**Next Up in Crusader Basketball:** Making its ninth appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 1996, the 13th-seeded Valparaiso men's basketball team travels to Columbus, Ohio to open tournament play with a Second Round game against fourth-seeded Maryland on Friday afternoon at approximately 3:45 p.m. CT.

**Last Time Out:** Given opportunities where it could have folded, the Valparaiso men's basketball team did what it had done all season long – stepped up to the challenge. The Crusaders scored the final two baskets of the first half to cut their halftime deficit to six points, and then dominated the second half, outscoring Green Bay 35-19 to earn a 54-44 victory and claim the 2015 Horizon League Championship – Valpo's second league title in three years. David Skara led Valpo with 12 points, while E. Victor Nickerson added 11 points. The win also extended the Crusaders' school record victory total to 28 wins.

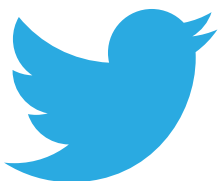

**Head Coach Bryce Drew:** Bryce Drew (94-41) is in his fourth season at the helm of the Crusader men's basketball program in 2014-15. In his first four years to date, Drew has led Valpo to 94 victories and postseason berths in each of his four seasons, along with three Horizon League regular season and two league tournament titles. The 2012 and 2015 HL Coach of the Year, Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

**Series Notes:** Valparaiso and Maryland have met just once in program history, and that meeting also came during the NCAA Tournament, as the second-seeded Terrapins beat the 15th-seeded Crusaders, 82-60, in the first round of the 1999 tournament. Zoran Viskovic led Valpo that day with 14 points and nine rebounds, while Greg Tonagel and Jason Jenkins added 10 points each. Laron Profit and Terence Morris led all players with 18 points apiece. Steve Francis chipped in 15 points, six rebounds and seven assists for the Terrapins.

## @ValpoBasketball...

### ...and the @HorizonLeague

- @ValpoBasketball was picked to finish in fourth place in the league standings in 2014-15 in preseason polling.
- The Crusaders have now not finished worse than their preseason projection in the last five years.
- Sophomore Alec Peters was the lone underclassman on the pre-season #HLMBB First Team All-League squad.

### ...notes from Green Bay

- Valpo limited Green Bay to 19 second-half points, including just 11 points in the game's final 16:40 and five points in the last 11:43.
- The Phoenix scored just one field goal in the final 12:23 of the game, as Valpo ended the game on a 23-6 run over that stretch.
- The 44 points were the fewest surrendered by a Valpo team since a 71-40 win over Milwaukee on Feb. 1, 2013.
- The 54 points matched the fewest scored by Valpo in a victory since a Dec. 10, 1996 win over Green Bay by a 50-44 final.
- Valpo overcame a double-digit deficit for just the second time this season (Ball State).
- David Skara led the Crusaders with 12 points off the bench, his first time leading Valpo in scoring versus a D-I opponent this year.
- Alec Peters failed to score in double figures for just the sixth time this season (2-4).

### ...looking ahead

- With a win Friday, Valpo would take on either fifth-seeded West Virginia or 12th-seeded Buffalo on Sunday.
- Keith Carter's cousin, Jevon, plays for West Virginia, while Valpo and Buffalo met in a closed scrimmage before the season.

### ...at a neutral site

- Valpo is a perfect 5-0 this season on neutral courts, winning two games at Central Michigan and three games in Nashville.
- Among the Crusaders' three wins at the Challenge in Music City was a 35-point drubbing of Murray State, the Racers' last loss before the OVC title game.
- Overall this season, the Crusaders own a 13-4 record away from home, including an 8-4 mark in true road games.

## Back to the NCAA

- The Crusaders are in the NCAA Tournament for the ninth time since 1996 and the 14th time overall in program history.
- Valpo's last trip to the NCAA Tournament came in 2013, when the Crusaders suffered a first-round loss to Michigan State.
- Valpo owns a 2-8 record since 1996 in the NCAA Tournament, with both wins coming in its run to the Sweet Sixteen in 1998 - when the Crusaders were also a 13 seed.
- The Crusaders also made five appearances in the old NCAA College Division Tournament, including three trips under coach Gene Bartow - Valpo advanced to the national quarterfinal twice.

## Another Tournament Crown

- This year was the third appearance in the Horizon League title game in the last four years for Valpo, and the second win in three years.
- Valpo has appeared in 13 conference title games in the last 21 years - the Crusaders are 10-3 in title games over that span.

## Regular Season Champions Again

- @ValpoBasketball entered the final week of the regular season having already clinched a share of the league title, and clinched the outright crown with the win over Cleveland State.
- The Crusaders have now won three outright regular season titles in Bryce Drew's four years at the helm.
- Valpo has now claimed its conference regular season title in 12 of the last 21 seasons.

## Three in Four Years

- Valpo's stretch of three regular season titles in four years puts the Crusaders among the top spans of results in Horizon League history.
- Xavier won six regular season championships in an eight-year stretch (1987-88; 89-90; 90-91; 92-93; 93-94; 94-95).
- Butler won four straight regular season titles (1999-2003) and then had another five-year string of championships (2006-2011).
- Milwaukee also won three straight #HLMBB regular season titles, from 2003-04 through 2005-06.

## All-League Honorees

- Three Valpo players were honored following the league tournament title, as Alec Peters was named tournament MVP.
- E. Victor Nickerson and David Skara joined Peters on the All-Tournament Team.
- Five Crusaders were honored with #HLMBB postseason awards.
- Head coach Bryce Drew earned Coach of the Year honors for the second time (2011-12).
- Drew joins Pete Gillen, Jim Crews, Barry Collier, Bruce Pearl, Todd Lickliter and Brad Stevens as multiple-time #HLMBB Coach of the Year honorees.
- Senior Vashil Fernandez was named Defensive Player of the Year - Valpo's first since joining the league - and was also a member of the league's All-Defensive Team.
- Sophomore Jubril Adekoya earned Sixth Man of the Year honors, the third Crusader to earn the award in the last eight years.
- Peters was a First Team All-League honoree, while Tevonn Walker earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team.

## Postseason Trips a Habit

- The NCAA Tournament berth marks the fifth straight season Valpo will appear in postseason play and the 14th time in the last 20 years.
- Every four-year senior class since the 1995 class has made at least one postseason trip.

## Hitting 28 Wins

- @ValpoBasketball reached 28 wins on the year with the championship game win over Green Bay.
- The Crusaders are one of just 13 teams in the nation with at least 28 wins entering the NCAA Tournament.
- The Crusaders earned their 20th win at UIC on Jan. 31 - they had previously never reached their 20th win before Feb. 12 (2012-13).
- Valpo has now won at least 20 games 14 times in the last 22 years, including three times in four seasons under Bryce Drew.

## 28-5

- This year's team is the first in program history to win at least 28 games.
- The semifinal win over CSU gave Valpo its 27th win of the year, breaking a tie for most wins with the 2012-13 squad, which finished 26-8.

- Other teams which lost fewer than five games include the "World's Tallest Team" in 1944-45 (23-3), the 1930-31 squad (16-2) and the "Victory Five" in 1923-24 (24-4).

### Young Guns

- Valpo won the outright #HLMBB title despite being an underclassman-laden squad.
- The Crusaders have just one senior in their regular rotation and have five underclassmen among their nine players averaging 10+ minutes.
- Valpo ranks 261st nationally in Ken Pomeroy's Experience metric, with only Kentucky and Duke ranking lower among teams with 28+ wins.
- The Crusaders are the least-experienced team in the Horizon League, with Detroit (210th) the next least-experienced squad.

### Hitting the Glass

- Valpo has out-rebounded opponents by double figures 13 times on the year, and has only been out-rebounded twice this season.
- The Crusaders' league-leading rebounding margin sits at +7.2, good for 13th in the nation.
- Valpo leads the league in rebounding margin by over four boards/game, and also paces the circuit in both offensive and defensive rebounding pct.

### Defensive Prowess

- The Crusaders held 13 of 16 opponents to 65 or fewer points in #HLMBB play, as well as both league tournament foes.
- Valpo has won five games this year while scoring in the 50s, matching their number of wins with fewer than 60 points over the last five seasons.
- Valpo ranks 18th nationally in scoring defense and eighth in field goal percentage defense.
- Valpo boasts a defensive efficiency of 94.3, 31st-best nationally - the Crusaders haven't ranked in the top-100 since 2006-07.
- Crusader opponents are shooting just 42.1% from 2-point range (13th nationally) and are pulling down just 27.6% of available offensive boards (37th nationally).

### What's Back and Who's New

- @ValpoBasketball returns just seven letterwinners from its 2013-14 team, returning 48.3% of scoring and 56.8% of rebounding.
- Nearly half of the Crusader roster (6 of 14 players) is new to the program this season.
- Five players are eligible for the first time this season, including Charlotte transfer E. Victor Nickerson, who sat out at Valpo last year.
- Darien Walker came to Valpo from junior college, while Max Joseph, David Skara and Tevonn Walker are all true freshmen.
- Shane Hammink (LSU) and Chandler Levingston Simon (UMKC) both transferred to Valpo last off-season and have to sit out this year.

## The International Flavor

- This year's squad continues the international pipeline that @ValpoBasketball has cultivated over the past two decades.
- The Crusaders boast five international players on this year's roster from four different countries.
- Represented are Canada (Joseph, T. Walker), Croatia (Skara), Jamaica (Fernandez) and Netherlands (Hammink).
- The duo from Canada mark the first Canadian players in program history.
- Over the past two decades, @ValpoBasketball has welcomed 31 international players from 18 different countries.
- Crusader signee Daniel Relvao is from Portugal and will become the first Portuguese player in program history when he joins in 2015-16.

## In the Crusaders' Future

- Daniel Relvao and Derrik Smits have both signed NLI's to join @ValpoBasketball as freshmen for the 2015-16 campaign.
- Relvao (6'9", 235 lbs.) hails from Coimbra, Portugal and currently plays prep ball at Mountain Mission [Va.] School.
- Relvao averaged 8.2 ppg, 5.2 rpg and 3.3 bpg for Portugal last summer in Division B of the FIBA U18 World Championship.
- Smits (7'0", 230 lbs.) will join Valpo from Zionsville [Ind.] H.S., where he averaged in double figures last season & also posted 3.6 rpg and 1.8 bpg.
- Smits is the son of former Indiana Pacers star center Rik Smits.

## Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his fourth season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his tenth season overall on the coaching staff.
- Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year this season and has led Valpo to a school-record 28 victories and the league title.
- Last season, Drew led the Crusaders to 18 wins and their fourth straight postseason berth.
- In 2012-13, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
- Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach - 22 wins and #HLMBB regular season title.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with Valparaiso, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.
- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over Ole Miss.
- "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.

## #DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.
  - Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
  - Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
  - A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 27 years.
- #DrewFamilyDynasty

- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 485 victories and 12 postseason appearances. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 982 collegiate victories over a combined 45+ seasons of head coaching. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- With Scott leading Baylor to a Big XII tournament win over West Virginia, the Drews passed the Knight family (Bob & Pat, 981) for total coaching wins.

## #CoachesWhoCanPlay

- @ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,211 points during their D-I careers.
- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.
- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.
- Assistant coach Matt Lottich poured in 891 points over his four-year career at Stanford.
- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.

## Alec Peters

- Peters was an #HLMBB First Team All-League selection and was named the Horizon League Championship MVP.
- Peters scored 22 points in the #HLMBB semifinal win over CSU, including four in the final minute, and also added eight rebounds.
- Peters paced Valpo in the regular season finale against CSU with 15 points, including the key four-point play with 1:14 to play.
- Peters matched his career high with 10 field goals, going 10-of-14 from the floor for a game-high 24 points in the win over Milwaukee.
- Peters earned his second #HLMBB Player of the Week award Dec. 22 after scoring 52 points in the Crusaders' last three halves of play.
- Peters scored 23 points in the second half at IPFW in the come-from-behind win and then posted 29 points against Goshen.
- Peters was named MVP of the Challenge in Music City and named #HLMBB Player of the Week by College Sports Madness.
- Peters was named to the All-Tournament Team at CMU and was named #HLMBB Player of the Week Nov. 24.
- Peters set a new career high with 31 points (9-13 FG, 4-6 3PT, 9-10 FT) in the win over Maine.
- Peters was a preseason First Team All-League selection after earning All-Freshman team honors last year as a rookie.
- A four-time #HLMBB Freshman of the Week, he averaged 12.7 ppg and 4.8 rpg last year, becoming the highest-scoring Valpo freshman since 1998-99.

## Vashil Fernandez

- Fernandez was named #HLMBB Defensive Player of the Year.
- Fernandez now has 98 blocks this season, breaking the previous single-season Valpo record just 24 games into this year, and ranks eighth nationally in blocks/game.
- Fernandez moved into second position on Valpo's all-time blocks chart in the home game against UIC and now has 170 career blocks.
- Fernandez was a perfect 5-of-5 from the floor against Oakland, posting 11 points and seven rebounds.
- Fernandez led all players in both scoring (14) and rebounding (9) in the win at Wright State.
- Fernandez set a new career high with 15 points (6-6 FG) while also tallying eight rebounds and four blocks vs. UIC.
- Fernandez grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds and also tallied eight points and three blocks versus YSU.

- Fernandez blocked a Crusader single-game record eight shots against Goshen.
- Fernandez was a perfect 6-of-6 from the field for 12 points and six rebounds in the win at ECU.
- Fernandez was named to the All-Tournament Team at CMU.
- Fernandez averaged 4.3 points and 5.1 rebounds per game as a junior, and blocked 58 shots - fourth-most in a season in Valpo history.
- Fernandez spent the summer of 2014 playing for the Jamaican national team at FIBA Centrobasket.

## Keith Carter

- Carter finished with eight points, seven rebounds and six assists in the #HLMBB title game win over Green Bay.
- Carter picked up his first career double-double, registering 15 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Youngstown State.
- Carter matched a season best with 18 points at Oakland, including a game-tying triple with 9.9 seconds left to force overtime.
- Carter scored a season-best 18 points (7-11 FG, 4-4 3PT) and tallied four assists and four steals in the win at IPFW.
- Carter matched his career high with seven assists and scored nine second-half points in the win at ECU.
- Carter scored 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting in the victory over Drake and recorded a career-high four steals the next night versus Murray State.
- Carter appeared in each of the final 22 games of the 2013-14 season after becoming eligible, averaging 5.7 ppg and 2.3 apg.
- Carter connected at a 40% clip from 3-point range in his first year as a Crusader.
- Carter, a former Illinois Mr. Basketball runner-up, came to Valpo after spending the first half of his freshman year at Saint Louis.

## Jubril Adekoya

- Adekoya was named #HLMBB Sixth Man of the Year.
- Adekoya averaged 5.4 points and 4.4 rebounds in league play while shooting at a 59.3% clip from the field.
- Adekoya set a new career high at YSU with 14 points (7-8 FG).
- Adekoya scored 10 points (4-5 FG) and matched his career best with nine rebounds in the win over UIC.
- Adekoya was a perfect 3-3 from the field for seven points, nine rebounds and four assists at Oakland.
- Adekoya scored six points and grabbed five rebounds versus Drake, and pulled down seven boards the next day against Murray State.
- Adekoya appeared in all 34 games as a rookie for Valpo in 2013-14, starting 24 times and averaging 5.8 points and 3.4 rebounds per game.
- Adekoya shot at a 63.6% clip from inside the 3-point line last year.
- Adekoya scored a season-high 13 points at Youngstown State and pulled down a season-best nine rebounds at Detroit.

## David Chadwick

- Chadwick set a new personal best against a D-I team, scoring eight points in the win at JMU in 11 minutes.
- Chadwick scored nine points and grabbed a pair of rebounds in 19 minutes of action in the win over Goshen.
- Chadwick made both his field goal attempts, including a 3-pointer, en route to seven points in five minutes in the win over Murray State.
- Chadwick made his first career start as a Crusader in the win over IUSB, playing 19 minutes and grabbing four rebounds.
- Chadwick appeared in 12 games last season in his first season playing for the Crusaders, scoring career-best 14 points vs. Cincinnati Christian.
- Chadwick appeared in 52 games over his first two collegiate seasons at Rice.

## Nick Davidson

- Davidson scored four points and handed out an assist in 11 minutes against UIC.
- Davidson set a new career high with eight points in the win at JMU, connecting on a pair of 3-pointers.
- Davidson made his first career start against TIU, scoring four points.

## Bryce Drew - 2014-15 #HLMBB Coach of the Year

**Head Coach**

**4th Season**

**94-41 overall and at Valpo  
Valparaiso, 1998**

Bryce Drew was named head coach of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in May of 2011 and enters his fourth season at the helm of the program in 2014-2015.

Drew reloaded the Valpo program entering the 2013-2014 campaign, as despite returning less than 25% of the scoring from the previous year's squad, the Crusaders won 18 games and earned their fourth consecutive postseason berth - the program's 13th in the last 19 years.

Drew coached a First Team All-League and an All-District selection in Lavonte Dority, while a pair of members of the Crusaders' talented freshman class earned Horizon League All-Freshman Team accolades.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season title during the 2012-2013 season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I-best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players who earned postseason honors from the Horizon League, including a pair of All-District honorees in Ryan Broekhoff and Kevin Van Wijk.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the helm of the program, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Van Wijk and Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. He competed in the postseason twice as a pro, with Houston in 1999 and with Charlotte in 2002.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made 37% of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara reside in Valparaiso with their son, Bryson.
