Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will look to extend its three-game winning streak on Tuesday as Purdue Fort Wayne comes to town for a midweek matchup. This will be the first of six straight games against Horizon League teams as Valpo has upcoming dates with UIC and Milwaukee. A victory on Tuesday would extend the winning streak to four, which would match the team's longest of the season and represent the program's second four-game winning streak this year. Furthermore, Valpo is hoping to get above the .500 threshold on Tuesday.

Last Time Out: Valpo experienced all four seasons during Friday's doubleheader as the weather ranged from rain to sunshine to sleet to rainbows, but at the end of the day the Beacons defeated both Mother Nature and St. Bonaventure by sweeping the twinbill 8-5 and 10-0. The three-game series was shortened when Saturday's series finale was canceled due to snow and cold temperatures. Valpo pitchers racked up 34 strikeouts over the course of the doubleheader with starters Trent Turzenski and Colin Fields fanning 12 and 10, respectively.

Following the Beacons: Tuesday's game will air on ESPN+, the first ever ESPN+ game originating from Emory G. Bauer Field after the first ever ESPN3 broadcasts from the facility took place this past weekend vs. St. Bonaventure. Todd Ickow (play-by-play) and Sam Michel (analyst) handle on-air responsibilities for Tuesday's showdown. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (161-244), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo and Purdue Fort Wayne (previously known as IPFW, among other names) have faced off 37 times, but this will be the first matchup between the two instate foes since 2012. Valpo earned an 11-8 victory in April 2012 in Fort Wayne. The Beacons hold a three-game head-to-head winning streak against the Mastodons. This will be the program's first visit to Valpo since April 20, 2010.

Fields Fans No. 200: Colin Fields achieved a significant milestone when he recorded his 200th career strikeout on March 25 vs. St. Bonaventure. Fields became just the 12th player in program history to reach that milestone. He needs 10 more strikeouts to crack the program's all-time top 10. For the season, Fields leads the Missouri Valley Conference with 52 strikeouts.

More From the Whiff Wire: Prior to this season, Valpo pitchers had not struck out 17 or more batters in a single game since 2011. This year alone, that feat has been achieved three times — March 5 at Omaha and both games of a March 25 doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure. In Game 1 of that double dip, starter Trent Turzenski became the first Valpo hurler to rack up a dozen strikeouts in a game since Jon Tieman on April 19, 2019 at SIUE. Prior to that, no Valpo pitcher had struck out 12 since Jon Gulbransen in 2011. In the nightcap, Fields fanned 10, matching a season high. He has struck out seven or more in each of his six starts this season. In his career, Fields has reached double-figure strikeouts on six occasions.

.500 Through 18 Games: Valpo holds a .500 record through 18 games for just the second time since 1997, joining the 2014 squad. The 2014 team was 9-9 through 18 games, while the 1997 group was 10-8 at this juncture. A win on Tuesday over Purdue Fort Wayne would give Valpo its best record through 19 games since 1998. Valpo enters Tuesday seeking a 3-0 home start, something the program most recently achieved in 2015.

Opening the Home Slate: Valpo started the home portion of the season by securing a doubleheader sweep over St. Bonaventure. The Beacons improved to 4-4 in home openers during the Brian Schmack Era.

Other Notes Wrapping Up St. Bonaventure (March 25 – W 8-5, W 10-0)

- Valpo swept a doubleheader for the second time this season, joining Feb. 25 at Alabama A&M.
- The 10-run margin of victory was Valpo's largest since beating Western Michigan 11-1 on April 16, 2019.
- In Game 2, Valpo notched its first shutout since March 13, 2021 at Middle Tennessee. The 10-0 victory over St. Bonaventure was the program's most lopsided shutout win since April 16, 2016, an 11-0 triumph at Oakland.
- Valpo batters worked a season-high 14 walks in Game 2, the team's most since Feb. 24, 2018 vs. Holy Cross (18).
- In Game 1, Beacon batters had a season-low four strikeouts and a season-high 16 hits. The hit total was the club's most since May 1 of last season vs. Illinois State (18).
- Nolan Tucker had a career-high four hits in Game 1, becoming the first Valpo player with a four-hit game this season.
- Bobby Nowak nailed down his league-leading fifth save of the season in Game 1. He already has the most saves by a Valpo pitcher in a single season since Jon Tieman's seven in 2017.

In the Other Dugout: Purdue Fort Wayne

- Picked seventh in the seven-team Horizon League's preseason poll.
- Finished last season at 11-35 overall and 8-28 in conference play.
- Led offensively by Cade Fitzpatrick, who is hitting .321.
- Under the direction of head coach Doug Schreiber, who is tied to Northwest Indiana as his father Ken was a legendary coach at LaPorte High School. Doug Schreiber coached against Valpo numerous times during his lengthy run as the head coach at Purdue, which spanned from 1999-2016.

Sophomore Jump: Alex Thurston is off to a stellar start to his sophomore season. Thurston's year has featured a sophomore jump rather than a sophomore slump as he has boosted a .158 batting average from last season to .359 in 2022, second on the team. Thurston is reaching base at a .438 clip after he finished his freshman season with a .284 OBP. March 15 at No. 6 Notre Dame, he became the first Valpo player with a double-figure hitting streak this season after two did so a year ago (Kyle Schmack and Kaleb Hannahs). That 10-game hitting streak came to an end on March 18 at Murray State, but he still has a hit in 15 of his last 16 games entering Tuesday vs. Purdue Fort Wayne.

Home Sweet Home

- Although Valpo started the season with its usual long stretch of road games by playing the first 16 contest of the year away from home, there is plenty of home baseball to look forward to this spring.
- Valpo has 19 Emory G. Bauer Field games on the docket. There were 20 prior to weather removing the home opener vs. Milwaukee from the slate. If all 19 are played, it will mark the first time Valpo has played that many times on its home field since 2016.
- Furthermore, over the last five seasons, Valpo hasn't had more than 15 home games completed in a single year.
- The chance to play at home with regularity is good news for Brian Schmack's squad, as the team went 7-6 at home last season to finish with a winning home record for the fifth time in the last six seasons and the 12th time in the last 14 campaigns.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.
- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf: "In the

time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).
- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.
- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Three-year all-conference honoree on the diamond while also playing four years of tennis and one year of basketball in high school... Appeared in 40 games and made 39 starts in 2021... In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, both of Valpo's starting corner infielders are the sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Civil engineering major... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Had a career-high five RBIs in the first game of a doubleheader at Butler on March 27, 2021 and finished the day with five hits, three runs scored, three RBIs and three walks over the two games... Earned MVC Player of the Week on May 3 after posting a slash line .556/.636/.667 over five games during the week... Led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389) in 2021, becoming the first rookie to pace the team in batting average since Spencer Mahoney in 2012... Finished the 2021 season on a 20-game on-base streak... Had a team-high 15 multi-hit games in 2021 including three three-hit outputs and a season-high four hits in Game 1 of a May 1 double-

header vs. Illinois State... Started his freshman season with a .200 average over the first 11 games before hitting .336 over his last 36 regular-season contests while posting a .434 on-base percentage in that time... Listed by D1Baseball.com as the No. 3 prospect in the Missouri Valley Conference for the 2023 MLB Draft... Has gotten stronger over the offseason leading into his sophomore season... Had three of Valpo's five hits on Feb. 19 at Memphis... Enjoyed the first two-homer game of his collegiate career on Feb. 20, helping Valpo to a 10-8 victory in the series finale at Memphis. Finished the day with his second straight three-hit game... Hit his third home run of the season and also doubled in Valpo's 4-2 win in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Omaha on March 4... Had three hits in each game of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO, totaling six hits on the day including a double and home run.

- #27 Kyle Schmack, RF, So. (Wanatah, Ind. / South Central) - After graduating from nearby South Central High School in 2019, Kyle joined his father Brian's program at Valpo... Is the first Valpo student-athlete to play for his or her parent as a head coach since Bryce Drew in 1998... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Appeared in all 51 games and made 50 starts in 2021, posting a .264 average that ranked fourth on the team while tying for second on the club with 24 RBIs and ranking second on the squad with nine doubles... Over the final 15 games of the 2021 season, hit a team-high .304 with two home runs, a .464 slugging percentage, a .361 on-base percentage and a team-high 14 RBIs... Has trimmed down during the offseason leading into 2022 to become more mobile... Had a double and a two-run homer to pace the offense in Game 2 of the Feb. 25 doubleheader at Alabama A&M...Had a pair of doubles to help Valpo to a 4-2 win in Game 1 of a March 4 doubleheader at Omaha... Launched his fourth career home run and second of the season on March 15 at No. 6 Notre Dame, part of a multi-hit day... Ripped his third home run of the season and fifth of his career in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 19 at Murray State, his 21st birthday... Followed that by tying a season high with three hits in the March 20 series finale, a victory at Murray State.
