Next Up in Valpo Basketball: Fresh off a season-opening win earlier this week, the Valpo women's basketball team looks to make it back-to-back victories to open the season Saturday afternoon at the ARC as the Beacons welcome Southern Miss to town.

Previously: Valpo took the lead for good early in the third quarter Monday evening en route to a 71-64 victory at Central Michigan to open the 2022-23 season. Leah Earnest set a career best with 20 points and matched her career high with 10 rebounds, one of four Beacons to finish in double figures in the scoring column.

Head Coach Mary Evans: Mary Evans is in her fifth year at the helm of the program in 2022-23 and owns a record of 49-68. Evans has made an impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Evans' preferred style of play has been a big part of the program's turnaround, as Valpo has led the MVC in 3-pointers made per game in each of the last three seasons and in steals per game in two of the last three years.

Series Notes: Saturday will mark the first matchup between Valpo and Southern Miss on the hardwood. Valpo has previously faced four current members of the Sun Belt and holds a 7-4 cumulative record against current Sun Belt programs.

...and @ValleyHoops

- Valpo was picked to finish in 10th place in the MVC preseason poll, totaling 197 points, just 10 points behind Evansville.
- Valpo is in its sixth season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The Valley was ranked 10th in conference NET last year, was ranked seventh nationally in conference NET in 2020-21 and was eighth nationally in conference RPI in 2019-20.

...looking back at last year

- Valpo finished last year with an 11-19 overall record, but was strong in MVC play, going 9-9 in conference and finishing in sixth place - both of which match the program's best since joining the Valley.
- The Beacons registered the first win at Drake and the first win at Bradley in program history.
- Valpo swept the season series over Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs.
- The Beacons also tallied four top-100 wins within Valley play.
- Grace White was named MVC Sixth Player of the Year - the program's first major postseason award since joining the Valley. Shay Frederick was a First Team All-MVC choice, while White was an All-Defensive Team selection and Olivia Brown earned a spot on the All-Newcomer Team.

...at Central Michigan

- Valpo trailed by seven early in the first quarter, but rallied to lead by two at the end of the period and was ahead 33-32 at intermission.
- The Beacons took the lead for good early in the third quarter and led 55-48 with 10 minutes to play.
- CMU cut the lead to one possession three times in the game's final four minutes, but each time Valpo responded with points on its end - the last a driving layup by Ilysse Pitts with 1:02 to play after CMU had made it a 64-62 game.
- Leah Earnest set a career high with 20 points to lead all players, hitting 8-of-11 from the field, and matched her career best with 10 rebounds.
- Earnest was one of four Valpo players to score in double figures, as

Olivia Brown and Katie Beyer scored 11 points apiece and Ali Saunders added 10.

- The Beacons shot 51% from the field and limited CMU to 31.6% shooting.
- The Beacons were an efficient 7-of-17 from 3-point range while CMU was just 3-of-27 from deep.

...looking ahead

- It's a long stretch of time at home for Valpo, as the Beacons will play three consecutive home games.
- Valpo hosts Eastern Illinois Nov. 16 and UAB Nov. 21 following Saturday's game.
- The Beacons' next game away from home won't be until Nov. 27, when they travel to Northwestern.

...at the ARC

- Saturday's game is the first of 15 home games this season for Valpo, five of which will be nonconference games.
- The Beacons went 6-7 in home games last season.

@SouthernMissWBB

- Led by 36 points from LSU transfer Domonique Davis, the Golden Eagles won their season opener over William Carey on Monday, 81-58.
- Southern Miss was picked fourth in the Sun Belt preseason poll after going 18-12 and posting a 9-8 record in Conference USA play last season.

Winning the Season Opener

- Valpo's win over CMU on Monday was its first in a season opener since a 81-47 win over IU Kokomo to open the 2017-18 season.
- It was the program's first win over a D-I team in a season opener since a 91-57 win over Butler to kick off the 2014-15 campaign, and the first time the team has won a season opener on the road since a 61-47 win at UIC in 1999-2000.
- With a win over Southern Miss, Valpo would open a season 2-0 for the first time since 2012-13. It would also be the first time in program history Valpo has won back-to-back games over D-I programs to start a season.

Doubling Up

- Leah Earnest wasted no time asserting herself as the 2022-23 campaign got underway at CMU, setting her career best with 20 points and matching her career high with 10 rebounds for her second career double-double.
- It was the first double-double by a Valpo player since Shay Frederick tallied 17 points and 11 assists Feb. 10 at Bradley.
- Earnest is the first Valpo player with a double-double in a season opener since Bryce Blood vs. IU Kokomo to open the 2017-18 season (13 PTS/13 REB), and the first in a season opener against a D-I opponent since Aimee Litka vs. Bowling Green in 2008-09 (17 PTS/12 REB).

Four Score (In Double Figures)

- A comparison of last year's regular season finale and this year's season opener, both of which featured four Beacons scoring in double figures, shows how revamped this year's squad is.

- In last year's win over MVC champion Southern Illinois to close the regular season, Carie Weinman, Shay Frederick, Grace White and Caitlin Morrison scored in double figures - none of whom are on this year's roster.

- Leah Earnest, Olivia Brown, Katie Beyer, and Ali Saunders scored in double figures on Monday in the win at Central Michigan.

New Faces Featured

- On Monday, Valpo fans got their first look at a couple of new faces and their first extended look at a couple of players who have moved into the rotation this year.

- Sophomore Katie Beyer, who played just 11 minutes over six games in her first season and a half with the program, played 17 minutes at CMU, tallying 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting and five rebounds.

- Junior Ava Interrante, who played just 69 minutes over 18 appearances her first two seasons, played 15 minutes off the bench, scoring two points and grabbing three rebounds.

- Sophomore Olivia Sims started her Valpo debut, finishing with five points and a pair of steals in 24 minutes.

- Freshman Ali Saunders made an immediate impact in her collegiate debut, racking up 10 points in 18 minutes of action.

Replacing Production

- It is a revamped squad on the court for the Beacons in 2022-23.

- Valpo returns just 32.1% of their scoring, 38.1% of their rebounding, 24.4% of their assists and 35.9% of their minutes played from last year's squad.

- Valpo lost its three leading scorers, four of its five leading rebounders and its three highest assist talliers from the 2021-22 team.

Who's Back

- Seven letterwinners return for the Beacons in 2022-23.

- Included among that group are four regulars from last year's team, highlighted by senior Olivia Brown, who was an MVC All-Newcomer choice last season.

- Brown averaged 6.6 points/game and hit at a conference-best 39.8% clip from the 3-point line. Brown stepped up her game within Valley play, averaging 9.5 points/game in MVC action and hitting at a 42.4% rate from deep.

- Also returning from last year's starting group is junior wing Leah Earnest. Earnest averaged 7.7 points/game and 4.6 rebounds/game in 2021-22, ranking second on the team in rebounding.

- She paced Valpo on the boards nine times and scored in double figures on nine occasions, including a pair of 17-point efforts.

- Fifth years Maya Dunson (3.6 ppg, 2.1 rpg) and Ilyse Pitts (1.4 ppg, 1.4 rpg) also saw regular action last season.
- Juniors Ava Interrante and Jayda Johnston and sophomore Katie Beyer look to take advantage of the available playing time entering this year.

Who's New

- While Valpo has three freshmen on this year's team, none of them are traditional true freshmen.
- Both Ella Van Weelden and Lovie Malone redshirted last season in their first year on campus.
- Meanwhile, Ali Saunders came to campus at the holiday break and spent the spring semester with the team.
- The Beacons also added a pair of transfers to the roster for this season.
- Emma Tecca spent three seasons at Akron, but used just one season of eligibility. Tecca hit at a 45.2% clip from behind the 3-point line in 2020-21 — a mark which ranks among the best single-season clips in Akron history.
- Olivia Sims was at Oakland last season, where she hit at a 46.9% clip from the 3-point line in 12 appearances. Sims scored in double figures four times, including a 12-point performance against Michigan State.

Raining Threes

- In her time at the helm of the Valpo program, head coach Mary Evans' teams have become known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers.
- Evans' first four seasons at the helm saw Valpo's top-four single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history.
- Valpo has ranked among the top-35 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.
- Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history.
- In her four seasons at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.
- The style of play isn't a surprise if you follow the coaching tree. Evans coached under Bob Boldon at Ohio for five years before getting the head job at Valpo, and Boldon was a former assistant coach at FGCU under their legendary head coach, Karl Smesko, whose teams have ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 3-pointers made in each of the last 10 years.

Top 100 Wins

- Valpo has made a habit of knocking off top-100 opponents in MVC play over the last few seasons.
- Four times in MVC play in 2021-22, the Beacons earned a victory over a top-100 team.
- Valpo has nine top-100 NET/RPI wins in Valley action over the last three seasons.
- Prior to its Feb. 16, 2020 win at Illinois State - its first top-100 win in conference play since joining the Valley - Valpo had gone nearly seven years without a top-100 victory.

Down 10? No Problem

- Not surprisingly given their penchant for the 3-point shot, a double-digit deficit isn't a death sentence for Valpo.
- Last season, five of the Beacon's nine conference wins saw Valpo overcome a double-figure deficit at some points during the game.
- Valpo has rallied from down 10 or more to win 15 times in head coach Mary Evans first four years at the helm of the program.

Same Alma Maters

- While there are 12 players on the 2022-23 Valpo women's basketball roster, there are only 10 high schools represented.
- Fifth year Maya Dunson and redshirt freshman Lovie Malone are both alums of Wayne (Ohio) H.S.
- Junior Ava Interrante and sophomore Katie Beyer were teammates at McHenry (Ill.) H.S.

#1 Emma Tecca

- Tecca spent the last three years at Akron, appearing in a total of 28 games.
- Tecca hit at a 45.2% clip from 3-point range in 2020-21, one of the top single-season marks in Zips history.
- Tecca played her prep basketball at Archbishop Hoban H.S., where she was an All-Ohio Division II Honorable Mention selection as a sophomore before injuries ended her final two seasons.

#2 Olivia Brown

- Brown opened the season with 11 points in Valpo's win at Central Michigan.
- Brown was named to the 2021-22 MVC All-Newcomer Team for her performance in her first year at Valpo.
- Brown averaged 6.6 points/game in 2022-23 as she appeared in all 30 games, making 19 starts.
- Brown's scoring average increased to 9.5 points/game in MVC play.
- Brown led all Valley players as she connected at a 39.8% clip from the 3-point line.
- Brown ranked second in MVC-only action in 3-point percentage (42.4%), fourth in field goal percentage (51.6%) and ninth in 3-pointers made.
- Brown scored in double figures six times, including a pair of 20+ point outings.

#3 Ava Interrante

- Interrante opened the year with two points and three rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the season-opening win at CMU.
- Interrante appeared in 18 games in her first two seasons at Valpo.
- Interrante scored four points in last year's MVC Tournament quarterfinal against UNI.
- Interrante earned Honorable Mention All-State honors and was a two-time All-Conference selection for McHenry [Ill.] H.S.

Hired as the eighth head coach in the history of the Valpo women's basketball program in April 2018, Mary Evans enters her fifth year at the helm of the program in 2022-23.

Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Through four seasons, Evans has a record of 48-68 at the helm of the Brown and Gold.

Evans led the 2021-22 Valpo squad to a number of firsts en route to a 9-9 mark in MVC play and a sixth-place finish in the conference standings, both of which match the program's bests since joining the Valley. The Beacons registered the first win at Drake and the first win at Bradley in program history. Valpo swept the season series over Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs. The Beacons also tallied four top-100 wins within Valley play.

The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal BIG wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history. Entering the season without a win over a Power Five program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers. Valpo became the first program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18.

The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET. Valpo has five top-100 wins in MVC play over the last two seasons after going nearly seven years since its last top-100 win.

Evans led the Valpo program to a remarkable season across the board in 2019-20, one that concluded among the nation's top turnarounds from the season before. Valpo posted a 17-12 record in Evans' second season at the helm, the 17 wins the most by a Valpo team since the 2006-07 campaign and the 10th-most in a single season in program history.

Valpo improved its record by 10.5 games over the previous season in 2019-20, tied for the sixth-best improvement in Division I. Even more impressively, Valpo jumped by 171 spots in the RPI in Evans' second season as head coach, the nation's largest RPI jump.

With the 17 victories came many notable accomplishments throughout the season. Nine of the 17 wins came on the road, giving Valpo its highest number of true road wins since the 2001-02 season. Valpo concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record, the best pre-conference mark by winning percentage in program history. That non-conference slate ended with seven straight wins, which was Valpo's longest winning streak since the 2001-02 team won 10 straight and was just the seventh winning streak of at least seven consecutive games in program history.

Conference play brought more of the same for Evans and the 2019-20 Valpo squad. Valpo posted a 9-9 record in MVC play, finishing the regular season with both its highest win total and its best conference finish (6th) since joining the MVC. Most impressively, this record came in a conference which finished the year ranked eighth among Division I leagues, matching its best-ever finish and trailing just the Power Five, the Big East and the Ivy League.

The nine conference wins included victories at Illinois State and at home over UNI - the program's first wins over top-100 RPI teams since March 2013. In fact, the road win at Illinois State was the program's first true road victory over a top-100 program since March 2002.

Upon her arrival, Evans immediately instituted a style of play on both sides of the ball which encourages aggressiveness. On the offensive end, her teams are known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers. Evans' first four seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history. Valpo has ranked among the top-35 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.

Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history. In the four seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with 14+ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.

Meanwhile defensively, Evans' teams have racked up steals at a high rate, averaging at least 7.8 steals/game in each of her three seasons. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 teams ranked among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game, with the 2019-20 squad totaling 300 steals - the program's highest single-season total since 2002. Valpo has also boasted the conference leader in steals each of the last three years as well.

Evans brought 15 years of Division I experience with her to Northwest Indiana, spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Ohio before her arrival at Valpo.

Evans was a two-sport athlete at Georgia Southern, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. She won four letters in basketball (1995-1999) and three in soccer during her time as a collegiate athlete. A native of Summerville, S.C., Evans was inducted into the Summerville High School Hall of Fame in 2008. She and her husband Daryl have two children, Keegan Thomas and Zoe Mae.
