Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The first of back-to-back home weekends for the Valparaiso University baseball team is up next for the Beacons, who welcome perennial Missouri Valley Conference powerhouse Dallas Baptist to Emory G. Bauer Field for a three-game series. DBU will make its first trip to Northwest Indiana since Valpo's inaugural MVC campaign in 2018.

Recently in Valpo Baseball: After dropping a 4-0 pitchers' duel in the series opener and a 15-12 slugfest in the middle game, Valpo held on for an 11-10 victory over host Southern Illinois in the third and final game of a weekend series in Carbondale. The win came over a team that entered the day tied atop the Missouri Valley Conference standings. Valpo was competitive in all three games, outpitching the Salukis 11-8 in the Friday game before owning a seven-run lead in the eventual Saturday setback. The victorious series finale saw Valpo put up crooked numbers in four of the first five innings.

Following the Beacons: All three games this weekend will air on ESPN3. Todd Ickow will have the play-by-play for all three games. He'll be joined in the booth by Sam Michel on Friday and Saturday before Brian Jennings joins Todd for Sunday's series finale. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com. Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (166-260), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: DBU has won 14 of the 17 all-time matchups between the two teams including all five matchups last year, sweeping four regular-season games in Dallas before also winning a conference tournament matchup. DBU has won nine straight in the series since a memorable 13-10 Valpo victory to begin the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. That was the second win over DBU during Valpo's inaugural MVC campaign.

Tucker's Tear: Second baseman Nolan Tucker has been on an offensive tear of late, leading to him being named the Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week on Monday, May 2. Tucker posted a robust .667 batting average in a three-game weekend series at Southern Illinois and an overall average of .563 over four games this week. He went 8-for-12 in a road series with the Salukis while driving in four runs and scoring three times. Three of his eight hits in the series went for extra bases. Tucker ranks among the Missouri Valley Conference leaders in batting average (.387, fourth), slugging percentage (.548, 13th) and on-base percentage (.454, seventh) and leads the team in

all three slash line categories. In MVC-only action, he owns a .419 batting average that ranks third in the league. This marks a noteworthy turnaround for Tucker, who entered the season as a .188 career hitter over two injury-riddled seasons. Weekly awards can be hard to come by in such a strong baseball conference, as this marks the team's first weekly award of the season and just the third Player of the Week honor since joining The Valley (Sam Shaikin, Kaleb Hannahs).

In the Other Dugout: DBU

- Preseason favorite to win the league as defending league champions that reached NCAA Super Regionals last season and won a super regional game.
- Have dropped two of three in three consecutive MVC series, losing sets to Southern Illinois, Bradley and Illinois State.
- Cole Moore and Luke Heefner lead the offense with batting averages over .300.
- Sons of three of the eight MVC head coaches will be involved in this series in Luke Heefner, Kyle Schmack and Kaleb Hannahs.

Five-Hit Output: Alex Thurston posted five hits in the April 29 series opener at Southern Illinois, becoming the first Valpo player with a five-hit game since Scott Kapers on May 8, 2018 at Western Michigan. Thurston became just the third Beacon with four or more hits in a game this season, joining Kaleb Hannahs and Nolan Tucker. The following day, in the April 30 middle game at SIU, Tucker lashed out four hits and was a homer away from the natural cycle after recording a single, double and triple in that order in his first three plate appearances. Tucker became the first Beacon with multiple four-hit games this year.

Nowak Nailing It Down: Bobby Nowak nailed down his eighth save of the season in Sunday's 11-10 victory at Southern Illinois, moving to within one save of cracking the single-season Top 5 in the program record book. Nowak now owns Valpo's highest single-season save total since 2014, when Karch Kowalczyk had 11. In addition, Nowak now ranks tied for ninth in program history in career saves despite being in his first season at Valpo. Furthermore, Nowak moved into a tie for the Missouri Valley Conference lead with his eighth save of the year.

Notes Wrapping Up SIU (April 29- May 1)

- Valpo was shut out in a 4-0 loss in the series opener despite achieving 11 hits. However, only one of the 11 knocks went for extra bases and the Beacons stranded 13 on base.
- The Beacons boasted their highest run total of the season in Game 2 of the series with the Salukis, but it still came in a setback as SIU rallied from an 11-4 fourth-inning deficit to win 15-12. The 12 runs were Valpo's most in a game since May 1 of last season, a 17-13 victory vs. Illinois State. It marked the team's highest scoring output in a road game since 18 at Western Michigan on May 8, 2018.
- The dozen runs in the middle game of the series marked the program's highest run total in a loss since March 2, 2018, a 14-13 loss to CSUN in Phoenix.

- After recording just one extra-base hit in the series opener, Valpo notched seven extra-base knocks in Game 2 of the series.
- Jake Kapers started all three games behind the plate, seeing his first defensive action this season. He launched his first collegiate home run in the middle game of the series.
- Kapers was not the only Beacon to blast his first collegiate big fly in the series, as Alex Ryan followed suit in Sunday's series finale.
- Eight of the nine batters in the Valpo lineup had at least one hit in Sunday's series finale.
- Eight of Valpo's 11 runs on Sunday came with two outs.
- After posting crooked numbers in three of the first four innings on Saturday, Valpo did so in four of the first five frames on Sunday.
- Valpo improved to 3-3 in one-run games and 6-7 in games decided by two runs or fewer by virtue of the 11-10 win in the series finale.
- The Saturday and Sunday games marked the first time Valpo produced a double-figure run total in back-to-back contests this season. In fact, those were the team's two highest single-game run outputs this year. Valpo reached double figures in the hit column in all three games in the series, the second time they've done that this season (at UIC).
- Nolan Tucker hit .667 (8-for-12) during the three-game series.
- Brady Renfro extended his on-base streak to 14 by reaching base in all three games in the series.

200-Hit Pace: Sophomore Kaleb Hannahs collected his 100th career hit during the April 23-24 series against Missouri State, putting him well on pace to reach the 200-hit milestone by the end of his collegiate career. If he eventually reaches that threshold, he would become just the 11th player in program history and first since Spencer Mahoney in 2015 with 200 career hits. Chase Dawson came close in 2019, but finished his career with 199 hits. Hannahs reached the 100-hit milestone during Saturday's doubleheader vs. Missouri State, when he had two hits in each game. Kyle Schmack, also a sophomore in terms of eligibility but in his third year in the program due to the COVID year, achieved his 100th career hit on April 30 at SIU.

A Look at the Leaderboards: Valpo ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference in strikeouts per nine innings at 9.6 and strikeout-to-walk ratio at 2.40. Bobby Nowak ranks 27th nationally and tied for first in The Valley with eight saves. Colin Fields leads the MVC and ranks 15th in the nation with 91 strikeouts. He leads the MVC and ranks fifth nationally with 14.20 strikeouts per nine innings. Jake Miller ranks fourth in the MVC in strikeouts per nine innings at 11.27. Nolan Tucker ranks fourth in the league in hitting at .387 and seventh in on-base percentage at .454. Fields is sixth in the league in ERA at 3.75. Kyle Schmack is tied for fifth in The Valley with eight stolen bases.

Seeking Support: Since the injury to Trent Turzenski that prompted Colin Fields to be moved to Game 1 in the weekend rotation, Valpo has not scored a single run of support during Fields' four starts. In part due to facing off with the aces of other MVC teams, Fields has had tough luck in terms of run support. Valpo has not scored in the righty's last 22 innings on the mound.

Fields on the Single-Season Strikeout List: Colin Fields struck out nine on April 29 at SIU, his 10th time in 11 starts with seven strikeouts

or more this season. That lifted his season strikeout total to 91. Fields has already notched the team's highest single-season strikeout total since Dalton Lundeen's 94 in 2015. Fields is well positioned to become the first Valpo hurler to rack up 100 strikeouts in a single season since Bryce Shafer in 2010. To crack the top five in single-season program history, he needs to get to 103 strikeouts for the season. Three of the current top five single-season strikeout totals in program history came in 1972 or earlier.

Fields on the Career Strikeout List: After becoming the 12th player in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts on March 25 at St. Bonaventure, Valpo starting pitcher Colin Fields unlocked another achievement on April 1 at UIC, cracking the program's career top 10. He did so in resounding fashion, fanning a career-high 13 to usurp Chuck Donley (212, 1991-1995) for 10th in program history. Furthermore, the 13 strikeouts marked the most by a Valpo pitcher in a single game since April 12, 2011, when Jon Gulbrandsen reached that same number in a game against Chicago State. Fields turned in another gem to start MVC play on April 9 vs. Indiana State, logging six scoreless innings of five-hit ball while striking out eight. He now has 241 career strikeouts, a number that ranks eighth in program history. He needs three more strikeouts to tie his former teammate Jon Tieman for seventh on the program's all-time strikeout list.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.

- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.
- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- **Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf:** "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).
- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total

of 10 newcomers.

- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Pitching Profiles – Projected Starters

- **#25 RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)**
– Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2021 season with 81 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen in 2015... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13, 2021 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three strikeouts) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0. That outing earned Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year at the end-of-season ARC Awards... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27, 2021... Rated the No. 15 2022 draft prospect in the MVC by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Struck out eight while permitting four hits over six shutout innings in his first start of the season on Feb. 19 at Memphis, exiting in position for the win... Limited Alabama A&M to two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out seven over five innings to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25... Posted his fifth career double-figure strikeout total by fanning 10 in five innings of Valpo's 7-5 win at Omaha on March 5. He gave up five hits and allowed three runs in 4 1/3 innings to take no decision... Struck out eight batters over just 3 1/3 innings while allowing six runs (four earned) on five hits and walking five in Game 1 of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO. That marked his fourth straight start with seven or more strikeouts... Earned the victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 19 at Murray State, ending the Racers' longest home winning streak since 1958 by handing them their first home loss of the season. He recovered after walking five in the first two innings – four of which came on full counts – and did not permit a walk for the remainder of his outing while sending down 11 straight from the second to the sixth. He totaled nine strikeouts, his fifth straight start with seven or more, and allowed two runs on just two hits in five frames... Became the 12th pitcher in program history to reach the 200-strikeout milestone on March 25 in Game 2 of a doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure, doing so by fanning 10 over five shutout innings of two-hit, two-walk baseball to earn the win and improve to 3-0... Logged seven dazzling innings of two-run, two-hit ball while striking out a career-high 13 and walking three to improve to 4-0 in an 8-3 victory at UIC in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 1. He became the first Valpo hurler to

strike out 13 in a game since 2011 and climbed into the program's all-time top-10 in career strikeouts... Logged six scoreless innings of five-hit ball while striking out eight in the MVC opener on April 9 vs. Indiana State. That outing came against a team that entered the game leading the MVC and ranking 16th nationally in batting average. He jumped two more places on the program's career strikeout list, advancing to eighth in program history... Drilled his first collegiate home run, a three-run bomb, in Game 1 of a March 25 doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure... Had a career-high three hits on March 29 vs. Purdue Fort Wayne... Had two hits on April 5 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Milwaukee, accounting for half of the team's hits in that contest... Homered in both games of the April 10 doubleheader vs. Indiana State, launching

his second and third home runs of the season. He drove in four in the nightcap, becoming just the second Valpo player with a four-RBI game this season.

They all fit the profile of what we're looking for to keep the team rolling. We're excited about this class as a whole. They are pumped to compete in the MVC and continue to take us to the next level. I would like to thank our assistant coaches who have played a vital role in finding these players. Inside the Assistants: Top assistant Kory Winter returns to head coach Brian Schmack's staff this season, while assistant coach Mitchell Boe has joined the fold.
