Next Up in Valpo Baseball: A stretch of 19 straight days on the road during spring break for the Valparaiso University baseball team continues this weekend as the program's annual spring trip makes its next stop in Charleston, S.C. for a three-game weekend series with The Citadel.

Last Time Out: Valpo enjoyed two wins at Elon last week, beating a warm-weather opponent that won over 30 games last season with 9-4 and 7-5 triumphs on Friday and Saturday. The Beacons followed that with back-to-back one-run setbacks, falling to Binghamton 3-2 on Sunday and Jacksonville 6-5 on Tuesday. Valpo rallied with three two-out runs in the ninth against the Dolphins including a go-ahead single by Liam Patton, but the Dolphins scored twice in the bottom of the inning to walk off with the win.

Following the Beacons: All three games this weekend will air on ESPN+. Links to live coverage for all three games will be available on ValpoAthletics.com.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (192-302) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he enters 2024 having skippered 482 Valpo games. He enters the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: This weekend will mark the first ever matchups between these two teams.

In The Other Dugout: The Citadel

- Picked last in the eight-team Southern Conference based on the preseason poll.
- Had three preseason all-conference picks pitcher Sam Swygert, pitcher Will Holmes and shortstop Sawyer Reeves.
- Coming off a 23-31 season (7-14 SoCon) last year.
- Have weekend series wins over Harvard and St. Bonaventure plus a series sweep of Akron so far this season.

Schmacking Extra-Base Hits

- Kyle Schmack is up to eight extra-base hits in 11 games this season, racking up four doubles and four home runs.
- He is up to 22 career home runs, climbing into a tie for fifth in program history in that category. He will move into a tie for fourth with his next home run.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 41, a number that ranks tied for seventh in program history.
- Schmack is up to 103 career RBIs. He needs to get to 116 to crack the top 10 in program history.

Notes Wrapping Up March 1-5

- Valpo started the spring trip with a 9-4 win at Elon on Friday, March 1. Kevin Denty went 4-for-4 with two home runs, three runs scored and three RBIs. He became the first Valpo player to enjoy a multi-homer game since Jake Skrine on May 19, 2013 vs. Illinois State.
- The Beacons prevailed 7-5 on March 2 at Elon as Josh Cottrill yielded just two runs (one earned) on five hits while walking one and striking out three to earn the win. Denty continued to make an impact at the plate, walking twice and lifting a sacrifice fly while scoring two runs in the victory. Each team had eight hits, but Valpo batters worked seven walks while the pitching staff yielded only three. Elon won 32 games last season.
- Valpo lost 3-2 vs. Binghamton on Sunday in Winston-Salem, N.C. Kyle Schmack doubled and homered and he and Kaleb Hannahs combined for four of the team's five hits. Binghamton was the preseason favorite to win the American East Conference.
- The Beacons fell 6-5 at Jacksonville on Tuesday, March 5, the team's second straight one-run defeat. Denty went 3-for-4, while Schmack and Liam Patton had multi-hit games. Patton had a go-ahead, two-out, two-run single in the ninth, but Jacksonville walked off with the win. Each team had a dozen hits, with Valpo's total representing a season high. The Beacons worked a season-high eight walks while issuing just two. Jacksonville won 34 games last season.

Rankings Report

- Entering March 8 at The Citadel, Valpo ranks third in the Missouri Valley Conference and 53rd nationally in total doubles with 26.
- The Valpo pitching staff is second in the MVC in walks allowed per nine innings at 3.38, ranking 33rd nationally in that category. Valpo ranks fourth in the MVC in strikeout to walk ratio at 2.30.
- Kyle Schmack ranks fourth in the MVC in home runs (four), fifth in slugging percentage (.714) and fifth in stolen bases (five).

Other Notes Wrapping Up Alabama State (Feb. 16-18)

- After hitting 50 home runs last season to mark the program's highest total since 2001, Valpo picked up right where it left off by launching three big flies in the Feb. 16 season opener at Alabama State.
- Kaleb Hannahs (ninth career), Alex Thurston (fourth career) and Connor Giusti (11th collegiate, first at Valpo) all drilled dingers on Opening Night.
- The three home runs marked Valpo's highest single-game total since March 5, 2023, when the team slugged three at Little Rock.
- The seven Beacon hits on Opening Night came from seven different players.
- Alex Ryan had a game-high three hits in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader.
- Jake Jakubowski polished off a win with a flawless ninth and retired all six men he faced in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader.
- In the series finale, Kyle Schmack hit his first home run of the season and the 19th of his Valpo career.
- Defense was a bugaboo in the series finale as Valpo committed three miscues and seven of the nine Alabama State runs were unearned.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1-2, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference another team that finished with a winning record last year Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Valpo will have a three-game series at Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.
- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Talkin' Schmack

- Head coach Brian Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack is eight wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-win milestone.
- Schmack will reach another milestone this season when the 2024 campaign reaches its 18th tilt. That will mark Schmack's 500th game in charge of the program, becoming the third skipper in program history to reach that number.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.
- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.
- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.
- Maka hit two grand slams April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois
- becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).
- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

LHP Lucas Foley.

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.
- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).
- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.
- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).
