Valparaiso (3-7, 2-5 PFL) at St. Thomas (7-3, 6-1 PFL) Game #11 Saturday, Nov. 18, 1 p.m. CT O'Shaughnessy Stadium (5,025) – St. Paul, Minn.

This Week in Valpo Football: The Valparaiso University football team will close out the 2023 season on Saturday afternoon with a visit to St. Paul, Minn. to take on defending Pioneer Football League champion and 2023 preseason favorite St. Thomas. The Beacons hope to play the role of spoiler as the Tommies can clinch a share of the 2023 PFL crown with a win and a Drake loss. Valpo has an opportunity to end a season on a three-game winning streak for the first time since 2000 and possess its first three-game winning streak at any point in the calendar since 2003.

Previously: Special teams played a big role in Valpo's 23-20 overtime victory vs. Stetson on Senior Day at Brown Field, as Max Samuel blocked a pair of punts and Ryan Hawk connected on a 34-yard field goal in overtime that proved to be the difference. Samuel's first blocked punt was recovered by Micah Mackay in the end zone for a touchdown, while his second also led to points as Jeffery Vercher recovered and ran it 51 yards to the Stetson six-yard line before Jeffrey Jackson punched it in from a yard out. Evan Annis had a huge sack in overtime on the game's penultimate play to highlight a nine-tackle performance that featured three tackles for loss and two sacks.

Series Notes: This will be the third all-time meeting between Valpo and one of the Pioneer Football League's newest teams, former Division-III powerhouse St. Thomas. Valpo very much held its own during its last trip to Minnesota, falling 20-13 on Oct. 9, 2021. The Beacons lost to a nationally-ranked St. Thomas squad 34-7 on Nov. 5 of last season.

The hometown radio call with Todd Ickow (play-by-play) and Brandon Vickrey (analyst) will air on 95.1 FM WVUR, The TuneIn Radio App and ValpoAthletics.com. Head Coach Landon Fox: Landon Fox (17-34) is in his fifth season as the head coach of the Valparaiso University football program in 2023. Over the last three seasons, Fox has led Valpo to 12 Pioneer Football League victories, the most in a three-year period in program history. The program finished with a PFL record of .500 or better for a third consecutive season in 2022, the first time that has occurred since 1998-2000. Prior to that, Valpo had not had a stretch of three straight years with a league record of .500 or better since 1961-1964. The program won four PFL games in the same season just once in the 26 seasons prior to Fox's arrival. Now, the program has reached that threshold in three straight seasons and three of the first four years under his direction (Spring 2021, Fall 2021, 2022). During his four years in charge of the program, Valpo has boasted 43 All-PFL honorees and 22 academic all-PFL selections. During his second season at the helm in Spring 2021, Fox was a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award – which is presented annually to the FCS National Coach of the Year – after guiding Valpo to its best winning percentage since 2003 and tying for the squad's best winning percentage since 1999. He led his team to Pioneer Football League runner-up honors, the program's highest finish in the league standings since the PFL championship season of 2003. Fox's defensive roots paid dividends on that side of the football in his second year at the helm, as

the team enjoyed its best defensive season in four decades. Valpo held opponents to 283.3 yards per game, the program's best total defense in the last 40 years. In Year 1 of the Fox Era in 2019, Valpo ranked in the Top 5 in the PFL in scoring defense (32.0, fifth), total defense (381.6, fourth), rushing defense (184.2, fourth) and passing defense (197.3, fifth). After spending the previous 11 seasons as the defensive coordinator and secondary coach at the University of Dayton, Fox was named the head football coach at Valpo prior to the 2019 season. He helped the Flyers finish with 10 winning seasons in his 11 years on staff and guided a defensive backfield that produced one All-American, four Academic All-Americans, two PFL Special Teams Players of the Year and three corners who were invited to NFL Rookie Minicamp. Prior to joining Dayton's staff, Fox served as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Wayne State University in Detroit from 2005-2007. He also spent time as a defensive graduate assistant at Ball State University (2004), Dayton (2002-2003) and Lakeland College (2001). Fox began his coaching career as an assistant varsity coach at Preble Shawnee High School in Camden, Ohio during the 2000 season. During his playing days, Fox was a team captain and all-conference performer at Defiance College in Defiance, Ohio from 1995-1999 and graduated with a degree in physical education and health in May 2000 before earning his master's degree in education from Lakeland in May 2002.

As Easy as "One, Two, Three"?

- After beating Dayton (21-7 on Nov. 4) and Stetson (23-20 in overtime on Nov. 11) over the last two weeks, Valpo will look to extend its winning streak to three on Saturday at St. Thomas.
- This would be Valpo's longest winning streak since capturing three in a row in 2003 at Dayton (W 33-28), vs. San Diego (W 41-34) and vs. Drake (W 51-45 OT).
- This would mark the first time Valpo won each of its final three games of a season since 2000 – Oct. 28 at San Diego (W 32-10), Nov. 4 vs. Dayton (W 16-15) and Nov. 11 vs. Aurora (W 23-10).
- This would mark the first time ever that Valpo has won each of its final three PFL games. The league was founded in 1993.
- The last time Valpo won each of its final three league games of a season was 1971, wins over Evansville, DePauw and Butler in Indiana Collegiate Conference play.
- Valpo will look to end a fall season with a win for the first time since 2017. The team did close out the Spring 2021 campaign in victorious fashion.
- The last time Valpo finished the season with a road win was 2005 at Aurora.

Block Party

- Freshman Max Samuel blocked two punts in the Nov. 11 win over Stetson, the first of which was recovered in the end zone by Micah Mackay for a touchdown and the second of which was returned 51 yards to the Stetson six-yard line and eventually resulted in a touchdown.
- Mackay received credit for a punt return touchdown, Valpo's first since Jamari Booker in 2019. He was the 26th player in program history with a punt return TD.
- Samuel became only the eighth player in the FCS nation to block multiple kicks in a single game this season and the 11th in all of Division-I football (FCS and FBS). Owen Goss of Colgate is the only player nationally to block three kicks in one game this season.
- Samuel has three blocked kicks this season, including two on Nov. 11 vs. Stetson. He is now tied for fifth in program history for blocked kicks in a single season, joining Brett Bittner (Fall 2021) and Adam Rundh (2008).
- For his efforts in the win over the Hatters, Samuel was named the Pioneer Football League Special Teams Player of the Week, becoming the second straight Beacon to earn the award. Evan Matthes did so the previous week for his punting efforts in the win over Dayton.

Record Book Watch

- Entering Saturday's season finale at St. Thomas, Evan Matthes owns a punting average of 42.9. That would rank fourth in program history for single-season punting average behind Greg Wood (2010; 43.6), Ben Niesner (Spring 2021; 43.6) and Niesner again (Fall 2021, 43.2).
- Valpo has five blocked kicks as a team, one more would tie for fourth in program history for single-season blocked kicks.
- Solomon Davis has 1,333 career receiving yards. Despite essentially playing only two seasons, he will not finish far outside of the program's single-season top 10 for career receiving yards. The threshold to enter the top 10 would be 1,580 with all of the top 10 three- and four-year players.

Fox on Valpo's Wins List

- The Nov. 4 game vs. Dayton was Landon Fox's 50th as Valpo head coach.
- The win over the Flyers allowed Fox to have an identical record to his predecessor Dave Cecchini through 50 games at Valpo. Cecchini beat Butler 35-17 in his 50th game on Oct. 13, 2018.
- The win allowed Fox to tie for the most victories by a Valpo head coach through the first 50 games of a tenure since the late Bill Koch coached his 50th game on Sept. 18, 1982 at Wisconsin Eau Claire.
- The win over the Flyers also helped Fox surpass Stacy Adams on Valpo's all-time wins list. The following week vs. Stetson, he moved into a tie for seventh in program history with Cecchini with 17 wins at Valpo.

Among PFL and National Leaders

- Tyler Geiman leads the nation in passes defended per game at 1.8. He is tied with Eastern Illinois' Russell Dandy with 18 passes defended apiece. Both Dandy and Geiman have 17 pass breakups and one interception.
- Sam Hafner ranks second in the nation for total tackles by a defensive lineman. Eric O'Neill of LIU leads the FCS nation in tackles by a defensive lineman with 71, while Hafner is second with 62.
- Valpo leads the league and ranks 11th nationally in kickoff return average at 23.50.
- Jashon Butler ranks second in the PFL and seventh nationally in combined kickoff return yards at 615. He is first in the league and fourth in the nation in kickoff return average at 30.8.
- Evan Matthes leads the league and ranks 19th in the nation in punting average at 42.9.
- Valpo is tied for second nationally in blocked kicks with five, one of six teams in the country with five or more blocked kicks.
- Valpo is allowing just 320.8 yards per game, ranking second in the PFL and 23rd nationally in total defense.

Scouting the Tommies

- Coming off a 20-14 win at San Diego last week after downing Marist 49-14 on Oct. 28 in their most recent home game.
- Can clinch a share of the PFL title with a win and a Drake loss.
- Are not eligible for the PFL's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs as they are completing the transition cycle from Division-II.
- Preseason favorites to win the PFL.

Going Back-to-Back

- The win on Nov. 11 vs. Stetson has allowed Valpo to possess back-to-back victories for the first time this season.
- Before that, Valpo's last set of consecutive wins were Sept. 24, 2022 vs. San Diego (W

28-21) and Oct. 8, 2022 at Presbyterian (W 41-21).

- This marked unique scheduling as Valpo played back-to-back PFL home games. This was the first time Valpo played a league game at home in consecutive weeks since March 20, 2021 vs. Drake and March 27, 2021 vs. Butler. This was the first time that had occurred during a normal fall season since October 2015, when the Brown & Gold hosted these same opponents in consecutive weeks, Dayton on Oct. 17 and Stetson on Oct. 24.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 11: Valpo 23, Stetson 20

- Valpo overcame a minus-four disparity in the turnover margin to win the game. The Beacons threw three interceptions and muffed a punt, while Stetson did not turn it over.
- This marked Valpo's second OT game of the season and sixth one-score game. Four of the five home games this season were decided by one score including a pair that went to overtime. This is the first time on record that Valpo has played multiple overtime games in the same season.
- Ryan Mann ran for a personal-best 121 yards on 25 carries. He notched his third career touchdown run, all this season.
- Jeffrey Jackson had his first rushing touchdown of the season and the second of his career.
- Valpo notched 10 tackles for loss and five sacks, both season highs.
- The defense had nine pass breakups, including three by Tyler Geiman.
- Valpo's stellar rushing defense was evident yet again. The Hatters could muster up only 60 yards on the ground, the seventh time in 10 games that Valpo's rushing defense has kept the opposition under 80 rushing yards.
- Colin Graves and Austin Chilton had 10 tackles apiece to lead the team. Chilton boasted seven solos. Evan Annis contributed nine tackles including three tackles for loss and two sacks.

Defense Dominates Dayton

- Valpo held Dayton to 175 yards of total offense on Nov. 4, the fewest yards gained by a Valpo opponent since Oct. 11, 2014, when Missouri Baptist was limited to 122 yards.
- The game against the Flyers marked the fewest yards permitted by Valpo in a Pioneer Football League game since Nov. 15, 2018 at Campbell, when the Fighting Camels mustered up just 158 yards of total offense.
- Dayton was held to 68 yards on the ground, the sixth time in nine games this season that a stingy Valpo rushing defense has kept the opposition under 80 rushing yards.
- Valpo's three best performances of the season in terms of passing defense have come over the last three weeks. Valpo allowed over 150 passing yards in each of the first six games of the season but has permitted under that threshold in each of the last three weeks including 107 on Nov. 4 vs. Dayton.
- The Valpo defense has put together a first-half shutout in back-to-back weeks, holding Butler off the scoreboard in the first half on Oct. 28 before doing the same to Dayton on Nov. 4. The Valpo defense has enjoyed a shutout half on three occasions this season, with the first of those coming in the first half on Sept. 30 vs. Southwest Minnesota State.
- The seven points were the fewest allowed by Valpo since a 47-3 win at Butler on Nov. 13, 2021.

Soaring Past the Flyers

- Two of Valpo's five all-time wins over Dayton have come in the last three seasons. Valpo head coach Landon Fox is 2-2 against Dayton, where he served as defensive coordinator before his arrival at Valpo.
- Before Fox, Valpo was 2-25 all-time against Dayton in a series that started in 1988. Fox owns as many wins over the Flyers in just four meetings as every coach in Valpo history before his arrival had against that opponent in 27 all-time matchups.
- The Brown Field fans have become used to cliffhangers as the 21-7 Valpo victory over Dayton on Nov. 4 represented the team's most lopsided home win since its previous home faceoff with the Flyers on Oct. 23, 2021, a 45-28 triumph.
- Valpo's two victories over Dayton during the Fox Era have come by margins of 17 and 14. Prior to Fox, the margins for Valpo's two wins over Dayton were one (2017) and five (2003).
- Before Fox took over Valpo's program in 2019, the team was 1-14 in its last 15 matchups with Dayton with an average margin of defeat of 32.9 points per game in those losses.

Matthes Receives Recognition

- Punter Evan Matthes became the first Valpo player this season to receive a Pioneer Football League honor when he was tabbed PFL Special Teams Player of the Week on Nov. 5 for his performance in the Nov. 4 win over Dayton.
- Matthes played a key role in the field position battle, pinning Dayton deep on a regular basis in the 21-7 win over the Flyers.
- He averaged 41.7 yards per punt on seven attempts with a long of 53, pinning five of his seven boots inside the 20 including three inside the 10 and two inside the 5.
- Matthes, who leads the PFL and ranks 18th nationally in punting average at 42.8, would rank fourth in single-season program history in punting average if the season ended today.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 4: Valpo 21, Dayton 7

- Ryan Mann ran for 68 yards on 11 carries, all in the second half after his comeback from the back trouble that plagued him during warmups and throughout the first half. He also had two catches for 34 yards.
- Solomon Davis hauled in a team-high four catches for 25 yards including a touchdown, his fifth receiving TD (sixth total TD) this season and his ninth career receiving score (10th total).
- Rowan Keefe went 15-of-21 through the air for 126 yards, two touchdowns and no interceptions.
- Jake Vickers' TD catch was his second this season and the fourth of his career.
- Jashon Butler ran for his first touchdown in a Valpo uniform.
- Evan Annis achieved a team-high 10 tackles, while Sam Hafner and Austin Chilton chipped in eight apiece. Hafner had a big day that featured two tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks.
- Max Samuel picked up his first career fumble recovery and his second big play of the season to go along with a blocked kick.

Eberhart, redshirt junior defensive lineman Sam Hafner and redshirt senior wide receiver Solomon Davis. Annis is a captain for the third straight season, while the others hold the distinction for the first time this year.

Preseason Picks

- Valpo was picked sixth of 11 in the preseason poll.
- WR Solomon Davis and TE Evan Jernegan were recognized with Preseason All-PFL honors.
- Evan Matthes was named to the FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List.
- Six Valpo players earned Phil Steele First All-PFL honors – WR Solomon Davis on the first team; TE Evan Jernegan, DL Sam Hafner, DL Kevin Spelman and P Evan Matthes on the second team and LB Evan Annis along with Spelman (as a long snapper) on the third team.

2022 Valpo Football Feats

- Winning on the road is never easy, but Valpo finished out a successful season in terms of Pioneer Football League games away from Brown Field with the 45-24 win at Marist in Week 11. The team finished 3-1 in league road games, the first time Valpo has won three PFL road games in the same season since the league was founded in 1993.
- In addition, 2022 marks the first time Valpo has won three league road games in the same season since 1962.
- Valpo finished with a PFL record of .500 or better for a third consecutive season. This is the program's first such stretch since 1998-2000. Prior to that, Valpo had not had a league record of .500 or better in three straight years since doing so in four straight seasons from 1961-1964.
- The program has won four PFL games in the same season for the third straight year and just the fourth time ever. Prior to the Spring 2021 season, Valpo had won four league games in a season just once since 1968, with the one instance coming in 2017.
- To put the last note in further perspective, Valpo had won four Pioneer Football League games once in 26 seasons prior to Fox's arrival. Now, the program has reached that threshold for league wins in three of his first four seasons. (Although, in fairness, the program played only four to five league games per year in each of its first 13 PFL seasons.)
- Fox's team achieved yet another program first with the Week 11 win at Marist. That marked the program's first-ever win in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. (previously 0-4) and the team's second win over Marist in any location (previously 1-9, last win in 2017 at Brown Field.)
- That one was the latest on a growing list of the program's feats, as earlier in the season Valpo garnered the program's first win at Morehead State since 2006.
- Also during the Fox Era, Valpo has achieved its first-ever win at Drake, its first win over Drake in any location since 2003 and its first win over San Diego since 2003.
- During the 2021 campaign, Valpo prevailed 47-3 in a game at rival Butler, setting a program record for margin of victory in a game against a Division-I opponent. Valpo and Butler are instate foes who play for the Hoosier Helmet rivalry trophy.

2022 PFL Postseason Plaudits

- Seven members of Valpo's program earned All-PFL First or Second Team status, while three others received Honorable Mention nods as the league announced its postseason awards on Tuesday, Nov. 29.
- Redshirt junior wide receiver Solomon Davis, fifth-year senior running back

Aaron Dawson, redshirt senior offensive lineman Aaron Byrd and redshirt senior linebacker Ben Hines were named to the All-PFL First Team.

- Redshirt sophomore defensive lineman Sam Hafner, fifth-year senior defensive back Kohlton Sherman and redshirt senior punter Evan Matthes were tabbed to the All-PFL Second Team.
- Redshirt freshman tight end Evan Jernigan, redshirt junior wide receiver Matt Ross and redshirt freshman defensive lineman and long snapper Kevin Spelman (at both positions) received PFL Honorable Mention.

Roster Rundown: The program has continued to bring in talent from all over the United States. This year's roster features athletes from nearly half of the 50 states as 22 states are represented.
