Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will close out the regular season on Sunday afternoon by making its first Missouri Valley Conference trip to league newcomer Murray State. The game holds significance for Arch Madness seeding as the Beacons have the opportunity to earn the No. 9 seed with a victory. This will serve as the final tune-up for the State Farm MVC Tournament, which begins on Thursday, March 2 in St. Louis.

Last Time Out: Valpo recognized seniors Nick Edwards, Quinton Green, Luke Morrill, Ben Krikke and Kobe King along with student manager Sam Back and senior cheer/dance team members prior to Wednesday's Senior Night game, a 76-66 loss to Bradley. Krikke has an additional year of eligibility due to COVID-19 and is undecided on whether or not he will return for a fifth season. Krikke scored a team-high 17 points, while Green contributed 16 and Edwards had a balanced stat line of eight points, eight assists and seven rebounds. King reached double figures for a program-record 30th consecutive game.

Head Coach Matt Lottich: Matt Lottich (108-115) is in his seventh season as the head coach of the men's basketball program in 2022-2023. Twice during his tenure, Valpo has upset Top-25 opponents, defeating Drake and Rhode Island at the ARC. Valpo has four wins over AP Top 25 teams in program history, and two have come under Lottich. In 2019-2020, Valpo became the first team in the history of Arch Madness, the annual Missouri Valley Conference Tournament in St. Louis, to reach the title game after playing in the opening round by winning three games in three days. Lottich, hired as the 22nd head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program in April 2016, graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and New Trier High School (Illinois) in 2000.

Series Notes: This will mark the fifth all-time matchup between the two teams with Valpo holding a 3-2 edge in the series. The first matchup of the year occurred way back on Dec. 4, a 77-70 overtime win for the Racers. Prior to Murray State joining The Valley this year, the most recent showdown between the two teams was Nov. 29, 2014, a 93-58 Valpo win as part of the Challenge in Music City in Nashville, Tenn. This will mark the second time Valpo has ever visited Murray State and first since Dec. 29, 2012, a 66-64 Valpo victory.

Dec. 4 – Murray State 77, Valpo 70 (OT): Valpo received a then career-high 31 points from Ben Krikke and led by as many as 10 during the first home conference game of the season, but visiting Murray State raced back for a 77-70 overtime victory. Valpo led for much of the first half but the second half was a seesaw battle in a game that featured 10 ties and 14 lead changes. Jerome Palm had a career-high 10 rebounds off the bench, while Quinton Green (18) and Kobe King (11) also tallied in double figures in the scoring column.

Seeding Scenarios

- With one game remaining in the regular season, Valpo's seeding possibilities for the upcoming State Farm MVC Tournament in St. Louis are ninth, 10th and 11th. The team's possible first-round opponents are Missouri State, Murray State and UNI.
- UIC hosts Southern Illinois on Sunday at 1 p.m. and Illinois State hosts Evansville at 2 p.m.
- If Valpo wins on Sunday at Murray State, the Beacons will clinch the No. 9 seed. If Illinois State loses to Evansville, Valpo also clinches the No. 9 seed.
- If Valpo loses, Illinois State wins and UIC loses, Valpo will be the No. 10 seed.
- If Valpo loses and Illinois State and UIC both win, Valpo will be the No. 11 seed.
- The No. 9 seed will start Arch Madness at noon on Thursday, March 2 against the No. 8 seed. The No. 10 seed plays the No. 7 seed that night at 6 p.m., while the No. 11 seed will play the No. 6 seed at 8:30 p.m. that evening.

Earning Accolades

- Ben Krikke added to his ever-growing trophy case this past week, first by earning Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week honors on Monday, Feb. 20 after averaging 29.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists over two games the previous week, shooting 61.1 percent from the floor (22-of-36), 40 percent from 3-point range (2-of-5) and 80 percent from the free-throw line (12-of-25).
- This marked the second time this season and the third time in his career that Krikke has earned MVC Player of the Week laurels.
- The big week continued on Tuesday, Feb. 21 when Krikke was named to the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District Team. He holds a 3.78 cumulative grade point average

in finance. This marks the second time in his career that Krikke has earned Academic All-District from CSC, previously known as CoSIDA.

The Conference's Leading Scorer

- Entering the final day of the regular season, Ben Krikke leads the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring both overall (19.5 ppg) and in league-only games (20.8 ppg).
- Krikke ranks among the league leaders in the following categories as well rebounds per game (5.9, t-11th), field goal percentage (54.8, second), free-throw percentage (79.6, 10th) and blocked shots per game (0.9, 10th).
- Krikke is hoping to become the first Valpo player to lead the MVC in scoring and the first Valpo player to sit atop any league in scoring since Alec Peters paced the Horizon League at 23.0 ppg in 2016-17.
- Kobe King ranks eighth in the league at 16.3 points per game, making Valpo the lone team in the league with two players who rank in the top 10 in scoring.

Krikke in the Record Book

- With his first basket on Feb. 18 at UIC, Ben Krikke joined the top 10 in program history in career scoring by usurping Harry Bell (1984-88; 1,508). During that game, he also climbed passed Dick Jones (1965-68; 1,520) and Bruce Lindner (1967-70; 1,539) to move into eighth in program lore.
- Entering Feb. 26 at Murray State, Krikke is 33 points away from tying and 34 from passing Ryan Broekhoff (2009-2013) for seventh in program history. Krikke has 1,558 career points.
- On Feb. 14 vs. Southern Illinois, Ben Krikke became the 11th player in program history to reach 1,500 career points.
- On Feb. 22 vs. Bradley, Krikke entered the program's single-season top 10. He has scored 584 points this season, ninth in program history. Krikke recently passed fellow left-hander Dan Oppland's 2004-05 season (577) and Oppland's 2005-06 season (573) on the program's single-season scoring list.
- Krikke's next targets on the single-season list are Bryce Drew's 1997-98 season (613) and Tracy Gipson's 1992-93 season (595).
- Krikke has knocked down 229 field goals this season, the seventh most in program history. He recently passed Javon Freeman-Liberty's 2019-20 season (227) and Alec Peters' 2015-16 season (223). Dan Oppland's 2005-06 season is fifth at 231 and John Wolfenberg's 1972-73 season is sixth at 230.
- Entering Feb. 26 at Murray State, Krikke has 617 career made field goals, a mark that ranks sixth in program history. He recently passed Harry Bell (1985-88; 606) on that list, and the threshold to get into the top five is 634 (John Wolfenberg; 1970-73).
- Krikke hit another milestone on Feb. 11 vs. Illinois State as he pulled down his 500th career rebound.

King's Double-Figure Streak Sets Program Record

- The only player in the Missouri Valley Conference who has scored in double figures in each of his team's games this season is Kobe King, who has scored 10+ in 30 straight.
- Thanks to his 10-point output on Feb. 22 vs. Bradley, King has set a program record for consecutive double-figure scoring outputs within the same season.
- Javon Freeman-Liberty scored in double figures in all 29 regular season games that he played during the 2019-20 season before seeing his streak snapped in the first MVC Tournament game. Alec Peters scored in double figures in all 29 games he played in 2016-17 before seeing his season cut short by an injury.
- King has scored in double figures in 49 of his 53 games in a Valpo uniform.

- The former Wisconsin Mr. Basketball has scored 15 points or more in 18 of his 30 games this season. He has eight 20-point outputs this year.
- King is up to 54 career double-figure scoring efforts including his tenure at Wisconsin.
- At the end of last season, King became Valpo's second All-Newcomer Team choice since joining the league and first since Bakari Evelyn in 2017-18.
- He appeared on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays after a three-quarter court buzzer-beater on Dec. 11 vs. Charlotte, a play that ranked No. 9 on the popular countdown that evening.

Edwards Anecdotes

- Valpo point guard Nick Edwards ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference and 18th nationally with 152 total assists.
- On Feb. 22 vs. Bradley, Edwards joined the program's single-season top 10, surpassing Bryce Drew's 1996-97 output of 145 and Ali Berdiel's 2002-03 number of 146.
- Entering Feb. 26 at Murray State, Edwards ranks ninth in program history in single-season assists, three in back of Drew's 1997-98 season for eighth and nine behind Keith Carter's 2015-16 campaign for seventh.
- Edwards is averaging 7.3 points per game and 5.1 assists per game. Just two Valpo players in the last 30 years have finished a season with 7.0 ppg and better than 5.0 apg Ali Berdiel (2003-04) and Bryce Drew (three times, 1994-1998).
- If Edwards stays on his current pace, he would post Valpo's highest apg number since Berdiel's 6.0 in 2003-2004.

More Ben Bits

- Ben Krikke has reached double figures in 28 of his 30 games this season including 12 outputs of 20 points or more.
- Krikke has scored 15+ points in 25 out of 30 contests.
- Krikke has tallied double figures in 18 consecutive games and all 19 league contests this season.
- Krikke has scored 17 points or more in nine consecutive games and is averaging 24.3 points per game during that stretch. He has scored 20 points or more in five of his last six.
- Last season, Krikke was one of three players in the Missouri Valley Conference to shoot 50 percent or better from the floor and 80 percent or better from the free-throw line, joining Isiaih Mosley of Missouri State and Malevy Leons of Bradley while owning the highest field-goal percentage of that elite group.
- Krikke had a 12-game double-figure scoring streak that was snapped in the final game of the season, the MVC Tournament quarterfinal vs. Missouri State. He totaled 22 double-figure outputs and seven performances of 20 points or more while pacing the team in scoring on 11 occasions.
- After earning third team honors for the second straight year, Krikke became the first Valpo player to earn All-MVC accolades in two different seasons. The program's last multi-time all-conference honoree was Alec Peters, who was a first-team all-Horizon League pick in each of his final three seasons, concluding in 2016-17.
- He earned MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team status for the second straight year. He is the only Valpo player who has been part of the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team since the department joined the conference.

Krikke in Select Company

- Ben Krikke is one of three players in the country who is averaging at least 19.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while shooting better than 75 percent from the free-throw line and better than 50 percent from the field.
- He joins Arizona's Azuolas Tubelis and Chattanooga's Jake Stephens.
- Krikke is on pace to become just the third different Missouri Valley Conference player since 2005 to average at least 17 points and five

boards while shooting better than 75 percent from the free-throw line and 50 percent from the field. He would join Missouri State's Isiaih Mosley and Creighton's Doug McDermott, who did so twice each.

- Krikke is one of three Missouri Valley Conference players averaging 19.0 points per game and 5.0 rebounds per game this year, joining fellow first team Larry Bird Player of the Year candidates Belmont's Ben Sheppard and Drake's Tucker DeVries.

A Rare Starter Switch

- Ben Krikke, Kobe King and Quinton Green have been fixtures in the starting lineup this season as all three have started each of the first 30 games.
- The other two spots rotated some earlier in the season, but Valpo seems to have found a consistent starting five with Maximus Nelson (20 starts) serving as Krikke's front court mate.
- However, walk-on Luke Morrill received a Senior Night start on Feb. 22 vs. Bradley. This marked the first start of his collegiate career and snapped a stretch of 14 straight games where Valpo featured the same starting lineup.
- Nick Edwards (22 total starts) has started 19 straight games at point guard.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Feb. 22: Bradley 76, Valpo 66

- Valpo led by four with 10:36 remaining in the first half and outscored Bradley 36-34 after halftime, but it was the final 10:36 of the first half where the game was decided.
- The Beacons raced out to a 9-2 lead early in the game, the second straight game where they sprinted ahead after grabbing a 9-0 lead on UIC.
- Bradley held a 12-3 edge on the offensive glass.
- Nick Edwards had a balanced stat line of eight points, seven rebounds and eight assists.
- Ben Krikke (17), Quinton Green (16) and Kobe King (10) all scored in double figures.

Scouting the Racers

- Coming off an 84-69 loss at Missouri State on Tuesday but had won the previous two games at Illinois State (76-75) and vs. Evansville (74-58).
- Currently in seventh place in the Missouri Valley Conference standings.
- Picked to finish eighth in the MVC Preseason poll.
- Led in scoring by Rob Perry at 14.4 points per game.

Krikke's Career Day

- Ben Krikke continued to reach new heights on Feb. 19 at UIC, when he once again delivered his best performance yet, this time going off for a career-high 34 points to outdo his previous personal

best of 31 set on Dec. 4 vs. Murray State.

- Krikke's 34 points came on 14-of-19 shooting, with the 14 made field goals also representing a personal watermark.
- The 34 points marked the second-highest single-game scoring output by any Missouri Valley Conference player this season behind Belmont's Ben Sheppard, who scored 35 on Feb. 1 at Murray State.
- Krikke delivered the highest single-game scoring output by a Valpo player since Alec Peters had 35 on Dec. 22, 2016 vs. Santa Clara, a game that went to double overtime.
- This was the highest scoring output by a Valpo player in a regulation game since Peters had 36 on Nov. 12, 2016 vs. Trinity Christian.
- Krikke had Valpo's highest scoring output in a road game since Peters posted a career-high 39 on Jan. 10, 2016 at Detroit Mercy.
- Krikke also led the team with 10 rebounds, four of which came on the offensive glass. This was his second double-double of the season and first since the season opener on Nov. 7 at Toledo. It was Valpo's fifth double-double of the year.
- Krikke recorded the first "30&10" game by a Valpo player since Javon Freeman-Liberty on Nov. 12, 2019 at SIUE. Krikke joins JFL and Peters (6x) as the only Valpo players with 30-point double-doubles in the last decade.
- Krikke's 14 made field goals tied with Peters' 14 vs. Trinity Christian on Nov. 12, 2016 for the most by a Valpo player in the last decade.
- Krikke's 14 made field goals were the most by a Valpo player against a Division-I opponent since Anthony Allison had 15 on Jan. 15, 1996 at Troy State
- The 14 made field goals were the most by any MVC player in a game this season.
- Krikke became just the 10th player in the nation this season with 34 or more points, 14 or more made field goals and 10 or more rebounds in the same game.

Close Calls Continue

- Valpo fell to 0-6 this season in MVC games that are decided by fewer than five points or go overtime with the 74-73 loss at UIC on Feb. 18.
- Nearly half of Valpo's 13 Missouri Valley Conference defeats have come in those aforementioned close calls.
- Valpo has dropped five of its last six games, but four of those five losses have come by fewer than five points or in overtime.
- The Feb. 19 game at UIC was the first Valpo contest decided by the slimmest of margins this season. The last such game was Dec. 11, 2021, a 68-67 loss to Charlotte. The game in Chicago was Valpo's first league game dictated by a single point since a 66-65 win at SIU on Feb. 21, 2021.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Feb. 19: UIC 74, Valpo 73

- Ben Krikke had a career-high 34 points, while Kobe King contributed 15. Nick Edwards dished out eight assists, while Krikke topped the team on the glass with 10 boards.
- UIC connected on nine of its 18 first-half 3-point attempts (50 percent), but cooled off to 18.2 percent (2-of-11) from long range after the break.
- Each team had 9-0 runs in the first four minutes of the game. Valpo's largest

lead of the first half was nine, while UIC led by as many as 11 before the break.

- The entire second half was tightly contested, with neither team leading by more than four points for the final 18:30 of the game.
- This marked Valpo's first defeat against a team picked to finish below the Beacons in the preseason poll. Each of Valpo's first 17 Valley games went according to expectations based on the preseason projections.

Lottich Leaps J.M. Christiansen

- Valpo head coach Matt Lottich moved into sole possession of third in program history when he garnered his 103rd career victory on Dec. 21 vs. Stonehill. That triumph helped him snap a tie with J.M. Christiansen (1929-1941) for third all-time.
- Lottich reached the 100-win milestone with an 81-79 overtime victory over James Madison on Nov. 27 in Savannah, Ga.
- The former Stanford sharpshooter became just the fourth head coach in program history to get to 100 wins, joining Homer Drew, Bryce Drew and J.M. Christiansen.
- Lottich is now trailing only the Drews on the program's all-time wins list.

Top Two Scorers Back

- With both Ben Krikke (14.2 ppg) and Kobe King (14.0 ppg) back, Valpo returns its top two scorers from last season.
- The last time the program had its top two scorers back from the previous year was 2015-2016, when Alec Peters and Darien Walker both returned after finishing as the team's top two scorers in 2014-15. The 2015-16 season was a historic one, as the Brown & Gold reached the NIT championship game.
- Only four of the 12 teams in the Missouri Valley Conference have their top two scorers back from last season, as Valpo joins Drake, Southern Illinois and Indiana State.

Looking Back at 2021-2022

- The team boasted two MVC Scholar-Athlete team selections, the captain of the All-Bench Team, an MVC Most-Improved Team honoree, an All-MVC Third Team performer, an All-Newcomer team member and an All-Freshman team honoree. Valpo had seven different MVC postseason honors won by five different players.
- Valpo went a combined 5-0 against instate foes Indiana State and Evansville, sweeping the Hoosier State for the first time since joining the MVC
- Valpo finished with a home record of .500 or better for the 30th consecutive season.
- Eight of Valpo's 18 MVC games were decided by three points or fewer or required overtime.
- The Beacons overcame double-figure deficits to win on three occasions (Tulane, Eastern Michigan and Evansville), something that has occurred 19 times during the Matt Lottich Era.
- The team finished fourth in the MVC in both free-throw percentage (.759) and field-goal percentage (.459) while also finishing fourth in assists per game (12.5), steals per game (6.4) and third in assist/turnover ratio (1.1).
- Valpo played six overtime games, the program's most since tying a Division-I record with eight in 1993.

Preseason Picks

- Ben Krikke was tabbed to the Preseason All-MVC First Team, becoming the first player to earn that honor in Valpo's time in the conference.
- Prior to this season, Valpo had five preseason all-conference selections since joining The Valley in 2017-18, all second team honorees.
- Kobe King was named to the Preseason All-MVC Third Team, making this the second time in the team's six years in The Valley that Valpo has boasted a pair of preseason all-league choices.
- Krikke, also a Preseason All-MVC Second Team choice last year, became the first Valpo player to earn Preseason All-MVC honors on multiple occasions.
- Valpo was picked to finish ninth of 12 in the preseason poll, ahead of Illinois State, UIC and Evansville.
- Drake hauled in 52 of the 54 first-place votes and finished a heavy preseason favorite, while Drake's Tucker DeVries was named MVC Preseason Player of the Year.
- In addition to the conference's honor, Krikke was named to the Preseason All-MVC First Team by Blue Ribbon Magazine

Roster Rundown

- The 2022-23 roster features eight returning letter winners, one returning player who redshirted last season and six newcomers (three freshmen, three transfers).
- Five Valpo players hail from outside of the United States two from The Netherlands, two from Canada and one from Denmark.
- Four members of the roster are natives of the state of Wisconsin, while two call Illinois home and one has remained in his home state of Indiana. The

remaining players come from Georgia, Minnesota and Ohio.

- Nick Edwards is the first Georgia native to play for the program since E. Victor Nickerson in 2015-16.

Newcomer Notes

- Nick Edwards had a triple-double while playing at Glenville last season, one of eight Division-II players in the nation to achieve that feat.
- Quinton Green earned All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) honors for three straight seasons. He finished with 1,288 points over four seasons at Cedarville and knocked down a team-high 59 3-point field goals last year.
- Ibra Bayu spent three years in the United States playing high school basketball before arriving at Valpo. He dealt with a serious medical issue during his junior season before being sidelined by two separate fractured ankles as a senior.
- Jerome Palm comes to Valpo after two junior college seasons at Hillsborough CC and Daytona State. He competed for the championship-winning Netherlands national team in the 2021 3x3 national tournament.
- Maximus Nelson was a unanimous first team all-conference and first-team all-state selection after his senior season at Appleton North High School in Appleton, Wis.

Who's Next?

- Valpo signed a trio of incoming student-athletes during the early signing period in November.
- 6-foot-9 forward Zane Dougherty (Avon, Ind. / Ben Davis), 6-foot-1 point guard Jahari Williamson (Pickering, Ontario, Canada / Royal Crown Academy) and 6-foot-6 combo guard Yanis Bamba (Laval, Quebec, Canada / Jean-de-Brebeuf) are poised to join the Valpo program for the 2023-2024 season.
- Lottich on Bamba: "Yanis is a little bit of a late bloomer," Lottich said. "He's from a very similar area to where Max (Joseph) and Tevonn (Walker) are from. He's a native French speaker. He's a big-body guard, about 6-6, 200. He's very athletic and a very good passer. He was excited about the opportunity to come to Valpo, where he's seen the improvement that players make here. I think he will come in and be able to compete right away because of his athleticism, size and physicality. He's just scratching the surface of who he is as a basketball player."
- Lottich on Williamson: "We saw Jahari in Milwaukee for the first time," Lottich said. "The Canadian pipeline that we've had has been really good to us. He's cerebral, and he shoots it really well. Recruiting internationally can be tougher because you don't get your eyes on the players as much, but we were able to see Jahari play in some Canadian games where he was in high-level environments. This was similar to how we recruited Ben Krikke. Right now, Jahari is one of the five best players in Canada. His ability to stretch the defense and play with pick-and-rolls with the ball in his hands is going to be big for us."
- Lottich on Doughty: "We saw him at a high school showcase, and what we really liked was his motor as a big man," Lottich said. "There's one thing that we don't want to have to coach, and that's effort. When you recruit big men, they are typically coming into their own and then have vast improvements when they get to college. In Zane's case, one thing that really stood out to us was just how tenacious he was on both ends of the floor. He was rebounding out of his area and loves contact. We followed him throughout the summer and got to watch him play in a few high-level games. We love his toughness, and he really fits Valpo. He saw the family atmosphere at Valpo, and that resonated with him. His family is really important to him."

Matt Lottich

Head Coach 7th Season * Stanford, 2004 108-115 Overall and at Valpo

Matt Lottich is in his seventh season as the head coach of the men's basketball program in 2022-2023. He owned a 97-96 record over his first six seasons as head coach.

During the 2021-22 campaign, Lottich helped Valpo players earn seven different Missouri Valley Conference postseason honors won by five different players. His team finished fourth in the MVC in free-throw percentage (.759), field-goal percentage (.459), assists per game (12.5) and steals per game (6.4) while finishing third in assist/TO ratio (1.1). Numerous players reached individual accomplishments under Lottich's watch, including Kevion Taylor scoring his 2,000th career point, a pair of Valpo players finishing in the top eight in the MVC in field-goal percentage and Ben Krikke finishing as one of three MVC players with a field-goal percentage of 50 percent or better and a free-throw percentage of 80 percent or better. Freshman walk-on Preston Ruedinger finished as the only player in the nation with 30 or more assists and fewer than 10 turnovers.

During 2021-22 campaign, Lottich led Valpo to a 5-0 record against instate foes Indiana State and Evansville, its first Hoosier State sweep since joining the MVC. The Beacons overcame three double-figure deficits to prevail (Tulane, Eastern Michigan and Evansville), lifting Lottich's career double-figure comeback total to 19. In addition, Lottich climbed into fourth in program history in career victories, surpassing the legendary Gene Bartow.

The 2020-2021 season saw Valpo improve its Arch Madness seeding for the fourth straight year as the program continued to make positive strides in each season as a Missouri Valley Conference member. The team earned a first-round bye in the State Farm MVC Tournament for the first time since joining the prestigious league.

Valpo upset previously-undefeated Drake, the nation's No. 25 team, 74-57 on Feb. 7, 2021 at the ARC, the fourth win over an AP Top 25 team in program history and second under Lottich. The Bulldogs were one of three undefeated teams in the nation prior to that setback, joining Gonzaga and Baylor. Valpo came close to two other victories over ranked foes, falling 80-77 vs. No. 25 Drake on Feb. 6 and 54-52 at No. 22 Loyola on Feb. 17. In addition, Valpo extended its streak to 29 straight seasons without a sub-.500 home record.

Just two years removed from finishing in last place and being knocked out in the first round of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament as a first-year Valley member, Lottich's team did more than hold its own in 2019-2020, ascending into a tie for sixth in the league standings before finishing as the conference tournament runner-up. Valpo became the first team in the history of Arch Madness to reach the title game after playing in the opening round.

Lottich led the program to its first conference championship game appearance since 2015 during the 2019-2020 campaign, doing so after being picked to finish ninth of 10 in the preseason poll. Valpo reached the conference title game as only a third-year MVC member, becoming the first Valpo team in any sport to do so during the department's young tenure in the prestigious league. After finishing with its highest conference win total, highest overall win total and highest finish in the league standings since joining The Valley, Valpo accepted a postseason tournament invitation to play in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The event was ultimately canceled due to COVID-19 concerns.

The 2019-2020 team's finest hour came on the biggest stage, as Lottich led the squad to three victories in as many days at Arch Madness, the 2020 State Farm MVC Men's Basketball Tournament in St. Louis. Lottich's team came from 18 down to upset Loyola in the MVC quarterfinal, tying for the second-biggest comeback in MVC Tournament history. During his time guiding the program, Lottich has instilled a no-quit attitude. The Loyola comeback marked the sixth time in 2019-2020 that Valpo came from double figures down to win. On 11 occasions, Valpo trailed by at least 10 points and eventually tied the game or took the lead. Valpo also became just the second team in the long history of the Missouri Valley Conference to come from 17 or more down to win twice in one season, joining Creighton from 2007-2008.

Working with a young team that featured just five returning players from the previous season, Lottich mentored a 2019-2020 First Team All-MVC selection, MVC All-Defensive Team choice, MVC All-Freshman Team honoree, MVC All-Bench pick, MVC Scholar-Athlete Second Team selection and a pair of MVC All-Tournament Team performers. Perhaps most noteworthy of all, the program's emphasis on player development paid dividends as Valpo accounted for 40 percent of the MVC Most-Improved Team.

Other noteworthy feats for Lottich's squad in 2019-2020 included making 18 3-pointers in a game against Bradley to set the league-only MVC record, holding Southern Illinois to 38 points to set the program record for the fewest allowed against a Division-I opponent since the advent of the shot clock, snapping a 22-game losing streak in games at Evansville that had dated back to 1969, breaking through with its first win over Loyola since joining The Valley after previously going 0-7 against the program's Chicagoland rival and twice turning a double-figure defeat from the first half of the MVC double-round robin into a double-figure victory in the second meeting with that opponent.

The 2018-2019 season saw Lottich lead Valpo to 15 wins. The season was headlined by road victories over UNLV and George Washington during the nonconference portion of the schedule, as well as a 4-0 start to Missouri Valley Conference play.

Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-2018 and guided the team through the move to the MVC, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI.

In his first season at the helm of the Valpo men's basketball program, Lottich guided the team to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in a six-year span as he led Valpo to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT. Lottich's inaugural season as head coach was highlighted by a home win over a nationally-ranked Rhode Island squad as well as neutral-site triumphs over Alabama and BYU to capture the MGM Grand Main Event.

Lottich coached the Horizon League Player of the Year and an NABC Third Team All-American in Alec Peters, guiding the senior as he closed out one of the top careers in program history. Peters enjoyed his finest season as a senior, ranking among the Top 20 in the nation in both scoring and rebounding and breaking five of Valpo's career records.

Lottich was hired as the 22nd head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program in April 2016. After spending the previous three seasons on staff as an assistant coach, he became just the fifth Valpo head coach in a 36-year span. Lottich arrived at Valparaiso University in summer 2013 and helped guide the team to 78 victories over his three seasons as an assistant. Valpo won two Horizon League regular season championships and one league tournament title over those three years.

Lottich brings nearly a decade of professional playing experience to the head coaching position at Valparaiso University. He spent eight years playing professionally in Japan for the Oita Heat Devils and the Osaka Evessa, earning All-Star recognition four times. He also played one season in Germany in the Bundesliga for the Dusseldorf Giants, played one season in New Zealand in the NBL for the Harbor Heat and was a member of the New Jersey Nets' summer league team in 2004.

Lottich played collegiately at Stanford University from 2000-2004. As a senior in 2003-2004, he helped lead the Cardinal to the Pac-10 title while earning NABC All-Star plaudits, awarded to the Top 15 seniors in college basketball. He was also a member of the Wooden Award midseason watch list and was an Honorable Mention All Pac-10 selection as a senior. Lottich was a member of the program's conference championship squad as a freshman in 2000-2001 and still ranks among Stanford's single-season and career leaders in 3-pointers made.

Off the court, Lottich came to Valpo from the National Collegiate Scouting Association, where he started in January 2013. Lottich ascended to the position of head scout during his time with the NCSA, which helps high school athletes navigate the world of college recruiting. Lottich also co-founded the TEAM Life Skills basketball camp in 2004 and spent nine years managing and developing the camp.

Lottich played his prep basketball at New Trier [Ill.] H.S., where he was named the Chicago Tribune Athlete of the Year in 2000 and holds the distinction of being the program's all-time leading scorer. Lottich graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and currently resides in Valparaiso with his wife, Kylan, and their four children: Grace, Matthan, Christian and Landon.






