Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will host a home series for the first time this season as St. Bonaventure comes to town for three games this weekend. The Beacons and Bonnies will lock horns in a doubleheader on Friday before concluding the set with a single game on Saturday. Note that the schedule for the weekend was altered due to forecasted cold temperatures for Saturday and Sunday. Since Wednesday's scheduled game vs. Milwaukee was postponed, Friday's doubleheader will mark the home opener and the first-ever web streamed games from Emory G. Bauer Field as the program has added streaming capabilities this season.

Last Time Out: Murray State's unblemished 12-0 home record and the program's longest home winning streak since 1958 came to an end at the hands of Valpo as the Beacons prevailed 7-2 in Game 1 of a doubleheader this past Saturday afternoon. Murray State won Friday's series opener 8-2 and Saturday's nightcap 5-1, but Valpo earned a 6-1 win in Sunday's series finale to garner a road split against the team picked to finish second in the Ohio Valley Conference. The series served as a preview of future Missouri Valley Conference showdowns as the Racers will join the MVC next season. Valpo was slated to play a midweek game on Wednesday vs. Milwaukee, but the contest was postponed due to inclement weather and will be made up as part of a doubleheader on April 5 at Milwaukee.

Following the Beacons: This weekend's games will air on ESPN3 with links to live video and stats available on ValpoAthletics.com. This marks the first season that Valpo baseball features video streaming capabilities for home games. Brian Jennings will have play-by-play for Friday's doubleheader, while Todd Ickow will describe the action on Saturday. Thomas Kithier will serve as the color analyst for all three games in the series.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (159-244), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Talking Schmack: Head coach Brian Schmack moved into third in program history in career games coached on March 13 at SEMO. Schmack's predecessor, Tracy Woodson, was at the helm for 397 contests. During the March 18 game at Murray State, Schmack became the third head coach in program history to work 400 games, joining Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 1011) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 606).

Series Notes: Valpo and St. Bonaventure have faced off on the diamond just once prior to this weekend. That meeting was a 5-4 Valpo victory on March 2, 2013 in Port Charlotte, Fla. That matchup occurred during Tracy Woodson's final seasons leading the program, a year that culminated with an NCAA Regional appearance.

Top 60 RPI: Valpo is rated among the top 60 nationally, according to Rating Percentage Index (RPI). The Beacons are 58th in the RPI through March 22 games, one of three Missouri Valley Conference teams in the top 60. DBU is No. 1 in the RPI and Illinois State is 36th. This marks a significant bump from last season, when Valpo finished the year at 210.

Leading the League: As of March 23, the Valpo pitching staff leads the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks 53rd nationally in strikeouts per nine innings at 10.2. Furthermore, the Beacons lead the league and rank 32nd in the nation with seven triples. Bobby Nowak is the MVC leader with four saves, a number that ranks 21st in the nation, while Colin Fields' 42 strikeouts have him first in the league and 31st nationally. In terms of strikeouts per nine innings, Fields ranks fourth in the nation and leads the MVC at 15.97.

Opening the Home Slate: Valpo will finally lift the lid on the home portion of the season after 16 straight away from home. Here's a look at home opener dates and results during the Brian Schmack Era, during which time the program holds a 3-4 mark in home lidlifters.

Fields Firing: Colin Fields racked up nine strikeouts in his most recent start, a victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 19 at Murray State. He has notched seven or more strikeouts in all five of his starts this season. Fields sent down 11 straight from the second to the sixth in the game against the Racers, settling in after walking five but allowing no runs over the first two frames. He has a league-high 42 strikeouts this season and 192 in his collegiate career. His 42 strikeouts rank tied for 31st nationally. Fields is eight strikeouts away from becoming the 12th player in program history to reach 200.

Through 16 Games: The start of the season is always a challenge for the Beacons, who play a string of true road games against warm-weather competition with little chance to practice outdoors. Valpo's 7-9 record through 16 games represents its best winning percentage at this juncture of the season since 2014.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Murray State (March 18-20)

- Valpo earned a four-game road series split against a team picked to finish second in the Ohio Valley Conference that entered the weekend with an unblemished home mark.
- Jake Miller turned in his best start in a Valpo uniform in Sunday's series finale, racking up nine strikeouts against no walks over seven innings of one-run, three-hit ball. He fanned eight or more for the second straight start, notching his second straight career high in the strikeout department. The seven frames represented the longest outing of his collegiate career to date.
- Valpo pitching issued no walks in Sunday's series finale, the first time this season that has occurred. In fact, it marked the program's first walk-free game on the mound since the 2021 season opener at UAB.
- Kyle Schmack launched a home run on his 21st birthday in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader.
- In Saturday's Game 1 victory, the Beacons outhit Murray State 11-3. The three hits were the fewest permitted by Valpo pitching in a game this season.
- In Saturday's first game, Valpo had two separate instances of sending down 10 or more consecutive Murray State hitters. Colin Fields sent down 11 in a row from the second to the sixth, while Nolan Lebamoff closed out the game by retiring 10 straight Racers.
- In the team's two victories, Valpo had 11 and 12 hits, respectively. The Beacons have now reached a double-figure hit total on six occasions this season.
- Four Valpo players were hit by a pitch in the second game of Sunday's doubleheader, the team's most this year. It was the first time four Valpo players were nailed by a pitch since April 16, 2019 vs. Western Michigan.
- The Beacons belted a season-high four doubles in Sunday's series finale.

In the Other Dugout: St. Bonaventure

- Coming off a series where they were swept in four games at Lehigh this past weekend.
- Under the direction of interim head coach B.J. Salerno, who took over in October for the retiring Larry Sudbrook, who spent the previous 36 seasons as the program's head coach.
- Led by Jagger Nucci, who is hitting .316 in 10 games. Jackson DeJohn is hitting .308 in nine contests. Brendyn Stillman and Pierce Hendershot have driven in a team-high eight runs apiece.
- Rushil Bhat has appeared in six games and owns a 4.32 earned run average over 8 1/3 innings.
- Picked to finish 12th in the 12-team Atlantic 10 Conference after finishing at 7-24 overall and 6-14 in league play a year ago.

Sophomore Jump: Alex Thurston is off to a stellar start to his sophomore season. Thurston's year has featured a sophomore jump rather than a sophomore slump as he has boosted a .158 batting average from last season to .339 in 2022, second on the team. Thurston is reaching base at a .403 clip after he finished his freshman season with a .284 OBP. March 15 at No. 6 Notre Dame, he became the first Valpo player with a double-figure hitting streak this season after two did so a year ago (Kyle Schmack and Kaleb Hannahs). That 10-game hitting streak came to an end on March 18 at Murray State, but he still has a hit in 13 of his last 14 games entering the weekend series vs. St. Bonaventure.

Home Sweet Home

- Although Valpo started the season with its usual long stretch of road games by playing the first 16 contest of the year away from home, there is plenty of home baseball to look forward to this spring.
- Valpo has 19 Emory G. Bauer Field games on the docket. There were 20 prior to weather removing the home opener vs. Milwaukee from the slate. If all 19 are played, it will mark the first time Valpo has played that many times on its home field since 2016.
- Furthermore, over the last five seasons, Valpo hasn't had more than 15 home games completed in a single year.
- The chance to play at home with regularity is good news for Brian Schmack's squad, as the team went 7-6 at home last season to finish with a winning home record for the fifth time in the last six seasons and the 12th time in the last 14 campaigns.

Strong Start: The start of the season is never easy for Valpo, a cold-weather team that begins the calendar each year with a lengthy string of road games, mostly against warm-weather competition. This year, Valpo withstood those early-season challenges to put together the program's best record through eight games since 1999. That season, Valpo also started 5-3, but had the benefit of starting the season with five neutral-site games in Florida. This year, the Beacons have played exclusively true road games entering the March 23 home opener vs. Milwaukee. Prior to dropping all three March 12-13 at Ohio Valley Conference preseason favorite SEMO, Valpo had won five of its previous six games, a stretch that included the program's first four-game winning streak since late in the 2019 season against Southern Illinois and Chicago State. This year's four-game winning streak was the program's longest that came in all true road games since March 2014 (two at Texas A&M CC, one at Chicago State, one at UIC).

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The

15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.

- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.

- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.

- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzwow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.

- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.

- **Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf:** "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.

- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).

- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.

- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.

- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Hannahs Honored for Freshman Feats

• Sophomore Kaleb Hannahs carried a 20-game on-base streak with him into the start of the 2022 season.

• He was named the 2021 MVC Freshman of the Year, an All-MVC Second Team honoree, the Valparaiso University co-Male Newcomer of the Year (ARC Awards) and a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

• Hannahs became the first Valpo player to collect MVC Freshman of the Year honors, and joined Jon Tieman (2017) and Spencer Mahoney (2012) as the three Valpo players who have earned Freshman All-American status from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

• The third baseman led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389). He became the first rookie to pace the squad in hitting since Spencer Mahoney in 2012.

Pitching Profiles – Projected Starters

• **#36 RHP Trent Turzenski (So., Burlington, Wis. / Burlington)** – Ranked seventh in the MVC in ERA and 11th in opponents' batting average (.236) as a freshman in 2020... Ranked No. 18 on D1Baseball.com's 2020 list of the Top 50 freshmen pitchers in the nation based on analytics... Had a team-best 2.48 ERA in 2020 over four games out of the bullpen... Played in the Little League World Series Regional Tournament on ESPN twice, when he was 11 and 12 years old... Followed the Colin Fields no-hitter with a strong pitching performance of his own in Game 2 of the March 13, 2021 doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, going seven innings to pick up the victory while allowing two runs on three hits and one walk with eight strikeouts... Earned the win on May 2, 2021 vs. Illinois State by scattering seven hits and walking none over four innings of one-run relief... Pitched an eight-inning complete game and allowed just two runs on five hits while striking out six in a tough-luck defeat as Valpo fell 2-1 at Missouri State in the May 22, 2021 regular-season finale... Made an MVC Tournament start and worked four frames on May 28, 2021 vs. host Southern Illinois... Throwing more strikes and has seen an uptick in velocity entering 2022... Rated the No. 30 2022 MLB Draft prospect among Missouri Valley Conference players by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Tossed a seven-inning complete game on Feb. 25 at Alabama A&M, allowing two runs that both came over the first two frames. He earned the victory in Valpo's 9-2 triumph after allowing two runs on five hits while walking two and striking out seven... Earned his second win of the season on March 4 at Omaha by allowing two runs (none earned) on five hits over six innings... Allowed eight runs (seven earned) on eight hits, four walks and six strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings on March 12 at SEMO, an elite offensive club. Half of the runs he permitted came on the final pitch he threw, a grand slam.

• **#25 RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)** – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2021 season with 81 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen in 2015... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first

since 1992 on March 13, 2021 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three strikeouts) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0. That outing earned Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year at the end-of-season ARC Awards... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27, 2021... Rated the No. 15 2022 draft prospect in the MVC by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Struck out eight while permitting four hits over six shutout innings in his first start of the season on Feb. 19 at Memphis, exiting in position for the win... Limited Alabama A&M to two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out seven over five innings to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25... Posted his fifth career double-figure strikeout total by fanning 10 in five innings of Valpo's 7-5 win at Omaha on March 5.
