**Next Up in Valpo Baseball:** The Valparaiso University baseball team holds a winning record through five games, all against warm-weather competition, and will look to sustain the early-season success with this weekend's four-game series at Omaha. The Beacons enter the weekend riding a three-game winning streak. This represents the lone scheduled four-game set this year.

**Last Time Out:** Valpo enjoyed a doubleheader sweep of Alabama A&M on Friday, Feb. 25, overcoming an early deficit to win 9-2 in Game 1 before holding on to an early lead to win 3-2 in Game 2. That proved to be the extent of the series, as Sunday's scheduled finale was washed away by rain. In Game 1, Angel DiFederico had three hits including two triples, while Alex Thurston also enjoyed a three-hit contest. Their efforts came in support of Trent Turzenski, who fired a seven-inning complete game to earn the victory while allowing two runs on five hits and two walks in a game where he fanned seven. Valpo got another quality pitching performance in the nightcap, as Colin Fields yielded just two runs, both coming on a home run, over five solid innings of four-hit, seven-strike-out ball. Nathan Chasey and Bobby Nowak came on to work scoreless frames in relief. Kyle Schmack had a double and a two-run homer to pace the offense.

**Head Coach Brian Schmack:** Brian Schmack, the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2022 campaign, he has served as the head coach for 387 games at Valpo, the fourth-most in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total of 152 ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

**Series Notes:** Valpo will face a first-time opponent for the second consecutive weekend as these two teams have never squared off on the baseball diamond.

**Strong Start:** Valpo owns a three-game winning streak, all in road games against warm-weather competition. This marks the team's longest winning streak since rapping off four straight late in the 2019 season vs. SIU and Chicago State. Valpo boasts a 3-2 mark through five games, the team's best record at this early stage in the season since 2014. The doubleheader sweep of the Bulldogs marked the program's first since April 23 of last season vs. SIU. This is the first time Valpo has won three straight with all of them coming on the road since April 13-20, 2018 at Michigan State, No. 25 Illinois and Evansville. If the Beacons take Friday's series opener at Omaha, they will have four wins in their first six games, which would be their best six-game start since 2009.

**Triple the Triples:** In Game 1 of the Feb. 25 doubleheader at Alabama A&M, Valpo had three triples in a single game for the first time since May 21, 2016 vs. Youngstown State. Angel DiFederico was responsible for two of them, while Alex Ryan had the other. DiFederico entered the day with one triple in 41 career games, a total that he tripled in a single seven-inning contest. Furthermore, DiFederico became the first Valpo player with a multiple-triple game since Andy Burns on April 6, 2013 vs. UIC. In addition, he became just the fourth player nationally with a two-triple game this season.

**Going the Distance:** Trent Turzenski delivered a seven-inning complete game in Game 1 of Valpo's road doubleheader sweep at Alabama A&M on Feb. 25, earning the win in a 9-2 triumph for the Beacons. Turzenski became the first Valpo hurler to toss a complete game since, well, himself on May 22 of last season, an eight-inning effort against Missouri State. He scattered just five hits and two walks while striking out seven and permitting only two earned runs in the game against the Bulldogs. He did not allow any runs over the final five frames. Opponents hit just .208 against Turzenski in the contest.

**Close Calls:** It didn't take long for Valpo to play its first one-run game of 2022, a 4-3 setback that came on a walk-off hit in the middle game of the opening weekend series at Memphis on Feb. 19. Valpo garnered its first one-run win of the year on Feb. 25 at Alabama A&M as Bobby Nowak improved to 2-for-2 in save chances to preserve a 3-2 triumph by striking out the side in the ninth. Last season, Valpo competed in 15 one-run games, posting a 7-8 record in such contests. The team played 10 affairs decided by the slimmest of margins in Missouri Valley Conference play alone a year ago.

### In the Other Dugout: Omaha

- Own a victory over a nationally-ranked opponent this season thanks to a 9-4 win at No. 21 UCLA on Feb. 23.
- Swept by USC Feb. 25-27, but all three games were decided by three runs or fewer and the series opener required 12 innings.
- Won the 2019 Summit League title and made an NCAA Regional appearance.
- Picked third of seven in the Summit League preseason poll.
- Returning first team all-conference selection Mike Boeve hit a team-best .319 last year. He's hitting a robust .419 through eight games, once again pacing the squad.

### A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's

top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.

- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.

- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.

- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

## Home Sweet Home

- Although Valpo starts the season with its usual long stretch of road games by playing the first 17 contest of the year away from home, there is plenty of home baseball to look forward to this spring.

- Valpo has 20 Emory G. Bauer Field games on the docket. If all 20 are played, it will mark the first time Valpo has played 20 times on its home field since 2016.

- Furthermore, over the last five seasons, Valpo hasn't had more than 15 home games completed in a single year.

- The chance to play at home with regularity is good news for Brian Schmack's squad, as the team went 7-6 at home last season to finish with a winning home record for the fifth time in the last six seasons and the 12th time in the last 14 campaigns.

## Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.

- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.

- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.

- **Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf:** "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

## Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.

- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).

- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.

- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.

- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

## Hannahs Honored for Freshman Feats

• Sophomore Kaleb Hannahs carries a 20-game on-base streak with him into the start of the 2022 season.

• He was named the 2021 MVC Freshman of the Year, an All-MVC Second Team honoree, the Valparaiso University co-Male Newcomer of the Year (ARC Awards) and a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

• Hannahs became the first Valpo player to collect MVC Freshman of the Year honors, and joined Jon Tieman (2017) and Spencer Mahoney (2012) as the three Valpo players who have earned Freshman All-American status from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

• The third baseman led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389). He became the first rookie to pace the squad in hitting since Spencer Mahoney in 2012.

• **#36 RHP Trent Turzanski (So., Burlington, Wis. / Burlington)** – Ranked seventh in the MVC in ERA and 11th in opponents' batting average (.236) as a freshman in 2020... Ranked No. 18 on D1Baseball.com's 2020 list of the Top 50 freshmen pitchers in the nation based on analytics... Had a team-best 2.48 ERA in 2020 over four games out of the bullpen... Played in the Little League World Series Regional Tournament on ESPN twice, when he was 11 and 12 years old... Followed the Colin Fields no-hitter with a strong pitching performance of his own in Game 2 of the March 13, 2021 doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, going seven innings to pick up the victory while allowing two runs on three hits and one walk with eight strikeouts... Earned the win on May 2, 2021 vs. Illinois State by scattering seven hits and walking none over four innings of one-run relief... Pitched an eight-inning complete game and allowed just two runs on five hits while striking out six in a tough-luck defeat as Valpo fell 2-1 at Missouri State in the May 22, 2021 regular-season finale... Made an MVC Tournament start and worked four frames on May 28, 2021 vs. host Southern Illinois... Throwing more strikes and has seen an uptick in velocity entering 2022... Rated the No. 30 2022 MLB Draft prospect among

Tossed a seven-inning complete game on Feb. 25 at Alabama A&M, allowing two runs that both came over the first two frames. He earned the victory in Valpo's 9-2 triumph after allowing two runs on five hits while walking two and striking out seven.

• **#25 RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville)** – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2021 season with 81 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen in 2015... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13, 2021 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three strikeouts) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0. That outing earned Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year at the end-of-season ARC Awards... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27, 2021... Rated the No. 15 2022 draft prospect in the MVC by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Struck out eight while permitting four hits over six shutout innings in his first start of the season on Feb. 19 at Memphis, exiting in position for the win... Limited Alabama A&M to two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out seven over five innings to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25.

• **#29 LHP Jake Miller, So. (Chester, N.Y. / Don Bosco Prep)** – Was a 2018 Rawlings Perfect Game Preseason All-American... Is just the second Valpo player to hail from the state of New York since 2005, joining Zack Leone... Redshirted in 2020 before seeing action in 11 games out of the Valpo bullpen in 2021... Earned a well-deserved win on a hitter-friendly day in his season debut on Feb. 20 at Memphis, bouncing back from a rough first inning to log five innings of three-run ball while scattering seven hits, walking one and striking out six.

• **#14 Angel DiFederico, C, So. (New Haven, Ind. / New Haven)** – Earned a spot in the 2019 North/South All-Star Game after his senior year at New Haven in Indiana... Had the highest batting average on the team in a limited sample size in 2020, hitting .348 in seven games (six starts)... Drove in four and posted a .455 batting average during Valpo's series win over SIU (April 23-25, 2021)... Led the team in league-only batting average at .313 in his 19 MVC games (18 starts) in 2021, reaching base at a .387 clip in MVC play... Hit two triples in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25 at Alabama A&M, the first two-triple game by a Valpo player since Andy Burns on April 6, 2013 vs. UIC.

• **#15 Kaleb Hannahs, 3B, So. (West Terre Haute, Ind. / West Vigo)** – 2021 MVC Freshman of the Year, Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American, All-MVC Second Team and Valparaiso University co-Male Newcomer of the Year (ARC Awards)... In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, both of Valpo's starting corner infielders are the sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Civil engineering major... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Had a career-high five RBIs in the first game of a doubleheader at Butler on March 27, 2021 and finished the day with five hits, three runs scored, three RBIs and three walks over the two games... Earned MVC Player of the Week on May 3 after posting a slash line .556/.636/.667 over five games during the week... Led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389) in 2021, becoming the first rookie to pace the team

in batting average since Spencer Mahoney in 2012... Finished the 2021 season on a 20-game on-base streak... Had a team-high 15 multi-hit games in 2021 including three three-hit outputs and a season-high four hits in Game 1 of a May 1 doubleheader vs. Illinois State... • **#27 Kyle Schmack, 1B, So. (Wanatah, Ind. / South Central)** – After graduating from nearby South Central High School in 2019, Kyle joined his father Brian's program at Valpo... Is the first Valpo student-athlete to play for his or her parent as a head coach since Bryce Drew in 1998... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season...
