Game #6 Saturday, Oct. 9, 1 p.m. CT O'Shaughnessy Stadium (5,000) – St. Paul, Minn.

This Week in Valpo Football: The Valparaiso University football program will take on one of the two new members of the Pioneer Football League on Saturday as the Beacons make their first-ever trip to St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minn. After a week where all five PFL games were decided by seven points or fewer including Valpo's overtime defeat to Marist on Homecoming Saturday at Brown Field, the team will hope to start 2-0 in PFL road games for the second straight year.

**Previously:** Valpo rallied from 14 points down to force overtime, but Marist prevailed 27-24 on a game-winning 25-yard touchdown pass in OT after Valpo had made a field goal on its OT possession. Running back Robert Washington rushed for 149 yards and two touchdowns, while quarterback Ben Nimz went 15-of-25 through the air for 193 yards. The Valpo defense had 12 tackles for loss and six sacks, while the special teams unit blocked a pair of kicks. Brian Bartholomew missed a 58-yard field goal try on the final play of regulation, but converted a 25-yard attempt on Valpo's OT possession. Nick Orekoya had his first rushing TD in a Valpo uniform in Saturday's setback. Valpo outgained Marist 351-349 in the contest.

**Series Notes**: This will represent the first ever meeting between these two teams.

**Head Coach Landon Fox**: Landon Fox (6-17) is in his third season as the head coach of the Valparaiso University football program in Fall 2021. During his second season at the helm in Spring 2021, Fox was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award – which is presented annually to the FCS National Coach of the Year – after guiding Valpo to its best winning percentage since 2003 and tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999. He led his team to Pioneer Football League runner-up honors, the program's highest finish in the league standings since the PFL championship season of 2003. Fox's defensive roots paid dividends on that side of the football in his second year at the helm, as the team enjoyed its best defensive season in four decades. Valpo held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last 40 years. Valpo limited the opposition to 172.2 passing yards per game, the program's best passing defense since 2008. In addition, the squad boasted its best rushing defense (111.2 yards per game) and scoring defense (18.7 points per game) since 1999. In Year 1 of the Fox Era in 2019, Valpo ranked in the Top 5 in the PFL in scoring defense (32.0, fifth), total defense (381.6, fourth), rushing defense (184.2, fourth) and passing defense (197.3, fifth). After spending the previous 11 seasons as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at the University of Dayton, Fox was named the head football coach at Valpo prior to the 2019 season. He helped the Flyers finish with 10 winning seasons in his 11 years on staff and guided a defensive backfield that produced one All-American, four Academic All-Americans, two PFL Special Teams Players of the Year and three corners who were invited to NFL Rookie Minicamp. Prior to joining Dayton's staff, Fox served as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Wayne State University

in Detroit from 2005-2007. He also spent time as a defensive graduate assistant at Ball State University (2004), Dayton (2002-2003) and Lakeland College (2001). Fox began his coaching career as an assistant varsity coach at Preble Shawnee High School in Camden, Ohio during the 2000 season. During his playing days, Fox was a team captain and all-conference performer at Defiance College in Defiance, Ohio from 1995-1999 and graduated with a degree in physical education and health in May 2000 before earning his master's degree in education from Lakeland in May 2002.

**Close Calls**: Dating back to last season, Valpo has played six straight PFL games decided by four points or fewer. Dating back to 2019, Valpo's last 13 league games have been decided by 12 points or fewer and 11 of those 13 have been dictated by 10 points or fewer.

**Working Overtime**: Although Valpo's Week 5 game vs. Marist continued a trend in terms of close contests, it was the only game in that stretch that required overtime to determine a victor. In fact, the game marked Valpo's first overtime contest since Sept. 28, 2013 vs. Campbell, a 49-42 victory.

**Block Party**: Entering Week 6 at St. Thomas, Valpo is one of three teams in the FCS nation with four or more blocked kicks. The Beacons are tied for second in FCS with four blocked kicks, joining Arkansas Pine Bluff. Only Delaware State has more with five. During the Spring 2021 campaign, Valpo finished as one of 17 teams nationally with three or more blocked kicks. In 2019, Valpo was tied for ninth nationally with five blocked kicks. In total, the team has blocked 12 kicks since Landon Fox took over prior to the 2019 season.

**Bittner Blocks**: Brett Bittner blocked a Dartmouth punt in the second quarter of the Sept. 18 game against the Big Green, then turned away a Marist punt in the Oct. 2 game at Brown Field. Through Week 5, Bittner is one of just four players in the FCS nation with multiple blocked kicks this season. Delaware State's Kevin Deshields leads the FCS nation with three blocks, while Bittner joins Maine's Richard Carr and William & Mary's Alex Washington with two apiece.

**Dropped Behind the Line**: The Valpo defense had success with dropping Marist players behind the line of scrimmage in the Oct. 2 game at Brown Field. The team accrued 12 tackles for loss and six sacks in the matchup with the Red Foxes. The six sacks represented Valpo's most in a single game since Oct. 3, 2009, a seven-sack performance at Drake. The dozen TFL was Valpo's most since Oct. 5, 2019 at Drake and tied for the most in the Landon Fox Era. Prior to Fox's arrival, Valpo's last PFL game with 12 or more TFL was Sept. 25, 2010 (13 vs. Drake). Through Week 5, there have been only 14 instances nationally of a team having more than 12 TFL in a game this season. In addition, only 14 teams have seven or more sacks in a single game this year. Since head coach Landon Fox took over prior to the 2019 season, Valpo has totaled 134 tackles for loss in 23 games, a significant uptick from prior to his arrival.

Where Robert Ranks: Through Week 5, running back Robert Washington has two games that rank in the top 30 nationally in FCS among single-game rushing performances. His 143-yard day at Drake is tied for 29th nationally and his 149-yard output vs. Marist is tied for 24th. Washington joins Quay Holmes (East Tennessee State) and Ramon Jefferson (Sam Houston) as the only three players in the nation with multiple single-game rushing performances in the top 30 nationally this year. In addition, Washington is tied for 30th nationally with four rushing TDs, ranks 11th nationally and leads the PFL with 433 total rushing yards and ranks 23rd nationally

**100-Yard Efforts**: Running back Robert Washington accrued 149 rushing yards in the Oct. 2 game vs. Marist, representing a season high and his seventh 100-yard rushing game in a Valpo uniform in just his 11th appearance. He eclipsed the 100-yard threshold for the third straight week. Over the last five seasons, there have been 12 100-yard rushing games by Valpo players, and Washington has accounted for seven of them.

**Scouting the Opponent:** St. Thomas is coming off a 27-24 loss at San Diego after topping Butler 36-0 in the PFL opener. The Tommies are in their first season of Division-I competition after more than 30 years in the Division-III ranks. They were picked eighth of 11 in the PFL preseason poll. Prior to conference play, St. Thomas picked up a 12-9 victory at Michigan Tech and incurred a 44-3 loss at UNI.

**Among Active Leaders:** Combined between his time at Portland State and Valpo, Ben Niesner has punted for 7,524 total yards in his collegiate career. His number ranks seventh among active players in Division-I FCS and 22nd among players in all levels of college football. In addition, Niesner ranks 23rd nationally in FCS so far this season with 41.9 yards per punt.

**Beating the Bulldogs**: Prior to the 10-7 win at Drake on April 3, 2021, Valpo had lost 17 straight head-to-head meetings with the Bulldogs and was 0-14 all-time at Drake. After the 24-21 victory on Sept. 25, the Beacons have won back-to-back games in the head-to-head series and earned their first two wins in Des Moines in the same calendar year. This marks the first time ever that Valpo has recorded consecutive wins over Drake.

**Starting in Style**: The Beacons have won the Pioneer Football League opener in back-to-back seasons after going on the road to beat Butler in the spring and starting the fall PFL slate with a win at Drake. Prior to the Spring 2021 PFL-opening victory, Valpo's last win to begin league play was 2016 vs. Davidson. Valpo has started the conference docket with a victory in consecutive years for the first time since 2005 and 2006.

**80-Yard Dash**: Robert Washington's 80-yard touchdown run in the Sept. 25 victory at Drake was Valpo's longest play on the ground since Jarrett Morgan's 86-yard pickup on Sept. 16, 2017 at Trinity International. It was Valpo's longest rush against a Division-I opponent since at least 2001. The 80 yarder was just shy of the program record for longest scoring run from scrimmage, which is 86 yards by Joe Pahr on Oct. 8, 1949 vs. Saint Joseph's. (Somehow, Morgan's 86-yard run was not a touchdown.) Washington's dash tied for the third longest from scrimmage in the FCS nation through the first four weeks of the season. Cole Mueller (Illinois State), Rogan Wells (Western Carolina) and Darran

Butts (Hampton) are the other FCS players in the nation with a rush of 80 or more yards through Week 4.

All-Purpose Threat: Washington finished with 199 all-purpose yards in the Sept. 25 win at Drake. Only 16 players nationally had eclipsed 200 all-purpose yards in a game to that point in the season. Washington averaged 8.4 yards per carry en route to 143 rushing yards, which tied for the 23rd-most by any FCS player in a single game this season at that point. His total represented the second-highest single-game rushing output by a Pioneer Football League player through the first four weeks of the season. He ran for two TDs in the game to up his career touchdown total to eight (seven rushing, one receiving). Washington was also a key piece in the passing game, accumulating 56 receiving yards on a team-high eight catches. He became the first Valpo player with eight or more receptions in a game since Ollie Reese on March 20, 2021 vs. Drake.

Mr. Clutch: Quarterback Ben Nimz entered the Sept. 25 game at Drake with 2:39 remaining as Valpo took over on its own 20-yard line trailing 21-17. He led a nine-play, 80-yard drive that resulted in a game-winning, 30-yard touchdown pass to Jordan Bingham on 4th-and-10 with 1:05 remaining. Nimz had also connected with Ollie Reese for a 42-yard hookup on a 4th-and-17 from the Valpo 28. Dating back to last season, Valpo has won back-to-back PFL games with Nimz throwing game-winning touchdown passes in the final 1:05 in both instances. He found Braden Contreras from nine yards out for a go-ahead score with 25 seconds remaining in Valpo's 20-19 victory vs. San Diego in the Spring 2021 season finale. Nimz was also inserted midgame on April 10, 2021 at Morehead State and nearly led Valpo's biggest rally since 1995, but the Eagles prevailed 28-24. The Nimz-to-Reese 42 yarder was the longest pass completion by a Valpo player this season to that point and the team's longest since Nimz found Holden Hodge for 45 yards in the aforementioned Spring 2021 finale vs. San Diego.

Weekly Awards: Valpo's Austin Martins holds the rare distinction of having won weekly honors in different phases of the game in consecutive weeks. He was named the Week 3 College Sports Madness Defensive Player of the Week after securing two fourth-quarter fumble recoveries in Valpo's game vs. Dartmouth. Following his blocked field goal in the closing seconds of the team's 24-21 victory at Drake in Week 4, Martins was named the PFL Special Teams Player of the Week. Martins' pair of weekly awards come after Valpo totaled seven weekly honors from either the PFL or College Sports Madness during the six-week Spring 2021 PFL season.

**Proving Polls Imprecise**: Valpo was picked to finish sixth of 11 in the Pioneer Football League preseason poll, but knocked off a Drake team that was projected to finish third in the Week 4 PFL opener. Valpo has won three straight games against teams predicted to finish ahead of them in the standings after topping Drake and San Diego last spring, when the Toreros were picked to finish first and the Bulldogs were projected third. Valpo's next chance to knock off a team picked ahead of the Beacons in the preseason poll will come on Oct. 23 vs. Dayton at Brown Field.

**Twice is Nice:** Defensive lineman Austin Martins had a pair of fourth-quarter fumble recoveries to go along with a career-high six tackles including five solos in the Sept. 18 game vs. Dartmouth. He became the first Valpo player

with two fumble recoveries in a single game since Mike Jones on Oct. 8, 2005 vs. St. Joseph's. For his efforts, Martins was named the College Sports Madness PFL Defensive Player of the Week. Through three weeks, Martins was one of just 13 players tied for the FCS lead with two fumble recoveries this season.

Safety Dance: When Trey Psota sacked the Dartmouth quarterback for a safety on the first Big Green possession of the game on Sept. 18 at Brown Field, it represented Valpo's first safety since a team safety on Sept. 2, 2006 in a 54-0 win over Wisconsin Lutheran. Lightning struck twice on Sept. 18, as a Dartmouth punt attempt in the third quarter resulted in a safety as the snap sailed through the back of the end zone. This is the first time Valpo has had two safeties in the same season - let alone the same game – in the last 20 years. Psota became the first Valpo individual to receive credit for a safety in over two decades as the only other Valpo safeties in that time period were of the team variety. Davidson and Butler each had two safeties in 2017, which was the last time any PFL team had multiple safeties over the entire season. Valpo was one safety away from tying the single-game national record of three, which has occurred three times in FCS history.

Finding the Football: Valpo had three fumble recoveries on Sept. 18 vs. Dartmouth, which marked just the third time since the start of the 2018 season that a PFL team had three or more fumble recoveries in a single game. The game against the Big Green represented the first time Valpo had three or more fumble recoveries in a single game since Sept. 28, 2013, a 49-42 overtime victory over Campbell.

**Electric Atmosphere:** An enthusiastic student section led a large gathering of 3,856 fans on Saturday, Sept. 18 at Brown Field as Valpo hosted Dartmouth in the team's home opener. That marked Valpo's largest crowd for a non-Homecoming game since 4,673 spectators witnessed Valpo take on St. Joseph's College on Sept. 18, 2010

Strong Schedule: The Beacons may have entered PFL play with an 0-3 mark, but head coach Landon Fox's team challenged itself in nonconference action. The team's 28-18 setback vs. Dartmouth in Week 3 was the closest the program has ever come to beating a member of the Ivy League. The Big Green had gone a combined 26-4 over their last three seasons and were the defending Ivy League champions. Dartmouth went on to beat scholarship foe Sacred Heart 41-3 the following week and won 31-7 at Penn on Oct. 1. Prior to hosting the Big Green, Valpo visited No. 5/4 North Dakota State for the program's first game against a ranked opponent since 2016. The Bison have won eight of the last 10 FCS national titles. It was the highest ranked team Valpo has ever faced. Valpo's Week 1 opponent, Indiana Wesleyan, is a quality team and beat No. 6 Olivet Nazarene 52-28 in Week 3.

senior wide receiver Ollie Reese, senior running back Robert Washington, redshirt sophomore linebacker Evan Annis and fifth-year senior defensive lineman Nathan Orlandini were elected team captains by their peers. Haugh is in his second year as a team captain, while the other players occupy that role for the first time this season.

#### A Look Back at Spring 2021

- Finished with the program's best winning percentage since 2003 (.666), tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999.
- Held its best record through the first six games of a season (in this case, the only six games of the season) since 1999 and its best record through six league games since 1964.
- Won four PFL games in the same season for the second time ever (five, 2017) and four league games in any conference for just the second time since 1968.
- Snapped a 14-game losing streak to San Diego, earning the program's first victory over the Torcros since 2003.
- Snapped a 17-game head-to-head skid by picking up its first win over Drake since 2003 and its first-ever win in Des Moines.
- Beat a San Diego team that was receiving votes in the latest STATS FCS Top 25 and AFCA Coaches Top 25 at the time of the matchup. The Toreros were nationally ranked earlier in the season. The loss marked San Diego's second in its last 42 PFL games.
- The final four games of the season were all decided by four points or fewer, and all six games were dictated by 11 points or fewer.
- Completed a significant turnaround, going from 1-11 during the 2019 fall slate to 4-2 in Spring 2021 and a second-place finish in the PFL, the team's highest finish in the PFL standings since the 2003 season.
- Five players earned all-PFL First Team honors, the team's most since 2005.
- Placed 56 on the academic honor roll, a 15 student-athlete jump from the previous year and the second-most in program history (60, 2018).
- Outrushed opponents 910-668, the team's first time gaining more yards on the ground than its opponents since 2007.
- Eclipsed 150 rushing yards per game for the second time in the last 12 seasons and the first time since 2014.
- Held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last  $40~\mathrm{years}$ .
- Held opponents to 172.2 passing yards per game, the program's best passing defense since 2008.
- Held opponents to 111.2 rushing yards per game, the team's best rushing defense since 1999.
- Held opponents to 18.7 points per game, the team's best scoring defense since 1999.

#### Fall 2021 Preseason Picks

- Valpo was picked to finish sixth of 11 in the Pioneer Football League preseason poll.
- Davidson was projected to win the league, edging out perennial favorite San Diego.
- Valpo boasted five players on the Preseason All-PFL team running back Robert Washington, linebacker Jaxon Peifer, defensive back Keyon Turner, kicker Brian Bartholomew and punter Ben Niesner.
- Washington was named the Phil Steele PFL Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while Niesner and Bartholomew joined Washington on the Phil Steele Preseason PFL First Team. Valpo's second-team honorees included offensive

lineman Aaron Byrd, defensive lineman Trejuan Purty, Turner, Peifer, kick returner Chuck Maxwell and long snapper Doug Haugh. In addition, linebacker Evan Annis was named to the third team.

- Niesner was also named to the FCS Punter of the Year Preseason Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council.

2021 season, tied for the fourth longest in the nation.

- Drew Gedrys had two blocked kicks against San Diego, becoming only the third player in the FCS nation with multiple blocked kicks in a single game in the Spring 2021 season.
- Keyon Turner was part of a turnover in all six games with four interceptions and two fumble recoveries. He finished the season as the outright leader in takeaways. He was one of only five players in the nation with four or more interceptions... Lone freshman on all-PFL First Team... One of only five Valpo players with four or more interceptions in a single game over the last 12 years despite the fact that the slate was shortened to six games. He ranked in the top 10 nationally in interceptions per game, led the nation in interceptions among freshmen and became the first Valpo player with an interception in four straight games in over two decades and the first Valpo freshman with four interceptions in a season in over 20 years.
- Robert Washington ranked eighth nationally in FCS in rushing yards per game at 108.8. Accrued 100 or more rushing yards on four occasions including a season-high 199 on 39 carries in the March 13 season opener at Butler, the highest single-game rushing output by a Valpo player since 2012. His 199-yard performance marked the ninth-highest single-game rushing number in the nation during the Spring 2021, and he was one of three players nationally with multiple games of 180+ rushing yards. Had the most rushing yards in a season by any Valpo player since Brandon Hall's 855 in 2014 despite the Spring 2021 slate being shortened to six games...
