Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The annual spring trip has arrived for the Valparaiso University baseball team as the Beacons will spend 19 consecutive days on the road as the team departs on Wednesday, Feb. 28 and returns to Valpo's campus after a game at Campbell on Sunday, March 17. The first weekend of the spring trip features a tournament in North Carolina. Valpo will start the weekend by playing at Elon on Friday before visiting the No. 1 team in the nation – Wake Forest – on Saturday afternoon. The three-game event will wrap up on Sunday morning as Valpo battles Binghamton in a game hosted by Wake Forest in Winston-Salem, N.C.

Last Time Out: Valpo visited No. 17 Alabama for a three-game series last weekend, dropping all three games to the Crimson Tide, who prevailed 14-2, 13-3 and 11-1 in a trio of seven-inning contests. The highlight of the weekend was the offensive production of Kyle Schmack, who went 5-for-10 (.500) in the series, scored four of the team's six runs and drove in three.

Following the Beacons: Links to live coverage for all three games will be available on ValpoAthletics.com. Friday's game will be broadcast on FloBaseball, while Saturday's contest will be carried by ACC Network Extra.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (190-300) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he enters 2024 having skippered 482 Valpo games. He enters the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo and Elon have never clashed in baseball, though the two teams did meet on the men's basketball hardwood with Elon winning 82-78 on Dec. 29 of this season. Binghamton will also be a first-time opponent for the Beacons, who have squared off with Wake Forest on two prior occasions, falling 13-4 and 3-0 in March 2012 in Winston-Salem.

Valpo vs. Ranked Adversaries

- Valpo's game against Wake Forest will be the team's fourth in a five-game span against Top-25 competition after dropping all three at No. 17 Alabama last weekend.
- Valpo's only three games against a top-25 team last season were a three-game series at No. 22 Southern Miss in March. Valpo won the series opener 6-1, snapping a streak of 15 straight losses to Top-25 teams that dated back to a win over No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.
- The win over No. 22 Southern Miss was Valpo's best win in terms of national ranking since beating No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.
- Since 2012, Valpo has Top-25 wins over No. 22 Southern Miss (March 10, 2023), No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).
- Valpo did recently play a team that was No. 1 in the country in at least one poll on March

15, 2022 at Notre Dame, but the Fighting Irish were No. 6 according to D1Baseball, which is the industry standard poll. The highest ranked team Valpo has played during the Brain Schmack Era, per D1Baseball, was a three-game set at No. 3 Louisville in 2020.

In The Other Dugout: Elon

- Picked to finish fifth of 12 in the CAA Preseason Poll.
- Starting pitcher Justin Mitrovich was a member of the preseason all-league team.
- Went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 CAA mark.
- Lost two of three to Navy during the first weekend of the season before taking two of three from NJIT. Coming off a 6-3 win over UNCG on Tuesday.

In The Other Dugout: Wake Forest

- Ranked No. 1 in the nation by D1Baseball and the USA Today Coaches' Poll.
- Went 54-12 last season and 22-7 in the ACC on their way to NCAA Regional and Super Regional crowns and a College World Series Appearance.
- This will mark Valpo's ninth straight game against a team with 30 or more wins last season.
- Swept Dayton last weekend before beating North Carolina A&T on Tuesday.

In the Other Dugout: Binghamton

- Preseason favorite to win the American East conference.
- Were the No. 3 seed in the conference tournament last season and advanced to the championship game in that event.
- Were swept at Houston in a three-game series to start the season before taking two of three at UNCG.
- First team all-conference selections Tommy Riefler (.371 average last year) and pitcher Gabe Driscoll are back.

Schmacking Extra-Base Hits

- As part of a weekend where he hit .500 at No. 17 Alabama, Kyle Schmack homered and doubled in the team's 13-3 loss to the Crimson Tide on Feb. 24.
- Schmack's home run was his second of the season and the 20th of his collegiate career. He is one home run away from moving into a tie for ninth in program history for career home runs, where he would join five others Dan Schrum (1999-2002), Jamie Sykes (1994-1997), Dale Polonus (1986-1988), Marc Boggio (1999-2003) and Sam Shaikin (2016-2019).
- Schmack, who is in his fifth season in the program, is also among the program's all-time leaders in career doubles. He moved into sole possession of 10th in program history in that category with his 39th during the aforementioned game at Alabama. That snapped a tie for 10th with Spencer Mahoney (2012-2015), Dale Polonus (1986-1988) and Kurt Gesse (1982-86).

Fast Starts

- Valpo has made a habit out of striking first in recent games, jumping ahead in the first inning in three of the last four and each of the last two.
- However, fast starts haven't led to favorable results as the Beacons are 0-3 when scoring in the first inning this season compared to 2-2 when not striking right away.

Rankings Report

- Entering the March 1 game at Elon, Valpo ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference and 38th nationally in total doubles with 17.
- The Valpo pitching staff is fourth in the MVC in both walks allowed per nine innings (3.78, 66th nationally) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.14, 97th nationally).
- Connor Giusti is tied for the MVC lead with four doubles.
- Kyle Schmack's four stolen bases rank third in the MVC and 58th nationally.
- Lucas Foley's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 12.0 is third in the league and 64th in the country.

Notes Wrapping Up Alabama (Feb. 23-25)

- In the series opener on Feb. 23 (L 14-2), Valpo's five hits came from five different players. Three of the five hits went for extra bases and each of the top four players in the batting order had a hit.
- In the middle game on Feb. 24 (L 13-3), Kyle Schmack's home run and double accounted for two of the team's three hits. Reliever Joe Seiber worked the sixth for Valpo and did not allow a run, serving as a bright spot for the pitching staff. Valpo was plagued by four errors and allowed six unearned runs.
- In the series finale on Feb. 25 (L 11-1), Grant Jablonski had the best day of any member of the pitching staff, allowing just one run (none earned) on two hits and one walk over two frames. Schmack had another productive day, lashing two of the team's five hits. The lone Beacon extra-base knock of the day was a double by Ryan Maka.

Starters Start Strong

- The starting pitching staff turned in a pair of gems over the opening weekend as Josh Cottrill and Lucas Foley both pitched Valpo to wins as part of a doubleheader sweep on Saturday, Feb. 17 at Alabama State.
- Cottrill allowed just one run on four hits while walking two and striking out seven in the opener, a six-inning start that helped him pick up his first win of the season and the second of his career. He matched the longest outing of his career and picked up right where he left off last season,

when he covered a career-long six innings and allowed just one unearned run on one hit over six innings in the May 24 MVC Tournament game vs. Belmont, Valpo's final game of the 2023 campaign.

- Foley went seven innings of one-run ball while scattering five hits in his collegiate debut. The southpaw struck out 11 and walked none, becoming the first Valpo hurler with double-figure strikeouts since Griffin McCluskey on May 12, 2023 at Belmont (11). McCluskey also had no walks in that outing.
- Through one weekend of action, Foley led the MVC in strikeouts and was one of 10 players in the country with 11 or more.
- Foley was one of two freshmen in the country with an 11-strikeout game on the opening weekend, joining Deven Sheerin of Mount St. Mary's.
- The pitching prowess of Cottrill and Foley helped Valpo pick up its first doubleheader sweep since April 15 of last season at Bradley.

Double the Fun

- Valpo clubbed six doubles in the opening game of the doubleheader on Feb. 17 at Alabama State, an 8-2 victory.
- The half dozen doubles marked the team's highest total since May 1, 2021, seven vs. Illinois State.
- Six of Valpo's 10 hits in the game went for two bases including two doubles by Connor Giusti.
- Valpo finished the weekend with 11 doubles, the most in the MVC and the 12th most nationally during the opening weekend of action.
- Giusti had three doubles for the weekend, tied for the most in the MVC and the 13th most nationally over the opening weekend.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Alabama State (Feb. 16-18)

- After hitting 50 home runs last season to mark the program's highest total since 2001, Valpo picked up right where it left off by launching three big flies in the Feb. 16 season opener at Alabama State.
- Kaleb Hannahs (ninth career), Alex Thurston (fourth career) and Connor Giusti (11th collegiate, first at Valpo) all drilled dingers on Opening Night.
- The three home runs marked Valpo's highest single-game total since March 5,2023, when the team slugged three at Little Rock.
- The seven Beacon hits on Opening Night came from seven different players.
- Alex Ryan had a game-high three hits in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader.
- Jake Jakubowski polished off a win with a flawless ninth and retired all six men he faced in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader.
- In the series finale, Kyle Schmack hit his first home run of the season and the 19th of his Valpo career.
- Defense was a bugaboo in the series finale as Valpo committed three miscues and seven of the nine Alabama State runs were unearned.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continues on March 1, when Valpo

will play at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).

- Valpo will play a fourth straight opponent and ninth straight game against a team with 30 or more wins last season on March 2 at preseason No. 1 Wake Forest. The Demon Deacons were 54-12, going 22-7 in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) on their way to NCAA Regional and Super Regional crowns that resulted in a College World Series appearance.
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference another team that finished with a winning record last year Valpo will visit Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Valpo will have a three-game series at Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.
- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Talkin' Schmack

- Head coach Brian Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack is 10 wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-win milestone.
- Schmack will reach another milestone this season when the 2024 campaign reaches its 18th tilt. That will mark Schmack's 500th game in charge of the program, becoming the third skipper in program history to reach that number.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.
- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.
- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.
- Maka hit two grand slams April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).
- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.
- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).
- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.

- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.
