Head Coach Mary Evans: Mary Evans is in her fifth year at the helm of the program in 2022-23 and owns a record of 50-69. Evans has made an impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Evans' preferred style of play has been a big part of the program's turnaround, as Valpo has led the MVC in 3-pointers made per game in each of the last three seasons and in steals per game in two of the last three years.

Series Notes: Valpo and UAB have met just once in program history, and that matchup came well before any of the participants in Monday's game were born. The Blazers earned an 84-53 win in that meeting, which came on Nov. 25, 1989 at a tournament hosted by Indiana. Valpo is just 1-6 all-time against current CUSA members, with that lone win coming in 2007 over North Texas.

- Valpo was picked to finish in 10th place in the MVC preseason poll, totaling 197 points, just 10 points behind Evansville.
- Valpo is in its sixth season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The Valley was ranked 10th in conference NET last year, was ranked seventh nationally in conference NET in 2020-21 and was eighth nationally in conference RPI in 2019-20.


## ...looking back at last year

- Valpo finished last year with an 11-19 overall record, but was strong in MVC play, going 9-9 in conference and finishing in sixth place - both of which match the program's best since joining the Valley.
- The Beacons registered the first win at Drake and the first win at Bradley in program history.
- Valpo swept the season series over Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs.
- The Beacons also tallied four top-100 wins within Valley play.
- Grace White was named MVC Sixth Player of the Year - the program's first major postseason award since joining the Valley. Shay Frederick was a First Team All-MVC choice, while White was an All-Defensive Team selection and Olivia Brown earned a spot on the All-Newcomer Team.


## ...versus Eastern Illinois

- Valpo led by 10 in the first quarter, but the Panthers erased the deficit and used a 12-0 run to take the lead in the second quarter. EIU eventually led 36-35 at intermission.
- Neither team enjoyed more than a three-point lead in the third quarter and the teams were tied at 52-52 entering the fourth period.
- Valpo led 57-54 following a triple by senior Olivia Brown with 8:31 to play in the game. The Beacons went scoreless on their next four trips, as EIU scored six in a row to take the lead for good.
- Valpo had a shot to tie with $1: 38$ to play, but was unable to connect.
- The loss snapped an eight-game winning streak for Valpo in the series with EIU.
- The Beacons shot just $37.7 \%$ from the field on Wednesday. They did knock down 103 -pointers and went 11 -of-12 ( $91.7 \%$ ) from the foul line. - Wednesday marked just the second time in the last four seasons that Valpo has lost after holding a double-digit lead at some point during the contest.
- Brown paced the Beacons on Wednesday with a team-best 20 points, one off her high in the Valpo uniform. She also grabbed six rebounds, five of which came on the offensive end, and led the Beacons with four assists.

## ...versus Southern Miss

- It was a tight game throughout for the most part, as the largest lead either team had in the first three quarters was six points.
- Valpo took the lead for good with a three-minute stretch where the Beacons outscored USM, 13-5, in the third quarter, flipping a four-point deficit into a four-point lead.
- Valpo quickly pushed its lead to nine points with 8:25 to play in the fourth quarter before the Golden Eagles cut the lead to two with 5:52 to play.
- Three times in the next three minutes, after Southern Miss had moved within one possession, Valpo countered with a 3-pointer, getting big triples from Ilysse Pitts, Olivia Brown and Maya Dunson.
- USM got to within 67-64 with 1:43 to go, but Valpo limited the Golden Eagles to one point the rest of the way.
- The win came over a Southern Miss program which won 18 games a season ago.
- Leading four players in double figures in scoring was Brown, who delivered 15 points to pace Valpo for the fourth time in her time as a Beacon. The senior also matched her high in a Valpo uniform with six rebounds.
- After going for 20 points in Monday's season opener, Leah Earnest followed up with 12 points on 6 -of-10 shooting Saturday while again leading the team on the glass with eight rebounds.
- Ali Saunders again delivered an offensive spark off the bench, needing just 13 minutes of action to pour in 11 points and dish out three assists.
- Pitts hit a career-best three triples (3-5 3PT) as part of a 10 -point performance. The veteran matched her career high in scoring for the third time, but hit double figures for the first time since Dec. 16, 2018.


## ...looking ahead

- Valpo hits the road Nov. 27, when it makes the short trip to Evanston to face Northwestern.
- The Beacons then welcome a pair of MAC opponents to the ARC following that game, as Bowling Green (Dec. 2) and Western Michigan (Dec. 7) come to town.


## ...at the ARC

- Saturday's game is the third of 15 home games this season for Valpo, five of which will be nonconference games.
- The Beacons are 1-1 at home so far this year and went 6-7 in home games last season.


## @UAB_WBBALL

- The Blazers come to the ARC with a 2-0 record on the year after big wins over Auburn Montgomery and Nicholls.
- It has been a balanced offense for UAB through two games, as despite averaging 77 points in the pair of wins, no Blazer is averaging more than 12 points/game individually.
- UAB went 16-15 overall last year and posted an 8-10 record in CUSA play.
- The Blazers were picked seventh in the CUSA preseason poll.


## Earnest Hits the Boards

- Leah Earnest has had a strong start to the season scoring the basketball, but more notably, hitting the glass and rebounding.
- Earnest, who had reached double figures in rebounding twice in her first two seasons, has already done so twice this year - 10 at Central Michigan and 14 last time out versus Eastern Illinois.

- The 14 rebounds last time out were the most by a Valpo player since Dani Franklin grabbed 16 against Indiana State on Jan. 28, 2018.
- Through three games, Earnest's average of 10.7 rebounds/game is tops in the MVC and ranks among the top- 30 nationally.
- Earnest has also scored in double figures in all three games, going for a ca-reer-best 20 points at CMU, 12 points against Southern Miss and 11 points versus Eastern Illinois.
- She has been impressively prolific inside the ARC, hitting 76.2\% (16-of-21) from 2-point range - among the top-60 nationally.


## Brown Leads the Way

- For the second straight game, it was senior Olivia Brown leading Valpo in the scoring column last time out, pouring in 20 points against Eastern Illinois - just one off her career best.
- Brown has been in double figures all three games this season, as she posted 11 points in the season opener at CMU and a team-high 15 points in the win over Southern Miss.
- Brown ranks among the top-10 in the Valley in both scoring (15.3 ppg, 7th) and field goal percentage (.500).


## Saunders Wastes No Time

- Freshman Ali Saunders has jumped right into Valpo's rotation off the bench as the reserve point guard and has made an immediate impact.
- Saunders opened her career with 10 points (2-3 FG; 5-6 FT) and two assists in 18 minutes of action in the win at CMU.
- The rookie followed with 11 points (4-8 FG; 3-3 FT) and three assists in just 13 minutes of playing time in the win over Southern Miss, and then notched 12 points (3-7 FG; 5-6 FT) last time out versus Eastern Illinois.
- Saunders is the first Valpo freshman to score in double figures in back-to-back games to open a career since Dani Franklin did so in 2014-15 in six straight to open her career.


## Hitting From Deep

- Led by four triples from Brown, Valpo connected on 10 3-pointers last time out against Eastern Illinois to reach double figures in the category for the first time this season.
- Last season saw Valpo hit 10 or more triples on 11 occasions.
- In her fifth year at the helm of the program, Mary Evans' squads have made double-digit 3-pointers 48 times.


## Replacing Production

- It is a revamped squad on the court for the Beacons in 2022-23.
- Valpo returns just $32.1 \%$ of their scoring, $38.1 \%$ of their rebounding, $24.4 \%$ of their assists and $35.9 \%$ of their minutes played from last year's squad.
- Valpo lost its three leading scorers, four of its five leading rebounders and its three highest assist talliers from the 2021-22 team.


## Who's Back

- Seven letterwinners return for the Beacons in 2022-23.
- Included among that group are four regulars from last year's team, highlighted by senior Olivia Brown, who was an MVC All-Newcomer choice last season.
- Brown averaged 6.6 points/game and hit at a conference-best $39.8 \%$ clip from the 3-point line. Brown stepped up her game within Valley play, averaging 9.5 points/game in MVC action and hitting at a $42.4 \%$ rate from deep.

- Also returning from last year's starting group is junior wing Leah Earnest. Earnest averaged 7.7 points/game and 4.6 rebounds/game in 2021-22, ranking second on the team in rebounding.
- She paced Valpo on the boards nine times and scored in double figures on nine occasions, including a pair of 17-point efforts.
- Fifth years Maya Dunson ( $3.6 \mathrm{ppg}, 2.1 \mathrm{rpg}$ ) and Ilysse Pitts ( $1.4 \mathrm{ppg}, 1.4$ rpg ) also saw regular action last season.
- Juniors Ava Interrante and Jayda Johnston and sophomore Katie Beyer look to take advantage of the available playing time entering this year.


## Who's New

- While Valpo has three freshmen on this year's team, none of them are traditional true freshmen.
- Both Ella Van Weelden and Lovie Malone redshirted last season in their first year on campus.
- Meanwhile, Ali Saunders came to campus at the holiday break and spent the spring semester with the team.
- The Beacons also added a pair of transfers to the roster for this season.
- Emma Tecca spent three seasons at Akron, but used just one season of eligibility. Tecca hit at a $45.2 \%$ clip from behind the 3-point line in 2020-21 - a mark which ranks among the best single-season clips in Akron history. - Olivia Sims was at Oakland last season, where she hit at a $46.9 \%$ clip from the 3-point line in 12 appearances. Sims scored in double figures four times, including a 12-point performance against Michigan State.


## Raining Threes

- In her time at the helm of the Valpo program, head coach Mary Evans' teams have become known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers.
- Evans' first four seasons at the helm saw Valpo's top-four single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19 - a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history.
- Valpo has ranked among the top-35 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.
- Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history.
- In her four seasons at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with $14+$ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17.
- The style of play isn't a surprise if you follow the coaching tree. Evans coached under Bob Boldon at Ohio for five years before getting the head job at Valpo, and Boldon was a former assistant coach at FGCU under their legendary head coach, Karl Smesko, whose teams have ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 3-pointers made in each of the last 10 years.


## Top 100 Wins

- Valpo has made a habit of knocking off top-100 opponents in MVC play over the last few seasons.
- Four times in MVC play in 2021-22, the Beacons earned a victory over a top-100 team.
- Valpo has nine top-100 NET/RPI wins in Valley action over the last three seasons.
- Prior to its Feb. 16, 2020 win at Illinois State - its first top-100 win in conference play since joining the Valley - Valpo had gone nearly seven years without a top-100 victory.


## Down 10? No Problem

- Not surprisingly given their penchant for the 3-point shot, a double-digit deficit isn't a death sentence for Valpo.
- Last season, five of the Beacon's nine conference wins saw Valpo overcome a double-figure deficit at some points during the game.
- Valpo has rallied from down 10 or more to win 15 times in head coach Mary Evans first four years at the helm of the program.


## Same Alma Maters

- While there are 12 players on the 2022-23 Valpo women's basketball roster, there are only 10 high schools represented.
- Fifth year Maya Dunson and redshirt freshman Lovie Malone are both alums of Wayne (Ohio) H.S.
- Junior Ava Interrante and sophomore Katie Beyer were teammates at McHenry (Ill.) H.S.


## \#1 Emma Tecca

- Tecca made her Valpo debut against Southern Miss, playing five minutes off the bench.
- Tecca spent the last three years at Akron, appearing in a total of 28 games. - Tecca hit at a $45.2 \%$ clip from 3-point range in 2020-21, one of the top single-season marks in Zips history.
- Tecca played her prep basketball at Archbishop Hoban H.S., where she was an All-Ohio Division II Honorable Mention selection as a sophomore before injuries ended her final two seasons.


## \#2 Olivia Brown

- Brown scored a team-best 20 points, including four 3-pointers, while adding six rebounds and four assists last time out versus Eastern Illinois.
- Brown paced Valpo with 15 points and tied her high in the Beacon uniform with six rebounds in the win over Southern Miss.
- Brown opened the season with 11 points in Valpo's win at Central Michigan.
- Brown was named to the 2021-22 MVC All-Newcomer Team for her performance in her first year at Valpo.
- Brown averaged 6.6 points/game in 2022-23 as she appeared in all 30 games, making 19 starts.
- Brown's scoring average increased to 9.5 points/game in MVC play.
- Brown led all Valley players as she connected at a $39.8 \%$ clip from the 3-point line.
- Brown ranked second in MVC-only action in 3-point percentage (42.4\%), fourth in field goal percentage ( $51.6 \%$ ) and ninth in 3-pointers made.
- Brown scored in double figures six times, including a pair of $20+$ point outings.


## \#3 Ava Interrante

- Interrante opened the year with two points and three rebounds in 15 minutes of action in the season-opening win at CMU.
- Interrante appeared in 18 games in her first two seasons at Valpo.
- Interrante scored four points in last year's MVC Tournament quarterfinal against UNI.
- Interrante earned Honorable Mention All-State honors and was a two-time All-Conference selection for McHenry [III.] H.S.

# Mary Evans Head Coach <br> 5th Season * Georgia Southern, 2000 50-69 overall and at Valpo 

Hired as the eighth head coach in the history of the Valpo women's basketball program in April 2018, Mary Evans enters her fifth year at the helm of the program in 2022-23.

Evans has made an immediate impact on the program in her first four years, raising the team's level of play to be competitive in a strong Missouri Valley Conference. Through four seasons, Evans has a record of 48-68 at the helm of the Brown and Gold.

Evans led the 2021-22 Valpo squad to a number of firsts en route to a 9-9 mark in MVC play and a sixth-place finish in the conference standings, both of which match the program's bests since joining the Valley. The Beacons registered the first win at Drake and the first win at Bradley in program history. Valpo swept the season series over Drake, the program's first two wins ever against the Bulldogs. The Beacons also tallied four top-100 wins within Valley play.

The 2020-21 squad counted some big wins among its 12 victories, including a pair of literal B1G wins, as the Brown and Gold beat multiple Big Ten teams in the same season for the first time in program history. Entering the season without a win over a Power Five program since 2012-13, Valpo won at Illinois for its first-ever win over the Illini, and followed four days later with a road win at Purdue - the second win in program history over the Boilermakers. Valpo became the first program with multiple nonconference road wins at Big Ten programs since 2017-18.

The team picked up some big wins once the schedule flipped to Missouri Valley Conference play as well, as three of Valpo's seven conference victories came over teams in the top-100 of the NET. Valpo has five top-100 wins in MVC play over the last two seasons after going nearly seven years since its last top- 100 win.

Evans led the Valpo program to a remarkable season across the board in 2019-20, one that concluded among the nation's top turnarounds from the season before. Valpo posted a 17-12 record in Evans' second season at the helm, the 17 wins the most by a Valpo team since the 2006-07 campaign and the 10th-most in a single season in program history.

Valpo improved its record by 10.5 games over the previous season in 2019-20, tied for the sixth-best improvement in Division I. Even more impressively, Valpo jumped by 171 spots in the RPI in Evans' second season as head coach, the nation's largest RPI jump.

With the 17 victories came many notable accomplishments throughout the season. Nine of the 17 wins came on the road, giving Valpo its highest number of true road wins since the 2001-02 season. Valpo concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with an 8-3 record, the best pre-conference mark by winning percentage in program history. That non-conference slate ended with seven straight wins, which was Valpo's longest winning streak since the 2001-02 team won 10 straight and was just the seventh winning streak of at least seven consecutive games in program history.

Conference play brought more of the same for Evans and the 2019-20 Valpo squad. Valpo posted a 9-9 record in MVC play, finishing the regular season with both its highest win total and its best conference finish (6th) since joining the MVC. Most impressively, this record came in a conference which finished the year ranked eighth among Division I leagues, matching its best-ever finish and trailing just the Power Five, the Big East and the Ivy League.

The nine conference wins included victories at Illinois State and at home over UNI - the program's first wins over top-100 RPI teams since March 2013. In fact, the road win at Illinois State was the program's first true road victory over a top-100 program since March 2002.

Upon her arrival, Evans immediately instituted a style of play on both sides of the ball which encourages aggressiveness. On the offensive end, her teams are known for their propensity to shoot 3-pointers. Evans' first four seasons at the helm have seen Valpo's top-3 single-season total 3-pointers made, including a program-record 276 in her first season in 2018-19-a mark which ranks seventh in MVC history. Valpo has ranked among the top-35 in the nation in 3-pointers/game all three years, with the 2020-21 squad setting a program single-season record by averaging 9.0 triples/game.

Prior to Evans' arrival, Valpo had made 14 or more 3-pointers in a game just nine times in program history. In the four seasons with her at the helm, Valpo owns 11 more games with $14+$ triples, including twice matching the program single-game record of 17 .

Meanwhile defensively, Evans' teams have racked up steals at a high rate, averaging at least 7.8 steals/game in each of her three seasons. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 teams ranked among the top-40 teams nationally in steals/game, with the 2019-20 squad totaling 300 steals - the program's highest single-season total since 2002 . Valpo has also boasted the conference leader in steals each of the last three years as well.

Evans brought 15 years of Division I experience with her to Northwest Indiana, spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Ohio before her arrival at Valpo.
Evans was a two-sport athlete at Georgia Southern, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in 2000. She won four letters in basketball (1995-1999) and three in soccer during her time as a collegiate athlete. A native of Summerville, S.C., Evans was inducted into the Summerville High School Hall of Fame in 2008. She and her husband Daryl have two children, Keegan Thomas and Zoe Mae.
