Head Coach Kate Stake

Kate Stake enters her third year as Head Coach of the Crusader softball program after capping off the 2016 season with a Horizon League Championship and berth to NCAA Regionals. Under Stake's direction the squad continues to make its mark on the Crusader record books. As a team,

Valpo posted a .381 on-base percentage in 2015, setting a new single-season program record – breaking the previous record of .376. The Crusaders also cracked the single-season record book as a team in batting average (.300, 4th), doubles (80, 4th), slugging percentage (.441, 5th), walks (160, 5th) and fielding percentage (.964, 5th). In Stake's two seasons she has guided five Crusaders to All-League selections. Prior to arriving at Valpo, Stake spent two seasons at Hofstra helping the Pride to a combined 81 wins over two years. The 2014 squad went 35-14 and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season ranked #33 in RPI. Prior to her time at Hofstra, Stake spent three seasons as an assistant coach at the United States Military Academy. She helped the Black Knights set single season records for wins, conference wins, hits, and total bases. Before coaching at West Point, Stake served as the assistant at Eastern Illinois.
