Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will return to the road after back-to-back home weekends with the short journey to UIC for a three-game weekend series that is scheduled to begin under the lights on Friday night in Chicago. Every game is big for the Beacons as they need to make up ground in the race to qualify for the conference tournament, but there is still plenty of baseball to be played with four regular-season series remaining.

Last Time Out: Valpo rallied for a dramatic 7-6, 12-inning victory over Missouri State on Friday thanks to a two-run, walk-off home run by Brady Renfro that came with two outs in the bottom of the 12th. Missouri State rebounded to win 8-6 on Saturday and 14-3 on Sunday to take the weekend series at Emory G. Bauer Field. Valpo was on the wrong end of a walk-off homer on Tuesday at Northern Illinois, as the host Huskies took advantage of last hacks in a back-and-forth affair to win 10-9 in the nonconference midweek matchup.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (200-320) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he coached his 500th game on March 17, 2024 at Campbell. On April 19 vs. Missouri State, he became the third head coach in program history to secure his 200th win. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo is 65-77 all-time against UIC, the most common opponent in program history, as the two teams have faced off 142 times on the baseball diamond. Valpo took two of three last season at Emory G. Bauer Field in the first Missouri Valley Conference series between the two longtime foes. Last year, UIC surpassed Butler (140) for the program's most frequent all-time opponent. The Beacons went to UIC for a nonconference series in 2022 and won two of three, but this will mark the first visit to UIC as a Valley member. After this weekend, the team's last three trips to UIC will have been once for a Missouri Valley Conference series (2024), once for a nonconference series (2022) and once for a Horizon League series (2017).

In The Other Dugout: UIC

- Both teams are coming off midweek games against Northern Illinois, as Valpo visited NIU on Tuesday and UIC hosted the Huskies on Wednesday.

- UIC dropped the opener but battled back to take two of three from Murray State last weekend at Curtis Granderson Stadium.

- The Flames are led by Zane Zielinski, who is hitting .396 with seven home runs and 33 RBIs. Kendal Ewell holds a .375 batting average with 12 dingers and 44 runs driven in. From a pitching perspective, Brandon Bak is 3-2 with a 4.75 ERA in 10 starts.

- Currently in third place in the MVC standings behind only Indiana State and Evansville after being picked eighth in the MVC preseason poll.

Beacon Bombs

- Last season, Valpo drilled 50 home runs, the program's most since 2001 and the fourth most in program history.
- With 14 regular-season games left on the docket, Valpo is well positioned to once again climb into the all-time top five for single-season home runs.
- The Beacons have launched 44 home runs this year, five away from writing an entry in the program record book.

Good with the Glove

- Valpo owns a .972 fielding percentage this season, currently in position to rank third in program history.
- Last season, Valpo tied a program record set in 2018 by posting a .973 fielding percentage.
- This year's mark ranks narrowly ahead of the 2017 team, which entered the season in third at .971.
- Valpo has played errorless ball in four of its last five games entering the weekend series at UIC.

Lucky Number Seven?

- Valpo is 10-4 when scoring seven runs or more this season. However, the team is 2-22 when scoring six runs or fewer.
- The Beacons are 1-19 when opponents score seven runs or more, but own an 11-7 mark when holding opponents to fewer than seven.

Notes Wrapping Up April 23 – Northern Illinois 10, Valpo 9

- The lead changed hands time and time again in the late innings after the game was scoreless until the fourth and 4-1 NIU through six.
- The teams combined for 13 runs in the seventh and eighth innings alone in a game where the squads combined for 19 runs on 28 hits in total.
- To illustrate the back-and-forth nature of the contest, seven different pitchers (four Northern Illinois, three Valpo) were at one point in line for either a win or a loss and all ended up with no decisions.
- Valpo played its ninth one-run game of the year and fell to 3-6 in such contests. Four of Valpo's last seven games have been one-run affairs.
- Kevin Denty and Connor Giusti both made the most of their opportunities in the lineup as each had three hits. Denty was a home run shy of the cycle and had his first collegiate triple, the team's fourth of the season.
- Although NIU did get two late walks, the first four Valpo pitchers did not issue any free passes and control was a bright spot for most of the day.
- Valpo head coach Brian Schmack pitched collegiately at Northern Illinois from 1992-1995 before going on to a professional career that included time in the big leagues with the Detroit Tigers in 2003.
- Valpo played a three-game set with NIU that was held at Chicago State in 2019, but this marked the team's first visit to DeKalb since 2018.

Schmack Reaches 200-Win Milestone

- Head coach Brian Schmack reached the 200-career win milestone with a 7-6, 12-inning victory over Missouri State on April 12.
- Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).
- Schmack reached a milestone on March 17 at No. 21 Campbell, his 500th game at the helm of the program. He became the third skipper in program history to reach that number, joining the aforementioned Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Bauer (1954-1981; 606).

Notes Wrapping Up Missouri State (April 19-21)

- The 7-6, 12-inning victory in Friday's series opener helped Valpo snap a six-game skid in head-to-head matchups with Missouri State and improve to 2-19 all-time against the Bears. Both of Valpo's wins over Missouri State have come in extra innings as the previous one was May 25, 2021 in an MVC Tournament elimination game. That marked Valpo's first-ever regular season victory over Missouri State.
- Brady Renfro (third of the season, 18th career), Alex Ryan (fifth of the season, eighth career), Ryan Maka (second season, 14th career) and Liam Patton (first at Valpo) all homered.
- Half of Valpo's hits were home runs as the team hit four home runs in a game for the first time since Feb. 26, 2023 at UT Martin.
- The series opener was Valpo's longest game in terms of innings played since May 10, 2019, a 5-4, 14-inning win over Southern Illinois.
- Carson Husmann drilled his sixth home run of the season and the 29th of his collegiate career in Saturday's 8-6 loss. That marked his fourth home run in a six-game span.
- Missouri State took Sunday's series finale 14-3 despite Kyle Schmack's 30th career home run and a big day at the dish from Alex Ryan, who racked up three of the team's eight hits including a homer and double.

Schmack schmacks

- Kyle Schmack has hit 31 career home runs, the third most in program history and the most by any Valpo player since 2002.
- Schmack has entered the program's single-season top 5 in home runs as well. His 13 long balls in 2024 rank tied for fourth in single-season program history.
- Schmack has increased his career double total to 43, a number that ranks seventh in program history.
- The Valpo slugger moved into the program's all-time top 10 in RBIs during the Easter weekend series vs. Bradley. His total of 121 is tied for eighth in program history.
- Schmack also ranks among the program's all-time leaders in career walks with 97. He ranks sixth in that category.
- Enter this weekend's series at UIC, Schmack has 208 career hits. He recently moved into 10th in program history.
- Schmack also ranks ninth in program history in runs scored with 136.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
- The Beacons played three more in the Heart of Dixie from Feb. 23-25 at Alabama. The Crimson Tide of the Southeastern Conference (SEC) also won over 40 games in 2023, posting a 43-21 mark en route to an NCAA Regional crown and Super Regional appearance.
- A challenging early-season docket continued on March 1, when Valpo played at Elon, a team that went 33-22 last season including a 19-9 mark in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- After a neutral site game on March 3 vs. Binghamton of the American East Conference – another team that finished with a winning record last year – Valpo visited Jacksonville, a 34-win team last year and a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.
- Valpo had a three-game series at No. 21 Campbell (March 15-17) against a team that went 46-15 and 22-5 in the Big South in 2023. The conference champion Fighting Camels reached NCAA Regionals.
- The Beacons made their way to Nashville, Tenn. for a game against preseason No. 6 Vanderbilt on March 26. The Commodores went 42-20 last season, were the runners-up of the College World Series in 2021 and won the national title as recently as 2019.

• **#21 Kaleb Krier, Sr. (Altoona, Iowa / Southeast Polk (DMACC)** – Made four appearances, all starts, in his first season at Valpo in 2023... Spent two seasons of JUCO ball at DMACC... Favorite MLB team is the New York Mets... Started on March 5 at Jacksonville and allowed three runs on five hits in three innings... Put together a solid start on March 12 at Gardner-Webb, going five innings of one-run, four-hit ball while walking none and striking out one. He received no decision in a game Valpo won 5-2... Started and went four innings while allowing six runs (five

earned) on six hits and one walk in the March 19 home opener vs. Ball State, an eventual 9-6 win in which he received no decision... Started and went three solid innings on March 26 at No. 7 Vanderbilt, allowing one run on two hits and one walk while striking out three... Started and picked up the win on March 31 vs. Bradley after allowing two runs on just one hit over three innings... Started on April 7 at Illinois State and allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits in 2 2/3 innings to take the defeat... Started and went three innings, allowing two runs on three hits on April 12 vs. Belmont... Took the defeat on April 16 at Notre Dame, allowing three runs on four hits in three innings... Allowed 10 runs (seven earned) on eight hits in 1 2/3 innings on April 21 vs. Missouri State.

• **#11 RHP Connor Lockwood, (Jr.), (Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)** - Named conference co-player of the year as a high school senior in 2021 and received all-state accolades... Interested in a career in elementary education... Favorite food is deep dish pizza... Finished his freshman season with an 0-5 record and 7.30 ERA in 2022, but did his best work late in the year, posting a 1.80 ERA over his last three regular-season starts... Pitched three scoreless innings of one-hit ball on May 7 vs. DBU before working 2 2/3 shutout frames while allowing one hit on May 13 vs. Bradley... Started his 2023 season with a gem, earning the win thanks to a career-long seven innings and a career-high six strikeouts while allowing no runs on two hits and walking none in an 11-3 victory over Big 12 foe Kansas in Corpus Christi, Texas on Feb. 18, 2023... Logged 6 1/3 innings of two-run, four-hit ball while striking out six on Feb. 25, 2023 at UT Martin... Pitched six innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking one to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 4 at Little Rock... Made his first appearance since April 2, 2023 vs. Murray State on March 1 at Elon as after that game he underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery. In his return to the rubber, he started and went three innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and one walk while striking out four... Tossed five shutout innings and earned the win in a 3-2 victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader at The Citadel on March 8... Pitched four solid innings at No. 21 Campbell on March 15, allowing two runs on two hits while walking three and striking out four in four innings... Recovered from an early grand slam and five runs allowed over the first two innings to go six while allowing six runs on six hits and taking the loss in the March 22 MVC opener at Southern Illinois... Threw a complete game to earn the win while scattering eight hits, striking out nine and walking none on March 30 vs. Bradley. He became the first Valpo hurler to toss a nine-inning complete game in five years and was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on April 1, becoming the second Valpo pitcher since the team joined the MVC to become a multi-time winner of that award... Did not allow a walk or an extra-base hit while putting together a quality start in a tough-luck loss on April 6 at Illinois State. He allowed three runs on nine singles while striking out five in six frames... Allowed nine runs on nine hits including four home runs while walking none and striking out four in four innings on April 13 vs. Belmont, when he received no decision... Took the defeat after allowing

six runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out five in 5 1/3 innings on April 20 vs. Missouri State.

• **#32 Bryce Konitzer, Sr. (Mukwonago, Wis. / Mukwonago [Oakland])** – Started his collegiate career at Illinois State as a member of the 2019 MVC championship team for the Redbirds... Then spent one season at Madison College before three years at Oakland... Worked his way back from March 2022 Tommy John surgery to be ready for the start of the 2023 campaign, during which he appeared in 15 games and made eight starts... Tossed a shutout inning on March 3 vs. Binghamton... Earned his first save at Valpo by pitching the final two innings of a 9-6 win over Ball State on March 19 without allowing a run or hit... Pitched two solid innings but took the loss on March 26 at No. 7 Vanderbilt. He allowed one run (a solo homer) on three hits while walking one and striking out two... Finished out Valpo's victory in the March 31 series finale vs. Bradley with a scoreless inning, allowing just one hit... Worked three shutout innings on April 7 at Illinois State... Allowed one run on three hits in his two frames on April 14 vs. Belmont... Had 19 starts over three seasons at Oakland but will make his first collegiate start on April 19 vs. Missouri State... Started and threw three scoreless innings while yielding one hit and no walks with four strikeouts on April 23 at Northern Illinois.

Two-time all-conference performer in basketball in addition to earning all-conference on the diamond as a senior in high school... Set his high school's record for rebounds in a single season on the hardwood with 320 in 2021-22... Favorite TV shows are Breaking Bad and Ozarks... Made his first collegiate appearance and start by pitching four innings on Feb. 18 at Alabama State, allowing three runs (one earned) on Feb. 18 at Alabama State... Made his second start of the season on March 8 in Game 2 of a doubleheader at The Citadel, logging six innings of two-run (one earned), two-hit ball while striking out six and walking none in a game that Valpo won in extra innings... Took the defeat on March 16 at No. 21 Campbell after allowing eight runs on five hits in four innings... Allowed seven runs (six earned) on nine hits while walking none over 4 2/3 innings in his first MVC start on March 23 at Southern Illinois...
