Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team has reached the final stop of a 19-day, 11-game journey as the Beacons have arrived in Buies Creek, N.C. for a three-game weekend series with No. 21 Campbell. This also closes a stretch of 18 straight games away from home to begin the season before Valpo finally opens up the home portion of the slate on Tuesday afternoon at Emory G. Bauer Field. Valpo, ranked 66th in the RPI, has held its own through 15 games with a nearly .500 record with almost every game coming on the road against warm-weather competition. The Beacons are 5-3 on this spring-break road trip with three games to play.

Last Time Out: After a weekend series win at The Citadel, Valpo kept the positive vibes going with a 5-2 midweek victory at Gardner-Webb. Kaleb Krier put together a solid start on the mound and three relievers all did good work on a day where the Valpo pitching staff did not issue a walk. Valpo took a slim 2-1 lead to the ninth inning before tacking on three important insurance runs to nullify an eventual solo shot in the bottom of the ninth and win 5-2. The only runs by the Fightin' Bulldogs were solo homers by Alec Burns that bookended the game in the first and ninth innings.

Following the Beacons: There will be no video feed available for this weekend's games, but live radio coverage courtesy of Campbell Athletics will be provided with links to live audio and stats posted on ValpoAthletics.com. For in-game updates, follow @ValpoBaseball on X, the social media platform that was once known as Twitter.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (195-302) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he enters 2024 having skipped 482 Valpo games. He enters the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo has visited Campbell just once previously, losing all three games of a March 2012 series. The Fighting Camels took the opener 6-5 in 10 innings before recording 3-2 and 7-3 wins in a doubleheader to round out the series. The two schools are more familiar with one another on the gridiron than on the diamond, as Valpo and Campbell shared Pioneer Football League affiliation from 2008-2017 before the Camels went the scholarship football route, first in the Big South and now in the Colonial Athletic Association.

In The Other Dugout: Campbell

- Went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South last season.
- Won the Big South for the fourth time in five years and reached NCAA Regionals for the fifth straight year last season, when they were ranked as high as No. 9 nationally.
- Joined the Colonial Athletics Association prior to this academic year.
- Ranked 21st nationally by D1Baseball and 23rd by the USA Today Coaches' Poll.
- Ranked 28th in the RPI.
- Preseason all-conference performers include catcher Grant Knipp and outfielder Lawson Harrill.

Valpo vs. Ranked Adversaries

- Valpo will play a weekend series against Top-25 competition for the second time this season after playing at No. 17 Alabama on Feb. 23-25.
- Valpo's only three games against a top-25 team last season were a three-game series at No. 22 Southern Miss in March. Valpo won the series opener 6-1, snapping a streak of 15 straight losses to Top-25 teams that dated back to a win over No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.
- The win over No. 22 Southern Miss was Valpo's best win in terms of national ranking since beating No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.
- Since 2012, Valpo has Top-25 wins over No. 22 Southern Miss (March 10, 2023), No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).

Don't Walk This Way

- Valpo ranks among the national leaders in walks allowed per nine innings, as the Beacons are permitting just 2.9 bases on balls per every nine innings pitched.
- As of March 13, Valpo is 10th nationally in that category, behind only Nebraska (2.44), Fresno State (2.47), UTSA (2.66), UT Arlington (2.68), Purdue (2.71), California Baptist (2.82), Sam Houston (2.85), Texas A&M (2.86) and Arkansas (2.87).
- Entering this weekend's series at Campbell, Valpo pitching has allowed two walks or fewer in six straight games. The Beacons have gone walk-free three times this season including two of the last three games and most recently the March 12 contest at Gardner-Webb.
- Lucas Foley has allowed just three walks in 17 innings.
- The team ranks second in the MVC and 37th nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 2.70.

A Look at Other Leaders

- The Beacons rank second in the MVC and 71st nationally in total doubles with 33. In doubles per game, the squad's average of 2.20 is also second in the MVC and 58th in the nation.
- Kyle Schmack is tied for fifth in the MVC with five home runs. He is tied for seventh in total bases with 39 and ranks eighth in slugging percentage at .650 and ninth in OPS at 1.079. He is also tied for fourth in the league with six stolen bases.
- Kaleb Hannahs has five doubles, tied for 10th in the league. He has been hit by a pitch six times, tied for the third most in the league.

Talkin' Schmack

- Head coach Brian Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack is five wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-win milestone.
- Schmack will reach another milestone this weekend when the 2024 campaign hits its 18th tilt, which barring any schedule changes will be on Sunday at Campbell. That will mark Schmack's 500th game in charge of the program, becoming the third skipper in program history to reach that number. He will join Paul Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981; 606).

Sticks Heating Up

- Valpo posted a season-high 18 hits in the second game of the March 8 doubleheader sweep at The Citadel as part of a 10-5, 10-inning victory.
- That marked the team's highest hit total since May 1, 2021 vs. Illinois State and the team's highest hit total in a road game since May 8, 2018 at Western Michigan.
- The Beacons followed that up with 13 hits in the March 10 series finale, the team's second-highest hit total of the season. The club's three highest hit totals to date came in a four-game span the week of March 10.

- The 10 runs in Game 2 of the March 8 doubleheader at The Citadel marked the squad's highest run total of the season.
- The Beacons have also displayed patience at the plate of late, working seven walks or more in five straight games.

Notes Wrapping Up March 12: Valpo 5, Gardner-Webb 2

- Alex Ryan lashed two of the team's five hits.
- Kyle Schmack worked three walks.
- Valpo produced five runs on five hits and prevailed despite being outthit 6-5.
- Carson Husmann accounted for the team's lone extra-base knock.
- Kaleb Hannahs was hit by a pitch, extending his on-base streak to 15 games. He owns the team's longest such streak since Ryan Maka reached in 25 straight last season.

Bonus Baseball

- The 10-inning win over The Citadel in the second game of the March 8 doubleheader marked the culmination of a stretch where four straight Valpo games were either one-run affairs or went extra innings.
- That marked Valpo's first extra-inning affair since April 28 of last season at Missouri State.
- The five-run win was the largest margin of victory in a Valpo extra-inning game on record.

Notes Wrapping Up The Citadel: March 8-10

- Valpo's doubleheader sweep on March 8 helped the team improve to 4-0 in doubleheader games this season after previously sweeping Alabama State on Feb. 17 in Montgomery.
- In Game 1 of the doubleheader, a 3-2 victory, Kaleb Hannahs had his second career triple and the first since the now-senior's freshman campaign on May 21, 2021 at Missouri State.
- Carson Husmann homered in both games of the doubleheader, his first two jacks in a Valpo uniform. He lifted his career total to 22 counting his four seasons at Bradley. He reached base nine times during the twinbill.
- In Game 2 of the doubleheader, a 10-5, 10-inning win, Alex Thurston enjoyed a 4-for-4 performance, while Kyle Schmack had three hits and three other Beacons posted multi-hit efforts.
- In the March 10 series finale, Schmack hit his 23rd career home run as part of his team-leading seventh multi-hit game, a contest Valpo dropped 10-6. Five Beacons had multi-hit games. Kaleb Hannahs extended his hitting streak to seven games and reached safely for the 14th straight time to start the season.

Schmacking Extra-Base Hits

- Kyle Schmack is up to nine extra-base hits in 15 games this season, racking up four doubles and five home runs.
- He is up to 23 career home runs, climbing into a tie for fourth in program history in that category. He will move into sole possession of fourth with his next home run. He now owns the most career home runs of any Valpo player since 2003.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 41, a number that ranks tied for seventh in program history.
- Schmack is up to 105 career RBIs. He needs to get to 116 to crack the top 10 in program history.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1-2, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Valpo will have a three-game series at Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.
- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.
- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.
- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.

- Maka hit two grand slams – April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois – becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).
- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.
- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters – Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).
- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.
- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program – outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).
- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold – LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.

- **#11 RHP Connor Lockwood, (Jr.), (Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville):** Named conference co-player of the year as a high school senior in 2021 and received all-state accolades... Interested in a career in elementary education... Favorite food is deep dish pizza... Finished his freshman season with an 0-5 record and 7.30 ERA in 2022, but did his best work late in the year, posting a 1.80 ERA over his last three regular-season starts... Pitched three scoreless innings of one-hit ball on May 7 vs. DBU before working 2 2/3 shutout frames while allowing one hit on May 13 vs. Bradley... Started his 2023 season with a gem, earning the win thanks to a career-long seven innings and a career-high six strikeouts while allowing no runs on two hits and walking none in an 11-3 victory over Big 12 foe Kansas in Corpus Christi, Texas on Feb. 18, 2023... Logged 6 1/3 innings of two-run, four-hit ball while striking out six on Feb. 25, 2023 at UT Martin... Pitched six innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking one to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 4 at Little Rock... Made his first appearance since April 2, 2023 vs. Murray State on March 1 at Elon as after that game he underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery. In his return to the rubber, he started and went three innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and one walk while striking out four... Tossed five shutout innings and earned the win in a 3-2 victory in Game 1
