Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will open up the home portion of the 2022-2023 slate on Sunday as Western Michigan comes to town for a 4 p.m. CT tipoff. It's a country western theme night as the first 100 students will receive a free Valpo cowboy hat. This begins a stretch of three games in seven days as the Beacons visit Chicago State on Wednesday, Nov. 16 and host Incarnate Word on Saturday, Nov. 19.

Last Time Out: Toledo used an early 15-0 run to open up a 21-4 lead as the Beacons experienced cold shooting early in an eventual 85-70 setback to the Rockets, a team that has won the Mid-American Conference regular-season championship each of the last two seasons. Ben Krikke turned in a double-double of 18 points and 13 rebounds, rebounding from an uncharacteristic first half with a strong second half. Quinton Green buried five 3s on his way to a team-high 20 points.

Head Coach Matt Lottich: Matt Lottich (97-97) is in his seventh season as the head coach of the men's basketball program in 2022-2023. Twice during his tenure, Valpo has upset Top-25 opponents, defeating Drake and Rhode Island at the ARC. Valpo has four wins over AP Top 25 teams in program history, and two have come under Lottich. In 2019-2020, Valpo became the first team in the history of Arch Madness, the annual Missouri Valley Conference Tournament in St. Louis, to reach the title game after playing in the opening round by winning three games in three days. Lottich, hired as the 22nd head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program in April 2016, graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and New Trier High School (Illinois) in 2000.

Series Notes: Western Michigan holds a 38-30 lead in an all-time series that dates all the way back to the early days of Valpo's program. The first matchup between these two foes took place over a century ago in 1920. Last season, Valpo prevailed 71-60 in Kalamazoo, the first matchup between the two teams since 2007. This will mark the first time the Broncos have visited the ARC since a 77-65 Valpo victory on Nov. 28, 2007.

Home Opener History

- When the Beacons open up the home portion of the season on Sunday, they will look to get back on track in terms of home-opening success.
- The program had won the home opener in 16 consecutive seasons with 14 of those victories coming by double figures prior to starting the 2021-2022 campaign with a 69-61 setback vs. Toledo.
- Last season marked the first time Valpo started the home slate with a loss since Nov. 27, 2004, an 85-71 defeat to Charlotte.
- Road openers have been a different story, as the Brown & Gold have dropped the first road game of the season in five straight years, including this season's tipoff at Toledo.
- Valpo has finished with a home record of .500 or better in 30 straight seasons.

The Green Light

- Quinton Green scored 13 second-half points as part of a 20-point output in his Division-I debut on Nov. 7 at Toledo.
- Green appeared to have the green light from long range as he connected on five of his nine 3-point attempts.
- The former Division-II Cedarville standout matched a career high for made 3s, as he made five triples twice during his four-year career with the Yellow Jackets, most recently on Feb. 3, 2022.
- Green became the first Valpo player to make five 3s in a game since Sheldon Edwards on Feb. 16 of last season vs. Loyola.
- Green became the first Valpo player to make five 3s in a season opener since Darien Walker on Nov. 14, 2014 vs. East Tennessee State.
- Green's 20-point output was the 18th of his collegiate career.

Approaching 1,000

- Valpo senior Ben Krikke enters the Nov. 13 home opener on the cusp of a significant career milestone, as he is eight points away from 1,000 for his collegiate career. He has 992 career points.
- Krikke is looking to become the first Valpo player to reach the 1,000-career-point threshold since current graduate assistant Tevonn Walker hit that mark on Nov. 13, 2017 vs. Trinity Christian.
- Last season, Krikke was one of three players in the Missouri Valley Conference to shoot 50 percent or better from the floor and 80 percent or better from the free-throw line, joining Isaiah Mosley of Missouri State and Malevy Leons of Bradley while owning the highest field-goal percentage of that elite group.
- Krikke entered the season with a career field-goal percentage of 53.4, a mark that ranks seventh in program history.
- Krikke had a 12-game double-figure scoring streak that was snapped in the final game of the season, the MVC Tournament quarterfinal vs. Missouri State. He totaled 22 double-figure outputs and seven performances of 20 points or more while pacing the team in scoring on 11 occasions.
- The Valpo forward entered this season having played in 90 career

games with two years of eligibility remaining. The threshold to crack the program's all-time top 10 is 126 and the program record is 138 (Erik Buggs). He started the final 29 games last season after missing the first three games of the year due to an ankle injury.

- After earning third team honors for the second straight year, Krikke became the first Valpo player to earn All-MVC accolades in two different seasons. The program's last multi-time all-conference honoree was Alec Peters, who was a first-team all-Horizon League pick in each of his final three seasons, concluding in 2016-17.
- He earned MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team status for the second straight year. He is the only Valpo player who has been part of the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team since the department joined the conference.

Double-Double Details

- Speaking of Krikke, the senior forward put together his second career double-double in the Nov. 7 season opener at Toledo, pulling down a game-high 12 rebounds to go along with 18 points.
- This marked the second-highest rebounding output of Krikke's career behind only his career-high 15 on Jan. 24, 2021 at Illinois State, part of his only prior double-double.
- The bulk of Krikke's production came in the second half, as he rebounded from a slow start to hit six of his seven second-half field-goal attempts. He finished with 13 points and five rebounds in the second half alone.
- Krikke became the first Valpo player with a double-double in a season opener since Markus Golder on Nov. 10, 2017 vs. North Park.

Second-Half Sharpshooting

- Valpo shot 67.9 percent in the second half of the Nov. 7 season opener at Toledo, making 19 of the team's 28 attempts including 4-of-7 (57.1 percent) from 3.
- This marked Valpo's best field-goal percentage in a half since shooting 68.4 percent in the second half on Feb. 19, 2022 at Evansville.
- This was the program's third-highest single-half shooting percentage of the Matt Lottich Era behind the aforementioned half against Evansville and the first half on Feb. 17, 2018 vs. Bradley (73.9 percent).

Formidable Foe

- The 85-70 season-opening setback at Toledo on Nov. 7 came against a strong opponent.
- Picked to finish second in the Mid-American Conference, Toledo has won the MAC regular-season title each of the last two years and returned four starters from last season.
- Entering the contest, the Rockets were ranked No. 4 in the CollegeInsiders.com Mid-Major Top 25 and were receiving votes nationally in both the AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches' poll.
- Toledo, which posted a 17-3 MAC mark last season, ranks 28th

nationally with 112 wins over the last five seasons and rank 18th nationally with 47 wins over the last two years.

Kobe's Kingdom

- Kobe King has scored in double figures in 20 of his 24 games in a Valpo uniform, including a 15-point effort in this year's season opener on Nov. 7 at Toledo.
- The former Wisconsin Mr. Basketball has scored 15 or more points in 11 of his 24 games with the Beacons.
- The Nov. 7 lidlifter at Toledo marked King's 25th double-figure scoring effort in his collegiate career.
- At the end of last season, King became Valpo's second All-Newcomer Team choice since joining the league and first since Bakari Evelyn in 2017-18.
- He appeared on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays after a three-quarter court buzzer-beater on Dec. 11 vs. Charlotte, a play that ranked No. 9 on the popular countdown that evening.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 7: Toledo 85, Valpo 70

- The Beacons played shorthanded for the season opener as Ibra Bayu, Maximus Nelson, Preston Ruedinger and Connor Barrett were all sidelined.
- Only two players – Darius DeAveiro and Emil Freese-Vilien – saw action in both last season's opener vs. Toledo and this year's opener at Toledo.
- Point guard Nick Edwards accrued eight points on an efficient 4-of-6 shooting to go along with a team-high five assists.
- Toledo had 14 steals while forcing 17 Valpo turnovers.

Scouting the Broncos

- Picked to finish eighth of 12 in the Mid-American Conference preseason poll.
- Trailed by nine with under two minutes remaining but rallied to get within a point in a 61-60 defeat to Big Ten foe Minnesota in the Nov. 7 season opener.
- Will be playing their third game of the season as they also host Goshen College on Thursday before Sunday's game at Valpo.
- Under the direction of first-year head coach Dwayne Stephens.
- Returned Lamar Norman Jr., who averaged 19.8 points per game last season to lead the MAC in scoring.
- Also brought back Markeese Hastings, who finished second in the

MAC in rebounding at 8.8 per game last year.

Top Two Scorers Back

- With both Ben Krikke (14.2 ppg) and Kobe King (14.0 ppg) back, Valpo returns its top two scorers from last season.

- The last time the program had its top two scorers back from the previous year was 2015-2016, when Alec Peters and Darien Walker both returned after finishing as the team's top two scorers in 2014-15. The 2015-16 season was a historic one, as the Brown & Gold reached the NIT championship game.

- Only four of the 12 teams in the Missouri Valley Conference have their top two scorers back from last season, as Valpo joins Drake, Southern Illinois and Indiana State.

Century Mark in Sight

- Valpo head coach Matt Lottich earned his 97th career win on March 3, 2021 vs. Evansville in the opening round of the MVC Tournament.

- He enters the season needing three more wins to become just the fourth head coach in program history to reach 100 career victories, joining Homer Drew, Bryce Drew and J.M Christiansen.

- Last season, Lottich moved into sole possession of fourth place in program history, surpassing the legendary Gene Bartow (1964-1970). On a side note, Valpo assistant coach Matt Bowen worked under Bartow at UAB in 1995.

Point Guard Prowess

- Sophomore Preston Ruedinger has been placed on scholarship after spending much of the 2021-22 season as the starting point guard while competing as a nonscholarship freshman. He initially planned to redshirt but instead used a season of eligibility, making his season debut on Dec. 20 vs. Eastern Michigan.

- Ruedinger did not make more than one turnover in any of his 19 contests and played turnover-free basketball on 11 occasions.

- He finished the season with 32 assists against just eight turnovers. He was the only player in the nation with 30 or more assists and fewer than 10 turnovers, becoming the first Valpo player to finish a season with 30 or more assists and fewer than 10 turnovers in the last 15 years.

- At season's end, Ruedinger was named to the MVC All-Freshman Team, the fourth straight season Valpo has had a rookie earn that distinction.

- In addition, sophomore Darius DeAveiro finished his freshman season as one of two freshmen nationally (joining Youngstown State's Luke Chicone) with 50 or more assists and fewer than 25 turnovers. He was the only player in the MVC to achieve that feat.

- Valpo has added fifth-year senior Nick Edwards to the mix after he played at Glenville State last season. Edwards was one of eight players in the Division-II nation to post a triple-double a year ago en route to averaging 7.9 assists per game over 11 games while being limited by a foot injury.

Looking Back at 2021-2022

- The team boasted two MVC Scholar-Athlete team selections, the captain of the All-Bench Team, an MVC Most-Improved Team honoree, an All-MVC Third Team performer, an All-Newcomer team member and an All-Freshman team honoree. Valpo had seven different MVC postseason honors won by five different players.
- Valpo went a combined 5-0 against instate foes Indiana State and Evansville, sweeping the Hoosier State for the first time since joining the MVC.
- Valpo finished with a home record of .500 or better for the 30th consecutive season.
- Eight of Valpo's 18 MVC games were decided by three points or fewer or required overtime.
- The Beacons overcame double-figure deficits to win on three occasions (Tulane, Eastern Michigan and Evansville), something that has occurred 19 times during the Matt Lottich Era.

- Valpo played six overtime games, the program's most since tying a Division-I record with eight in 1993.

- Kobe King was named to the Preseason All-MVC Third Team, making this the second time in the team's six years in The Valley that Valpo has boasted a pair of preseason all-league choices.
- Krikke, also a Preseason All-MVC Second Team choice last year, became the first Valpo player to earn Preseason All-MVC honors on multiple occasions.
- Valpo was picked to finish ninth of 12 in the preseason poll, ahead of Illinois State, UIC and Evansville.
- Drake hauled in 52 of the 54 first-place votes and finished a heavy preseason favorite, while Drake's Tucker DeVries was named MVC Preseason Player of the Year.
- In addition to the conference's honor, Krikke was named to the Preseason All-MVC First Team by Blue Ribbon Magazine

Roster Rundown

- The 2022-23 roster features eight returning letter winners, one returning player who redshirted last season and six newcomers (three freshmen, three transfers).
- Five Valpo players hail from outside of the United States – two from The Netherlands, two from Canada and one from Denmark.
- Four members of the roster are natives of the state of Wisconsin, while two call Illinois home and one has remained in his home state of Indiana. The remaining players come from Georgia, Minnesota and Ohio.
- Nick Edwards is the first Georgia native to play for the program since E. Victor Nickerson in 2015-16.

- Nick Edwards had a triple-double while playing at Glenville last season, one of eight Division-II players in the nation to achieve that feat.
- Quinton Green earned All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) honors for three straight seasons. He finished with 1,288 points over four seasons at Cedarville and knocked down a team-high 59 3-point field goals last year.

- Assistant coach Matt Bowen returned to Valpo's staff in 2018-19 after previously spending four seasons with the Brown & Gold from 2002-2006. He was the head coach at the University of Minnesota Duluth from 2012-2018. Bowen coordinates the team's offense.

- Assistant coach Rob Holloway is back for his fifth season after spending the previous two years on staff at Eastern Illinois, his alma mater.

- Director of Basketball Operations Peter Funk is in his second season in that role after spending the previous two years as a graduate assistant and the three years prior to that as a student manager.

- Vijay Blackmon joined the Valpo staff this summer, leading the program's strength & conditioning efforts. 97-97 Overall and at Valpo

Matt Lottich is in his seventh season as the head coach of the men's basketball program in 2022-2023. He owned a 97-96 record over his first six seasons as head coach.

During the 2021-22 campaign, Lottich helped Valpo players earn seven different Missouri Valley Conference postseason honors won by five different players. His team finished fourth in the MVC in free-throw percentage (.759), field-goal percentage (.459), assists per game (12.5) and steals per game (6.4) while finishing third in assist/TO ratio (1.1). Numerous players reached individual accomplishments under Lottich's watch, including Kevion Taylor scoring his 2,000th career point, a pair of Valpo players finishing in the top eight in the MVC in field-goal percentage and Ben Krikke finishing as one of three MVC players with a field-goal percentage of 50 percent or better and a free-throw percentage of 80 percent or better. Freshman walk-on Preston Ruedinger finished as the only player in the nation with 30 or more assists and fewer than 10 turnovers.

During 2021-22 campaign, Lottich led Valpo to a 5-0 record against in-state foes Indiana State and Evansville, its first Hoosier State sweep since joining the MVC. The Beacons overcame three double-figure deficits to prevail (Tulane, Eastern Michigan and Evansville), lifting Lottich's career double-figure comeback total to 19. In addition, Lottich climbed into fourth in program history in career victories, surpassing the legendary Gene Bartow.

The 2020-2021 season saw Valpo improve its Arch Madness seeding for the fourth straight year as the program continued to make positive strides in each season as a Missouri Valley Conference member. The team earned a first-round bye in the State Farm MVC Tournament for the first time since joining the prestigious league.

Valpo upset previously-undefeated Drake, the nation's No. 25 team, 74-57 on Feb. 7, 2021 at the ARC, the fourth win over an AP Top 25 team in program history and second under Lottich. The Bulldogs were one of three undefeated teams in the nation prior to that setback, joining Gonzaga and Baylor. Valpo came close to two other victories over ranked foes, falling 80-77 vs. No. 25 Drake on Feb. 6 and 54-52 at No. 22 Loyola on Feb. 17. In addition, Valpo extended its streak to 29 straight seasons without a sub-.500 home record.

Just two years removed from finishing in last place and being knocked out in the first round of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament as a first-year Valley member, Lottich's team did more than hold its own in 2019-2020, ascending into a tie for sixth in the league standings before finishing as the conference tournament runner-up. Valpo became the first team in the history of Arch Madness to reach the title game after playing in the opening round.

Lottich led the program to its first conference championship game appearance since 2015 during the 2019-2020 campaign, doing so after being picked to finish ninth of 10 in the preseason poll. Valpo reached the conference title game as only a third-year MVC member, becoming the first Valpo team in any sport to do so during the department's young tenure in the prestigious league. After finishing with its highest conference win total, highest overall win total and highest finish in the league standings since joining The Valley, Valpo accepted a postseason tournament invitation to play in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The event was ultimately canceled due to COVID-19 concerns.

The 2019-2020 team's finest hour came on the biggest stage, as Lottich led the squad to three victories in as many days at Arch Madness, the 2020 State Farm MVC Men's Basketball Tournament in St. Louis. Lottich's team came from 18 down to upset Loyola in the MVC quarterfinal, tying for the second-biggest comeback in MVC Tournament history. During his time guiding the program, Lottich has instilled a no-quit attitude. The Loyola comeback marked the sixth time in 2019-2020 that Valpo came from double figures down to win. On 11 occasions, Valpo trailed by at least 10 points and eventually tied the game or took the lead. Valpo also became just the second team in the long history of the Missouri Valley Conference to come from 17 or more down to win twice in one season, joining Creighton from 2007-2008.

Working with a young team that featured just five returning players from the previous season, Lottich mentored a 2019-2020 First Team All-MVC selection, MVC All-Defensive Team choice, MVC All-Freshman Team honoree, MVC All-Bench pick, MVC Scholar-Athlete Second Team selection and a pair of MVC All-Tournament Team performers. Perhaps most noteworthy of all, the program's emphasis on player development paid dividends as Valpo accounted for 40 percent of the MVC Most-Improved Team.

Other noteworthy feats for Lottich's squad in 2019-2020 included making 18 3-pointers in a game against Bradley to set the league-only MVC record, holding Southern Illinois to 38 points to set the program record for the fewest allowed against a Division-I opponent since the advent of the shot clock, snapping a 22-game losing streak in games at Evansville that had dated back to 1969, breaking through with its first win over Loyola since joining The Valley after previously going 0-7 against the program's Chicagoland rival and twice turning a double-figure defeat from the first half of the MVC double-round robin into a double-figure victory in the second meeting with that opponent.

The 2018-2019 season saw Lottich lead Valpo to 15 wins. The season was headlined by road victories over UNLV and George Washington during the nonconference portion of the schedule, as well as a 4-0 start to Missouri Valley Conference play.

Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-2018 and guided the team through the move to the MVC, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI.

In his first season at the helm of the Valpo men's basketball program, Lottich guided the team to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in a six-year span as he led Valpo to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT. Lottich's inaugural season as head coach was highlighted by a home win over a nationally-ranked Rhode Island squad as well as neutral-site triumphs over Alabama and BYU to capture the MGM Grand Main Event.

Lottich coached the Horizon League Player of the Year and an NABC Third Team All-American in Alec Peters, guiding the senior as he closed out one of the top careers in program history. Peters enjoyed his finest season as a senior, ranking among the Top 20 in the nation in both scoring and rebounding and breaking five of Valpo's career records.

Lottich was hired as the 22nd head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program in April 2016. After spending the previous three seasons on staff as an assistant coach, he became just the fifth Valpo head coach in a 36-year span. Lottich arrived at Valparaiso University in summer 2013 and helped guide the team to 78 victories over his three seasons as an assistant. Valpo won two Horizon League regular season championships and one league tournament title over those three years.

Lottich brings nearly a decade of professional playing experience to the head coaching position at Valparaiso University. He spent eight years playing professionally in Japan for the Oita Heat Devils and the Osaka Evessa, earning All-Star recognition four times. He also played one season in Germany in the Bundesliga for the Dusseldorf Giants, played one season in New Zealand in the NBL for the Harbor Heat and was a member of the New Jersey Nets' summer league team in 2004.

Lottich played collegiately at Stanford University from 2000-2004. As a senior in 2003-2004, he helped lead the Cardinal to the Pac-10 title while earning NABC All-Star plaudits, awarded to the Top 15 seniors in college basketball. He was also a member of the Wooden Award midseason watch list and was an Honorable Mention All Pac-10 selection as a senior. Lottich was a member of the program's conference championship squad as a freshman in 2000-2001 and still ranks among Stanford's single-season and career leaders in 3-pointers made.

Off the court, Lottich came to Valpo from the National Collegiate Scouting Association, where he started in January 2013. Lottich ascended to the position of head scout during his time with the NCSA, which helps high school athletes navigate the world of college recruiting. Lottich also co-founded the TEAM Life Skills basketball camp in 2004 and spent nine years managing and developing the camp.

Lottich played his prep basketball at New Trier [Ill.] H.S., where he was named the Chicago Tribune Athlete of the Year in 2000 and holds the distinction of being the program's all-time leading scorer. Lottich graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and currently resides in Valparaiso with his wife, Kylan, and their four children: Grace, Matthan, Christian and Landon.
