Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The 2024 Valparaiso University baseball season will get underway this weekend with a four-game series at Alabama State in Montgomery, Ala. The set will open on Friday night before the two teams double up on Saturday and close out the series with a Sunday matinee. This begins a challenging nonconference schedule for the Brown & Gold including a season-opening stretch of 18 straight games away from Emory G. Bauer Field.

Last Time Out: Valpo qualified for the 2023 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by virtue of a top-eight finish in the regular-season standings. The team dropped both conference tournament games in Terre Haute, Ind., falling to Murray State 11-6 and Belmont 10-9. The Beacons rallied from down 9-3 in the elimination game against the Bruins, but could not quite overcome a nine-run second inning for the team from Nash-ville. Valpo enjoyed its best season since joining the Missouri Valley Conference in 2023.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (188-294) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he enters 2024 having skippered 482 Valpo games. He enters the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo has split four all-time meetings with Alabama State, most recently splitting two games in Montgomery, Ala. in 2020, winning 8-3 before a 4-2 setback on March 10 and March 11. Those were the final two games before the world was put on hold and the remainder of that season was cancelled due to COVID-19. Before that, the two teams matched up in 1996, when Valpo won 22-4, and 1992, a 6-5 loss.

In The Other Dugout: Alabama State

- Picked to finish first in the SWAC East preseason poll.

- Catcher Jamal George, first baseman Jack Hay and second baseman Randy Flores were named to the preseason SWAC First Team, while third baseman Christian Lopez, shortstop Kyler McIntosh, outfielder Ali LaPread and pitcher Sebastian Colon made the second team.

- Won 41 games last season and went 26-4 in conference play.

- Under the direction of head coach Jose Vazquez, who is in his eighth season.

Valpo on Opening Day

- Valpo has dropped eight of its last nine Opening Day games with the one win during that span coming 6-2 at UAB to start the 2021 campaign.

- The aforementioned victory over the Blazers was the squad's first Opening Day triumph since beating Samford 6-5 on Feb. 14, 2014.

- The Beacons will look to get back in the Opening Day win column this year. Most recently, the team fell 5-1 to Kansas last season.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo starts the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.

- The Beacons will play three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.

- A challenging early-season docket continues on March 1, when Valpo will play at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).

- Valpo will play a fourth straight opponent and ninth straight game against a team with 30 or more wins last season on March 2 at preseason No. 1 Wake Forest. The Demon Deacons were 54-12, going 22-7 in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) on their way to NCAA Regional and Super Regional crowns that resulted in a College World Series appearance.

- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghampton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo will visit Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.

- Valpo will have a three-game series at Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.

- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.

- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).

- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.

- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.

- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.

- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.

- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.

- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.

- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Talkin' Schmack

- Head coach Brian Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).

- Schmack is 12 wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-win milestone.

- Schmack will reach another milestone this season when the 2024 campaign reaches its 18th tilt. That will mark Schmack's 500th game in charge of the program, becoming the third skipper in program history to reach that number.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.

- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.

- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).

- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.

- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.

- Maka hit two grand slams – April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois – becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.

- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).

- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.

- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters – Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).

- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.

- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program – outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).

- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold – LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.

• #38 RHP Griffin McCluskey, Sr. (Normal, Ill. / Normal Community) - As a freshman, got the starting nod on May 11, 2021 vs. No. 8 Notre Dame and pitched a gem at Emory G. Bauer Field, holding the guests to no runs on one hit - a seeing-eye single through the left side - while walking just one and striking out four in six innings. He left in position for the win after becoming just the third pitcher to hold Notre Dame scoreless while pitching six or more innings all season, joining Duke's Jack Carey and Boston College's Emmett Sheehan ... Posted the highest fielding percentage by a starting shortstop in program history in high school... Finished in the top 10 in his high school's history in career 3-point field goals in basketball... Enjoys playing the guitar... Earned his first collegiate victory in his hometown of Normal, Ill. on April 17, 2022, pitching Valpo to a 2-1 win over Illinois State on Easter Sunday. He allowed just one run on four hits and one walk while striking out five over six strong innings... Was Valpo's 2023 opening day starter vs. Kansas in Corpus Christi, Texas... In 2023, tied for fourth in the league in games started, ranked 13th in innings pitched and was eighth in strikeouts.

• #16 RHP Josh Cottrill, R-Jr. (Pewaukee, Wis. / Pewaukee) – Redshirted in 2021 during his first season on campus, then logged 8 2/3 innings in seven games out of the bullpen in 2022... Two-time all-conference performer in high school... Set his school's record for highest batting average by a freshman at .531 in 2017... Hobbies include Guitar Hero... Can juggle... Loves to travel... Posted a 5.63 ERA while making 14 appearances including one start in 2023... Made his first collegiate start and logged four innings on May 19, 2023 vs. Illinois State.

• #42 LHP Lucas Foley, Fr. (Deer Park, Ill. / Lake Zurich) – 2023 IHS-BCA 4A First Team All-State and PBR Third Team All-State... Conference Pitcher of the Year as a senior in high school in 2023... Kicks with his left foot but does everything else right handed... Enjoys golfing and disc golfing.

- #30 Brady Renfro, 1B, Sr. (Antigo, Wis. / Antigo) – Is an only child... Hobbies include hunting and fishing... Favorite MLB player is Clayton Kershaw and team is the Milwaukee Brewers... Played with STiKS Baseball Academy and the Chicago Scouts Association... Posted a 21-game on-base streak that was snapped on May 2, 2021 vs. Illinois State, at the time Valpo's longest on-base streak since 2017... Named 2021 All-MVC Honorable Mention... - #9 Connor Giusti, 2B, Sr. (Hoffman Estates, Ill. / Fremd [Wisconsin Oshkosh]) – Played in 117 games over four seasons at Wisconsin Oshkosh before transferring to Valpo for the 2023 campaign... Named to the all-defensive team and all-conference honorable mention at Oshkosh... Big Chicago Bears fan and loves football.

- #6 Alex Thurston, SS, Sr. (Fowler, Ind. / Benton Central) – Finished as the Valedictorian of his high school senior class... Won the 2019 Nanoline Automation National Championship with three classmates after creating an automated paint brush cleaner... Three-year all-conference honoree on the diamond while also playing four years of tennis and one year of basketball in high school... Appeared in 40 games and made 39 starts in 2021... - #15 Kaleb Hannahs, 3B, Sr. (West Terre Haute, Ind. / West Vigo) – 2021 MVC Freshman of the Year, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American, All-MVC Second Team and Valparaiso University co-Male Newcomer of the Year (ARC Awards)... In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, Valpo has two sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches in the starting lineup... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Earned MVC Player of the Week on May 3, 2021 after posting a slash line .556/.636/.667 over five games during the week ... Led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389) in 2021, becoming the first rookie to pace the team in batting average since Spencer Mahoney in 2012... Finished the 2021 season on a 20-game on-base streak... Started his freshman season with a .200 average over the first 11 games before hitting .336 over his last 36 regular-season contests while posting a .434 on-base percentage in that time... Named to the 2022 MVC All-Defensive Team... Led the team in runs scored with 36 while starting all 48 games in 2022, posting a .275 batting average... Was hit by a pitch on April 9, 2023 at Evansville, suffering an injury that caused him to be sidelined until May 18 vs. Illinois State (with
