## **Head Coach Kate Stake**

Kate Stake enters her fourth year as Head Coach of the Crusader softball program as Valpo enters its inaugural season in the Missouri Valley Conference. In 2017 the Crusaders continued to build off of their 2016 Horizon League Championship and NCAA Tournament berth, finishing third

in league play and earning a third consecutive trip to the Horizon League Tournament. Under Stake's tutelage, senior Sam Stewart was named Horizon League Player Of The Year and an NFCA Second Team All-Region selection, enjoying one of the most productive seasons in program history at the plate and breaking four school records. Through her first three years at the helm, Stake's squads have made their mark on the program's record books at the plate, in the circle and in the field—most notably setting a new team singleseason record for on-base percentage in 2015 (.381). In Stake's three seasons, she has guided 10 Crusaders to All-League selections. Stake arrived at Valpo after two seasons as an assistant at Hofstra, where she helped lead the Pride to 81 wins and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Prior to her time at Hofstra, she also spent time as an assistant at the United States Military Academy and Eastern Illinois.
