Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team continues its challenging slate of non-conference games away from home on Saturday afternoon, as Valpo faces off against West Virginia in a non-bracketed game of the Myrtle Beach Invitational. Valpo is in the midst of a stretch of five out of six games away from home.

Last Time Out: Heading into a holiday known for extra helpings of food, fans at the ARC got an extra helping of basketball Wednesday evening, as Valparaiso and SIUE went into overtime before Valpo out-scored the Cougars 7-2 in the extra period to earn a 75-70 victory. Bakari Evelyn led the way for Valpo with 16 points, 15 of which came after halftime, while Deion Lavender narrowly missed a double-double with 10 points and nine rebounds

Head Coach Matt Lottich: Matt Lottich (42-28) is in his sixth season overall at Valpo and third as head coach in 2018-19. Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-18 and guided the Crusaders through the move to the MVC, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI. In his first year as head coach, Lottich guided Valpo to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in the last six years as he led the Crusaders to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT.

Series Notes: Saturday marks just the second meeting in the all-time series between Valpo and West Virginia. In the only prior matchup, which came in the first round of the Fiesta Bowl Classic in Tucson, Ariz. on Dec. 28, 2001, Valpo out-scored the Mountaineers by 20 points in the second half to earn a 76-57 victory. Milo Stovall led five Valpo players in double figures with 20 points, while Stalin Ortiz recorded five of Valpo's 12 team steals as the Crusaders forced 21 West Virginia turnovers.

- Valpo was selected to finish in seventh place in the MVC preseason poll with 173 points.

- Valpo has finished worse in the final standings than its preseason projection just once in the last eight years.

...looking back at last year

- Valpo went 15-17 in its first season as a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.

- The Brown and Gold posted a 6-12 record in MVC play in a conference which ended the season ranked eighth in the nation in conference RPI.

- The 2017-18 campaign marked the first time in the last eight years that Valpo has not earned a bid to postseason tournament play.

- Sophomore Bakari Evelyn was named to the MVC's All-Newcomer Team, while sophomore Markus Golder earned a spot on the conference's All-Bench Team.

... in the win over SIUE

- Bakari Evelyn tied the game at 68-68 with an elbow jumper with 11 seconds to play in regulation, and Valpo forced a 3-point miss at the buzzer to send the game to overtime.

- Valpo outscored SIUE 7-2 in the extra period.

- Wednesday was just the second overtime game in head coach Matt Lottich's three years as head coach – the Crusaders had lost the previous one in double overtime to Santa Clara at the ARC on Dec. 22, 2016.

All five Valpo starters scored in double figures on Wednesday in a balanced effort, led by a season-high 16 points from Evelyn - 15 of which came after halftime.
Valpo out-scored SIUE from the foul line 21-8, going 21-of-33 versus the Cougars' 8-of-15. Valpo also limited SIUE to just 4-for-21 shooting from the 3-point line.

... at the Myrtle Beach Invitational

- Valpo went 1-2 in Myrtle Beach, finishing the tournament in sixth place.

- Valpo fell 83-71 to Western Kentucky, beat Monmouth 64-53, and dropped a 69-63 decision to Wake Forest.

Javon Freeman scored in double figures for Valpo in all three games, while Deion Lavender handed out at least five assists in all three contests.
Derrik Smits had Valpo's high game of the tournament with a career-best 23 points against Wake Forest - 19 of which came in the second half.

- Smits and Ryan Fazekas shared high scoring honors for the tournament, both averaging 11.3 ppg, while Smits also grabbed a team-high 5.3 rebounds per game.

...looking ahead

- Valpo flies out west on Sunday, heading to Las Vegas for its MWC/MVC Challenge game against UNLV next Wednesday, Nov. 28.

- The Crusaders then have back-to-back home games to kick off the month of December, starting with a 1 p.m. matchup against UC Riverside on Sunday, Dec. 2.

... on the road

- Saturday marks the first of 13 true road games for Valpo in the 2018-19 regular season.

- Valpo went just 3-12 in true road games last season.

- Prior to last year, Valpo had finished above .500 in true road games in four of the last five seasons.

@WVUHoops

- The Mountaineers enter Saturday's game at 2-2 on the season.
- WVU has not played since its Sunday finale in Myrtle Beach.

West Virginia and Valpo both faced off against Monmouth and Western Kentucky in Myrtle Beach, both defeating the former and falling to the latter.
The Mountaineers, who were picked to finish third in the Big 12 preseason poll, have four players averaging in double figures so far this season, led by 14.0 ppg from Lamont West.

Tough Slate Away From Home Continues

- Valpo continues its challenging slate of games away from home in the non-conference portion of the schedule on Saturday afternoon as it faces West Virginia.

- The three-game Myrtle Beach Invitational included games against Conference USA preseason favorite Western Kentucky, as well as Wake Forest out of the ACC.

- Valpo will play four true road games in the non-conference slate - two against Sweet 16 teams from a season ago in West Virginia and Texas A&M, as well as games at UNLV and George Washington.

Taking Extra Time

- Valpo needed five extra minutes to beat SIUE last time out on Wednesday, downing the Cougars 75-70 in overtime.

- Valpo has not gone to overtime in its previous 57 games.

- The overtime win was the first for Valpo since an 80-76 win on Feb. 26, 2016 at Milwaukee.

- Valpo's last overtime win at home prior to Wednesday was a 66-62 victory over Loyola on Feb. 21, 2012.

All-Tournament Honors

- A trio of Crusaders were named to the Honorable Mention All-Tournament Team at the Myrtle Beach Invitational at the tournament's conclusion.

- Ryan Fazekas averaged 11.3 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.

- Deion Lavender posted 9.7 points, 5.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per game, leading the tournament in assists.

- Derrik Smits averaged 11.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game, and had Valpo's top tournament game with a 23-point outing against Wake Forest.

No Freshman Jitters

- Freshman Javon Freeman has enjoyed a strong start to his Valpo career through five games.

- Freeman is the first Valpo freshman to score in double figures in each of the first five games of his career in at least three decades.

- In that time span, only Bryce Drew and Erik Buggs had even started their Valpo career with three consecutive games in double figures.

- Freeman's first game against Concordia University Chicago was the highest-scoring debut by a Valpo freshman in two decades.

- Freeman scored 22 vs. Concordia, the most points by a Valpo freshman in his debut since Lubos Barton scored 27 in a win over South Carolina in November of 1998 - also the last time a Valpo freshman led the team in scoring in his debut.

Distributing the Ball

- Graduate transfer Deion Lavender has been productive early on in his Valpo career getting others involved offensively.

- Lavender is averaging 5.0 assists/game through five games.

- Lavender handed out at least five assists in each of the first four games, including a season-best seven against Western Kentucky.

- Lavender is the first Valpo player in at least three decades to open a season with four consecutive games of five or more assists.

Points Galore

- Fans at the ARC for the season opener saw a number on Valpo's side of the scoreboard which hasn't been seen in over a generation.

- Valpo's 121 points scored were tied for the fourth-most in a single game in program history, matching a Feb. 26, 1974 win over Wabash and a March 1, 1969 victory over Wheaton.

- The last time Valpo scored more than 121 points was in its program-record 138-point outing against Muhlenberg on Dec. 6, 1968.

The 56-point margin of victory was the seventh-highest in program history.Six players finished in double figures in the win, the first time a sextet of Valpo

players has scored 10 or more since an 86-84 win over Oakland on Feb. 19, 2016.

Redshirts Aplenty

- Valpo boasts five players who have redshirted on its active roster entering the 2018-19 season.

- Derrik Smits redshirted due to injury in his first year at Valpo, while Bakari Evelyn and Ryan Fazekas each sat out as a redshirt after transferring from Nebraska and Providence, respectively.

- Deion Lavender and Markus Golder both redshirted before arriving at Valpo as well.

- Only 12 schools nationally have more redshirts on their active roster this year than Valpo's five.

- Valpo also has a pair of Division I transfers in Eron Gordon and Nick Robinson sitting out this season as redshirts as well.

What's Back

 Seven letterwinners return from last year's team, including three starters.
 The returnees are highlighted by MVC All-Newcomer Team honoree Bakari Evelyn and MVC All-Bench Team selection Markus Golder.

- In all, Valpo returns 63.3% of its scoring, 66.6% of its rebounding and 64.1% of its minutes played from last season in 2018-19.

What's New

- Five players have made their Valpo debuts this season.

Valpo's lone senior is a graduate transfer, as Deion Lavender joined the program for his final season of collegiate eligibility after spending the last two years at UAB.
Junior Ryan Fazekas is eligible this year after sitting out last season as a transfer from Providence.

- Valpo welcomed a trio of true freshmen to the fold this year as well: Chicago native Javon Freeman, Winnipeg product Daniel Sackey and a Region representative in Bowman Academy graduate Langston Stalling.

Developing Pros

- Valpo has produced a myriad of professional basketball players over the last 25 years, most notably a pair of NBA players in the last two years.

- Ryan Broekhoff (class of 2013) signed a contract with the Dallas Mavericks in the summer of 2018 after spending five seasons playing internationally in Russia and Turkey.
- Alec Peters (class of 2017) was the 54th pick in the 2017 NBA Draft by the Phoenix Suns.
- Peters appeared in 20 games for the Suns in 2017-18, highlighted by a 36-point performance

in the season finale against Dallas - a new single-game high by a Valpo alum in the NBA. - Peters is currently playing for CSKA Moscow in Russia.

- 2018 Valpo graduates Tevonn Walker and Max Joseph are currently playing for Hamburg Towers in Germany and Nassjo Basket in Sweden, respectively.

- Valpo has now produced 50 pro basketball players over the last 25 years.

The International Flavor

- This year's squad continues the international pipeline that Valpo has cultivated over the past two-plus decades.

- The Crusaders boast a pair of international players on this year's roster.

- Represented are Canada (Sackey) and Spain (Sorolla).

- Over the past 22 years, the Crusaders have welcomed 34 international players from 19 different countries.

Non-Conference Success

Valpo is looking to continue its recent string of successful non-conference play.
The Crusaders have entered conference play with at least 10 victories under their belt in four of the last six years and just missed the mark last year, going 9-4 prior the start of conference play.

- Valpo owns a 63-25 (.716) record in pre-league action dating back to the start of the 2012-13 season.

Deion Lavender

- Lavender narrowly missed a double-double last time out versus SIUE, finishing with 10 points and a game-high nine rebounds.

- Lavender was named Honorable Mention All-Tournament at Myrtle Beach.

- Lavender led all players in the win over Monmouth with 18 points, eight rebounds and five assists.

- Lavender handed out seven assists in Valpo's game against Western Kentucky.

Lavender is a graduate transfer who joins the Valpo program after spending the last two years at UAB.
Lavender led UAB and ranked eighth in Conference USA with 3.4 assists/game in

Lavender led UAB and ranked eighth in Conference USA with 3.4 assists/game in 2016-17, while also ranking ninth in the conference that season in assist/turnover ratio.
 Lavender played as a freshman in the MVC for Southern Illinois (2014-15), averaging 6.6 points/game and raising his scoring average to 8.6 points/game within MVC play.

Bakari Evelyn

Evelyn notched a team-best 16 points - 15 of which came after halftime - and sent Valpo to overtime with a jumper with 11 seconds to play last time out in the win over SIUE.
Evelyn posted 11 points, four rebounds and four assists against Western Kentucky.
Evelyn tallied 12 points, five rebounds and a team-best five assists in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Evelyn was an MVC All-Newcomer Team selection last year.

- Evelyn was the lone Valpo player to start all 32 games and averaged 12.6 points/ game to rank second on the team.

- Evelyn led Valpo with 93 assists and pushed his scoring average to a team-best 14.1 points/game in MVC-only play, connecting at a 42.3% clip from 3-point range against conference opponents.

Markus Golder

Golder paced Valpo with 15 points and eight rebounds versus Western Kentucky.
Golder scored 16 points in just 18 minutes off the bench in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Golder was named to the MVC All-Bench Team last season in his first year at Valpo.

the team with 9.5 points/game.

- Golder paced Valpo with 138 total rebounds on the year, and also led Valpo in both

3-point percentage (42.9%) and free throw percentage (83.1%).

Ryan Fazekas

- Fazekas was named Honorable Mention All-Tournament at Myrtle Beach.

- Fazekas scored in double figures in two of the three tournament games: 14 points vs. WKU, 13 in the win over Monmouth.

- Fazekas debuted with 18 points on 6-of-8 shooting and seven rebounds in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Fazekas has two years of eligibility remaining after sitting out last season following a transfer from Providence.

- Fazekas appeared in 58 games in his two years with the Friars, making 19 starts.

- Fazekas helped lead Marquette Catholic H.S. to the Indiana 1A state championship in 2014 and a repeat appearance in the state title game in 2015.

Jaume Sorolla

- Sorolla has missed Valpo's first five games of the season (ankle).
- Sorolla saw action in 30 games as a sophomore for Valpo, starting 14 times.

- Sorolla averaged 4.9 points and 3.4 rebounds per game as a sophomore and led Valpo with 32 blocked shots.

Derrik Smits

- Smits tallied 10 points and matched his career best with eight rebounds last time out in the win over SIUE.

- Smits was named Honorable Mention All-Tournament at Myrtle Beach.

- Smits led all players against Wake Forest with a career-high 23 points - 19 of which came in the second half - and added seven rebounds as well.

- Smits went 8-of-9 from the floor for 18 points and seven rebounds in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Smits appeared in all 32 games for the Crusaders as a sophomore, making 18 starts - including each of the final 16 games of the year.

- Smits averaged 7.5 points and 3.6 rebounds per game in 2017-18, scoring in double figures 10 times as a sophomore.

Micah Bradford

- Bradford was inactive last time out against SIUE (back).

- Bradford made his season debut against Monmouth.

- Bradford averaged 16.4 minutes/game off the bench as a sophomore for Valpo in 2017-18.

- Bradford scored 5.1 points/game and finished second on the team with 68 assists,

while also posting the team's best assist/turnover ratio (1.79/1).

John Kiser

- Kiser finished with six points and a team-high seven rebounds in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Kiser was awarded a scholarship prior to his sophomore year in 2017-18.

- Kiser averaged 18.2 minutes/game and grabbed 3.7 rebounds/game last season, leading Valpo in rebounds on eight occasions.

Mileek McMillan

McMillan scored seven points against WKU and six points vs. Wake Forest in Myrtle Beach.
McMillan appeared in all 32 games as a freshman for Valpo, starting each of the season's final 18 games.

- McMillan averaged 10.6 minutes/game as a rookie and shot 36.4% from 3-point range for the season.

Javon Freeman

- Freeman posted 11 points, six rebounds and four assists last time out in the win over SIUE.

- Freeman scored in double figures in all three of Valpo's games in Myrtle Beach: 10 versus WKU, 12 against Monmouth and 11 versus Wake Forest.

- Freeman was 7-of-8 from the field and 6-of-8 from the foul line for a game-high 22

- Golder averaged 22.6 minutes/game, mainly off the bench, and finished third on points to go with four assists and three steals in the season-opening win over Concordia.

- Freeman became the first Valpo freshman to lead the team in scoring in a season opener and produced the highest scoring output by a freshman in his debut since Lubos Barton in 1998.

- Freeman finished his senior year fifth in voting for Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois and was a consensus top-10 player in the Illinois Class of 2018.

- Freeman led Whitney Young to the Illinois class 4A state championship in 2017 as a junior and a second straight championship game appearance in 2018.

Daniel Sackey

Sackey debuted with 13 points, four rebounds and three assists off the bench in the season-opening win over Concordia.
 Sackey played his final season of prep basketball for Thornlea Secondary School, earning First Team All-Star honors from the Ontario Scholastic Basketball Association.

- Sackey was selected to the 2018 BioSteel All-Canadian Game, where he won the Slam Dunk Contest leading up to the game.

- Sackey played with the Canadian u17 squad at the 2016 FIBA u17 World Championship in Spain.

Langston Stalling

Stalling knocked down all four of his free throw attempts and grabbed three rebounds in his debut vs. Concordia.
Stalling is a walk-on who is attending Valparaiso University on a Lilly Scholarship after finishing as class valedictorian at Bowman Academy.

- Stalling averaged 18.6 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 2.4 steals as a senior for the Eagles.

Eron Gordon

Gordon is a transfer from Seton Hall who is sitting out the 2018-19 season and will have two seasons of eligiblity remaining.
 Gordon was an Indiana All-Star selection following his senior year at Cathedral H.S. and was a finalist for Indiana's Mr. Basketball award.

- Gordon is the younger brother of Eric Gordon, who is in his 11th season in the NBA.

Nick Robinson

- Robinson is a transfer from Saint Joseph's who is sitting out the 2018-19 season and will have two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- Robinson started 30 times over his two years at St. Joe's and closed his sophomore year strong, averaging 9.5 points and 5.7 rebounds per game in Atlantic 10 play.

- Robinson was a Second Team All-State selection from both the Associated Press and the IBCA as a senior at Kenwood Academy.

Matt Lottich Head Coach 3rd Season * Stanford, 2004

42-28 Overall and at Valpo

Matt Lottich enters his sixth season overall at Valparaiso University and third season as head coach of the men's basketball program entering the 2018-2019 season.

Lottich led Valpo to 15 victories in his second season in charge in 2017-2018 and guided the Crusaders through the move to the Missouri Valley Conference, which ended the campaign ranked eighth nationally in conference RPI.

In his first season at the helm of the Crusader men's basketball program, Lottich guided Valpo to its fifth Horizon League regular season championship in the last six years as he led the Crusaders to 24 wins and an at-large berth into the NIT. Lottich's inaugural season as head coach was highlighted by a home win over a nationally-ranked Rhode Island squad, as well as neutral-site wins over Alabama and BYU to capture the MGM Grand Main Event.

Lottich coached the Horizon League Player of the Year and an NABC Third Team All-American in Alec Peters, guiding the senior as he closed out one of the top careers in program history. Peters enjoyed his finest season as a senior, ranking among the top-20 in the nation in both scoring and rebounding and breaking five of Valpo's career records.

Lottich was hired as the 22nd head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program in April of 2016. Lottich, who had served the previous three seasons as an assistant coach on the Crusaders' staff, became just the program's fifth head coach in the last 36 years.

Lottich arrived at Valparaiso University in summer 2013 and helped guide the Crusaders to 78 victories over his three seasons as an assistant. Valpo won two Horizon League regular season championships and one league tournament title over those three years.

The Crusaders recorded the top two victory totals in program history over Lottich's final two years as an assistant. Valpo broke the previous school record for wins in a season during the 2014-2015 campaign, winning 28 games and earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament. Then, the 2015-2016 season saw Valpo win a program-record 30 games and advance to the NIT championship game at Madison Square Garden.

Lottich brings nearly a decade of professional playing experience to the head coaching position at Valparaiso University. Lottich spent eight years playing professionally in Japan for the Oita Heat Devils and the Osaka Evessa, earning All-Star recognition four times. He also played one season in Germany in the Bundesliga for the Dusseldorf Giants, played one season in New Zealand in the NBL for the Harbor Heat and was a member of the New Jersey Nets' summer league team in 2004.

Lottich played collegiately at Stanford University from 2000 through 2004. As a senior in 2003-2004, he helped lead the Cardinal to the Pac-10 title while earning NABC All-Star plaudits, awarded to the top-15 seniors in college basketball. He was also a member of the Wooden Award midseason watch list and was an Honorable Mention All Pac-10 selection as a senior. Lottich was also a member of the program's conference championship squad as a freshman in 2000-2001 and still ranks among Stanford's single-season and career leaders in 3-pointers made.

Off the court, Lottich came to Valpo from the National Collegiate Scouting Association, where he started in January 2013. Lottich ascended to the position of head scout during his time with the NCSA, which helps high school athletes navigate the world of college recruiting. Lottich also co-founded the TEAM Life Skills basketball camp in 2004 and spent nine years managing and developing the camp.

Lottich played his prep basketball at New Trier [III.] H.S., where he was named the Chicago Tribune Athlete of the Year in 2000 and holds the distinction of being the program's all-time leading scorer. Lottich graduated from Stanford University in 2004 and currently resides in Valparaiso with his wife, Kylan, and their four children: Grace, Matthan, Christian and Landon.






