Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will close out the season this weekend by welcoming nationally-ranked Indiana State for a three-game series. The series does not hold any significance with regard to Missouri Valley Conference seeding as Indiana State has locked up the No. 1 seed and Valpo has been eliminated from tournament contention, but every game is still meaningful for the No. 20 Sycamores in terms of NCAA Regional seeding and earning hosting responsibilities. Valpo will celebrate its 15-member senior class in a pregame ceremony that begins at 12:35 p.m. on Saturday. In a very unique circumstance, the head coaches of both teams will be senior parents during that ceremony as Valpo head coach Brian Schmack's son Kyle and Indiana State head coach Mitch Hannahs' son Kaleb are among Valpo's 15 departing seniors.

Last Time Out: Four Valpo relievers combined for five shutout innings, but a five-run third inning for the hosts played a big role as Northwestern beat Valpo 7-2 on Tuesday in Evanston, Ill. Pop from the middle infield accounted for the Valpo runs as second baseman Connor Giusti and shortstop Alex Thurston both homered. Of Giusti's seven home runs this season, five have come in the last nine games. Joe Seiber, Grant Jablonski, Trent Turzenski and Josh Spencer all worked scoreless ball out of the bullpen. Ryan Maka was the lone Beacon with a two-hit game.

Following the Beacons: All three games this weekend will air on ESPN+. Broadcasters Todd Ickow (play-by-play), Leo Staudacher (analyst, Thursday) and Brian Jennings (analyst, Friday/Saturday) will have the call. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com. For in-game updates, follow @ValpoBaseball on X.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (202-329) is in his 11th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he coached his 500th game on March 17, 2024 at Campbell. On April 19 vs. Missouri State, he became the third head coach in program history to secure his 200th win. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 30-57-1 all-time record in this instate showdown that began in 1947. Valpo has lost 22 consecutive head-to-head matchups with Indiana State dating all the way back to an 11-2 victory in Terre Haute on March 31, 2007. The Beacons are 0-17 against the Sycamores since joining the Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 campaign.

Valpo vs. Ranked Adversaries

- Valpo will play its fourth top-25 opponent and its eighth, ninth and 10th games against nationally-ranked competition this weekend.

- The Beacons previously played at No. 17 Alabama on Feb. 23-25, at No. 21 Campbell on March 15-17 and at No. 7 Vanderbilt on March 26.

- The Beacons are 0-7 in those games against Top-25 teams this year. There were a pair of close calls including a 10-9 loss at No. 21 Campbell on March 15, a game Valpo led 5-1 and 9-5. Valpo fell 3-2 in the game at Vandy.

- Valpo's only three games against a top-25 team last season were a three-game series at No. 22 Southern Miss in March. Valpo won the series opener 6-1, snapping a streak of 15 straight losses to Top-25 teams that dated back to a win over No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.

- The win over No. 22 Southern Miss was Valpo's best win in terms of national ranking since beating No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

- Since 2012, Valpo has Top-25 wins over No. 22 Southern Miss (March 10, 2023), No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).

Saluting the Seniors

- Valpo's 15-player senior class that will be recognized this weekend includes three players in their fifth year in the program (Kyle Schmack, Grant Jablonski and Trent Turzenski), five players in their fourth year in the program (Kaleb Hannahs, Alex Thurston, Brady Renfro, Alex Ryan and Griffin McCluskey), two in their third year (Jonathan Hyman and Brady Nowicki), two in their second year (Kaleb Krier and Josh Spencer) and three in their first year (Chase Maifield, Carson Husmann and Bryce Konitzer).

- The senior class is highlighted by a core of five longtime starting position players (six total starters including right fielder Carson Husmann, who joined the program as a grad transfer this year) – one fifth-year starter (left fielder Kyle Schmack), three fourth-year starters (third baseman Kaleb Hannahs, shortstop Alex Thurston and first baseman Brady Renfro) and one three-year starter (center fielder Alex Ryan).

- Those five seniors have combined for 845 starts at Valpo.

- Nowicki plans to coach a 16U travel team this summer. Krier plans to get a job in the sports world and work his way up the ladder. McCluskey is starting a job in June with State Farm in Bloomington, Ill. Jablonski will start a job with Patrick Industries in July in their leadership development program.

- Ryan is starting a job with Generic this summer and will get married to his fiancé Katie at the end of the summer. Thurston and his wife Ashlyn will welcome a baby boy to the family in September.

- This will be a unique Senior Day in the sense that two of the senior parents during the ceremony will have their "dad" hats on only briefly before putting their "head coach" hats on before game time. Valpo head coach Brian Schmack's son Kyle and Indiana State head coach Mitch Hannahs' son Kaleb are both part of the Valpo baseball senior class.

In the Other Dugout – Indiana State

- Won two of three last weekend against Evansville to lock up the MVC regular season title and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming MVC Tournament, which will be hosted by the Purple Aces.

- Ranked No. 20 nationally by D1Baseball and also No. 20 in the latest USA Today Coaches' Poll.

- Won the NCAA Terre Haute Regional and advanced to the Super Regional at TCU last season.

- Had Tuesday's game at Ball State called off due to rain.

- Led offensively by Luis Hernandez, who is hitting .369 with 17 home runs and 61 RBIs.

- Brennyn Cutts (6-1, 3.28 ERA in 13 starts) and Luke Hayden (6-2, 3.66 ERA in 13 starts) lead the pitching staff.

Schmack's Home Run Chase

- Kyle Schmack hit two more home runs in the May 10-12 series at Murray State, moving into sole possession of second in program history for both single-season and career long balls.

- With three games left in the regular season, Schmack needs two home runs to tie both records and three to become the program's sole home run king both for a career and single season.

- Brian Wolotka (2001, 18) owns the single-season record, while J.J. Swiatkowski (1997-

Notes Wrapping Up Murray State (May 10-12)

- Valpo improbably rallied for six runs in the top of the ninth of Friday's series opener, creating a 10-10 tie only to fall 11-10 in 10 innings.
- Kyle Schmack and Connor Giusti both hit three-run homers in the inning. That marked the first time Valpo had two home runs worth three or more runs each in the same inning since April 25, 2016 when Giovanni Garbella hit a grand slam and Josh Clark had a three-run shot against Purdue North Central. Before that, Valpo had not slugged a pair of home runs worth three runs or more in the same frame since at least 2006.
- Giusti's home run came with two outs and Valpo down 10-7. It marked the second time this season that Valpo has been down to its final out and hit a home run to tie or take the lead. Brady Renfro had a walk-off home run with Valpo down to its final out against Missouri State.
- Murray State's Drew Vogel hit for the reverse natural cycle, hitting a home run, triple, double and single in that order. His single to lead off the 10th clinched it before he eventually scored the winning run. Previously, a Valpo opposing player hit for the cycle on May 13, 2018 – Illinois State's Owen Miller, now in the big leagues with the Milwaukee Brewers.
- The Friday game marked Valpo's fourth extra-inning contest of the season, with the Beacons dropping to 2-2 in such games. Valpo played its 11th one-run game of the season and fell to 3-8 in those games. The squad played its 18th game decided by two runs or fewer, falling to 4-14 under those circumstances.
- Six Beacons had multiple hits on Friday, led by Kyle Schmack and Kade Reinertson with three hits apiece. Each team produced 16 hits in the game, Valpo's second-highest total of MVC play behind 18 on April 28 at UIC.
- Valpo experienced the wrong side of a walk-off for the fifth time this season in the Friday game at Murray State. The Beacons were previously

walked off on April 30 at Western Michigan, April 23 at Northern Illinois, March 15 at No. 21 Campbell and March 5 at Jacksonville.

- Murray State won the middle game of the series 7-3 on Saturday despite Valpo nearly doubling up the Racers in the hit column, 11-6. Eight Valpo players had at least one hit including multi-hit games from Kaleb Hannahs, Ryan Maka and Alex Thurston. Alex Ryan extended his on-base streak to 16, and then stretched that streak to 17 with Sunday's series finale.
- Valpo lost the final game of the set 12-3 despite home runs by Maka and Schmack.

Beacon Bombs

- Valpo has launched 66 home run this season, the team's second straight year with 50 or more.
- The program's 2024 total is second in program history. During the May 10-12 series at Murray State, this year's team moved into a tie with the 1985 squad for second in program history, then the Beacons moved into sole possession of second in single-season program history with two bombs on May 14 at Northwestern.
- This marks the club's top home run total since 2001, which Valpo set a program record by drilling 81 dingers.

- Center fielder Alex Ryan made an incredible leaping catch in the bottom of the third inning on April 28 at UIC, robbing Ryan Nagelbach of a grand slam. The catch instead ended the inning with no damage done.
- Ryan's incredible play was featured on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays on Sunday evening, checking in at No. 4 on the popular daily countdown on ESPN.
- The snag was also featured on D1Baseball's Top 10 Plays of the Weekend.

Extinguishing the Flames

- Bryce Konitzer was named the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week on April 29 after throwing 10 shutout innings over two games the previous week.
- Konitzer yielded just three hits and two walks while striking out 12 over the two starts. He held opponents to an .094 batting average and permitted just one extra-base hit over the 10 shutout frames.
- Konitzer started at Northern Illinois on April 23 and allowed just one hit and no walks while striking out four over three shutout innings.
- He followed that up with a complete game shutout in the April 28 series finale at UIC, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out eight in seven frames to earn the win as the Beacons beat the Flames 20-0.
- The shutout came on a hitter-friendly day with the wind blowing out against a UIC team that was leading the conference in runs per game (7.8), on-base percentage (.412) and batting average (.306).
- Konitzer became the second Beacon to be named MVC Pitcher of the Week this season, joining Connor Lockwood (April 1). Since Valpo joined The Valley, Konitzer, Lockwood (twice), Colin Fields (twice), Jacob Rosenkranz, Jake Miller, Bobby Nowak and Easton Rhodehouse have

accounted for nine MVC Pitcher of the Week awards.

- Konitzer hurled Valpo's first individual two-hitter since Cole Webb on April 17, 2014 at Milwaukee. (Note, Colin Fields threw a no-hitter on March 12, 2021 at Middle Tennessee).

- The right hander delivered Valpo's second complete game of the season (Lockwood, March 30 vs. Bradley) and first shutout since Bobby Nowak on April 15, 2023 at Bradley.

Sunday Sluggers

- Valpo blasted UIC 20-0 in seven innings on Sunday, April 28.

- The team slugged eight home runs, tied for the sixth most in a game nationally this season as of April 28.

- This marked just the second time since the start of the 2007 season that Valpo hit five or more home runs in a game, joining May 1, 2021 vs. Illinois State (five). This was the team's first time hitting six or more in a game since April 4, 2006 at Ball State. The eight home runs marked the team's most on record in a single game, dating back at least 20 years.

- The 20 runs marked Valpo's most in a league game since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. This was the team's highest run total since April 11, 2018 vs. Milwaukee (23).

- Carson Husmann went deep twice, recording Valpo's first multi-homer game since Kyle Schmack on March 19 of this season vs. Ball State. One of his home runs was a grand slam, Valpo's first of the year and first since Ryan Maka on May 5, 2023 vs. Southern Illinois.

- The 20-run margin of victory was Valpo's largest since April 2, 2010, a 26-5 win over Chicago State. This marked Valpo's most lopsided shutout since April 15, 2004, a 20-0 win over Lewis.

- Brady Renfro had four hits to lead an 18-hit attack, while Kaleb Hannahs had three and six total Beacons had multi-hit efforts.

- The lopsided win helped Valpo break out of a 15-game road skid, returning to the road win column for the first time since March 12 at Gardner Webb. That was the nation's second longest active such streak before it came to an emphatic end.

Midweek Marathon

- Valpo's game on April 30 at Western Michigan went 15 innings and saw the Broncos prevail 8-6 on a walk-off home run.

- That marked Valpo's longest game in terms of innings played since April 17, 2012, a 16-inning contest at Indiana State.

- It was just the sixth game in the nation to go at least 15 innings this season. Washington at Long Beach State was in the 17th when it was called a 3-3 tie on Feb. 18 due to Washington travel. Valpo's game at Western Michigan tied with four others for the longest game in the nation that had a winner this season.

- The time of the game was four hours, 12 minutes. This was Valpo's longest game in terms of time elapsed since the team enjoyed four hours, 29 minutes of excitement in an 8-7, 13-inning win on May 5, 2015 against – guess who? – Western Michigan.

Schmack Reaches 200-Win Milestone

- Head coach Brian Schmack reached the 200-career win milestone with a 7-6, 12-inning victory over Missouri State on April 12.

- Schmack ranks third in program history in career victories, trailing only Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359).

- Schmack reached a milestone on March 17 at No. 21 Campbell, his 500th game at the helm of the program. He became the third skipper in program history to reach that number, joining the aforementioned Twenge (1,011; 1988-2006) and Bauer (1954-1981; 606).

Schmack schmacks

- In addition to the aforementioned home run chase, Kyle Schmack ranks among the program's all-time top 10 in doubles, RBIs, walks, hits and runs scored.

Inside the Schedule

- Valpo started the season with a four-game series against an Alabama State team that won 41 games and went 26-4 in the Southwest Athletic Conference last season.
