Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will look to continue its home success as the Beacons attempt to build upon a 3-1 Emory G. Bauer Field record during this weekend's three-game series against Belmont. This starts a home-heavy stretch for the Beacons as three of the next four Missouri Valley Conference series will be at home and the one road weekend will be comprised of three one-day trips to UIC. The road-weary Beacons are in the midst of a welcome change of pace as they are just beginning a stretch of over a month between hotel stays.

Last Time Out: Valpo will try to snap a four-game losing streak after being swept at Illinois State and dropping a midweek matchup 7-3 at Milwaukee on Tuesday. The Beacons raced out to an early 3-0 lead in Franklin, Wis., but the Panthers took the lead with a five-run third and won 7-3 despite being outhit 11-7.

Following the Beacons: All three games this weekend will air on ESPN+. Todd Ickow (play-by-play) will have the call alongside Jamie Stangel (analyst, Friday) and Brian Jennings (analyst, Saturday and Sunday). Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com. For in-game updates, follow @ValpoBaseball on X.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (198-314) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he coached his 500th game on March 17, 2024 at Campbell. He entered the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo is 1-7 all-time against Belmont in a series that began in 2001. The Bruins, now in their second season in the league, won two of three in last year's regular-season series in Nashville, battling back to take the series after Valpo prevailed 12-3 in the opener. Belmont was also responsible for ending Valpo's 2023 campaign, beating the Beacons 10-9 in an MVC Tournament elimination game. Valpo gave up nine in the second inning but climbed back into the game to make it a one-run affair thanks in part to a stellar relief outing by Josh Cottrill. This weekend will represent the first time Valpo has ever hosted Belmont.

In The Other Dugout: Belmont

- Picked to finish sixth of 10 in the MVC preseason poll.
- Coming off dropping two of three vs. Evansville last weekend but did capture a 12-0, seven-inning victory in the series finale.
- Swept Murray State but lost two of three to UIC.
- Led offensively by Sam Slaughter (.349 AVG) and Mason Landers (.339 AVG).
- Coming off a 13-5 loss to Austin Peay on Tuesday.

Notes Wrapping Up April 9: Milwaukee 7, Valpo 3

- Valpo led 3-0 after an inning and a half but Milwaukee rallied with seven unanswered runs as Valpo did not score the rest of the way.
- Brady Renfro drilled his second home run of the season and the 17th of his career.
- Alex Ryan hit his fourth home run this season and the seventh of his career.
- Renfro and Ryan both homered in their home state of Wisconsin.
- Trent Turzenski, another Wisconsin native, made his first start in over two years as he started on the bump for the first time since April 1, 2022. His first seven appearances this year came in relief after he missed over a calendar year due to Tommy John surgery.
- Kyle Schmack recorded his 199th collegiate hit, one shy from reaching the 200 milestone. He also drew his 91st career walk, moving into a tie for sixth in program history. In addition, he swiped a base, improving to 8-for-8 this season in stolen bases and recording his 30th career steal.
- Ryan and Carson Husmann had two hits apiece.
- Valpo dropped to 7-3 this season when outhitting the opponent as the Beacons held an 11-7 edge in the hit column but came out on the wrong end of the column that counts. Six of Valpo's 11 hits went for extra bases.

Notes Wrapping Up Illinois State (April 5-7)

- The Redbirds invoked the 10-run rule in the series opener on Friday, beating the Beacons 11-1 in seven innings. Ryan Maka drilled his first home run of the season – in part because he missed 16 games due to an injury. That was his 13th career home run, seven of which came last year.
- In the series opener, Kaleb Hannahs saw his season-long on-base streak come to an end. His 26-game streak halted with an 0-for-3 day.
- Maka was joined in the hit column by Kyle Schmack and Connor Giusti, both of whom singled in the series opener.
- Neither team had an extra-base knock in the Saturday game, when all 16 combined hits were singles. Illinois State prevailed 3-1. This was the first Valpo game where neither team had an extra-base hit since May 22, 2021 at Missouri State.
- Connor Lockwood yielded three runs on nine hits while walking none and striking out five in six innings on Saturday. All three runs against him came in the third as he took a tough-luck defeat despite a quality start.
- Brady Renfro worked two walks to go along with a base hit, reaching three times in the Saturday game.
- Lockwood and reliever Griffin McCluskey – who was pitching in his hometown of Normal – combined to walk just one in the game. McCluskey threw two clean innings after Lockwood's departure.
- Valpo dropped the series finale 6-0 as the Beacons were shut out for the first time since May 25, 2022, an 8-0 loss to Indiana State in the MVC Tournament in Springfield, Mo. Valpo's two hits in the series finale tied a season low with the game at No. 7 Vanderbilt.

Closing in on 200 (Times Two)

- Head coach Brian Schmack is just two wins away from becoming the third skipper in program history to reach the 200-win threshold.
- Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack reached a milestone on March 17 at No. 21 Campbell, his 500th game at the helm of the program. He became the third skipper in program history to reach that number, joining Paul Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981; 606).
- While his father Brian is closing in on 200 career victories, Valpo left fielder Kyle Schmack is closing in on 200 career hits. Entering the series vs. Belmont, Kyle has 199 career hits. He needs six more hits to crack the program's all-time top 10 in that category.

Lock'd In

- RHP Connor Lockwood threw a complete game in the 9-2 win over Bradley on March 30, allowing two runs while scattering eight hits. He did not issue a walk and struck out nine in the triumph.
- Lockwood tossed Valpo's first complete game since Bobby Nowak on April 15, 2023 at Bradley in a seven-inning contest. This was Valpo's first nine-inning CG since Zach Fricke on May 11, 2019 vs. Southern Illinois.
- Valpo had multiple nine-inning complete games during the 2018 season, when Jon Tieman, Trey Ferketic and Wes Gordon all turned the trick. Lockwood became the first Valpo pitcher to go nine innings and allow no walks since Wes Gordon on Feb. 25, 2018 at Oklahoma. However, that was not a complete game as Gordon went nine in a 10-inning defeat.
- Lockwood became the first Valpo pitcher to issue no walks in a nine-inning complete game since Ellis Foreman on April 29, 2017 vs. Wright State.
- Thanks to his efforts against the Braves, Lockwood was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week on April 1, becoming the first Valpo player to win an MVC weekly award this season. Valpo's last MVC weekly award winners came on April 17 of last year, when Jake Skrine (Player of the Week) and Bobby Nowak (Pitcher of the Week) swept the honors.
- This marked Lockwood's second career MVC Pitcher of the Week award, joining Colin Fields as the only Valpo pitchers to have won the award multiple times since joining the MVC.
- The list of Valpo hurlers to win MVC Pitcher of the Week since the team joined the league are as follows – Lockwood (twice), Fields (twice), Nowak, Jacob Rosenkranz, Jake Miller and Easton Rhodehouse.

Schmack schmacks

- Kyle Schmack has hit 28 career home runs, the third most in program history and the most by any Valpo player since 2002.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 42, a number that ranks seventh in program history.
- The Valpo slugger moved into the program's all-time top 10 in RBIs during the Easter weekend series vs. Bradley. His total of 116 is tied for ninth in program history.
- Schmack also ranks among the program's all-time leaders in career walks with 91. He ranks tied for sixth in that category.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member

of the Atlantic Sun Conference.

- Valpo had a three-game series at No. 21 Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons made their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.
- Other power-five opponents on the docket include April 16 at Notre Dame.

Program Progress: Looking Back at 2023

- Valpo enjoyed 20 wins in 2023, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team surpassed 2018 (19) for the program's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years came despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo finished with a .426 overall winning percentage, the team's highest since joining the MVC and highest in any season since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to last season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- Last season also represented the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.
- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener. The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018. At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo launched 50 home runs last season, surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) and the 2002 season (49) to climb all the way to fourth in single-season program history.
- Valpo held its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.
- The 50 bombs marked the program's most since 2001, a year were the team launched a program-record 81 long balls.

Other Record Book Updates from 2023

- Valpo drew 231 walks as a team last season, tied for the fifth most in program history. That marked the team's highest number of bases on balls since 2018 (248).
- The Beacons also reached base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage was its highest in over 20 years. That tied for fifth in the program record book,

joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This was the first time since 2001 that Valpo owned an OBP of .386 or better.

- Valpo possessed a .973 fielding percentage last season, matching a program record set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka was named to the 2024 Preseason All-MVC Team after earning first-team all-conference accolades at the conclusion of the 2023 campaign. The left-handed hitting outfielder raised his average nearly 100 points from the previous season by batting .345 a year ago including a .382 mark in Valley play.
- Maka hit two grand slams – April 2 vs. Murray State and May 5 vs. Southern Illinois – becoming the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- He ranked second in the MVC in batting average and eighth in on-base percentage (.454).
- In league-only play, Maka ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.

Who's Back, Who's New?

- The 2024 roster features 16 seniors and nine juniors including an upperclassmen core of position players who have been together for several seasons.
- The bulk of Valpo's position players are back from last season including returning starters at seven of the eight positions. Four of those are set to become four-year starters – Kyle Schmack (LF), Kaleb Hannahs (3B), Brady Renro (1B) and Alex Thurston (SS). Other returning starters include Alex Ryan (CF), Ryan Maka (RF) and Kade Reinertson (C).
- In total, the roster features 22 returning players.
- Valpo has welcomed nine transfers to the program – outfielder Carson Husmann (Bradley), infielder Connor Giusti (Wisconsin Oshkosh), RHP Ryan Kruse (Northern Kentucky), RHP Spencer Boynton (Eastern Nazarene College), RHP Joe Seiber (College of DuPage), RHP Bryce Konitzer (Oakland), catcher Liam Patton (Wabash), infielder Chase Maifield (Augustana) and RHP Jake Jakubowski (Heartland).
- In addition, five true freshmen have joined the fold – LHP Jack Thompson, infielder Aidan Thaxton, infielder/outfielder Kevin Denty, RHP Bennett Musser and LHP Lucas Foley.

innings on March 26 at No. 7 Vanderbilt, allowing one run on two hits and one walk while striking out three... Started and picked up the win on March 31 vs. Bradley after allowing two runs on just one hit over three innings... Started on April 7 at Illinois State and allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits in 2 2/3 innings to take the defeat.

• **#11 RHP Connor Lockwood, (Jr.), (Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville):** Named conference co-player of the year as a high school senior in 2021 and received all-state accolades... Interested in a career in elementary education... Favorite food is deep dish pizza... Finished his freshman season with an 0-5 record and 7.30 ERA in 2022, but did his best work late in the year, posting a 1.80 ERA over his last three regular-season starts... Pitched three scoreless innings of one-hit ball on May 7 vs. DBU before working 2 2/3 shutout frames while allowing one hit on May 13 vs. Bradley... Started his 2023 season with a gem, earning the win thanks to a career-long seven innings and a career-high six strikeouts while allowing no runs on two hits and walking none in an 11-3 victory over Big 12 foe Kansas in Corpus Christi, Texas on Feb. 18, 2023... Logged 6 1/3 innings of two-run, four-hit ball while striking out six on Feb. 25, 2023 at UT Martin... Pitched six innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking one to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 4 at Little Rock... Made his first appearance since April 2, 2023 vs. Murray State on March 1 at Elon as after that game he underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery. In his return to the rubber, he started and went three innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and one walk while striking out four... Tossed five shutout innings and earned the win in a 3-2 victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader at The Citadel on March 8... Pitched four solid innings at No. 21 Campbell on March 15, allowing two runs on two hits while walking three and striking out four in four innings...
