Next Up in Crusader Basketball: After spending the majority of its Thanksgiving break in picturesque Southern California, the Valpo women's basketball team returns to Northwest Indiana to face Miami (Ohio) at the Athletics-Recreation Center. Wednesday evening's tilt marks the first of five games over the next ten days for the Crusaders.

Last Time Out: The Crusaders dropped both tilts at last weekend's USD-Court-yard San Diego Central Classic. San Diego parlayed a 49-24 rebounding margin into a 76-60 victory over the Brown and Gold at the Jenny Craig Pavilion on Friday. Jasmyn Walker pulled down 13 boards to go with 13 points, but Valpo's unlucky streak continued on Saturday. Northern Colorado's Savannah Scott scored 21 points (6-7 FG, 4-4 3FG, 5-5 FT) to overshadow Hannah Schaub's 15-point (5-7 3FG) effort for Valpo in a 77-63 defeat.

Head Coach Tracey Dorow: Tracey Dorow (23-73) is in her fourth season at the helm of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in 2015-16. She collected her 250th career victory on November 14th, 2014 after a 91-57 defeat of Butler. In her first season, Dorow led the Crusaders to eleven victories overall, including five in Horizon League play. Dorow arrived in Valparaiso after 14 seasons at Ferris State. She compiled a 232-163 record while with the Bulldogs. Furthermore, Ferris State posted the #1 grade point average in all of Division II for the 1999-2000 women's basketball season as well as the #2 ranking in 2002-03.

Series Notes: The RedHawks have won all seven games in a series that began in 1992. Two of the seven tilts have required overtime and another was a one-point contest. Miami (Ohio) trailed 40-39 at halftime in last season's Dec. 3rd meeting in Oxford before rallying for an 82-59 victory. MU's Hannah McCue was 7-of-16 from downtown as part of a 26-point, 15-rebound performance.

Storylines

- Wednesday night will mark the first road game this season for Miami (Ohio).
- Valpo head coach Tracey Dorow and Miami head coach Cleve Wright faced each other seven times when both were at Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) schools. Dorow led Ferris State to a 6-1 record over Wright's Gannon Golden Knights in those games.
- Valpo is last in the Horizon League in rebounding margin at -15.3. Miami paces the MAC with a +10.8 rebounding margin.
- Miami's Jessica Rupright and Valpo's Abby Dean were teammates on the Junior All-Star Core Team following the 2010-11 prep season.
- Miami is the first of two Mid-American Conference (MAC) teams to visit the ARC in December (Akron, Dec. 9).

@ValpoWBB

- In its 44th season, @ValpoWBB is 502-591 all-time (as of Dec. 1st).
- @ValpoWBB has made two NCAA Tournament appearances (2002-03, 2003-04) and earned one WNIT berth (2001-02).
- @ValpoWBB closed out the 2014-15 season slate with a 6-24 overall record, 2-14 in the Horizon League.
- @ValpoWBB was picked to finish 10th in the Horizon League in the 2015-16 Preseason Poll.
- @ValpoWBB's Dani Franklin was a Preseason Second Team All-Horizon League selection.
- @ ValpoWBB returns its three leading scorers (Franklin, Jasmyn Walker, Lexi Miller) in addition to its two top rebounders (Walker, Franklin).
- @ValpoWBB brings back 1,469 points, 767 rebounds, and 4,304 minutes played from the 2014-15 squad.

- Since joining the Horizon League in 2007-08, @ValpoWBB is 44-94 (through end of 2014-15 season).
- @ ValpoWBB has had one First Team All-League selection (Launa Hochstetler, 2008-09) and two Second Team All-League players (Agnieszka Kulaga, 2007-08; Tabitha Gerardot, 2012-13).
- @ValpoWBB also boasts four representatives on the All-New-comer Team (Lauren Kenney, 2008-09; Gerardot, 2010-11; Dani Franklin, 2014-15; Jasmyn Walker, 2014-15), an All-Defensive Team member (Laura Richards, 2011-12), one Freshman of the Year (Franklin, 2014-15), and one Sixth Player of the Year (Franklin, 2014-15).

- @ ValpoWBB defeated Toledo, 63-61, at Savage Arena in December of 2013 to capture the Toledo Invite.

@MiamiOH WBB

- @MiamiOH_WBB was picked to finish 4th in the East Division of the MAC Preseason Poll.
- @MiamiOH_WBB is off to a 3-2 start with victories over Evansville, Austin Peay, and Morehead State.
- @MiamiOH_WBB dropped a 71-57 to Horizon League newcomer Northern Kentucky.
- After facing the Crusaders Wednesday, @MiamiOH_WBB returns home to face Oakland on Friday its third Horizon League opponent in seven games.

- @MiamiOH_WBB's Kristen Levering is averaging 2.0 blocks per game (60th-most in nation).
- @MiamiOH_WBB's Megan Galloway played her freshman season at Detroit before transferring to Oxford in 2014.

@Cleve_Wright

- @Cleve_Wright is in his third season at Miami (Ohio).
- @Cleve_Wright enters Wednesday's game with a 251-147 career coaching record, but an 18-47 mark while at the helm of the RedHawks.
- @Cleve_Wright led D-II Gannon to a 233-100 (.700) record in his 11 seasons there.
- @Cleve_Wright was named Division II National Coach of the Year in 2009-10 after leading the Golden Knights to a Final Four appearance.
- @Cleve_Wright served as the top assistant at Northwestern for three seasons before taking over at Gannon.
- @Cleve_Wright's first collegiate coaching job was as an assistant at Butler.
- @Cleve_Wright oversaw the youngest team in D-I last season (freshmen combined for 53.5% of all minutes played).

- Shot a team-high 85.7% (42-49) from the foul line as a freshman.

Allison Schofield

Jasmyn Walker

Tracey Dorow

Head Coach 4th Season 255-236 overall, 23-73 at Valpo Western Michigan, 1996

Tracey Dorow was named head coach of the Valparaiso women's basketball program in April of 2012.

The 2014-2015 season saw Dani Franklin flourish under Dorow's tutelage. The newcomer averaged 14.0 points per game in just 22.4 minutes of action to earn Horizon League Freshman of the Year honors in addition to Sixth Player of the Year accolades. Fellow rookie Jasmyn Walker was also named to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team after setting a program record for rebounds by a freshman with 250.

Dorow arrived at Valpo after spending 14 seasons as the head coach at Ferris State University, guiding the Bull-dogs to four NCAA Division II Tournament appearances, two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) North Division championships, and four 20-win seasons.

In her 14 seasons at Ferris State, Dorow compiled a 232-163 (.587) record, including a 23-7 mark in 2011-2012 while guiding the Bulldogs to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The all-time winningest coach in FSU history, she led her squad to the Sweet Sixteen in 2007.

The GLIAC Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, Dorow had five players earn a total of seven All-American honors and had seven players tally 10 total All-Region Team accolades. As a prep player, she finished third in the state of Michigan for Miss Basketball in 1990 and was named to the Detroit Free Press All-Decade Team.

Dorow earned her Bachelor of Science degree in education from Western Michigan University in 1996 and her Master of Arts degree from the University of Indianapolis in 2003 in curriculum and instruction. She married her husband, Rob, in August of 2007. The Dorows have two children: Lainie, 6, and Baxter, 4.
