**Next Up in Valpo Baseball:** The Valparaiso University baseball team will play an important series in the Missouri Valley Conference standings as Missouri State makes its way to Emory G. Bauer Field for three this weekend. Valpo enters the weekend just a game behind the Bears and Bradley, who are tied for eighth in the MVC standings. Since eight teams make the league tournament, a series win over the Bears could go a long way to putting Valpo in position to make the tournament field. This continues a home-heavy stretch as Valpo plays its second straight home weekend and continues a month-long period without a hotel stay.

**Last Time Out:** After dropping two of three to Belmont last weekend at Emory G. Bauer Field, Valpo was on the wrong end of a one-run decision in Tuesday's midweek at Notre Dame, falling 7-6. A three-run homer by Carson Husmann in the ninth inning slimmed the lead to one, but the Fighting Irish got the 27th out to hold on for the win.

**Following the Beacons:** All three games this weekend will air on ESPN+. Todd Ickow (play-by-play), Brian Jennings (analyst, Friday and Saturday) and Leo Staudacher (analyst) will call the action. For in-game updates, follow @ValpoBaseball on X. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com.

**Head Coach Brian Schmack:** Brian Schmack (199-317) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he coached his 500th game on March 17, 2024 at Campbell. He entered the season with 188 victories, the third most in program history. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

**Series Notes:** Valpo is 1-19 all-time against Missouri State in a series that goes back to 1985. The Beacons are 1-17 against the Bears since joining the Missouri Valley Conference and 0-16 in regular-season matchups. Valpo's lone win over the Bears was 6-4 in 10-innings in the opening round of the 2021 MVC Tournament in Carbondale. Last year, Valpo dropped all three in Springfield, falling 4-3 in 10 innings, 12-2 in seven innings and 9-6 in nine innings.

### In The Other Dugout: Missouri State

- Picked to finish second in the MVC preseason poll, but instead find themselves tied for eighth.

- Legendary head coach Keith Guttin has announced that he will retire at the end of the season. He is in his 42nd season leading the Bears after taking over the program prior to the 1983 season.

- Led offensively by Zack Stewart, who is hitting .341 and slugging .726. On the bump, Brandt Thompson owns a glowing 5-0 record and 2.35 ERA in 10 starts.

- Lost 6-2 to Missouri on Tuesday after dropping two of three vs. UIC last weekend in Springfield. The Bears took the opener 17-3 in seven innings but lost a pair of high scoring affairs to close out the series, 16-9 and 9-8.

## Notes Wrapping Up April 16 – Notre Dame 7, Valpo 6

- Carson Husmann hit his third home run in his last four games after he had hit two in his first 25 games. This was the 25th home run of his collegiate career, the bulk of which came during his time playing for Bradley.
- Brady Renfro and Alex Ryan had two hits apiece as part of Valpo's 10-hit effort. The game was played quite evenly with Notre Dame owning a slight 12-10 advantage in the hit column and Valpo owning a 4-3 edge in walks.
- This was Valpo's seventh one-run game of the season and the team fell to 2-5 in such contests.
- Valpo lost its 16th straight head-to-head matchup with Notre Dame, but nine of the last 10 meetings have been decided by four runs or fewer.
- Valpo had a recent one-run loss against the Irish – then No. 8 nationally – on April 21, 2021 by a score of 8-7. Valpo also fell 4-3 in 2019 and 6-5 in 2018 but hasn't been able to get over the hump against its in-state foe.
- Valpo's last three one-run losses have all come against stiff competition – one power-5 opponent (Notre Dame), one nationally-ranked opponent (Campbell) and one nationally-ranked power-5 opponent (Vanderbilt).

## Balk-Off Win

- The April 13 10-9 victory over Belmont ended in unusual fashion as Carson Husmann broke for the plate, causing Belmont's pitcher to balk in the winning run in the bottom of the ninth.
- That was Valpo's first walk-off win since beating Milwaukee 7-6 in 11 innings on March 28, 2023 on a Kaleb Hannahs game-ending double.
- This was Valpo's sixth one-run game of the season as the team improved to 2-4 in such contests.
- However, Valpo has enjoyed good success in home games decided by the slimmest of margins over the last two seasons, improving to 5-0 in one-run games played at Emory G. Bauer Field since the start of the 2023 campaign.

## Other Notes Wrapping Up Belmont (April 12-14)

- Valpo dropped Friday's series opener 9-2 despite drawing 11 walks, the team's second highest total of the season and highest since March 15 at Campbell. Valpo has dropped both games this season when drawing double-figure walks.
- After the first two Valpo pitchers gave up nine runs on Friday, the rest of the staff pitched well. Josh Spencer had his second appearance of the season and first since March 17 at Campbell and heaved two scoreless innings. Bennett Musser followed with his fourth collegiate outing and put a zero on the board in the top of the ninth.
- Carson Husmann homered in the first and third games of the weekend series, lifting his career total to 24 and his season total to four.
- In Saturday's aforementioned balk-off win, Brady Nowicki hit the first home run of his three-year Valpo career.
- Griffin McCluskey delivered a heroic performance out of the bullpen on Saturday, tossing five scoreless innings to pick up his first win of the season and the seventh of his collegiate career. He got back on track with the clutch outing after entering the game with an 0-3 record and 10.12 ERA over 18 2/3 innings this season.
- Ryan Maka doubled twice on Saturday, the fourth time a Valpo player has had multiple doubles in a game this season.
- The 10 runs tied the team's second-highest total of the season (13 on March 31 vs. Bradley; 10 on March 8 at The Citadel).
- Kyle Schmack reached the 200-career hit milestone on Saturday, then slugged his 11th homer of the season and the 29th of his collegiate career on Sunday. He is one away from tying Jake Skrine's home run total from last season for the most by a Valpo player in a single season since 2002.
- RHP Grant Jablonski got the start on Sunday, his first collegiate start in his 44th career

### Closing in on 200

- Head coach Brian Schmack is just one win away from becoming the third skipper in program history to reach the 200-win threshold.
- Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack reached a milestone on March 17 at No. 21 Campbell, his 500th game at the helm of the program. He became the third skipper in program history to reach that number, joining Paul Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981; 606).

### Schmack schmacks

- Kyle Schmack has hit 29 career home runs, the third most in program history and the most by any Valpo player since 2002.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 43, a number that ranks seventh in program history.
- The Valpo slugger moved into the program's all-time top 10 in RBIs during the Easter weekend series vs. Bradley. His total of 117 is ninth in program history.
- Schmack also ranks among the program's all-time leaders in career walks with 96. He ranks sixth in that category.
- Enter this series vs. Missouri State, Schmack has 204 career hits. He needs two more to crack the program's all-time top 10.

### Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.

- Valpo had a three-game series at No. 21 Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.

- The Beacons made their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.

## Pitching Profile – Projected Starters

• **#32 Bryce Konitzer, Sr. (Mukwonago, Wis. / Mukwonago [Oakland])** – Started his collegiate career at Illinois State as a member of the 2019 MVC championship team for the Redbirds... Then spent one season at Madison College before three years at Oakland... Worked his way back from March 2022 Tommy John surgery to be ready for the start of the 2023 campaign, during which he appeared in 15 games and made eight starts... Tossed a shutout inning on March 3 vs. Binghamton... Earned his first save at Valpo by pitching the final two innings of a 9-6 win over Ball State on March 19 without allowing a run or hit... Pitched two solid innings but took the loss on March 26 at No. 7 Vanderbilt. He allowed one run (a solo homer) on three hits while walking one and striking out two... Finished out Valpo's victory in the March 31 series finale vs. Bradley with a scoreless inning, allowing just one hit... Worked three shutout innings on April 7 at Illinois State... Allowed one run on three hits in his two frames on April 14 vs. Belmont... Had 19 starts over three seasons at Oakland but will make his first collegiate start on April 19 vs. Missouri State.

• **#11 RHP Connor Lockwood, (Jr.), (Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)** - Named conference co-player of the year as a high school senior in 2021 and received all-state accolades... Interested in a career in elementary education... Favorite food is deep dish pizza... Finished his freshman season with an 0-5 record and 7.30 ERA in 2022, but did his best work late in the year, posting a 1.80 ERA over his last three regular-season starts... Pitched three scoreless innings of one-hit ball on May 7 vs. DBU before working 2 2/3 shutout frames while allowing one hit on May 13 vs. Bradley... Started his 2023 season with a gem, earning the win thanks to a career-long seven innings and a career-high six strikeouts while allowing no runs on two hits and walking none in an 11-3 victory over Big 12 foe Kansas in Corpus Christi, Texas on Feb. 18, 2023... Logged 6 1/3 innings of two-run, four-hit ball while striking out six on Feb. 25, 2023 at UT Martin... Pitched six innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking one to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 4 at Little Rock... Made his first appearance since April 2, 2023 vs. Murray State on March 1 at Elon as after that game he underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery. In his return to the rubber, he started and went three innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and one walk while striking out four... Tossed five shutout innings and earned the win in a 3-2 victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader at The Citadel on March 8... Pitched four solid innings at No. 21 Campbell on March 15, allowing two runs on two hits while walking three and striking out four in four innings... Recovered from an early grand slam and five runs allowed over the first two innings to go six while allowing six runs on six hits and taking the loss in the March 22 MVC opener at Southern Illinois... Threw a complete game to earn the win while scattering eight hits, striking out nine and walking none on March 30 vs. Bradley. He became the first Valpo hurler to toss a nine-inning complete game in five years and was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on April 1, becoming the second Valpo pitcher since the team joined the MVC to become a multi-time winner of that award... Did not allow a walk or an extra-base hit while putting together a quality start in a tough-luck loss on April 6 at Illinois State. He allowed three runs on nine singles while striking out five in six frames... Allowed nine runs on nine hits including four home runs while walking none and striking out four in four innings on April 13 vs. Belmont, when he received no decision.

• **#21 Kaleb Krier, Sr. (Altoona, Iowa / Southeast Polk (DMACC))** – Made four appearances, all starts, in his first season at Valpo in 2023... Spent two seasons of JUCO ball at DMACC... Favorite MLB team is the New York Mets... Started on March 5 at Jacksonville and allowed three runs on five hits in three innings... Put together a solid start on March 12 at Gardner-Webb, going five innings of one-run, four-hit ball while walking none and striking out one. He received no decision in a game Valpo won 5-2... Started and went four innings while allowing six runs (five earned) on six hits and one walk in the March 19 home opener vs. Ball State, an eventual 9-6 win in which he received no decision... Started and went three solid innings on March 26 at No. 7 Vanderbilt, allowing one run on two hits and one walk while striking out three... Started and picked up the win on March 31 vs. Bradley after allowing two runs on just one hit over three innings... Started on April 7 at Illinois State and allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits in 2 2/3 innings to take the defeat...
