Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Missouri Valley Conference portion of the season gets underway this weekend as the Valparaiso University baseball team travels to Southern Illinois to clash with the Salukis. After recently returning from an 18-day, 11-game road trip over spring break, the Beacons will embark on another six-day journey as this trip will continue on to Nashville for a midweek matchup with nationally-ranked Vanderbilt after the weekend in Carbondale. Valpo enters this trip ranked No. 62 in the latest RPI.

Last Time Out: Valpo faced deficits of 5-0 and 6-1 on Tuesday afternoon at Emory G. Bauer Field, but scored the game's final eight runs to beat Ball State 9-6. Kyle Schmack delivered a pair of birthday bombs, celebrating his 23rd in style including a go-ahead two-run shot that flipped the scoreboard in the bottom of the sixth. Alex Thurston homered as part of a three-hit day, while Grant Jablonski and Bryce Konitzer combined for five shutout innings of relief while permitting a combined two hits.

Following the Beacons: All three games in this weekend's series will air on ESPN+ with broadcasters Luke Martin and Mike Trude on the call. Links to live video and stats will be available on ValpoAthletics.com. For in-game updates, follow @ValpoBaseball on X, a social media platform that in its heyday was known as Twitter.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (196-305) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he entered 2024 having skippered 482 Valpo games. He entered the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo is 11-9 all-time against the Salukis and holds a 9-8 record against SIU since joining the MVC but did drop two of three last season at Emory G. Bauer Field and in 2022 in Carbondale. The Beacons won the series opener 9-8 on May 5, 2023 at Brown Field, but SIU took the remaining two games 7-3 and 10-6 to take the series. The last time Valpo made the trip to Carbondale, Valpo dropped the first two games 4-0 and 15-12 before prevailing 11-10 in the series finale on May 1, 2022.

#### In The Other Dugout: Southern Illinois

- Picked to finish fifth of 10 in the MVC preseason poll.

- Won two of three at home against Jacksonville State last weekend before playing a midweek home-and-home with Arkansas State on Tuesday and Wednesday. - Went 30-27 last season and 15-12 in MVC play.

#### **Talkin' Schmack**

- Head coach Brian Schmack reached a milestone on March 17 at No. 21 Campbell, his 500th game at the helm of the program. He became the third skipper in program history to reach that number, joining Paul Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981; 606).

- Schmack is on the verge of another milestone, as he is four wins away from becoming the third Valpo head coach to reach the 200-victory threshold.

- Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).

#### Notes Wrapping Up March 19: Valpo 9, Ball State 6

- Kyle Schmack ripped a pair of home runs on his 23rd birthday, including a go-ahead, two-run shot that turned a 6-5 deficit into a 7-6 lead in the sixth inning. He became the third Beacon to enjoy a multi-homer game this season, joining Kevin Denty on March 1 at Elon and Alex Ryan on March 16 at No. 21 Campbell.

- This was Schmack's third career multi-homer game and first since Feb. 26, 2023 at UT Martin. He also left the yard twice on April 16, 2022 at Illinois State.

- Schmack now has three career birthday bombs. He also homered on his 21st birthday in 2022 at Murray State. Lucky for opposing pitchers, Valpo did not play on his 22nd birthday in 2023.

- Alex Thurston had a team-high three hits including his second home run of the season and the fifth of his collegiate career. Kaleb Hannahs, Kyle Schmack and Carson Husmann each had multiple hits.

- Bryce Konitzer nailed down his first save of the season, becoming the fourth different Beacon with a save. Konitzer, Jake Jakubowski, Trent Turzenski and Joe Seiber have all closed out games for the Brown & Gold.

- Five of Valpo's 11 hits went for extra bases and the Beacons outhit the Cardinals 11-8. - The win came over a Ball State team that was picked to finish second in the Mid-American Conference preseason poll, received three of 11 first-place votes and made an NCAA Regional appearance last season.

#### **Schmacking Extra-Base Hits**

- Kyle Schmack is up to 13 extra-base hits in 19 games this season, racking up five doubles and eight home runs.

- He is up to 26 career home runs, climbing into a tie for fourth in program history for career home runs with Jeff Mandsager (2001-2003). He needs one more to take over sole possession of third in program history. He owns the most career home runs of any Valpo player since 2003.

- Schmack has increased his career double total to 42, recently grabbing sole possession of seventh in program history.

- Schmack is up to 111 career RBIs. He needs to get to 116 to crack the top 10 in program history.

#### A Look at the Leaderboards

- Valpo batters have drawn 102 walks this year, the third most in the league behind only this weekend's opponent, Southern Illinois (142), and UIC (112).

- The Beacons rank fifth in the MVC in doubles with 40.

- Valpo has swiped 26 bases this season, the third most in the league behind only Illinois State and this weekend's opponent, Southern Illinois (28).

- Kyle Schmack ranks tied for second in the league with eight home runs. - Schmack ranks fourth in the league in on-base plus slugging (OPS) at 1.210. He is third in slugging percentage at .743 and 10th in on-base percentage at .467.

- Schmack's six stolen bases rank tied for seventh in the league.

- Kaleb Hannahs is tied for fifth in the league with seven doubles and tied for fifth with six hit by pitches.

#### Don't Walk This Way

- Entering the March 15-17 series at No. 21 Campbell, Valpo ranked among the national leaders in walks allowed per nine innings, as the Beacons were permitting just 2.9 bases on balls per every nine innings pitched.

- Entering that series, Valpo was 10th nationally in that category, behind only Nebraska (2.44), Fresno State (2.47), UTSA (2.66), UT Arlington (2.68), Purdue (2.71), California Baptist (2.82), Sam Houston (2.85), Texas A&M (2.86) and Arkansas (2.87).

- Entering that series, Valpo pitching had allowed two walks or fewer in six straight games. The Beacons have gone walk-free three times this season including two of the previous three games before the weekend series at Campbell.

That trend took a turn in the wrong direction during the series in Buies Creek, as Valpo pitchers walked 29 in the three games after having walked 37 total in the first 15 games of the year. Valpo walked seven or more in each contest, including a season-high 14 in the series finale on March 17.
The 14 free passes were the most issued by Valpo pitching in Schmack's 500 games as head coach. In fact, that was the most walks allowed by Valpo pitching in Schmack's 18 years overseeing the Valpo pitching staff including the seven seasons he spent as pitching coach before taking the helm.
Valpo, which rebounded to walk only three on March 19 vs. Ball State, still ranks 60th nationally in walks allowed per nine innings despite the walkfest in the series at Campbell.

#### Notes Wrapping Up No. 21 Campbell (March 15-17)

- Valpo led 5-1 and 9-5 in the series opener against a top-25 opponent, but the Camels won 10-9 on a walk-off home run.

- Valpo batters took 14 walks in the series opener, nearly doubling the team's previous season watermark of eight. That was the club's highest walk total since 14 on March 25, 2022 vs. St. Bonaventure.

- Kyle Schmack went 3-for-3 and reached base five times in the series opener.

Valpo had Campbell on the ropes after the Camels went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South last year and won the conference for the fourth time in five years. The Camels have been an NCAA Regional team each of the last five seasons, and a year ago they were ranked as high as ninth in the country.
Campbell entered this series at No. 21 according to D1Baseball and No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll.

- Valpo's nine runs in the series opener marked the team's highest total against a nationally-ranked opponent since falling 14-10 at No. 3 Louisville on Feb. 23, 2020.

- In the series opener, Valpo played its fourth one-run game of the year and fell to 1-3 in those contests.

- Valpo dropped the middle game of the series 13-4 on March 16 despite two home runs by Alex Ryan, his first two blasts of the season and the fourth and fifth of his collegiate career. He had Valpo's second multi-homer game this season, joining Kevin Denty on March 1 at Elon.

- Campbell invoked the 10-run rule in an 18-7 victory in the March 17 series finale. The luck of the Irish did not go the way of the Beacons, as they gave up a 10-spot in the fifth inning and issued 14 walks.

- Kaleb Hannahs reached base in all three games in the series, extending his season-long on-base streak to 18.

- Valpo batters had at least six walks in all three games and the Beacons have accepted at least a half a dozen free passes in eight straight games.

- Valpo stranded 12 on base in both Game 1 and Game 2 of the series. Prior to the series finale when they stranded just six, the Beacons had stranded a dozen or more in six of their previous seven games.

#### Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.

- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.

- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).

- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.

- Valpo had a three-game series at No. 21 Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.

- The Beacons will make their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and

won the national title as recently as 2019.

- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 3 at Purdue and April 16 at Notre Dame.

#### Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).

- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.

- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.

- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.

- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.

- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.

- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.

- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

#### **Beacon Blasts**

Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.

- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

#### **Other Record Book Updates from 2023**

Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.

- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

#### Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.

- Maka hit two grand slams – April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois – becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.

- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).

- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

#### Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.

- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters – Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).

- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.

- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program – outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).

- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold – LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.
