Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will make its next stop on an 18-day, 11-game journey as the Beacons trek just over the South Carolina/ North Carolina state line to clash with Gardner-Webb in a midweek matchup. Valpo holds a solid 4-3 record over the first seven games of the spring break trip, which comes all on the road and all against warm-weather competition.

Last Time Out: Valpo picked up a doubleheader sweep on Friday, beating The Citadel 3-2 and 10-5 in 10 innings in a pair of thrilling games in Charleston, S.C. before dropping Sunday's series finale 10-6. Carson Husmann homered in each game of Friday's doubleheader and reached base at a .666 clip over four games this past week. In the doubleheader alone, Husmann reached base nine times with three hits, five walks, two home runs, three runs scored and a hit by pitch. Valpo got stellar pitching performances in both games as Connor Lockwood threw five shutout innings to get the win in the opener before Adam Guazzo carried a perfect game into the sixth and eventually received no decision in the nightcap.

Following the Beacons: Tuesday's game will air on ESPN+. Links to live coverage will be available on ValpoAthletics.com, and in-game updates on X (formerly known as Twitter) are available if you follow @ValpoBaseball.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (194-303) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he enters 2024 having skippered 482 Valpo games. He enters the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo is 2-5 all-time against Gardner-Webb after most recently battling the Bulldogs in 2015, when the Beacons dropped all three, 5-1, 5-1 and 8-7. Valpo has lost the last four meetings but took two of three including a 10-4 win in the series finale during a 2010 set.

In The Other Dugout: Gardner-Webb

- Picked second of nine behind only USC Upstate in the Big South preseason poll.
- Infielder Alec Burns was a member of the preseason all-conference squad.
- Coming off a four-game sweep of Manhattan this past weekend.
- Racked up 31 wins last season.

Sticks Heating Up

- Valpo posted a season-high 18 hits in the second game of the March 8 doubleheader sweep at The Citadel as part of a 10-5, 10-inning victory.
- That marked the team's highest hit total since May 1, 2021 vs. Illinois State and the team's highest hit total in a road game since May 8, 2018 at Western Michigan.
- The Beacons followed that up with 12 hits in the March 10 series finale, tied for the team's second-highest hit total of the season. The club's three highest hit totals to date came in a four-game span the week of March 10.
- The 10 runs in Game 2 of the March 8 doubleheader at The Citadel marked the squad's highest run total of the season.
- The Beacons have also displayed patience at the plate of late, working seven walks or more in four straight games.

Bonus Baseball

- The 10-inning win over The Citadel in the second game of the March 8 doubleheader marked the culmination of a stretch where four straight Valpo games were either one-run affairs or went extra innings.
- That marked Valpo's first extra-inning affair since April 28 of last season at Missouri
- The five-run win was the largest margin of victory in a Valpo extra-inning game on record.

Notes Wrapping Up The Citadel: March 8-10

- Valpo's doubleheader sweep on March 8 helped the team improve to 4-0 in doubleheader games this season after previously sweeping Alabama State on Feb. 17 in Montgomery.
- In Game 1 of the doubleheader, a 3-2 victory, Kaleb Hannahs had his second career triple and the first since the now-senior's freshman campaign on May 21, 2021 at Missouri State.
- Carson Husmann homered in both games of the doubleheader, his first two jacks in a Valpo uniform. He lifted his career total to 22 counting his four seasons at Bradley. He reached base nine times during the twinbill.
- In Game 2 of the doubleheader, a 10-5, 10-inning win, Alex Thurston enjoyed a 4-for-4 performance, while Kyle Schmack had three hits and three other Beacons posted multi-hit efforts.
- In the March 10 series finale, Schmack hit his 23rd career home run as part of his team-leading seventh multi-hit game, a contest Valpo dropped 10-6. Five Beacons had multi-hit games. Kaleb Hannahs extended his hitting streak to seven games and reached safely for the 14th straight time to start the season.

Schmacking Extra-Base Hits

- Kyle Schmack is up to nine extra-base hits in 14 games this season, racking up four doubles and five home runs.
- He is up to 23 career home runs, climbing into a tie for fourth in program history in that category. He will move into sole possession of fourth with his next home run. He now owns the most career home runs of any Valpo player since 2003.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 41, a number that ranks tied for seventh in program history.
- Schmack is up to 105 career RBIs. He needs to get to 116 to crack the top 10 in program history.

Notes Wrapping Up March 1-5

- Valpo started the spring trip with a 9-4 win at Elon on Friday, March 1. Kevin Denty went 4-for-4 with two home runs, three runs scored and three RBIs. He became the first Valpo player to enjoy a multi-homer game since Jake Skrine on May 19, 2013 vs. Illinois State.
- The Beacons prevailed 7-5 on March 2 at Elon as Josh Cottrill yielded just two runs (one earned) on five hits while walking one and striking out three to earn the win. Denty continued to make an impact at the plate, walking twice and lifting a sacrifice fly while scoring two runs in the victory. Each team had eight hits, but Valpo batters worked seven walks while the pitching staff yielded only three. Elon won 32 games last season.
- Valpo lost 3-2 vs. Binghamton on Sunday in Winston-Salem, N.C. Kyle Schmack doubled and homered and he and Kaleb Hannahs combined for four of the team's five hits. Binghamton was the preseason favorite to win the American East Conference.
- The Beacons fell 6-5 at Jacksonville on Tuesday, March 5, the team's second straight one-run defeat. Denty went 3-for-4, while Schmack and Liam Patton had multi-hit games. Patton had a go-ahead, two-out, two-run single in the ninth, but Jacksonville walked off with the win. Each team had a dozen hits, with Valpo's total representing a season high. The Beacons worked a season-high eight walks while issuing just two. Jacksonville won 34 games last season.

Rankings Report

- Entering March 12 at Gardner-Webb, Valpo is tied for second in the MVC in doubles with 33.
- The Valpo pitching staff has allowed the fewest walks in the MVC, issuing just 12 bases on balls.
- Kyle Schmack ranks eighth in the MVC in slugging percentage at .655. He is tied for fourth in home runs with five. He is also tied for fifth in stolen bases with five.
- Kevin Denty ranks 10th in the MVC in OPS at 1.060.
- Kaleb Hannahs is tied for fourth in the league in hit by pitch with five.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.

- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1-2, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference another team that finished with a winning record last year Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Valpo will have a three-game series at Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.
- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Talkin' Schmack

- Head coach Brian Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack is six wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-win milestone.
- Schmack will reach another milestone this season when the 2024 campaign reaches its 18th tilt, which barring any schedule changes will be Sunday, March 17 at Campbell. That will mark Schmack's 500th game in charge of the program, becoming the third skipper in program history to reach that number.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.
- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.
- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.
- Maka hit two grand slams April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois
- becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).
- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.
- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).
- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.
- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).
- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.

Allowed two runs on three hits and no walks in two innings of relief on March 8 at The Citadel in Game 1 of a doubleheader.

• #38 RHP Griffin McCluskey, Sr. (Normal, Ill. / Normal Community) – As a freshman, got the starting nod on May 11, 2021 vs. No. 8 Notre Dame and pitched a gem at Emory G. Bauer Field, holding the guests to no runs on one hit – a seeing-eye single through the left side – while walking just one and striking out four in six innings. He left in position for the win after becoming just the third pitcher to hold Notre Dame scoreless while pitching six or more innings all season, joining Duke's Jack Carey and Boston College's Emmett Sheehan... Posted the highest fielding percentage by a starting shortstop in program history in high school... Finished in the top 10 in his high school's history in career 3-point field goals in basketball... Enjoys playing the guitar... Earned his first collegiate victory in his hometown of Normal, Ill. on April 17, 2022, pitching Valpo to a 2-1 win over Illinois State on Easter Sunday.
