## Valparaiso (11-7, 4-1 MVC) Game \#19-Saturday, Jan. 19, 2019-3 p.m. UNI (8-10, 3-2 MVC) Athletics-Recreation Center $(5,000)$ - Valparaiso, Ind.

Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team looks to bounce back from its first loss of the conference season on Saturday afternoon when it hosts UNI at the ARC as part of Basketball Day Indiana. Valpo enters the game tied for first place in the MVC standings, while UNI is one of three teams one game back of the first-place tie.

Last Time Out: Valpo dropped its first Missouri Valley Conference game of the year on Tuesday evening, falling at defending conference champion Loyola by a 71-54 final. The Ramblers led by 10 at halftime and opened the second half on a 15-1 run. Markus Golder paced Valpo with 16 points.

Head Coach Matt Lottich: Matt Lottich (50-33) is in his sixth season overall at Valpo and third as head coach in 2018-19. Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-18 and guided the the program through the transition to the MVC, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI. In his first year as head coach, Lottich guided Valpo to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in the last six years as he led the team to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT.

Series Notes: Prior to last season, when Valpo joined the MVC, Valpo and UNI had not met for over 13 years and had faced off just once in the last quarter-century. The Crusaders and Panthers shared membership in the Mid-Continent Conference from the conference's formation in 1982 until UNI's departure for the MVC in 1991. UNI holds a 24-2 advantage in the all-time series over Valpo, including wins in both meetings as MVC opponents last season $-81-76$ in Cedar Falls and 68-63 at the ARC.

...and@ValleyHoops

- Valpo was selected to finish in seventh place in the MVC preseason poll with 173 points.
- Valpo has finished worse in the final standings than its preseason projection just once in the last eight years.
- Valpo is looking to buck MVC history this year - in 110 years of Valley basketball, only 28 teams have gone from last place one year to an upper division finish the following year.
...looking back at last year
- Valpo went 15-17 in its first season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference. - The Brown and Gold posted a 6-12 record in MVC play in a conference which ended the season ranked eighth in the nation in conference RPI.
- The 2017-18 campaign marked the first time in the last eight years that Valpo has not earned a bid to postseason tournament play.
- Sophomore Bakari Evelyn was named to the MVC's All-Newcomer Team, while sophomore Markus Golder earned a spot on the conference's All-Bench Team.


## ...in the loss at Loyola

- Valpo never led in the game, but took each shot Loyola threw at it in the early going.
- Loyola's Cooper Kaifes hit a 3-pointer in the final seconds of the period - his third triple of the first half - to give the Ramblers a 33-23 lead at intermission.
- Loyola started the second half on a 15-1 run to extend its lead to 24 points, and Valpo would get no closer than the final margin the rest of the way, outscoring Loyola 15-4 over the final five and a half minutes.
- Loyola limited Valpo to a season-low 17 baskets from the floor (17-for-40) and a season-low eight assists. Meanwhile, Valpo committed 14 turnovers which the Ramblers converted into 23 points.
- Valpo did enjoy one of its top free throw shooting performances of the year, going 14-of-17 from the charity stripe.
- Markus Golder led Valpo in scoring for just the second time this season, coming up just two points shy of his career best as he went 6 -of- 8 from the floor for 16 points.


## ...in the win at Southern Illinois

- A 12-2 run late in the first half gave Valpo the lead for good in the win over the Salukis.
- The two squads traded offensive punches early in the second half, and for the first 11 minutes of the half, Valpo's lead would fluctuate between seven and 11 points.
-Valpo extended its lead to its apex at 59-46 with 6:46 to play before SIU went on a 12-2 run over the next four minutes.
- With the score 63-61 Valpo with 40 seconds to play, SIU elected to play out the defensive possession, and Deion Lavender received a perfect pass from Derrik Smits and laid it in with under 13 seconds remaining to secure the win.
- Valpo won despite playing without leading scorer Ryan Fazekas due to injury.
- Valpo posted a season-low total of seven turnovers while forcing 13 SIU miscues.

Valpo enjoyed an 18-4 advantage in points off turnovers.

- Derrik Smits led three Valpo players in double figures with 16 points - 14 of which came in the second half - and recorded a team-high eight rebounds as well.


## ...looking ahead

- Valpo heads down to Terre Haute for a matchup against the Sycamores of Indiana State Wednesday, Jan. 23.
- Valpo then returns home to the ARC for consecutive home games to close out the month of January, hosting Drake (Jan. 26) and Missouri State (Jan. 29).


## ...at the ARC

- Valpo has 15 regular season home games scheduled at the ARC this season and is 6-2 so far this year at home following its win over Bradley.
- Valpo posted a 10-4 record at home last year, its eighth consecutive season reaching double figures in home victories.
- Valpo has recorded a 63-10 (.863) mark in home games since the start of the 2014-15 season.
- Over the last 23 years, Valpo owns a 298-66 (.819) record on its home court at the ARC.


## @UNIMBB

- UNI enters Saturday's game at 8-10 overall and 3-2 in MVC play, one game behind Valpo in the conference standings.
- The Panthers come into the game owners of back-to-back wins over Drake and Indiana State.
- UNI is just 1-4 in true road games this season, with their lone road victory coming to open MVC play at Bradley.
- Freshman AJ Green leads the Panthers, averaging 14.4 points per game.


## 4-0 Starts

- This year's squad became just the third Valpo team this century to win at least four straight games to open conference play.
- Despite winning five regular season titles in its last six seasons in the Horizon League, the 2015-16 season was the only time in that stretch Valpo won even its first two league games, starting 6-0 en route to a 16-2 league record.
- The 2002-03 Valpo squad also started 6-0 on its way to a 12-2 record and a Mid-Continent Conference regular season championship.


## Bouncing Back

- Valpo will be looking to bounce back from Tuesday night's loss on Saturday .
- Valpo owns a 5-1 record this season in games following losses - Ball State/Texas

A\&M are the team's only back-to-back losses this season.

- Last year's squad was just 6-10 in games following losses.
- Over a five-year stretch (2012-13 through 2016-17), Valpo had four regular seasons where it did not lose consecutive games.


## Defending Without Fouling

- Perhaps the biggest change defensively for Valpo this season has been its ability to play defense without committing fouls and sending opponents to the foul line. - Last year's team ranked 337th nationally (14th from last) in defensive free throw rate, while this year's squad ranks 57 th nationally in the same category.
- In terms of raw numbers, last year's Valpo opponents averaged 23.2 FT/game across all games and $22.8 \mathrm{FT} /$ game in conference play, while this year, opponents are averaging $16.1 \mathrm{FT} /$ game overall and $14.2 \mathrm{FT} /$ game in conference play.


## The Balanced Attack

- On the offensive end, Valpo has proven to have multiple threats who can step up through the season's first 18 games.
- Entering Saturday's game, five different players are averaging 9.4 points per game or better, led by Ryan Fazekas' 12.7 points/game.
- Six different players have led Valpo in scoring in a game this season.
- Valpo last featured five different players averaging in double figures in 2007-08, the program's first season in the Horizon League.

## First-Half Runs

- Big runs in the opening period have proven key to helping Valpo claim each of its last three victories.
- Missouri State - 30-6 run over span of 8:02 (8:44-0:42 - took tie game and made it a 24-point lead)
- Bradley - 18-2 run over span of 8:27 (12:42-4:15 - took one-point lead and extended it to 17 points)
- Southern Illinois - 22-6 run over span of 8:06 (8:44-0:38 - took seven-point deficit and turned it into nine-point lead)


## Challenging Start to Conference Play

- Valpo's schedule in the first quarter-plus of MVC play shaped up to be a tough slate entering the season.
- Valpo has already faced each of the conference's top four teams in the preseason poll within the first five games of MVC action.


## Buzzer Beaters

- Markus Golder's buzzer-beater against Illinois State added to the lore of last-second shots in Valpo history.
- It was Valpo's first game-winner with the clock at zero since Ryan Broekhoff connected on a 3-pointer to give Valpo the 70-69 win in the 2013 Horizon League semifinal at the ARC over Green Bay.
- It was Valpo's first game-winner from beyond halfcourt since Greg Tonagel drilled a heave from the opposite 3-point line for a 71-68 win over Belmont at the ARC on Jan. 11, 1999.
- Of course, the most famous buzzer-beater in program history came courtesy of Bryce Drew in the first round of the 1998 NCAA Tournament versus Ole Miss.
- Golder's shot came in at the top spot on SportsCenter's Top 10 on Wednesday night's countdown. He became the third different Valpo athlete over three different sports to earn a SportsCenter Top 10 spot since Valpo joined The Valley.


## Earning Honors

- Junior Ryan Fazekas became the first Valpo player since the program joined the MVC to earn a weekly award from the conference office, as he was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Jan. 2.
- Fazekas earned the honor after leading all players in scoring with 19 points - including five 3-pointers - in Valpo's win over Purdue Northwest.
- Fazekas repeated as MVC Newcomer of the Week Jan. 7 after pouring in 10 3-pointers over Valpo's first two MVC wins over Illinois State and Missouri State.


## Shooting - The Highs and the Lows

- The difference in Valpo's 3-point shooting in wins versus losses this year is striking - in its 10 victories, Valpo is hitting $40 \%$ from the 3-point line, while in its six losses, Valpo is shooting just $25 \%$ from deep.
- Valpo has hit better than 33\% from 3-point range in a loss just once this season and is averaging just 5.3 3-pointers/game in defeats.
- Meanwhile, Valpo has enjoyed a number of strong shooting performances in wins, including a 15-of-27 effort from deep in its win at George Washington and a 12-of24 performance in the win at Missouri State.
- The 15 triples were the program's highest total against a Division I opponent since going 15-of-26 from deep in a Feb. 5, 2013 win over UIC.

## Redshirts Aplenty

- Valpo boasts five players on this year's team who have redshirted.
- Derrik Smits redshirted due to injury in his first year at Valpo, while Bakari Evelyn and Ryan Fazekas each sat out as a redshirt after transferring from Nebraska and Providence, respectively.
- Deion Lavender and Markus Golder both redshirted before arriving at Valpo as well.
- Only 12 schools nationally have more redshirts on their active roster this year than Valpo's five.
- Valpo also has a pair of Division I transfers in Eron Gordon and Nick Robinson sitting out this season as redshirts as well.


## What's Back

- Seven letterwinners return from last year's team, including three starters.
- The returnees are highlighted by MVC All-Newcomer Team honoree Bakari Evelyn and MVC All-Bench Team selection Markus Golder.
- In all, Valpo returns $63.3 \%$ of its scoring, $66.6 \%$ of its rebounding and $64.1 \%$ of its minutes played from last season in 2018-19.


## What's New

- Five players have made their Valpo debuts this season.
- Valpo's lone senior is a graduate transfer, as Deion Lavender joined the program for his final season of collegiate eligibility after spending the last two years at UAB. - Junior Ryan Fazekas is eligible this year after sitting out last season as a transfer from Providence.
- Valpo welcomed a trio of true freshmen to the fold this year: Chicago native Javon Freeman, Winnipeg product Daniel Sackey and Bowman Academy graduate Langston Stalling.


## Developing Pros

- Valpo has produced a myriad of professional basketball players over the last 25 years, most notably a pair of NBA players in the last two years.
- Ryan Broekhoff (class of 2013) signed a contract with the Dallas Mavericks in the summer of 2018 after spending five seasons playing internationally in Russia and Turkey.
- Broekhoff tallied a season-high 15 points on 6-of-8 shooting from the floor (3-5 3PT) in 22 minutes of action Jan. 5 in a 106-100 loss against Philadelphia.
- Alec Peters (class of 2017) was the 54th pick in the 2017 NBA Draft by the Phoenix Suns.
- Peters appeared in 20 games for the Suns in 2017-18, highlighted by a 36 -point performance in the season finale against Dallas - a new single-game high by a Valpo alum in the NBA.
- Peters is currently playing for CSKA Moscow in Russia.
- 2018 Valpo graduates Tevonn Walker and Max Joseph are currently playing for

Hamburg Towers in Germany and Nassjo Basket in Sweden, respectively.

- Valpo has now produced 50 pro basketball players over the last 25 years.


## The International Flavor

- This year's squad continues the international pipeline that Valpo has cultivated over the past two-plus decades.
- The Crusaders boast a pair of international players on this year's roster.
- Represented are Canada (Sackey) and Spain (Sorolla).
- Over the past 22 years, the Crusaders have welcomed 34 international players from 19 different countries.


## Deion Lavender

- Lavender pulled down 10 rebounds to go with seven points and five assists in the win at Missouri State.
- Lavender reached 10 assists for the second time this year in the win at George Washington.
- Lavender tallied 12 points and game highs of seven rebounds and seven assists in the win over UC Riverside.
- Lavender became the first Valpo player in over a decade to reach double figures in assists and the first in 21 years to do so without committing a turnover, posting 10 assists, six rebounds and five points at West Virginia.
- Lavender was named Honorable Mention All-Tournament at Myrtle Beach.
- Lavender led all players in the win over Monmouth with 18 points and eight rebounds.
- Lavender is a graduate transfer who joins the Valpo program after spending the last two years at UAB.
- Lavender led UAB and ranked eighth in Conference USA with 3.4 assists/game in 2016-17, while also ranking ninth in the conference that season in assist/turnover ratio. - Lavender played as a freshman in the MVC for Southern Illinois (2014-15), averaging 6.6 points/game and raising his scoring average to 8.6 points/game within MVC play.


## Bakari Evelyn

- Evelyn hit a 3-pointer and dished out an assist on back-to-back possessions inside the final three minutes in the win over Bradley, helping extend a five-point lead to 10 points.
- Evelyn knocked down a trio of 3-pointers in a 13-point effort in the win at Missouri State.
- Evelyn connected on a career-best 10 field goals, including a career-high six

3-pointers, in finishing with 27 points in the win at George Washington.

- Evelyn finished with 13 points, a team-high five assists and matched his career best with four steals in the win at UNLV.
- Evelyn notched a team-best 16 points - 15 of which came after halftime - and sent Valpo to overtime with a jumper with 11 seconds to play in the win over SIUE.
- Evelyn was an MVC All-Newcomer Team selection last year.
- Evelyn was the lone Valpo player to start all 32 games and averaged 12.6 points/ game to rank second on the team.
- Evelyn led Valpo with 93 assists and averaged a team-best 14.1 points/game in MVC-only play, connecting at a $42.3 \%$ clip from 3-point range against MVC opponents.


## Markus Golder

- Golder led Valpo last time out at Loyola with 16 points, going 6-of-8 from the field.
- Golder hit a 50 -foot buzzer-beater for the win over Illinois State, a play which was number one on SportsCenter's Top 10.
- Golder also had three rebounds, a second-chance basket, a pair of free throws and drew two charges in the final 90 seconds of the win.
- Golder matched his career best with 18 points in the win over PNW, including five dunks.
- Golder matched his season best with 16 points ( $6-8 \mathrm{FG}$ ) vs. UC Riverside.
- Golder paced Valpo with 15 points and eight rebounds versus Western Kentucky.
- Golder scored 16 points in just 18 minutes off the bench in the season-opening win over Concordia.
- Golder was named to the MVC All-Bench Team last season in his first year at Valpo.
- Golder averaged 22.6 minutes/game, mainly off the bench, and finished third on the team with 9.5 points/game.
- Golder paced Valpo with 138 total rebounds on the year, and also led Valpo in both

3-point percentage ( $42.9 \%$ ) and free throw percentage ( $83.1 \%$ ).

## John Kiser

- Kiser earned his first start in over a calendar in the win at SIU, scoring give points in 13 minutes of action.
- Kiser started the second half and played a total of 14 minutes in the win over Bradley.
- Kiser scored three points and grabbed six rebounds in the win over PNW.
- Kiser finished with six points and a team-high seven rebounds in the season-opening win over Concordia.
- Kiser was awarded a scholarship prior to his sophomore year in 2017-18.
- Kiser averaged 18.2 minutes/game and grabbed 3.7 rebounds/game last season, leading Valpo in rebounds on eight occasions.


## Mileek McMillan

- McMillan tallied nine points in 14 minutes off the bench, going a perfect 6-of-6 from the foul line, last time out at Loyola.
- McMillan finished with nine points and six rebounds in the win over PNW.
- McMillan scored six points in 10 minutes off the bench at Texas A\&M.
- McMillan hit a 3-pointer and tallied a pair of steals in the win at GW.
- McMillan scored seven points against WKU and six points vs. Wake Forest.
- McMillan appeared in all 32 games as a freshman for Valpo, starting each of the season's final 18 games.
- McMillan averaged 10.6 minutes/game as a rookie and shot $36.4 \%$ from 3-point range for the season.


## Javon Freeman

- Freeman led Valpo with his season high against a D-I opponent, scoring 17 points on 7 -of-10 shooting in the win over Bradley.
- Freeman tallied 15 points and seven rebounds in the win at GW.
- Freeman is the only Valpo freshman in the last 30 years to open his career with five straight games of $10+$ points - only two others had started with three straight such games.
- Freeman posted 11 points, six rebounds and four assists in the win over SIUE.
- Freeman scored in double figures in all three of Valpo's games in Myrtle Beach.
- Freeman was 7 -of-8 from the field and 6-of-8 from the foul line for a game-high

22 points to go with four assists and three steals in the season-opening win over Concordia.

## Matt Lottich

## Head Coach

3rd Season * Stanford, 2004
50-33 Overall and at Valpo
Matt Lottich is in his sixth season overall at Valparaiso University and third season as head coach of the men's basketball program for the 2018-2019 season.

Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-2018 and guided the Crusaders through the move to the Missouri Valley Conference, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI.

In his first season at the helm of the Crusader men's basketball program, Lottich guided Valpo to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in the last six years as he led the Crusaders to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT. Lottich's inaugural season as head coach was highlighted by a home win over a nationally-ranked Rhode Island squad, as well as neutral-site wins over Alabama and BYU to capture the MGM Grand Main Event.

Lottich coached the Horizon League Player of the Year and an NABC Third Team All-American in Alec Peters, guiding the senior as he closed out one of the top careers in program history. Peters enjoyed his finest season as a senior, ranking among the top-20 in the nation in both scoring and rebounding and breaking five of Valpo's career records.

Lottich was hired as the 22nd head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program in April of 2016. Lottich, who had served the previous three seasons as an assistant coach on the Crusaders' staff, became just the program's fifth head coach in the last 36 years.

Lottich arrived at Valparaiso University in summer 2013 and helped guide the Crusaders to 78 victories over his three seasons as an assistant. Valpo won two Horizon League regular season championships and one league tournament title over those three years.

The Crusaders recorded the top two victory totals in program history over Lottich's final two years as an assistant. Valpo broke the previous school record for wins in a season during the 2014-2015 campaign, winning 28 games and earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament. Then, the 2015-2016 season saw Valpo win a program-record 30 games and advance to the NIT championship game at Madison Square Garden.

Lottich brings nearly a decade of professional playing experience to the head coaching position at Valparaiso University. Lottich spent eight years playing professionally in Japan for the Oita Heat Devils and the Osaka Evessa, earning All-Star recognition four times. He also played one season in Germany in the Bundesliga for the Dusseldorf Giants, played one season in New Zealand in the NBL for the Harbor Heat and was a member of the New Jersey Nets' summer league team in 2004.

Lottich played collegiately at Stanford University from 2000 through 2004. As a senior in 2003-2004, he helped lead the Cardinal to the Pac-10 title while earning NABC All-Star plaudits, awarded to the top-15 seniors in college basketball. He was also a member of the Wooden Award midseason watch list and was an Honorable Mention All Pac-10 selection as a senior. Lottich was also a member of the program's conference championship squad as a freshman in 2000-2001 and still ranks among Stanford's single-season and career leaders in 3-pointers made.

Off the court, Lottich came to Valpo from the National Collegiate Scouting Association, where he started in January 2013. Lottich ascended to the position of head scout during his time with the NCSA, which helps high school athletes navigate the world of college recruiting. Lottich also co-founded the TEAM Life Skills basketball camp in 2004 and spent nine years managing and developing the camp.

Lottich played his prep basketball at New Trier [Ill.] H.S., where he was named the Chicago Tribune Athlete of the Year in 2000 and holds the distinction of being the program's all-time leading scorer. Lottich graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and currently resides in Valparaiso with his wife, Kylan, and their four children: Grace, Matthan, Christian and Landon.
