ohio for five years before getting the head job at Valpo, and Boldon was a former assistant coach at FGCU under their legendary head coach, Karl Smesko, whose teams have ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 3-pointers made in each of the last 10 years.

#### **Thievery Abounds**

- As much as the offensive end has been highlighted by the 3-point numbers under Evans, the defensive side has seen prolific steal numbers over the last three seasons.

Valpo has averaged at least 8.9 steals/game in each of Evans' three seasons.
Each of the last two years has seen Valpo rank among the top-40 teams

nationally in steals/game. - Carie Weinman has led the MVC in steals in each of the last two seasons.

She ranked 16th nationally last year, averaging 2.9 steals/game.

- Valpo tallied double figures in steals 12 times in 25 games in 2020-21, after doing so 16 times the previous season.

- With 300 steals, the 2019-20 squad finished the campaign eighth in program history in the category. The 2001-02 team (330 steals) is the only Valpo team in the last quarter-century to have registered more steals.

#### Starters, Assemble

- Four regular starters return for Valpo in 2021-22, including a trio who own extensive streaks of consecutive games started.

- Shay Frederick, Caitlin Morrison and Carie Weinman were three of the four players who started every game a season ago.

Frederick has started 77 consecutive games dating back to the middle of her freshman year, while Morrison and Weinman have made 65 starts in a row.
The three were members of a quintet which started every single game in the 2019-20 season - the first time in program history the same five players started every game.

Grace White started all 22 games she was available for last season as well.
Valpo had a shakeup in the starting lineup for the first time this season at WMU, inserting Cara VanKempen in place of Maya Dunson.

#### Who's Back

- 14 letterwinners from last year's team, including four starters, return for Valpo in 2021-22.

- The four returning starters are sixth-year Caitlin Morrison, fifth-year Grace White, redshirt senior Carie Weinman and senior Shay Frederick.

- Two other seniors return as well: Maya Dunson and Ilysse Pitts.

- Junior Cara VanKempen is joined by a quintet of sophomores: Ava Interrante, Syria Butler, Leah Earnest, Lauren Gunn and Jayda Johnston.

- Katie Beyer and Molly Sheehan are also back after enrolling early for the spring 2021 semester to join the program ahead of schedule.

- In all, Valpo returns 93% of the team's scoring, 91.6% of the rebounding and 96.4% of the assists from last year's squad.

#### Who's New

- Three newcomers round out Valpo's 2021-22 roster.

- Junior Olivia Brown is ready for her first season in the Valpo uniform after playing her first two collegiate seasons at St. Bonaventure.

- Two true freshmen join the mix as well: Lovie Malone [Wayne (Ohio) H.S.] and Ella Van Weelden [Marion (Iowa) H.S.]. Both are projected to redshirt.

- Brown hit 39 3-pointers on 38.2% shooting from deep last season, leading the Bonnies in both 3-pointers and 3-point percentage and ranking eighth in the Atlantic 10 in the latter category.

### #3 Ava Interrante

- Interrante made her 2021-22 season debut late in the game at Xavier, scoring on her only field goal attempt.

- Interrante appeared in 10 games in 2020-21 in her first season at Valpo, averaging 5.1 minutes/game and scoring 12 points.

- Interrante scored a season-high four points and dished out two assists in 15 minutes of action Feb. 19 against Evansville.

- Interrante was an Honorable Mention All-State honoree for McHenry (Ill.) H.S.

#### #4 Ilysse Pitts

- Pitts made her season debut at Morehead State, recording a rebound and a steal.

- Pitts returns to action this year after appearing in just one game last season.

- Pitts saw action in 28 games off the bench as a sophomore in 2019-20, averaging 15 minutes/game and 2.9 points/game.

## Mary Evans Head Coach 4th Season \* Georgia Southern, 2000 39-58 overall and at Valpo

Hired as the eighth head coach in the history of the Valpo women's basketball program in April 2018, Mary Evans enters her fourth year at the helm of the program in 2021-22.

Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first three years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Through three seasons, Evans has a record of 37-49 at the helm of the Brown and Gold.

The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history. Entering the season without a win over a Power Five

program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers. Valpo became the first program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18. The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET. Valpo has five top-100 wins in MVC play over the last two seasons after going nearly seven years since its last top-100 win.

Individually, Shay Frederick earned First Team All-MVC honors after leading the conference in assists and finishing sixth in the MVC in scoring, becoming just the second First Team honoree for Valpo since joining the conference. Carie Weinman picked up Honorable Mention All-MVC recognition and repeated on the All-Defensive Team.

Evans led the Valpo program to a remarkable season across the board in 2019-20, one that concluded among the nation's top turnarounds from the season before. Valpo posted a 17-12 record in Evans' second season at the helm, the 17 wins the most by a Valpo team since the 2006-07 campaign and the 10th-most in a single season in program history. Valpo improved its record by 10.5 games over the previous season in 2019-20, tied for the sixth-best improvement in Division I. Even more impressively, Valpo jumped by 171 spots in the RPI in Evans' second season as head coach, the nation's largest RPI jump.

With the 17 victories came many notable accomplishments throughout the season. Nine of the 17 wins came on the road, giving Valpo its highest number of true road wins since the 2001-02 season. Valpo concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record, the best pre-conference mark by winning percentage in program history. That non-conference slate ended with seven straight wins, which was Valpo's longest winning streak since the 2001-02 team won 10 straight and was just the seventh winning streak of at least seven consecutive games in program history.

Conference play brought more of the same for Evans and the 2019-20 Valpo squad. Valpo posted a 9-9 record in MVC play, finishing the regular season with both its highest win total and its best conference finish (6th) since joining the MVC. Most impressively, this record came in a conference which finished the year ranked eighth among Division I leagues, matching its best-ever finish and trailing just the Power Five, the Big East and the Ivy League. The nine conference wins included victories at Illinois State and at home over UNI - the program's first wins over top-100 RPI teams since March 2013. In fact, the road win at Illinois State was the program's first true road victory over a top-100 program since March 2002.

Valpo was exceptional from the free throw line, setting a single-season record with a team free throw percentage of .792, a clip which was good for fourth in the nation. Individually, Grace Hales set Valpo's single-season mark with an .890 free throw percentage and ranked ninth nationally. Valpo also boasted the MVC's steals leader in Carie Weinman, a member of the conference's All-Defensive Team.

In Evans' first season in 2018-19, the program boasted a pair of 400-point scorers in Addison Stoller and Meredith Hamlet - the first time since 2007-08 two Valpo players reached the 400-point mark. Frederick was named an MVC All-Freshman Team honoree that year as well.

Upon her arrival, Evans immediately instituted a style of play on both sides of the ball which encourages aggressiveness. On the offensive end, her teams are known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers. Evans' first three seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history. Valpo has ranked among the top-25 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game. Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history. In the three seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns nine more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

Meanwhile defensively, Evans' teams have racked up steals at a high rate, averaging at least 8.9 steals/game in each of her three seasons. Each of the last two years has seen Valpo rank among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game, with the 2019-20 squad totaling 300 steals - the program's highest single-season total since 2002. Valpo has also boasted the conference leader in steals each of the last two years as well.

Evans brought 15 years of Division I experience with her to Northwest Indiana, spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Ohio before her arrival at Valpo. During her time on Ohio's staff under head coach Bob Boldon, Evans helped the Bobcats to three seasons of 22 wins or more, three postseason appearances and three Top 75 RPI finishes. The 2014-15 team established a school record with 27 wins, a 21-win improvement from two years earlier and an 18-win improvement from the previous season. The Bobcats won the 2014-15 MAC regular season and tournament titles and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Evans spent the 2012-13 season at Youngstown State University, where she helped the Penguins to a 23-10 record and a first-round win at Indiana State in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). She has also coached at Georgia Southern University (2007-2012), the University of South Carolina, Aiken (2005-2007) and Seton Hall University (2001-2005).

Evans was a two-sport athlete at Georgia Southern, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. She won four letters in basketball (1995-1999) and three in soccer during her time as a collegiate athlete. A native of Summerville, S.C., Evans was inducted into the Summerville High School Hall of Fame in 2008. She and her husband Daryl have two children, Keegan Thomas and Zoe Mae.
