**Next Up in Crusader Basketball:** Valparaiso faces its first out-of-state opponent Thursday as Northern Illinois plays host to the Crusaders. Both teams have split their first two games of 2014-15 with NIU defeating Illinois State 55-51 at home, but dropping a 61-47 tilt to the Flames at the UIC Pavilion. Hobart native Amanda Corral, who last season became the 27th Husky to eclipse 1,000 career points, continues to recover from a thumb injury and is not expected to play in Thursday's game.

**Last Time Out:** Freshman Dani Franklin finished in double figures for the second straight game, but Indiana snatched 18 steals en route to an 81-49 win at Assembly Hall. IU freshman Tyra Buss poured in 22 points and eight steals while Larryn Brooks added 14. Franklin's 11 points and eight rebounds were team watermarks.

**Head Coach Tracey Dorow:** Tracey Dorow (18-46) is in her third season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2014-15. She collected her 250th career victory on Friday, Nov. 14th after a 91-57 walloping of Butler. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the #1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season as well as the #2 ranking in 2002-2003.

**Series Notes:** Northern Illinois leads the all-time series 17-2. The Huskies won the first twelve meetings before Valpo snapped that streak with a 101-91 victory at the Athletics-Recreation Center on Feb. 18th, 1992. The two teams met 14 times in a six-year span from 1988-1994, but went on an 18-season hiatus. That layoff ended two seasons ago when NIU came to Valpo on Jan. 5th, 2013 (Valpo won 54-49).

## Storylines...

- Valparaiso head coach Tracey Dorow notched her 250th career win Friday versus Butler.
- Of the 19 games these two teams have played against one another, Northern Illinois has scored 100 or more points eleven times.
- The Crusaders won their only road game against a MAC opponent last season (Toledo).
- Valpo defeated NIU 54-49 on Jan. 5th, 2013. Of the 103 points scored, only 12 of those came from players expected to play Thursday (Wiedemann [Valpo] 6; L Miller [Valpo] 2; Thorp [NIU] 4).
- Valparaiso head baseball coach Brian Schmack played at Northern Illinois from 1992-1995.

## @ValpoWBB...

*...looking back at last season*

- @ValpoWBB were champions of the Toledo Invite, defeating Chicago State and the host Rockets.
- @ValpoWBB's Liz Horton signed a contract to play professionally with Germany's TG Neuss following a senior season where she averaged 10.9 points/game and recorded the 9th-highest three-point field goal percentage in a season in school history (39.8%).
- @ValpoWBB shot 77.6% from the free-throw line, the highest percentage ever by a Crusader team.

*...looking ahead to this season*

- @ValpoWBB was picked to finish eighth in the Horizon League in the 2014-15 Preseason Poll.
- @ValpoWBB returns 1,287 points, 732 rebounds, 244 assists, 4,132 minutes played from 2013-14.

## @GoHuskiesWBB

- @GoHuskiesWBB finished 2013-14 with a 11-19 overall record, and a 6-12 mark in the Mid-American Conference (MAC).
- @GoHuskiesWBB is shooting just 14.8% percent (4-for-27) from beyond the arc thus far.
- @GoHuskiesWBB has three players averaging double-digit points (Kelly Smith 13.5, Renee Sladek 10.0, Jenna Thorp 10.0).
- @GoHuskiesWBB's Kathi Bennett is the only active head coach whose father coached in the NCAA Final Four (Dick, at Wisconsin).

## Jessica Carr

- One of two team captains (Wiedemann) this season.
- Averaged 12.6 points in the final seven games of 2013-14.
- Drained a career-high six three-pointers in Valpo's season finale at Green Bay.

## Abby Dean

- Registered a career-high 21 points on 9-of-11 shooting Friday.
- Finished in double figures 12 different times in 2013-14.

- Led the Brown and Gold in free-throw shooting (85.2%) last year.
- Scored first collegiate points at historic Cameron Indoor Stadium in November of 2012.

## Annemarie Hamlet

- Scored 11 points in her Crusader debut last Friday.
- Last Friday represents the 616th day since Hamlet last played in a regular season game (3/9/13 with Oakland).

## Faith Miller

- Drained both three-point attempts vs. Butler.

## Anne Hamilton

- Was a perfect 2-for-2 from the field vs. Butler in her Crusader debut.

## Lexi Miller

- One of two Crusaders to finish with more assists (59) than turnovers (56) last season.
- Made collegiate debut against the Indiana Hoosiers Nov, 9th, 2012.

## Dani Franklin

- Scored 14 points on 6-of-11 shooting in her first game with the Brown and Gold on Nov. 14th.

## Tracey Dorow

Head Coach

3rd Season

**250-209 overall, 18-46 at Valpo**  
**Western Michigan, 1996**

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.

Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bulldogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. Her student-athletes earned All-GLIAC honors 22 times and 10 times she had players represented on the GLIAC All-Defensive Team. Under Dorow's guidance, Ferris State produced the GLIAC Player of the Year in 2000-2001, and she twice coached the GLIAC Freshman of the Year.

Dorow's student-athletes also excelled in the classroom, as three times she has led a First Team Academic All-American and 14 times her players have earned Academic All-District honors. A total of 45 different players earned GLIAC All-Academic recognition during her time at Ferris State. Ferris State posted the No. 1 grade point average in the country in Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season, and her team ranked second in the nation in 2002-2003.

Dorow began her coaching career as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan Community College in Benton Harbor, Mich. where she helped lead the Indians to a 69-22 record in three seasons, winning two Western Collegiate Conference titles. Lake Michigan finished fourth in the 1997 NJCAA national tournament and held a No. 1 national ranking in February of that same season. She also spent one season as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis.

A collegiate player at Illinois State from 1990-1993, she led the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference that same season. After transferring to Northern Michigan University for the 1993-1994 season, she earned Newcomer of the Year and Best Defensive Player honors for the Wildcats. Dorow had 131 assists and made 54 threes at NMU in her one season there. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorow's have two children: Lainie, 4, and Baxter, 2, who are both incredibly proud to be Crusaders.

**2014-15:** Tied a career high in rebounds with six in addition to handing out four assists in Valpo's 91-57 season-opening win over Butler (Nov. 14)...hit a pair of triples at Indiana (Nov. 18).

**2013-14:** Appeared in 18 games - 15 starts - after missing the first half of the season with a hand injury...averaged 7.9 points per game and handed out 73 assists...one of two Crusaders to finish the season with more assists than turnovers...was second on the team in three-point field goal percentage (35.2%)...scored 12 points in her second game back versus South Dakota (Dec. 31)...tossed in ten points against Wright State (Jan. 18)...recorded a season-high seven steals to go with eight points and four assists in Valpo's 85-44 victory over Detroit at the ARC...registered 11 points, six boards, and four assists at Milwaukee on Feb. 1st...shot 5-of-13 from the floor, including 3-of-6 from three-point range in an 84-70 defeat of Oakland (Feb. 22)...tallied a season-high 21 points thanks to a 7-for-15 night from the field at Detroit (Feb. 26)...distributed a season-high seven assists at Wright State (Mar. 8) to accompany her 11 points...scored 14 points in Valpo's 76-69 defeat of Detroit in the Horizon League Tournament (Mar. 10)...knocked down a career-most six treys in the season finale at Green Bay (Mar. 12).

**2012-13:** Saw action in 29 games with eight starts as a sophomore...averaged 4.1 points per game...went 22-for-25 from the free-throw line, good for the best FT percentage (88%) of any Crusader...her 34.4% from three-point land was also tops on the team for any player with more than five attempts...collected 55 assists on the season...logged three minutes in a win in the season opener over Indiana (Nov. 9)...played 20 minutes and dished out two assists in addition to knocking down a trey versus Purdue-Calumet (Nov. 14)...pulled down two boards and sunk a free throw at Butler (Nov. 19)...nailed a three-pointer and hauled in three rebounds in her first start of the season at Cameron Indoor Stadium versus #4 Duke (Nov. 23)...recorded an assist and a steal in a start at Western Illinois (Nov. 27)...made a three-pointer and had two assists at Louisville (Dec. 8)...went 2-for-3 from three-point land and recorded a steal at Michigan (Dec. 20)...tallied five points, five boards, and four assists in 27 minutes versus Youngstown State (Jan. 12)...scored nine points on 3-of-6 shooting versus Green Bay (Jan. 26)...converted on her only three-point attempt at Wright State as part of a five-point game (Jan. 31)...accumulated a season-high five assists against Cleveland State (Feb. 2)...was 2-for-2 from the field at Detroit (Feb. 9)...brought down six boards and went 6-for-6 from the charity stripe versus UIC (Feb. 16)...scored eight points and had four assists against Milwaukee (Feb. 21)...started the final six games of the season, averaging 7.5 points in those tilts...recorded a season-high 14 points versus UIC in the Horizon League Conference Tournament while logging a season-high 33 minutes (Mar. 11)...tallied eight points and five rebounds in the season finale at #20 Green Bay (Mar. 13).
