Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team will have one final tune-up prior to Friday's Missouri Valley Conference opener as the Beacons continue a stretch of six straight games against Horizon League members with a doubleheader on Tuesday against Milwaukee in Franklin, Wis. Both games will be seven innings in length and the second game is a makeup of a contest that was originally slated for Emory B. Bauer Field earlier this season.

Last Time Out: After dropping the series opener 9-7, Valpo rallied for a road series win at UIC by taking two of three from the Flames in the final nonconference weekend. The Beacons prevailed 8-3 in the nightcap of Friday's doubleheader before coming away with a 5-2 victory in Sunday's rubber match. Colin Fields and Jake Miller each delivered outstanding pitching performances in the final two games as the pair now owns a combined record of 7-0 this season. Kyle Schmack reached base 10 times in Friday's doubleheader and made an impressive catch while crashing into the left-field fence.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (163-246), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo and Milwaukee have matched up 72 times over the years with the Panthers holding a 39-33 advantage. The two teams last played in 2018, and Valpo prevailed 23-5 behind the program's highest run total in eight years. A seven-run first inning explosion set the tone, and Valpo enjoyed another seven-run frame in the sixth. Jayden Eggimann launched a grand slam and racked up seven RBIs. Valpo owns a five-game head-to-head winning streak that started with a 12-7 victory in the 2016 Horizon League semifinals. The two teams shared conference affiliation in the Horizon League for a decade.

.500 Through 22 Games: Wins are always hard to come by early in the season for a cold-weather team playing a slew of road games against warm-weather opponents, but this year Valpo has weathered that storm by posting an 11-11 record over the team's first 22 games. This marks the programs best record at this point in the season since 1998. If Valpo can secure at least a split of Tuesday's twinbill at Milwaukee, the team will enter conference play with a record of .500 or better for the first time since 2014.

Extinguishing the Flames: By going on the road and winning two of three from April 1-3 at Curtis Granderson Stadium in Chicago, Valpo earned a series win over UIC for the first time since 2012. The victories came over a quality program that won 30 games last season. Furthermore, Valpo won the series despite dropping the series opener, the first time Valpo rallied to win a series after losing the opener since May 2015 vs. Youngstown State.

Fields Cracks Program's Top 10: After becoming the 12th player in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts on March 25 at St. Bonaventure, Valpo starting pitcher Colin Fields unlocked another achievement on April 1 at UIC, cracking the program's career top 10. He did so in resounding fashion, fanning a career-high 13 to usurp Chuck Donley (212, 1991-1995) for 10th in program history. Furthermore, the 13 strikeouts marked the most by a Valpo pitcher in a single game since April 12, 2011, when Jon Gulbransen reached that same number in a game against Chicago State. He earned the victory over the Flames to improve to 4-0 this season.

Not Fooling Around: Valpo left fielder Kyle Schmack had a monster day at the plate during the April 1 doubleheader at UIC, reaching base 10 times over the two games. He had six total hits in addition to three walks and one HBP. In addition, Schmack turned in a web gem in left with a crucial catch while slamming into the fence in the eighth inning of the Game 2 victory.

A Look at the Leaderboards: Several Valpo players rank among the national and conference leaders in a variety of statistical categories. With a remarkable ratio of 41 strikeouts against just three walks in 27 innings, left-handed pitcher Jake Miller leads the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks eighth nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 13.67. Fields leads the nation in strikeouts per nine innings at 16.40, while ranking ninth nationally in total strikeouts with 65. Fields also ranks second in the MVC in opponents' batting average at .189 and fifth in ERA at 3.03. Bobby Nowak is 16th in the nation and tied for the MVC lead with six saves. Valpo catcher Angel DiFederico has caught 10 would-be base stealers and has caught the most runners of any catcher in the MVC. As a team, Valpo is 16th nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (11.0) and 36th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.82), leading the MVC in both areas. Kyle Schmack ranks among the league leaders in batting average (.368, eighth), slugging percentage (.575, 13th) and on-base percentage (.461, seventh).

Other Notes Wrapping Up UIC (April 1-3)

- Alex Thurston posted four RBIs in the second game of the April 1 doubleheader, becoming the first Valpo player with a four-RBI game this season. The last Valpo player with four or more RBIs in a game was Riley Dent, who had six on May 1 of last season vs. Illinois State.
- Thurston hit safely in all three games in the series, extending his hitting streak to nine. He has hit safely in 19 of his last 20 games.
- Valpo totaled 26 hits over the two games during the April 1 doubleheader. In Game 1, eight of the nine batters in the starting lineup notched at least one hit, and then the same thing occurred in Game 2. Valpo had 37 hits in the three-game series, posting double-figure hit totals in each contest.
- The Beacons stranded a season-high 15 on base in the 9-7 loss in Game 1 of the April 1 doubleheader. That was the team's highest LOB total since April 24 of last season vs. Southern Illinois (16). Valpo followed that by stranding 14 in the nightcap, so the team stranded 29 over the two games, in part a product of how many baserunners the Beacons had throughout the day.
- Valpo pitchers struck out 16 Flames in Game 2 of the April 1 doubleheader, the fourth time this season that Beacon pitching has fanned 16 or more.
- Jake Miller struck out a career-high 11 in the series finale, surpassing his previous peak of nine on March 20 of this season at Murray State. The southpaw did not issue any walks over his seven innings of six-hit, two-run ball in the series finale.
- Bobby Nowak nailed down his sixth save in Sunday's series finale, already the most by a Valpo hurler in a single season since Jon Tieman's seven in 2017.

In the Other Dugout: Milwaukee

- Common opponents include UIC and Alabama A&M, with Milwaukee holding a 4-0 mark against those two squads.
- Lost two of three to Northern Kentucky this past weekend.
- Finished last season 22-33 and 17-23 in the Horizon League.
- Picked to finish third in the Horizon League preseason poll.

Game 1 Pitching Probable

#38 RHP Griffin McCluskey, So. (Normal, Ill. / Normal Community) – Pitched in nine games and made two starts as a freshman in 2021... Made his first career start on April 27 at No. 8 Notre Dame... Also got the starting nod on May 11 vs. the No. 8 Fighting Irish and pitched a gem at Emory G. Bauer Field, holding the guests to no runs on one hit – a seeing-eye single through the left side – while walking just one and striking out four in six innings. He left in position for the win after becoming just the third pitcher to hold Notre Dame scoreless while pitching six or more innings all season, joining Duke's Jack Carey and Boston College's Emmett Sheehan... Posted the highest fielding percentage by a starting shortstop in program history in high school... Finished in the top 10 in his high school's history in career 3-point field goals in basketball... Enjoys playing the guitar... Pitched a scoreless inning in his season debut on March 4 at Omaha... Pitched an inning and allowed one run on one hit (a solo homer) on March 29 vs. Purdue Fort Wayne... Slated to make his first start of the season on Tuesday at Milwaukee.

More From the Whiff Wire: Prior to this season, Valpo pitchers had not struck out 17 or more batters in a single game since 2011. This year alone, that feat has been achieved three times – March 5 at Omaha and both games

of a March 25 doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure. In Game 1 of that double dip, starter Trent Turzenski became the first Valpo hurler to rack up a dozen strikeouts in a game since Jon Tieman on April 19, 2019 at SIUE. Prior to that, no Valpo pitcher had struck out 12 since Jon Gulbransen in 2011. In Game 2 of the April 1 doubleheader at UIC, Valpo pitching accrued 16 strikeouts, the fourth time this season the staff has struck out 16 or more.

Home Sweet Home

- Although Valpo started the season with its usual long stretch of road games by playing the first 16 contest of the year away from home, there is plenty of home baseball to look forward to this spring.
- Valpo has 19 Emory G. Bauer Field games on the docket. There were 20 prior to weather removing the home opener vs. Milwaukee from the slate. If all 19 are played, it will mark the first time Valpo has played that many times on its home field since 2016.
- Furthermore, over the last five seasons, Valpo hasn't had more than 15 home games completed in a single year.
- The chance to play at home with regularity is good news for Brian Schmack's squad, as the team went 7-6 at home last season to finish with a winning home record for the fifth time in the last six seasons and the 12th time in the last 14 campaigns.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all

season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006. - Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3+/ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- *Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf:* "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).
- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.
- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

In a very unusual and possibly even unprecedented occurrence, both of Valpo's starting corner infielders are the sons of Missouri Valley Conference head baseball coaches... Hannahs' father Mitch is the head coach at Indiana State... Civil engineering major... Fan of Luke Combs, the St. Louis Cardinals and Fernando Tatis Jr... Three-sport athlete in high school, where he earned four letters apiece in football, basketball and baseball... Had a career-high five RBIs in the first game of a doubleheader at Butler on March 27, 2021 and finished the day with five hits, three runs scored, three RBIs and three walks over the two games... Earned MVC Player of the Week on May 3 after posting a slash line .556/.636/.667 over five games during the week... Led the team in batting average (.296), hits (55) and on-base percentage (.389) in 2021, becoming the first rookie to pace the team in batting average since Spencer Mahoney in 2012... Finished the 2021 season on a 20-game on-base streak... Had a team-high 15 multi-hit games in 2021 including three three-hit outputs and a season-high four hits in Game 1 of a May 1 doubleheader vs. Illinois State... Was the MVP of the Indiana North/South All-Star Game in June 2019 following his senior year of high school... Also played football during his prep days... Appeared in 20 games and made nine starts during the shortened 2020 season... Appeared in all 51 games and made 50 starts in 2021, posting a .264 average that ranked fourth on the team while tying for second on the club with 24 RBIs and ranking second on the squad with nine doubles... Over the final 15 games of the 2021 season, hit a team-high .304 with two home runs, a .464 slugging percentage, a .361 on-base percentage and

a team-high 14 RBIs... Has trimmed down during the offseason leading into 2022 to become more mobile... Had a double and a two-run homer to pace the offense in Game 2 of the Feb. 25 doubleheader at Alabama A&M...
