This Week in Valpo Football: For the first time since the 2019 season, the Valparaiso University football team will welcome spectators with no capacity limitations on Saturday as Dartmouth visits Brown Field for the Fall 2021 home opener. After playing three home games with limited spectators during the Spring 2021 season, the Beacons will welcome fans back to Brown Field this week with a home game against a high-caliber, Ivy League opponent. Visiting Dartmouth will be playing its first game since 2019. Saturday will be Valpo's final tune-up before starting Pioneer Football League action on Sept. 25 at Drake.

Previously: Valpo fell 64-0 to No. 5/4 North Dakota State on Saturday, Sept. 11 at the Fargodome in North Dakota. The Beacons trailed 22-0 through one quarter and 43-0 by halftime against a full-scholarship, nationally-ranked program that has won eight of the last 10 FCS national championships. The game was played in front of a raucous crowd of 15,118.

Series Notes: This will mark Valpo's first-ever matchup with the Big Green and will represent the program's first game against a current member of the Ivy League since falling 48-2 at Yale on Sept. 25, 1999. Valpo last hosted an Ivy League school on Oct. 3, 1997, a 34-14 loss to Yale that took place at Solider Field in Chicago. The Beacons are 0-3 all-time against current Ivy League members with the two aforementioned games against Yale and one against Harvard (1920). (Note: Columbia listed in the program's all-time results in the 1920s is a school now known as Loras College in Iowa, not the Columbia in the Ivy League.)

Following the Beacons: All Valpo football home games this season will be carried on ESPN3. Play-by-play broadcaster Todd Ickow is in his 31st year as the soundtrack of Valpo Athletics. Valpo Hall of Famer Tom Byrne will make his broadcasting debut as the team's ESPN3 color analyst this week. Byrne was a standout on the Valpo offensive line from 1999-2002. The radio call will be available on 95.1 FM WVUR, ValpoAthletics.com and the TuneIn Radio app with Garrett Willis describing the action. Head Coach Landon Fox: Landon Fox (5-15) is in his third season as the head coach of the Valparaiso University football program in Fall 2021. During his second season at the helm in Spring 2021, Fox was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award – which is presented annually to the FCS National Coach of the Year – after guiding Valpo to its best winning percentage since 2003 and tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999. He led his team to Pioneer Football League runner-up honors, the program's highest finish in the league standings since the PFL championship season of 2003. Fox's defensive roots paid dividends on that side of the football in his second year at the helm, as the team enjoyed its best defensive season in four decades. Valpo held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last 40 years. Valpo limited the opposition to 172.2 passing yards per game, the program's best passing defense since 2008. In addition, the squad boasted its best rushing defense (111.2 yards per game) and scoring defense (18.7 points per game) since 1999. In Year 1 of the Fox Era in 2019, Valpo ranked in the Top 5 in the PFL in scoring defense (32.0, fifth), total defense (381.6, fourth),

rushing defense (184.2, fourth) and passing defense (197.3, fifth). After spending the previous 11 seasons as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at the University of Dayton, Fox was named the head football coach at Valpo prior to the 2019 season. He helped the Flyers finish with 10 winning seasons in his 11 years on staff and guided a defensive backfield that produced one All-American, four Academic All-Americans, two PFL Special Teams Players of the Year and three corners who were invited to NFL Rookie Minicamp. Prior to joining Dayton's staff, Fox served as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Wayne State University in Detroit from 2005-2007. He also spent time as a defensive graduate assistant at Ball State University (2004), Dayton (2002-2003) and Lakeland College (2001). Fox began his coaching career as an assistant varsity coach at Preble Shawnee High School in Camden, Ohio during the 2000 season. During his playing days, Fox was a team captain and all-conference performer at Defiance College in Defiance, Ohio from 1995-1999 and graduated with a degree in physical education and health in May 2000 before earning his master's degree in education from Lakeland in May 2002.

Valpo in Home Openers: The Beacons will attempt to reverse a trend as the program has dropped 10 of its last 11 home openers including four straight. The lone victory during that stretch came on Sept. 17, 2016, a 49-24 triumph over Trinity International. Valpo dropped the Spring 2021 home opener vs. Drake (17-6), the 2019 home opener to Central Connecticut State (42-13), 2018 vs. Truman State (34-20) and 2017 vs. Duquesne (45-40).

Wrapping Up Week 2: No. 5/4 North Dakota State 64, Valpo 0

- Valpo saw an 80-game scoring streak come to an end as the Beacons were shut out for the first time since Oct. 5, 2013, a 37-0 loss at Marist.
- The program played its first game against a member of the Missouri Valley Football Conference since Sept. 15, 2018 at Youngstown State. It was Valpo's first game against a ranked team since Sept. 3, 2016 at No. 8/10 Illinois State and it was the highest ranked team the program had ever faced. In addition, Valpo played an indoor game for the first time since Aug. 29, 2013 at North Dakota.
- Jadarius Horton notched a sack on Sept. 11 at North Dakota State for his first career tackle for loss. The sack went for a loss of seven, one of the defensive highlights of the day for the Beacons.
- Defensive back Kohlton Sherman had a big game in the Valpo secondary, racking up a team-high 10 tackles including four solos. It was his second-career double-figure tackle game and first since Nov. 2, 2019 at Davidson.
- Sophomore Adam Mekky enjoyed a breakout day for the Valpo defense, accruing seven tackles. His first tackle of the day represented the first of his career.
- Punter Ben Niesner was a bright spot for Valpo, totaling 302 yards on seven attempts for an average of 43.1 yards per punt. He placed two kicks inside the 20 including a 58 yarder, his longest of the season to this point. However, Niesner's most memorable play came when he turned in Valpo's longest rush of the day, a 17-yard gain to move the chains on 4th-and-4 from the Valpo 36-yard line early in the second quarter. He previously ran for 10 yards and a first down on a fake punt play on Oct. 10, 2019 at Drake, rushed for three yards and a first down on a 4th-and-2 play on April 17, 2021 vs. San Diego and converted a fake punt during his time at Portland State, his previous college stop.
- Valpo played the game shorthanded as leading tackler Jaxon Peifer, standout running back Nick Orekoya, starting quarterback Teryn Berry and return specialist / slot receiver Chuck Maxwell were all sidelined due to injuries.

Century Mark: The Beacons had a pair of individuals reach the 100-tackle threshold for their collegiate careers on Sept. 11 at North Dakota State as Kohlton Sherman

and Trey Psota both reached that milestone. Sherman's 10-tackle output elevated the senior's career accumulation to 106, while Psota had five tackles to boost his career total to 103. Jaxon Peifer is the team's active career leader in tackles with 125.

Among Active Leaders: Combined between his time at Portland State and Valpo, Ben Niesner has punted for 6,682 total yards in his collegiate career. His number ranks eighth among active players in Division-I FCS and 28th among players in all levels of college football. In addition, Niesner ranks 21st nationally in FCS so far this season with 41.5 yards per punt.

Scouting the Opponent: Dartmouth will be playing its first game of the season and first since Nov. 23, 2019 on Saturday. The Big Green won their most recent game 29-23 at Brown to close out the 2019 campaign. Dartmouth finished 9-1 in 2019 to share the Ivy League crown and is projected to finish third in the league's preseason poll. Dartmouth is seeking its league-record 19th Ivy League title this season. Head coach Buddy Teevens is the program's all-time winningest coach with 105 victories.

Wrapping Up Week 1: Indiana Wesleyan 28, Valpo 10

- The Valpo defense held Indiana Wesleyan scoreless after halftime, and seven of the first-half points for the hosts were recorded on a special teams play. The Beacons limited the Wildcats to 82 yards of total offense in the second half.
- Jaxon Peifer paced the defense with a career-high 14 tackles. It marked his third career double-figure tackle output and first since a 10-tackle performance on Nov. 9, 2019 vs. Morehead State. Peifer also totaled 10 tackles on Aug. 29, 2019 at Eastern Kentucky, so two of his three games with 10 or more tackles have come in season openers.
- Although Keyon Turner saw his remarkable streak of notching a takeaway in each of his first six collegiate games come to an end, the sophomore standout did turn in a career-best nine tackles.
- Sophomore Kurt Kessen had a strong showing on the defensive line, racking up seven tackles including four solos.
- Redshirt sophomore defensive back Austin Chilton turned in Valpo's first takeaway of the season by notching an interception, the first of his career.
- The Valpo defense racked up 11 tackles for loss totaling 45 yards, including three sacks. Nathan Orlandini had 2.0 TFL, leading a collection of 10 Valpo players who were involved in at least one tackle for loss. The fifth-year senior now has 5.5 TFL in his career. The 11 TFL were the team's most since Oct. 5, 2019 at Dayton (12).
- Valpo held Indiana Wesleyan to just 1-of-12 on third down and 0-of-2 on fourth down.
- Chuck Maxwell's speed was a bright spot for Valpo offensively as the sophomore had three carries for 77 yards including a 45-yard TD run that represented the only points of the second half by either team. That marked Maxwell's first career offensive TD and second overall score including a kickoff return last season. Maxwell finished the game as the team's leading rusher.
- Ollie Reese led the Valpo receiving core with three catches for 60 yards, including several difficult grabs where he battled a member of the Indiana Wesleyan secondary to pull down the football.
- Ben Niesner averaged 38.8 yards per punt on four attempts and pinned one at the IWU 2-yard line. Brian Bartholomew went 1-for-2 on field goals and made from 34 yards out. He is now 8-for-10 in his Valpo career. Freshman Ryan Hawk handled kickoff duties and booted all three of his kicks through the end zone for touchbacks, averaging 55.0 yards per kick.
- The two teams were fairly evenly matched in yards of total offense with the Wildcats outgaining the Beacons 328-300. Valpo outdid the hosts 178-175 in passing yards.

Team Captains: Fifth-year senior long snapper Doug Haugh, senior wide receiver Ollie Reese, senior running back Robert Washington, redshirt sophomore linebacker Evan Annis and fifth-year senior defensive lineman Nathan Orlandini were elected team captains by their peers. Haugh is in his second year as a team captain, while the other players occupy that role for the first time this season.

A Look Back at Spring 2021

- Finished with the program's best winning percentage since 2003 (.666), tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999.
- Held its best record through the first six games of a season (in this case, the only six games of the season) since 1999 and its best record through six league games since 1964.
- Won four PFL games in the same season for the second time ever (five, 2017) and four league games in any conference for just the second time since 1968.
- Snapped a 14-game losing streak to San Diego, earning the program's first victory over the Toreros since 2003.
- Snapped a 17-game head-to-head skid by picking up its first win over Drake since 2003 and its first-ever win in Des Moines.
- Beat a San Diego team that was receiving votes in the latest STATS FCS Top 25 and AFCA Coaches Top 25 at the time of the matchup. The Toreros were nationally ranked earlier in the season. The loss marked San Diego's second in its last 42 PFL games.
- The final four games of the season were all decided by four points or fewer, and all six games were dictated by 11 points or fewer.
- Completed a significant turnaround, going from 1-11 during the 2019 fall slate to 4-2 in Spring 2021 and a second-place finish in the PFL, the team's highest finish in the PFL standings since the 2003 season.
- Five players earned all-PFL First Team honors, the team's most since 2005.
- Placed 56 on the academic honor roll, a 15 student-athlete jump from the previous year and the second-most in program history (60, 2018).
- Outrushed opponents 910-668, the team's first time gaining more yards on the ground than its opponents since 2007.
- Eclipsed 150 rushing yards per game for the second time in the last 12 seasons and the first time since 2014.
- Held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last 40 years.
- Held opponents to 172.2 passing yards per game, the program's best passing defense since 2008.
- Held opponents to 111.2 rushing yards per game, the team's best rushing defense since 1999.
- Held opponents to 18.7 points per game, the team's best scoring defense since 1999.

Fall 2021 Preseason Picks

- Valpo was picked to finish sixth of 11 in the Pioneer Football League pre-season poll.
- Davidson was projected to win the league, edging out perennial favorite San Diego.
- Valpo boasted five players on the Preseason All-PFL team – running back Robert Washington, linebacker Jaxon Peifer, defensive back Keyon Turner, kicker Brian Bartholomew and punter Ben Niesner.
- Washington was named the Phil Steele PFL Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Niesner and Bartholomew joined Washington on the Phil

Steele Preseason PFL First Team. Valpo's second-team honorees included offensive lineman Aaron Byrd, defensive lineman Trejuan Purty, Turner, Peifer, kick returner Chuck Maxwell and long snapper Doug Haugh. In addition, linebacker Evan Annis was named to the third team.

- Niesner was also named to the FCS Punter of the Year Preseason Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council.

Spring 2021 Individual Achievements

- Ben Niesner finished with a season punting average of 43.6 yards per punt, tying Greg Wood's 2010 program record for single-season punting average (when rounded to the nearest 10th of a yard). When taken to the next decimal place, Wood's 2010 mark is slightly ahead of Niesner's Spring 2021 mark at 43.63 and 43.85, respectively. Wood's 2010 mark is also the PFL record with Niesner now second in PFL history.
- Niesner's career-long 72-yard punt against San Diego was only

the fifth punt of 72 yards or more in FCS during the Spring 2021 season, tied for the fourth longest in the nation.

- Drew Gedrys had two blocked kicks against San Diego, becoming only the third player in the FCS nation with multiple blocked kicks in a single game in the Spring 2021 season.

- Keyon Turner was part of a turnover in all six games with four interceptions and two fumble recoveries. He finished the season as the outright leader in takeaways. He was one of only five players in the nation with four or more interceptions... Lone freshman on all-PFL First Team... One of only five Valpo players with four or more interceptions in a single game over the last 12 years despite the fact that the slate was shortened to six games. He ranked in the top 10 nationally in interceptions per game, led the nation in interceptions among freshmen and became the first Valpo player with an interception in four straight games in over two decades and the first Valpo freshman with four interceptions in a season in over 20 years.

- Robert Washington – ranked eighth nationally in FCS in rushing yards per game at 108.8. Accrued 100 or more rushing yards on four occasions including a season-high 199 on 39 carries in the March 13 season opener at Butler, the highest single-game rushing output by a Valpo player since 2012. His 199-yard performance marked the ninth-highest single-game rushing number in the nation during the Spring 2021, and he was one of three players nationally with multiple games of 180+ rushing yards. Had the most rushing yards in a season by any Valpo player since Brandon Hall's 855 in 2014 despite the Spring 2021 slate being shortened to six games... Ranked 11th nationally in total rushing yards (653) and 12th in all-purpose yards per game (129.33)... One of seven unanimous All-PFL selections... First Valpo player with four 100-yard rushing games in the same season since Jeff Horton had six in 2005.

- Brian Bartholomew – Boasted the league's best field-goal percentage at 87.5 percent, converting seven of his eight attempts. He had the most PATs without a miss in the league, going a perfect 13-for-13 on PATs. The redshirt sophomore ranked sixth in the PFL in scoring at 5.7 points per game. His season-long 49-yard field goal came at a critical time as it represented the first points of an eventual 10-7 win over Drake. He had Valpo's best single-season field goal percentage in over 15 years.

- Chuck Maxwell finished his season as the FCS national leader in kickoff return average at 29.8 yards per return. He had 151 kickoff return yards in Week 6 vs. San Diego, the most by any PFL player in a single contest during the season. The 86 yarder marked the second-longest return by a PFL player in Spring 2021.

- QB Chris Duncan finished among the program's career leaders in both passing yards (4086, sixth) and total offense (4,902). He finished his career ranked 21st in yards of total offense among active players in Division-I FCS.

- **WR-z #13 Braden Contreras, So.** – Two-time all-conference selection at Hinsdale Central High School... Father Steve played football at Amherst from 1995-1999... Earned all-state second team status and named his team's Offensive Player of the Year Award in high school... Recovered a Butler onside kick in the final two minutes to help seal a 28-25 victory on March 27, 2021... Had his first career touchdown catch on April 17, 2021 vs. San Diego, hauling in the go-ahead score to put his team up 20-19 with seconds left on the clock in the game against the Toreros, an eventual upset over a team receiving votes nationally.

- **LT #68 Aaron Byrd, R-Jr.** – Majoring in bioengineering with a strong interest in prosthetics... The launch of Valpo's bioengineering program within the school's nationally-ranked College of Engineering attracted him to the University... Has performed undergraduate research in the Human Movement Research Laboratory under Craig Goehler, Ph.D., an associate professor of mechanical engineering and bioengineering... Serves as a student tutor in the Hesse Learning Center on campus... Was a starter in 2019 and saw action in all 12 games...
