Next Up in Valpo Baseball: For the first time this season, the Valparaiso University baseball team will compete in a midweek game on Tuesday as the Beacons make their way to Notre Dame, Ind. to battle the nationally-ranked Fighting Irish. This marks the first of two matchups this season between these two teams, both at Frank Eck Stadium. Notre Dame won all three meetings last season, but Valpo played all competitive games against the top-25 Irish.

Last Time Out: SEMO slugged 10 home runs in this past weekend's three-game series in Cape Girardeau, Mo., taking advantage of a wind that was carrying balls to right. The Beacons took an early lead by scoring in the top of the first in every game of the series, but the host Redhawks, the defending Ohio Valley Conference champions and this year's preseason favorites, rallied to win each contest. Valpo dropped the first two games 9-1 and 16-6 before SEMO prevailed 10-8 in a seesaw series finale. The game was tied as late as the eighth, but SEMO's fifth long ball of the contest propelled the hosts to the series sweep.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (157-241), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. Entering the 2022 campaign, he has served as the head coach for 387 games at Valpo, the fourthmost in program history with Tracy Woodson third at 397. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total of 152 ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Talking Schmack: Head coach Brian Schmack moved into third in program history in career games coached on Sunday at SEMO. He enters Tuesday at Notre Dame having skippered 398 Valpo games. Schmack's predecessor, Tracy Woodson, was at the helm for 397 contests. This coming weekend at Murray State, Schmack will become the third head coach in program history to work 400 games, joining Paul Twenge (1988-2006, 1011) and Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 606).

Series Notes: Notre Dame leads the all-time series 79-21 as the two teams have faced off exactly 100 times in a set that dates all the way back to 1958. Each of the last five matchups have been decided by three runs or fewer, but Valpo has dropped 11 straight head-to-head meetings since a 7-4 triumph on May 2, 2012. Valpo had then No. 8 Notre Dame on the ropes on May 11 of last season at Emory G. Bauer Field as the Beacons led 3-0 through seven, but the Fighting Irish rallied for a seven-run eighth to win 7-4. The two teams faced off three times a year ago with Notre Dame winning the other two matchups 6-3 and 8-7 at Frank Eck Stadium.

Valpo vs. Ranked Foes: Valpo will take on a nationally-ranked opponent for the first time this season after seven matchups with nationally-ranked competition last season. Valpo went 0-7 in those games, three of which came against Notre Dame and four against Indiana State. In the last decade, the program has Top-25 wins over No. 25 Illinois (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).

Pitching Probable: RHP#8 Zach Fricke, Jr. (Arlington Heights, Ill. / Buffalo Grove)

- Valpo prevailed in each of his final three starts of the season in 2021 before he missed the end of the season with an injury.
- Led the team in victories as a freshman in 2019 (3).
- During a three-game stretch late in the 2019 season, he made starts against Evansville, Bradley and Southern Illinois and posted a combined 3-0 record with a 2.14 ERA and opponents hitting .214 against him.
- Will make his second start of the season after taking the defeat in Game 2 of a double-header on March 4 at Omaha. He was charged with five runs on four hits and one walk while striking out two in 2 1/3 innings.
- Favorite food is fettuccine, movie is 21 Jump Street, pro baseball team is the Chicago White Sox, MLB player is Dansby Swanson, musical group is Logic and TV show is Hawaii Five-O.

Hannahs Stays Hot: After collecting three hits in each game of the March 13 double-header at SEMO, Hannahs has produced multiple hits in seven of his first 11 games this season. In addition, he has already racked up four three-hit contests. The sophomore third baseman leads the Missouri Valley Conference in batting average at .463 and on-base percentage at .549 while ranking second in slugging percentage at .829. He has drilled four home runs in 11 games this season, surpassing his season total of three from his entire rookie campaign (51 games). Entering Tuesday at Notre Dame, Hannahs has reached base safely in 10 consecutive games.

Sophomore Jump: Hannahs isn't the only Beacon who has avoided the sophomore slump, as Alex Thurston is off to a stellar start to his sophomore season. Thurston's year has featured a jump rather than a slump as he has boosted a .158 batting average from last season to .378 in 2022 (currently eighth in the MVC). Thurston is reaching base at a .439 clip after he finished his freshman season with a .284 OBP. Entering Tuesday at Notre Dame, Thurston possesses a nine-game hitting streak, trying to become the first Valpo player with a double-figure hitting streak this season after two did so a year ago (Kyle Schmack and Kaleb Hannahs).

Strikeout Success: Colin Fields struck out eight in just 3 1/3 innings in the second game of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO, lifting his season total to 33 and his career total to 183. He has struck out seven or more in all four of his starts this season. Fields leads the MVC in strikeouts this year. He is just 17 away from becoming the 12th pitcher in program history to reach 200.

Close Calls Continuing: Last season, Valpo competed in 15 one-run games, posting a 7-8 mark in such contests. The team had 10 affairs decided by the slimmest of margins in Missouri Valley Conference play alone. This year, the trend of close games has continued. Six of Valpo's first 11 games have been decided by two runs or fewer, with the Beacons holding a 4-2 mark in those outings.

Strong Start: The start of the season is never easy for Valpo, a cold-weather team that begins the calendar each year with a lengthy string of road games, mostly against warm-weather competition. This year, Valpo withstood those early-season challenges to put together the program's best record through eight games since 1999. That season,

Valpo also started 5-3, but had the benefit of starting the season with five neutral-site games in Florida. This year, the Beacons have played exclusively true road games. Prior to dropping all three March 12-13 at Ohio Valley Conference preseason favorite SEMO, Valpo had won five of its previous six games, a stretch that included the program's first four-game winning streak since late in the 2019 season against Southern Illinois and Chicago State. This year's four-game winning streak was the program's longest that came in all true road games since March 2014 (two at Texas A&M CC, one at Chicago State, one at UIC).

In the Other Dugout: Notre Dame

- Ranked No. 6 by D1Baseball.com as of Monday, March 14 and also ranked in the Top 10 in the latest Baseball Newspaper, USA Today Coaches' and Baseball America polls.
- Won both games this past weekend on the road against No. 17 NC State in an abbreviated two-game series to open ACC play.
- Hold a nine-game winning streak after a Feb. 20 5-4 loss to Delaware in DeLand, Fla.
- Will play their home opener on Tuesday.
- Finished the 2021 season at 34-13 including a 25-10 mark in ACC play. Won the South Bend Regional before falling to Mississippi State in three games in the Starkville Super Regional.
- Led in hitting by Carter Putz, who holds a .372 average to go along with a team-high 13 RBIs.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that

game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.

- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Home Sweet Home

- Although Valpo starts the season with its usual long stretch of road games by playing the first 17 contest of the year away from home, there is plenty of home baseball to look forward to this spring.
- Valpo has 20 Emory G. Bauer Field games on the docket. If all 20 are played, it will mark the first time Valpo has played 20 times on its home field since 2016.
- Furthermore, over the last five seasons, Valpo hasn't had more than 15 home games completed in a single year.
- The chance to play at home with regularity is good news for Brian Schmack's squad, as the team went 7-6 at home last season to finish with a winning home record for the fifth time in the last six seasons and the 12th time in the last 14 campaigns.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf: "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse

(11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).

- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.
- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Hannahs Honored for Freshman Feats

- Sophomore Kaleb Hannahs carried a 20-game on-base streak with him into the start of the 2022 season.
- He was named the 2021 MVC Freshman of the Year, an All-MVC Second Team honoree, the Valparaiso University co-Male Newcomer of the Year (ARC Awards) and a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.
- Hannahs became the first Valpo player to collect MVC Freshman of the Year honors, and joined Jon Tieman (2017) and Spencer Mahoney (2012) as the three Valpo players who have earned Freshman All-American status from Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.
- The third baseman led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389). He became the first rookie to pace the squad in hitting since Spencer Mahoney in 2012.

In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, both of Valpo's starting corner infielders are the sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Civil engineering major... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Had a career-high five RBIs in the first game of a doubleheader at Butler on March 27, 2021 and finished the day with five hits, three runs scored, three RBIs and three walks over the two games... Earned MVC Player of the Week on May 3 after posting a slash line .556/.636/.667 over five games during the week... Led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389) in 2021, becoming the first rookie to pace the team in batting average since Spencer Mahoney in 2012... Finished the 2021 season on a 20-game on-base streak... Had a team-high 15 multi-hit games in 2021 including three three-hit outputs and a season-high four hits in Game 1 of a May 1 doubleheader vs. Illinois State... Started his freshman season with a .200 average over the first 11

games before hitting .336 over his last 36 regular-season contests while posting a .434 on-base percentage in that time... Listed by D1Baseball.com as the No. 3 prospect in the Missouri Valley Conference for the 2023 MLB Draft... Has gotten stronger over the offseason leading into his sophomore season... Had three of Valpo's five hits on Feb. 19 at Memphis... Enjoyed the first two-homer game of his collegiate career on Feb. 20, helping Valpo to a 10-8 victory in the series finale at Memphis. Finished the day with his second straight three-hit game... Hit his third home run of the season and also doubled in Valpo's 4-2 win in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Omaha on March 4... Had three hits in each game of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO, totaling six hits on the day including a double and home run.

- #27 Kyle Schmack, 1B, So. (Wanatah, Ind. / South Central) - After graduating from nearby South Central High School in 2019, Kyle joined his father Brian's program at Valpo... Is the first Valpo student-athlete to play for his or her parent as a head coach since Bryce Drew in 1998... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Appeared in all 51 games and made 50 starts in 2021, posting a .264 average that ranked fourth on the team while tying for second on the club with 24 RBIs and ranking second on the squad with nine doubles... Over the final 15 games of the 2021 season, hit a team-high .304 with two home runs, a .464 slugging percentage, a .361 on-base percentage and a team-high 14 RBIs... Has trimmed down during the offseason leading into 2022 to become more mobile... Had a double and a two-run homer to pace the offense in Game 2 of the Feb. 25 doubleheader at Alabama A&M...Had a pair of doubles to help Valpo to a 4-2 win in Game 1 of a March 4 doubleheader at Omaha.
