This Week in Valpo Football: After a bye week that blended rest and recovery with additional practice and preparation, the Valparaiso University football team will return to action this week as the Beacons are set to host Dayton on Saturday at high noon at Brown Field. This week will mark a reunion of sorts for head coach Landon Fox, who will oppose one of his coaching mentors in longtime Dayton head coach Rick Chamberlin. Prior to arriving at Valpo, Fox spent 11 years as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at Dayton. Saturday will be Family Day at Brown Field.

Previously: Prior to the bye week, Valpo incurred a 20-13 setback at St. Thomas on Oct. 9. A strip sack by Nick Price and an interception by Austin Chilton helped ignite a fourth-quarter surge that saw Valpo outscore the hosts 10-0 over the final 15 minutes, but the Beacons couldn't fully overcome a 17-point deficit. Kicker Brian Bartholomew made a pair of field goals and punter Ben Niesner achieved 53.2 yards per boot, while the Valpo defense was led by Jaxon Peifer's career-high-tying 14 tackles. QB Ben Nimz completed 17 passes for 183 yards, while the Tommies contained the running game to the tune of 24 carries for 37 yards. Penalties were a major bugaboo as Valpo was flagged 13 times for 112 yards. The frequent penalties were an aberration from the norm under head coach Landon Fox, as this marked the first time during his tenure that Valpo was penalized for at least 100 yards in a game, something that had most recently occurred on Nov. 3, 2018 (110 at Marist).

Series Notes: Dayton holds a 26-3 advantage in an all-time series that dates back to 1988. The two teams faced off 27 consecutive seasons from 1993-2019, a streak that was snapped when Dayton opted to sit out the Spring 2021 season. This will mark the 28th straight season in which both teams have participated that the charter Pioneer Football League members have faced off. Dayton came to Brown Field and prevailed 41-28 on Oct. 12, 2019 in Fox's first matchup with his former team. Valpo's most recent win over the Flyers was 8-7 on Nov. 18, 2017, a victory that clinched the program's best season since 2003, a mark that has since been surpassed by the Spring 2021 squad. Dayton has won 14 of the last 15 matchups.

Following the Beacons: All home games this season will be broadcast on ESPN3. The longtime Voice of Valpo Todd Ickow will have the play-by-play alongside color analyst Tom Byrne, who was a standout on Valpo's offensive line from 1999-2002 and is a member of the Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame. In addition, Garrett Willis and James Sroge will have the call on WVUR, 95.1 FM Valparaiso, ValpoAthletics.com and the TuneIn Radio app. For in-game social media updates, follow @ valpoufootball on Twitter. Head Coach Landon Fox: Landon Fox (6-18) is in his third season as the head coach of the Valparaiso University football program in Fall 2021. During his second season at the helm in Spring 2021, Fox was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award – which is presented annually to the FCS National Coach of the Year – after guiding Valpo to its best winning percentage since 2003 and tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999. He led his team to Pioneer Football League runner-up honors, the program's highest finish in the league standings since the PFL

championship season of 2003. Fox's defensive roots paid dividends on that side of the football in his second year at the helm, as the team enjoyed its best defensive season in four decades. Valpo held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last 40 years. Valpo limited the opposition to 172.2 passing yards per game, the program's best passing defense since 2008. In addition, the squad boasted its best rushing defense (111.2 yards per game) and scoring defense (18.7 points per game) since 1999. In Year 1 of the Fox Era in 2019, Valpo ranked in the Top 5 in the PFL in scoring defense (32.0, fifth), total defense (381.6, fourth), rushing defense (184.2, fourth) and passing defense (197.3, fifth). After spending the previous 11 seasons as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at the University of Dayton, Fox was named the head football coach at Valpo prior to the 2019 season. He helped the Flyers finish with 10 winning seasons in his 11 years on staff and guided a defensive backfield that produced one All-American, four Academic All-Americans, two PFL Special Teams Players of the Year and three corners who were invited to NFL Rookie Minicamp. Prior to joining Dayton's staff, Fox served as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Wayne State University in Detroit from 2005-2007. He also spent time as a defensive graduate assistant at Ball State University (2004), Dayton (2002-2003) and Lakeland College (2001). Fox began his coaching career as an assistant varsity coach at Preble Shawnee High School in Camden, Ohio during the 2000 season. During his playing days, Fox was a team captain and all-conference performer at Defiance College in Defiance, Ohio from 1995-1999 and graduated with a degree in physical education and health in May 2000 before earning his master's degree in education from Lakeland in May 2002.

Strength of Schedule: Valpo's three nonconference opponents currently hold a combined 16-1 record. North Dakota State is a flawless 6-0 and is ranked third nationally. Dartmouth owns a 5-0 mark and is coming off a 38-21 victory at No. 23 New Hampshire. Dartmouth is now ranked 25th in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and is receiving votes in the FCS Coaches' Poll. Indiana Wesleyan has just one loss and is ranked 10th nationally in NAIA. In addition, Valpo's two conference setbacks have come against teams with a combined PFL mark of 5-1. This past weekend, Drake – a team Valpo beat earlier this season – took perennial league powerhouse San Diego down to the wire in a 13-10 Torero triumph, while Marist bested a traditionally-strong Dayton program 20-17 and St. Thomas blitzed Stetson 38-7.

Close Calls: Dating back to last season, Valpo has played seven straight PFL games decided by seven points or fewer. Dating back to 2019, Valpo's last 14 league games have been decided by 12 points or fewer and 12 of those 14 have been dictated by 10 points or fewer. Valpo's last two games have resulted in a pair of close defeats, 27-24 in overtime on Oct. 2 vs. Marist and 20-13 on Oct. 9 at St. Thomas. Dating back to 2019, six of Valpo's last eight losses in PFL play have come by seven points or fewer.

Niesner Notes: Ben Niesner averaged a career-high 53.2 yards per punt on six attempts in the Oct. 9 game at St. Thomas, helping him earn Pioneer Football League Special Teams Player of the Week honors. He launched four of his six punts 50-plus yards and all six 40-plus yards. His performance marked the 10th-best single-game punting average in Division-I FCS to that point in the season. His biggest boot of the day was a 63 yarder that represented his season long and the second-longest punt of his collegiate career. With his successful Saturday in St. Paul, Niesner is up to 43.7 yards per punt, which ranks 13th nationally in Division-I FCS. He is also seventh among active Division-I FCS players with 7,843 career punting yards. Niesner, who was named to the FCS Punter of the Year Preseason Watch List and was a semifinalist for that honor a year ago, also earned PFL Special Teams Player of the Week laurels

twice during the six-week Spring 2021 docket. Valpo has had a higher punting average than its opponent in each of the first six games this season. Niesner's season average is up to 43.7, currently placing him in position to surpass his program-record-tying mark of 43.6 from a year ago.

Robert in the Record Book: Valpo running back Robert Washington has rushed for 1,109 career yards in just 12 games in a Valpo uniform. He is on the fringe of passing Kyle Cartales (1,140 yards; 38 games) and Brandon Hall (1,196 yards; 23 games) on Valpo's career rushing list. He has a chance to get past Jarrett Morgan (1,267 yards; 39 games) and Jake Huston (1,296 yards, 26 games) for Valpo's highest career rushing total since Jeff Horton closed out his career in 2007 with a school-record 3,072. In order to crack the top 10 in program history in career rushing yards, Washington would need to get to 1,644. With 456 rushing yards in six games, Washington is on pace to rank third in Valpo history in single-season rushing yards. If he sustains the current pace, he would rush for 890 yards this year.

Coming Off a Bye: There were no bye weeks during the Spring 2021 season, and Valpo's bye week during the 2019 season came in Week 2, while 2018 came in Week 1. In 2016 Valpo had a bye the final week of the season, so over the last six years, this marks just the second time Valpo's bye has come in the midst of PFL play. The only other time in that stretch that Valpo broke up league action with an off week was the 2017 campaign, when a well-rested group followed an Oct. 21 bye with a 63-32 home victory over Morehead State on Oct. 28. That sparked a stretch where Valpo won three of its final four games.

Scouting the Opponent: Dayton was picked fourth of 11 in the Pioneer Football League preseason poll. The Flyers, who opted out of the Spring 2021 season, went 7-3 overall and 6-2 in PFL play during the 2019 campaign. They opened this season with a 17-10 victory over scholarship-foe Eastern Illinois. Dayton owns a league-record 12 PFL championships, has the best all-time PFL record in league history and entered this season with the fifth-best winning percentage in FCS football since 2000. The Flyers are coming off a 20-17 home loss to Marist last week.

Proving Polls Imprecise: Valpo was picked to finish sixth of 11 in the Pioneer Football League preseason poll, but knocked off a Drake team that was projected to finish third in the Week 4 PFL opener. Valpo has won three straight games against teams predicted to finish ahead of them in the standings after topping Drake and San Diego last spring, when the Toreros were picked to finish first and the Bulldogs were projected third. Valpo's next chance to knock off a team picked ahead of the Beacons in the preseason poll will come this week vs. Dayton at Brown Field.

Working Overtime: Although Valpo's Week 5 game vs. Marist continued a trend in terms of close contests, it was the only game in that stretch that required overtime to determine a victor. In fact, the game marked Valpo's first overtime contest since Sept. 28, 2013 vs. Campbell, a 49-42 victory.

Block Party: Entering Week 8 vs. Dayton, Valpo is one of six teams in the FCS nation with four or more blocked kicks. The Beacons are tied for third in FCS with four blocked kicks, behind only Arkansas Pine Bluff and Delaware State with five apiece. During the Spring 2021 campaign, Valpo finished as one of 17 teams nationally with three or more blocked kicks. In 2019, Valpo was tied for ninth nationally with five blocked kicks. In total, the team has blocked 12 kicks since Landon Fox took over prior to the 2019 season.

Bittner Blocks: Brett Bittner blocked a Dartmouth punt in the second quarter of the Sept. 18 game against the Big Green, then turned away a Marist punt in the Oct. 2 game at

Brown Field. Through Week 7, Bittner is one of just nine players in the FCS nation with multiple blocked kicks this season. He is tied for third nationally, behind only Delaware State's Kevin Deshields and Southern Illinois' Anthony Knighton, who have three apiece.

Dropped Behind the Line: The Valpo defense had success with dropping Marist players behind the line of scrimmage in the Oct. 2 game at Brown Field. The team accrued 12 tackles for loss and six sacks in the matchup with the Red Foxes. The six sacks represented Valpo's most in a single game since Oct. 3, 2009, a seven-sack performance at Drake. The dozen TFL was Valpo's most since Oct. 5, 2019 at Drake and tied for the most in the Landon Fox Era. Prior to Fox's arrival, Valpo's last PFL game with 12 or more TFL was Sept. 25, 2010 (13 vs. Drake). Through that point in the season, there were only 14 instances nationally of a team having more than 12 TFL in a game this season. In addition, only 14 teams had seven or more sacks in a single game this year at that juncture. Since head coach Landon Fox took over prior to the 2019 season, Valpo has totaled 134 tackles for loss in 23 games, a significant uptick from prior to his arrival.

100-Yard Efforts: Running back Robert Washington accrued 149 rushing yards in the Oct. 2 game vs. Marist, representing a season high and his seventh 100-yard rushing game in a Valpo uniform in just his 11th appearance. He eclipsed the 100-yard threshold for the third straight week. Over the last five seasons, there have been 12 100-yard rushing games by Valpo players, and Washington has accounted for seven of them.

Beating the Bulldogs: Prior to the 10-7 win at Drake on April 3, 2021, Valpo had lost 17 straight head-to-head meetings with the Bulldogs and was 0-14 all-time at Drake. After the 24-21 victory on Sept. 25, the Beacons have won back-to-back games in the head-to-head series and earned their first two wins in Des Moines in the same calendar year. This marks the first time ever that Valpo has recorded consecutive wins over Drake.

Starting in Style: The Beacons have won the Pioneer Football League opener in back-to-back seasons after going on the road to beat Butler in the spring and starting the fall PFL slate with a win at Drake. Prior to the Spring 2021 PFL-opening victory, Valpo's last win to begin league play was 2016 vs. Davidson. Valpo has started the conference docket with a victory in consecutive years for the first time since 2005 and 2006.

80-Yard Dash: Robert Washington's 80-yard touchdown run in the Sept. 25 victory at Drake was Valpo's longest play on the ground since Jarrett Morgan's 86-yard pickup on Sept. 16, 2017 at Trinity International. It was Valpo's longest rush against a Division-I opponent since at least 2001. The 80 yarder was just shy of the program record for longest scoring run from scrimmage, which is 86 yards by Joe Pahr on Oct. 8, 1949 vs. Saint Joseph's. (Somehow, Morgan's 86-yard run was not a touchdown.) Washington's dash tied for the third longest from scrimmage in the FCS nation through the first four weeks of the season. Cole Mueller (Illinois State), Rogan Wells (Western Carolina) and Darran Butts (Hampton) were the other FCS players in the nation with a rush of 80 or more yards through Week 4.

Mr. Clutch: Quarterback Ben Nimz entered the Sept. 25 game at Drake with 2:39 remaining as Valpo took over on its own 20yard line trailing 21-17. He led a nine-play, 80-yard drive that resulted in a game-winning, 30-yard touchdown pass to Jordan Bingham on 4th-and-10 with 1:05 remaining. Nimz had also connected with Ollie Reese for a 42-yard hookup on a 4th-and-17 from the Valpo 28. Dating back to last season, Valpo has won back-to-back PFL games with Nimz throwing game-winning touchdown passes in the final 1:05 in both instances. He found Braden Contreras from nine yards out for a go-ahead score with 25 seconds remaining in Valpo's 20-19 victory vs. San Diego in the Spring 2021 season finale. Nimz was also inserted midgame on April 10, 2021 at Morehead State and nearly led Valpo's biggest rally since 1995, but the Eagles prevailed 28-24. The Nimz-to-Reese 42 yarder was the longest pass completion by a Valpo player this season to that point and the team's longest since Nimz found Holden Hodge for 45 yards in the aforementioned Spring 2021 finale vs. San Diego.

Weekly Awards: Valpo's Austin Martins holds the rare distinction of having won weekly honors in different phases of the game in consecutive weeks. He was named the Week 3 College Sports Madness Defensive Player of the Week after securing two fourth-quarter fumble recoveries in Valpo's game vs. Dartmouth. Following his blocked field goal in the closing seconds of the team's 24-21 victory at Drake in Week 4, Martins was named the PFL Special Teams Player of the Week. Martins' pair of weekly awards come after Valpo totaled seven weekly honors from either the PFL or College Sports Madness during the six-week Spring 2021 PFL season. Punter Ben Niesner added PFL Special Teams Player of the Week honors following his Week 6 showing at St. Thomas, marking the team's third weekly award of the fall slate.

Twice is Nice: Defensive lineman Austin Martins had a pair of fourth-quarter fumble recoveries to go along with a career-high six tackles including five solos in the Sept. 18 game vs. Dartmouth. He became the first Valpo player with two fumble recoveries in a single game since Mike Jones on Oct. 8, 2005 vs. St. Joseph's. For his efforts, Martins was named the College Sports Madness PFL Defensive Player of the Week. Through

three weeks, Martins was one of just 13 players tied for the FCS lead with two fumble recoveries this season.

Safety Dance: When Trey Psota sacked the Dartmouth quarterback for a safety on the first Big Green possession of the game on Sept. 18 at Brown Field, it represented Valpo's first safety since a team safety on Sept. 2, 2006 in a 54-0 win over Wisconsin Lutheran. Lightning struck twice on Sept. 18, as a Dartmouth punt attempt in the third quarter resulted in a safety as the snap sailed through the back of the end zone. This is the first time Valpo has had two safeties in the same season – let alone the same game – in the last 20 years. Psota became the first Valpo individual to receive credit for a safety in over two decades as the only other Valpo safeties in that time period were of the team variety. Davidson and Butler each had two safeties in 2017, which was the last time any PFL team had multiple safeties over the entire season. Valpo was one safety away from tying the single-game national record of three, which has occurred three times in FCS history.

Finding the Football: Valpo had three fumble recoveries on Sept. 18 vs. Dartmouth, which marked just the third time since the start of the 2018 season that a PFL team had three or more fumble recoveries in a single game. The game against the Big Green represented the first time Valpo had three or more fumble recoveries in a single game since Sept. 28, 2013, a 49-42 overtime victory over Campbell.

Electric Atmosphere: An enthusiastic student section led a large gathering of 3,856 fans on Saturday, Sept. 18 at Brown Field as Valpo hosted Dartmouth in the team's home opener. That marked Valpo's largest crowd for a non-Homecoming game since 4,673 spectators witnessed Valpo take on St. Joseph's College on Sept. 18, 2010.

Strong Schedule: The Beacons may have entered PFL play with an 0-3 mark, but head coach Landon Fox's team challenged itself in nonconference action. The team's 28-18 setback vs. Dartmouth in Week 3 was the closest the program has ever come to beating a member of the Ivy League. The Big Green had gone a combined 26-4 over their last three seasons and were the defending Ivy League champions. Dartmouth went on to beat scholarship foe Sacred Heart 41-3 the following week and won 31-7 at Penn on Oct. 1. Prior to hosting the Big Green, Valpo visited No. 5/4 North Dakota State for the program's first game against a ranked opponent since 2016. The Bison have won eight of the last 10 FCS national titles. It was the highest ranked team Valpo has ever faced. Valpo's Week 1 opponent, Indiana Wesleyan, is a quality team and beat No. 6 Olivet Nazarene 52-28 in Week 3.

Team Captains: Fifth-year senior long snapper Doug Haugh, senior wide receiver Ollie Reese, senior running back Robert Washington, redshirt sophomore linebacker Evan Annis and fifth-year senior defensive lineman Nathan Orlandini were elected team captains by their peers. Haugh is in his second year as a team captain, while the other players occupy that role for the first time this season.

- Held opponents to 18.7 points per game, the team's best scoring defense since 1999.

Spring 2021 Individual Achievements

- Ben Niesner finished with a season punting average of 43.6 yards per punt, tying Greg Wood's 2010 program record for single-season punting average (when rounded to the nearest 10th of a yard). When taken to the next decimal place, Wood's 2010 mark is slightly ahead of Niesner's Spring 2021 mark at 43.63 and 43.85, respectively. Wood's 2010 mark is also the PFL record with Niesner now second in PFL history.
- Niesner's career-long 72-yard punt against San Diego was only the fifth punt of 72 yards or more in FCS during the Spring 2021 season, tied for the fourth longest in the nation.
- Drew Gedrys had two blocked kicks against San Diego, becoming only the third player in the FCS nation with multiple blocked kicks in a single game in the Spring 2021 season.
- Keyon Turner was part of a turnover in all six games with four interceptions and two fumble recoveries. He finished the season as the outright leader in takeaways. He was one of only five players in the nation with four or more interceptions... Lone freshman on all-PFL First Team... One of only five Valpo players with four or more interceptions in a single game over the last 12 years despite the fact that the slate was shortened to six games. He ranked in the top 10 nationally in interceptions per game, led the nation in interceptions among

freshmen and became the first Valpo player with an interception in four straight games in over two decades and the first Valpo freshman with four interceptions in a season in over 20 years.

- Robert Washington ranked eighth nationally in FCS in rushing yards per game at 108.8. Accrued 100 or more rushing yards on four occasions including a season-high 199 on 39 carries in the March 13 season opener at Butler, the highest single-game rushing output by a Valpo player since 2012. His 199-yard performance marked the ninth-highest single-game rushing number in the nation during the Spring 2021, and he was one of three players nationally with multiple games of 180+ rushing yards. Had the most rushing yards in a season by any Valpo player since Brandon Hall's 855 in 2014 despite the Spring 2021 slate being shortened to six games...
