

Non-Coaching Staff

Non-Coaching Staff are prohibited from:

- Contacting or evaluating prospective student-athletes off-campus (including reporting back to coaches how a particular PSA played in a particular game or event)
- In-person scouting of opponents
- Providing analysis or evaluation of videotape/film of prospects
- Being involved in selection of prospects, additionally, may not make decisions regarding prospects
- Participating in any on-court or on-field duties that could be considered coaching (e.g., participate in drills, act as referee, signal plays, use equipment in practice or competition-related warm-up activities)
- Participating with or observing student-athletes in your sport who are engaged in nonorganized voluntary athletically-related activities (e.g., pick-up games)
- Provide instruction to student-athletes
- Discuss, analyze, or evaluate opponents with student-athletes
- Making telephone calls to prospects (or their parents, legal guardians or coaches), except as permitted by NCAA bylaw 11.7.2.3
- Provide transportation to a student-athlete to and from classes in excess of an occasional basis

Non-Coaching Staff may:

- Discuss, analyze, or evaluate opponents in meetings with coaches only
- Observe practice
- Analyze video/film involving team or opponents
- Track statistics and keep play chart
- Attend meetings involving coaching activities
- Sit on team bench, in coaches box, dugout, or sidelines during competitions
- Arrange/coordinate team travel and public service activities
- Be present during on-campus recruiting visits
- Initiate and receive phone calls from a prospect, PROVIDED the calls meet the requirements outlined in NCAA bylaw 11.7.2.3
- Provide transportation to a prospect who is on-campus for an OFFICIAL VISIT, including to and from the airport
