Next Up in Crusader Basketball: The Valparaiso men's basketball team looks to maintain its grip on first place in the Horizon League standings as it hosts Green Bay at the ARC Friday night in a nationally-televised contest. The Crusaders are looking to avenge their second league loss after defeating Oakland last time out.

Last Time Out: Another chapter in the Valparaiso-Oakland series went down to the wire Sunday afternoon at the ARC, but this time, with more on the line than perhaps any other regular season meeting in the series history for both sides, it was the Crusaders who came out on top, out-scoring the Golden Grizzlies 8-2 over a stretch of 3:30 late to pull away and eventually earn an 82-76 victory. Six Valpo players finished in double figures, led by a season-best 16 points from E. Victor Nickerson.

Head Coach Bryce Drew: Bryce Drew (88-40) is in his fourth season at the helm of the Crusader men's basketball program in 2014-15. In his first three years, Drew led Valpo to 66 victories and postseason berths in each of his three seasons. The 2012 HL Coach of the Year, Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

Series Notes: Green Bay leads the all-time series over Valpo, 28-20, and holds a slim 9-8 edge in the series since the Crusaders joined the Horizon League. The Phoenix earned the win in a tight defensive battle in Green Bay earlier this season, $51-50$. At the ARC, Valpo is 14-9 all-time against Green Bay and is 6-3 at home against the Phoenix since joining the Horizon League, winning the last four home games.

## @ValpoBasketball...

## ...and the @HorizonLeague

- @ValpoBasketball has been picked to finish in fourth place in the league standings in 2014-15 in preseason polling.
- The Crusaders have not finished worse than their preseason projection in the last four years.
- Sophomore Alec Peters was the lone underclassman on the preseason \#HLMBB First Team All-League squad.
...looking back at last year
- @ ValpoBasketball won 18 games and finished in fourth place in the \#HLMBB regular season.
- The Crusaders advanced to the postseason for the fourth straight year, falling in the first round of the CIT to Columbia.
- Lavonte Dority was a First Team All-League selection and also earned All-Region honors.
- Alec Peters and Lexus Williams were both named to the league's All-Freshman Team.


## ...notes from Oakland

- This was the 10th straight meeting that was decided by six or fewer points in regulation.
- The Crusaders placed six players in double figures against a Division I opponent for the first time in over a decade.
- Valpo shot $57.7 \%$ from the floor, its third-best single-game field goal percentage of the season.
- Oakland shot $44.3 \%$ from the field, just the third time in league play a Crusader opponent has been above $40 \%$.
- E. Victor Nickerson scored a season-best 16 points on 7-of-11 shooting in the win.
- David Skara matched his best performance against a Division I opponent with 14 points.
- Alec Peters scored 11 points despite attempting just four field goals, matching his career low for field goal attempts.


## ...looking ahead

- @ValpoBasketball has a quick turnaround following Friday night's game, as the Crusaders travel to Milwaukee to play on Sunday afternoon.
- Valpo then hosts Wright State next Saturday, Feb. 21, in the Crusaders' regular season home finale.
...at the ARC
- @ ValpoBasketball has 14 regular season home games scheduled for the ARC in 2014-15. \#ValpoGameday
- The Crusaders posted a 12-6 mark at the ARC last season, and are now 11-1 at home this year following the win over Oakland.
- Valpo has won at least 10 home games in each of the last five years.
- Over the last 20+ years, @ValpoBasketball owns a 246-57 (.812) record on its home court.
- The Crusaders are 25-6 in home \#HLMBB games under Bryce Drew.


## @GBPhoenixMBB

- Green Bay enters Friday night's contest at 20-5 overall and 9-2 in \#HLMBB play after a narrow 63-62 win at YSU on Wednesday.
- The Phoenix is 5-4 in true road games this season, including 4-2 in league action.
- Senior Keifer Sykes leads Green Bay, averaging 18.0 points and 4.0 assists per game.


## Hitting 22 Wins

- @ ValpoBasketball reached 22 wins on the year with the win over Oakland on Sunday.
- The Crusaders were the fourth team nationally to reach 22 wins (Gonzaga, Kentucky, UNI) and are one of nine teams with at least 22 wins as of the end of play Wednesday.
- The Crusaders earned their 20th win at UIC on Jan. 31 - they had previously never reached their 20th win before Feb. 12 (2012-13). - Valpo has now won at least 20 games 14 times in the last 22 years, including three times in four seasons under Bryce Drew.


## 22-4

- This season marks the third time in Crusader history - and the first time in the program's D-I era - that Valpo had been 22-4 or better through 26 games.
- Most recently it occured during the FDR administration, as the "World's Tallest Team" in 1944-45 ended the year 23-3.
- The Crusaders won their first 19 games in 1923-24 en route to a 24 4 record, while the 1930-31 squad finished at 16-2.
- Valpo won seven games in a row earlier this year to set its longest winning streak under Bryce Drew [won six in a row twice in 2012-13].


## Poll Thoughts

- For the second straight week, @ValpoBasketball is receiving votes in both national top-25 polls (Associated Press/Coaches).
- The Crusaders are receiving seven points in the coaches poll, their highest tally of the season.
- The Crusaders previously earned votes in both polls in separate weeks earlier this week, including four points in the Jan. 19 coaches poll.
- Valpo sits at sixth in the Mid-Major Top-25 Poll and has been within the top-10 almost the entire year, reaching as high as fourth.


## Hitting the Glass

- Valpo has out-rebounded opponents by double figures 11 times on the year, including a +19 edge in the win at UIC.
- The Crusaders outrebounded Wright State by 21 earlier this year - best vs. a D-I opponent since $\mathrm{a}+22$ advantage on the glass last year vs. Saint Louis. - Valpo out-rebounded Oakland by two more recently, and has only been outrebounded on two occasions this year - losses to New Mexico and Missouri.
- The Crusaders' league-leading rebounding margin sits at +8.2 , good for 13th in the nation.
- Valpo leads the league in rebounding margin by more than five boards, and also paces the circuit in both offensive and defensive rebounding pct.


## Defensive Prowess

- Despite giving up 70+ points in the last two games, the Crusaders have ranked as one of the top defensive teams in the nation.
- Valpo held eight straight opponents to 65 or fewer points, and 3 straight teams to 56 points, the first time it has won 3 straight games and given up 56 or fewer points in all three since Dec. 7-17, 1983.
- Valpo ranks 51st nationally in scoring defense and 19th in field goal percentage defense.
- Valpo boasts a defensive efficiency of 94.5,51st-best nationally the Crusaders haven't ranked in the top-100 since 2006-07.
- Crusader opponents are shooting just $42.2 \%$ from 2-point range (20th nationally) and are pulling down just $26.5 \%$ of available offensive boards (23rd nationally).

## On Pace for $\mathbf{1 , 0 0 0}$

- Sophomore Alec Peters is near pace to become the first sophomore in Crusader history to reach the 1,000 point milestone.
- Peters enters Friday's game with 882 points and would need to average 19.7 ppg over the Crusaders' guaranteed six remaining games to hit 1,000 . - For comparison, Bryce Drew had 912 points through his first two seasons in a Valpo uniform.
- Peters has scored $20+$ points 10 times already this season, tied for the most among \#HLMBB players.
- Peters' . 467 3-point percentage this year would rank fifth in a single season in program history and ranks sixth nationally.


## Sir Blocks-A-Lot

- Senior Vashil Fernandez has cemented himself among the top shot-blockers in Crusader history this season.
- At UIC, Fernandez broke Valpo’s single-season blocks record - after two blocks Sunday, he currently has 78 blocked shots this year.
- For his career, Fernandez now has 150 rejections, second-most in Crusader history.
- Fernandez leads the league and tied for eighth nationally with 3.0 blocks/game, while he ranks ninth nationally in block pct. (13.0\%).
- Fernandez's blocks/40 minutes has risen from 3.5 last year to 4.8 this year, while his fouls/40 has fallen from 6.2 to 4.4.


## Who's Back This Season

- @ ValpoBasketball returns just seven letterwinners from its 201314 team, returning $48.3 \%$ of scoring and $56.8 \%$ of rebounding.
- Leading the returnees is preseason First Team All-League selection Alec Peters ( $12.7 \mathrm{ppg}, 4.8 \mathrm{rpg}$ ).
- Jubril Adekoya ( $5.8 \mathrm{ppg}, 53.7 \%$ FG\%) and Vashil Fernandez ( 58 blocks last year, fourth-most in program history) also are returning starters.
- Sophomore Lexus Williams returns as well, but is expected to miss the entire season.


## Lots of New Faces

- Nearly half of the @ ValpoBasketball roster (6 of 14 players) is new to the program this season.
- Five players are eligible for the first time this season, including Charlotte transfer E. Victor Nickerson, who sat out at Valpo last year. - Darien Walker came to Valpo from junior college, while Max Joseph, David Skara and Tevonn Walker are all true freshmen.
- Shane Hammink (LSU) and Chandler Levingston Simon (UMKC) both transferred to Valpo last off-season and have to sit out this year.


## The International Flavor

- This year's squad continues the international pipeline that @ ValpoBasketball has cultivated over the past two decades.
- The Crusaders boast five international players on this year's roster from four different countries.

- Represented are Canada (Joseph, T. Walker), Croatia (Skara), Jamaica (Fernandez) and Netherlands (Hammink).
- The duo from Canada mark the first Canadian players in program history.
- Over the past two decades, @ ValpoBasketball has welcomed 31 international players from 18 different countries.
- Crusader signee Daniel Relvao is from Portugal and will become the first Portugese player in program history when he joins in 2015-16.


## In the Crusaders' Future

- Daniel Relvao and Derrik Smits have both signed NLIs to join @ ValpoBasketball as freshmen for the 2015-16 campaign.
- Relvao (6'9", 235 lbs .) hails from Coimbra, Portugal and currently plays prep ball at Mountain Mission [Va.] School.
- Relvao averaged $8.2 \mathrm{ppg}, 5.2 \mathrm{rpg}$ and 3.3 bpg for Portugal last summer in Division B of the FIBA U18 World Championship.
- Smits (7'0', 230 lbs.) will join Valpo from Zionsville [Ind.] H.S., where he averaged in double figures last season \& also posted 3.6 rpg and 1.8 bpg .
- Smits is the son of former Indiana Pacers star center Rik Smits.


## Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his fourth season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his tenth season overall on the coaching staff.
- Last season, Drew led the Crusaders to 18 wins and their fourth straight postseason berth.
- In 2012-13, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
- Drew was named \#HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach - 22 wins and \#HLMBB regular season title.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with Valparaiso, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.
- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over Ole Miss. - "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.


## \#DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ ValpoBasketball.
- Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
- Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
- A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 27 years. \#DrewFamilyDynasty
- The Drew family has combined to lead @ ValpoBasketball to 479 victories and 12 postseason appearances. \#DrewFamilyDynasty
- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 972 collegiate victories over a combined 45+ seasons of head coaching. \#DrewFamilyDynasty


## \#CoachesWhoCanPlay

- @ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,211 points during their D-I careers.
- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.
- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.
- Assistant coach Matt Lottich poured in 891 points over his fouryear career at Stanford.
- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.


## Alec Peters

- Peters picked up his third double-double of the year vs. Detroit, posting 12 points and 10 rebounds.
- Peters matched his career high with 10 field goals, going 10-of-14 from the floor for a game-high 24 points in the win over Milwaukee.
- Peters led all players with 24 points against CSU, hitting 5-of-7 from 3-point range and 7 -of-7 from the foul line.
- Peters earned his second \#HLMBB Player of the Week award Dec. 22 after scoring 52 points in the Crusaders' last three halves of play.
- Peters scored 23 points in the second half at IPFW in the come-from-behind win and then posted 29 points against Goshen.
- Peters registered his second career double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Ball State.
- Peters matched his career high with seven 3-pointers, leading all scorers with 21 points and grabbing seven rebounds at EKU.
- Peters was named MVP of the Challenge in Music City and named \#HLMBB Player of the Week by College Sports Madness.
- Peters was named to the All-Tournament Team at CMU and was named \#HLMBB Player of the Week Nov. 24.
- Peters set a new career high with 31 points (9-13 FG, 4-6 3PT, 9-10 FT) in the win over Maine.
- Peters is one of just three Crusaders with three 30+ point games in their careers in the last two decades.
- Peters was a preseason First Team All-League selection after earning All-Freshman team honors last year as a rookie.
-Afour-time\#HLMBB Freshman of the Week, he averaged 12.7 ppg and 4.8 rpg last year, becoming the highest-scoring Valpo freshman since 1998-99.


## Vashil Fernandez

- Fernandez now has 78 blocks this season, breaking Valpo's singleseason record in the win at UIC.
- Fernandez was a perfect 5-of-5 from the floor last time out against Oakland, posting 11 points and seven rebounds.
- Fernandez led all players in both scoring (14) and rebounding (9) in the win at Wright State.
- Fernandez set a new career high with 15 points ( $6-6 \mathrm{FG}$ ) while also tallying eight rebounds and four blocks vs. UIC.
- Fernandez moved into second position on Valpo's all-time blocks chart with his fourth block vs. UIC and now has 150 career blocks. - Fernandez grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds and also tallied eight points and three blocks versus YSU.
- Fernandez blocked a Crusader single-game record eight shots against Goshen.
- Fernandez was a perfect 6-of-6 from the field for 12 points and six rebounds in the win at EKU.
- Fernandez was named to the All-Tournament Team at CMU.
- Fernandez averaged 4.3 points and 5.1 rebounds per game as a junior, and blocked 58 shots - fourth-most in a season in Valpo history.
- Fernandez spent the summer of 2014 playing for the Jamaican national team at FIBA Centrobasket.

## Keith Carter

- Carter picked up his first career double-double, registering 15 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Youngstown State.
- Carter matched a season best with 18 points at Oakland, including a game-tying triple with 9.9 seconds left to force overtime.
- Carter scored 13 points, grabbed five rebounds and handed out four assists in the win at JMU.
- Carter scored a season-best 18 points ( $7-11 \mathrm{FG}, 4-43 \mathrm{PT}$ ) and tallied four assists and four steals in the win at IPFW.
- Carter matched his career high with seven assists and scored nine second-half points in the win at EKU.
- Carter scored 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting in the victory over Drake and recorded a career-high four steals the next night versus Murray State.
- Carter appeared in each of the final 22 games of the 2013-14 season after becoming eligible, averaging 5.7 ppg and 2.3 apg .
- Carter connected at a $40 \%$ clip from 3-point range in his first year as a Crusader.
- Carter, a former Illinois Mr. Basketball runner-up, came to Valpo after spending the first half of his freshman year at Saint Louis.


## Jubril Adekoya

- Adekoya is averaging 6.3 points and 4.6 rebounds in league play while shooting at a $67.5 \%$ clip from the field.
- Adekoya set a new career high at YSU with 14 points on 7 -of-8 shooting.
- Adekoya scored 10 points (4-5 FG) and matched his career best with nine rebounds in the win over UIC.
- Adekoya was a perfect 3-3 from the field for seven points, nine rebounds and four assists at Oakland.
- Adekoya scored six points and grabbed five rebounds versus Drake, and pulled down seven boards the next day against Murray State. - Adekoya appeared in all 34 games as a rookie for Valpo in 2013-14, starting 24 times and averaging 5.8 points and 3.4 rebounds per game. - Adekoya shot at a $63.6 \%$ clip from inside the 3-point line last year. - Adekoya scored a season-high 13 points at Youngstown State and pulled down a season-best nine rebounds at Detroit.


## David Chadwick

- Chadwick set a new personal best against a D-I team, scoring eight points in the win at JMU in 11 minutes.
- Chadwick scored nine points and grabbed a pair of rebounds in 19 minutes of action in the win over Goshen.
- Chadwick made both his field goal attempts, including a 3-pointer, en route to seven points in five minutes in the win over Murray State. - Chadwick made his first career start as a Crusader in the win over IUSB, playing 19 minutes and grabbing four rebounds.
- Chadwick appeared in 12 games last season in his first season playing for the Crusaders, scoring career-best 14 points vs. Cincinnati Christian. - Chadwick appeared in 52 games over his first two collegiate seasons at Rice.


## Nick Davidson

- Davidson scored four points and handed out an assist in 11 minutes against UIC.
- Davidson set a new career high with eight points in the win at JMU, connecting on a pair of 3-pointers.
- Davidson knocked down a triple and handed out two assists in the win over Goshen.
- Davidson made his first career start against TIU, scoring four points.
- Davidson hit a pair of second-half 3-pointers in the win over Maine. - Davidson saw 11 minutes off the bench versus IUSB, scoring three points and tallying a pair of steals.

Bryce Drew
Head Coach
4th Season
88-40 overall and at Valpo
Valparaiso, 1998
Bryce Drew was named head coach of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in May of 2011 and enters his fourth season at the helm of the program in 2014-2015.

Drew reloaded the Valpo program entering the 2013-2014 campaign, as despite returning less than $25 \%$ of the scoring from the previous year's squad, the Crusaders won 18 games and earned their fourth consecutive postseason berth - the program's 13th in the last 19 years. Drew coached a First Team All-League and an All-District selection in Lavonte Dority, while a pair of members of the Crusaders' talented freshman class earned Horizon League All-Freshman Team accolades.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season title during the 2012-2013 season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I-best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players who earned postseason honors from the Horizon League, including a pair of All-District honorees in Ryan Broekhoff and Kevin Van Wijk.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the helm of the program, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Van Wijk and Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVPhonors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the first round of the NCAATournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. He competed in the postseason twice as a pro, with Houston in 1999 and with Charlotte in 2002.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made $37 \%$ of his three-point attempts. In 1999 , he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBAAll-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara reside in Valparaiso with their son, Bryson.
