Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball team has won each of its last two road series, going on the road to take series from a pair of quality programs in Illinois State and UIC. The Beacons will head back to the Land of Lincoln this week with hopes of continuing their road success at Southern Illinois.

Recently in Valpo Baseball: Winds blowing out in excess of 20 miles per hour altered the complexion of this past weekend's series with Missouri State, as the visiting Bears slugged six home runs in Saturday's doubleheader and three more on Sunday en route to a three-game sweep of host Valpo at Emory G. Bauer Field. The Beacons pounded out 12 hits in the first game of the series but had just two runs to show for it in a 14-2 loss that was shortened to eight innings due to the 10-run rule after Missouri State scored seven in the top of the eighth. Valpo dropped Saturday's second game 9-4 and was limited to three hits in a 6-1 loss on Sunday that was shortened to seven innings due to lightning. Valpo followed that up with a heartbreaking 6-5 setback at Big Ten foe Purdue on Tuesday. The Beacons led 2-0 early and regained the lead at 5-3 in the top of the seventh, but the Boilermakers forced extras and eventually walked off with a 6-5 win in the bottom of the 10th.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (165-258), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 9-5 lead in the all-time series with Southern Illinois, which dates back to 1966. The Salukis ended Valpo's season a year ago with an 11-5 win on their home field in the MVC Tournament in Carbondale. That came after Valpo won three of four at Emory G. Bauer Field during the regular season. Valpo has won six of the seven regular-season matchups, but all of those have occurred in Northwest Indiana. This will be Valpo's first regular-season visit to SIU since dropping two of three in 2018.

200-Hit Pace: Sophomore Kaleb Hannahs collected his 100th career hit during this weekend's series against Missouri State, putting him well on pace to reach the 200-hit milestone by the end of his collegiate career. If he eventually reaches that threshold, he would become just the 11th player in program history and first since Spencer Mahoney in 2015 with 200 career hits. Chase Dawson came close in 2019, but finished his career with 199 hits. Hannahs reached the 100-hit milestone during Saturday's doubleheader

vs. Missouri State, when he had two hits in each game. Kyle Schmack, also a sophomore in terms of eligibility but in his third year in the program due to the COVID year, enters this weekend series at SIU with 98 career hits.

Flexibility is Paramount: So far this season, three weekends have stayed on schedule, while seven weekend series (including this past weekend's series vs. Missouri State) have included at least one schedule change due to weather. Valpo has played a double-header in eight of 10 weekends (seven due to weather-related changes, one scheduled doubleheader). The weather forecast is not favorable for this weekend's series with the Salukis staying on schedule.

A Look at the Leaderboards: Valpo leads the Missouri Valley Conference in strikeouts per nine innings at 9.8 and strikeout-to-walk ratio at 2.57. Bobby Nowak ranks 31st nationally and second in The Valley with seven saves. Colin Fields leads the MVC and ranks 18th in the nation with 82 strikeouts. He leads the MVC and ranks fifth nationally with 14.28 strikeouts per nine innings. Jake Miller ranks third in the MVC in walks per nine innings at 12.23. Nolan Tucker ranks ninth in the league in hitting at .346. Fields is eighth in the league in ERA at 3.83.

Notes Wrapping Up Purdue

- This marked Valpo's first extra-inning game of the season and first since beating Missouri State in 10 innings in the MVC Tournament on May 25, 2021 in Carbondale.
- Valpo fell to 2-3 in one-run games and 5-7 in games decided by two runs or fewer this season.
- Valpo continued to play tight games against their instate, power-five foes from the Big Ten Conference. Valpo has played Purdue seven times during Brian Schmack's head coaching tenure, and all seven have been decided by four runs or fewer including a pair of Valpo victories.
- Kade Reinertson went 2-for-3 with two walks, reaching base four times to pace the Beacon bats. This was his first collegiate multi-hit game.
- Alex Thurston's triple was his second of the season and the fourth of his career.
- Brady Renfro moved into the team lead in RBIs with 23 thanks to his bases-clearing double. That also extended his on-base streak to 11.
- Connor Lockwood pitched well but received no decision and was charged with five runs on six hits while walking one and striking out four over six plus innings.

Notes Wrapping Up Missouri State (April 22-24)

- Brady Renfro belted his team-leading seventh home run of the season and the 11th of his collegiate career in Saturday's second game.
- Renfro became the third Valpo player this season to drive in his 20th run of the year.
- Alex Thurston launched his first collegiate home run in Saturday's second game.
- Kaleb Hannahs finished with two hits in each game of Saturday's doubleheader, reaching the 100-career-hit milestone.
- Missouri State lifted six home runs including three from Dakota Kotowski in Saturday's doubleheader, then Kotowski slugged his fourth home run of the weekend on Sunday. The Bears hit nine home runs in the series.

In the Other Dugout: Southern Illinois

- Went on the road and won two of three against MVC preseason favorite Dallas Baptist last weekend.
- Also own series wins over Bradley and Evansville.
- Enter this weekend tied atop the MVC at 6-3.
- JT Weber is hitting a team-best .401 with 15 home runs and 37 RBIs, while Kaeber Rog is hitting .309 with 10 bombs and 42 driven in.
- Picked to finish tied for third in the MVC preseason poll.

Fields on the Single-Season Strikeout List: On April 23 vs. Missouri State, Colin Fields lifted his season strikeout total to 82, already surpassing his 81 strikeouts that led the team last season. In fact, with at least five projected starts remaining, Fields has already notched the team's highest single-season strikeout total since Dalton Lundeen's 94 in 2015. Fields is well positioned to become the first Valpo hurler to rack up 100 strikeouts in a single season since Bryce Shafer in 2010. To crack the top five in single-season program history, he needs to get to 103 strikeouts for the season. Three of the current top five single-season strikeout totals in program history came in 1972 or earlier.

Fields on the Career Strikeout List: After becoming the 12th player in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts on March 25 at St. Bonaventure, Valpo starting pitcher Colin Fields unlocked another achievement on April 1 at UIC, cracking the program's career top 10. He did so in resounding fashion, fanning a career-high 13 to usurp Chuck Donley (212, 1991-1995) for 10th in program history. Furthermore, the 13 strikeouts marked the most by a Valpo pitcher in a single game since April 12, 2011, when Jon Gulbransen reached that same number in a game against Chicago State. Fields turned in another gem to start MVC play on April 9 vs. Indiana State, logging six scoreless innings of five-hit ball while striking out eight. He now has 232 career strikeouts, a number that ranks eighth in program history. Fields has struck out seven or more in nine of his 10 starts this season.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team

improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.

- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.
- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/+ broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf: "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including long-

time pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).

- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.
- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Pitching Profiles - Projected Starters

• #25 RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2021 season with 81 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen in 2015... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13, 2021 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three strikeouts) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0. That outing earned Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year at the end-of-season ARC Awards... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27, 2021... Rated the No. 15 2022 draft prospect in the MVC by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Struck out eight while permitting four hits over six shutout innings in his first start of the season on Feb. 19 at Memphis, exiting in position for the win... Limited Alabama A&M to two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out seven over five innings to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25... Posted his fifth career double-figure strikeout total by fanning 10 in five innings of Valpo's 7-5 win at Omaha on March 5. He gave up five hits and allowed three runs in 4 1/3 innings to take no decision... Struck out eight batters over just 3 1/3 innings while allowing six runs (four earned) on five hits and walking five in Game 1 of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO. That marked his fourth straight start with seven or more strikeouts... Earned the victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 19 at Murray State, ending the Racers' longest home winning streak since 1958 by handing them their first home loss of the season. He recovered after walking five in the first two innings - four of which came on full counts - and did not permit a walk for the remainder of his outing while sending down 11 straight from the second to the sixth. He totaled nine strikeouts, his fifth straight start with seven or more, and allowed two runs on just two hits in five frames... Became the 12th pitcher in program history to reach the 200-strikeout milestone on March 25 in Game 2 of a doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure, doing so by fanning 10 over five shutout innings of two-hit, two-walk baseball to earn the win and improve to 3-0... Logged seven dazzling innings of two-run, two-hit ball while striking out a career-high 13 and walking three to improve to 4-0 in an 8-3 victory at UIC in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 1. He became the first Valpo hurler to strike out 13 in a game since 2011 and climbed into the program's all-time top-10 in career strikeouts... Logged six scoreless innings of five-hit ball while striking out eight in the MVC opener on April 9 vs. Indiana State. That outing came against a team that entered the game

leading the MVC and ranking 16th nationally in batting average. He jumped two more places on the program's career strikeout list, advancing to eighth in program history... Took his first loss of the season on April 15 at Illinois State as he was touched for seven runs on 10 hits in five innings, his first rough outing of the year... Struck out seven over five innings of six-hit, threerun ball on April 23 in Game 1 of a doubleheader vs. Missouri State. He surpassed his season strikeout total from last season in that game, already notching the program's highest single-season strikeout total since 2015 with five projected starts remaining.

• #29 LHP Jake Miller, So. (Chester, N.Y. / Don Bosco Prep) – Was a 2018 Rawlings Perfect Game Preseason All-American... Is just the second Valpo player to hail from the state of New York since 2005, joining Zack Leone... Redshirted in 2020 before seeing action in 11 games out of the Valpo bullpen in 2021... Earned a well-deserved win on a hitter-friendly day in his season debut on Feb. 20 at Memphis, bouncing back from a rough first inning to log five innings of three-run ball while scattering seven hits, walking one and striking out six... Had back-to-back scheduled starts canceled due to weather on Feb. 27 at Alabama A&M and March 6 at Omaha... Finally returned to the rubber on March 13 at SEMO and allowed seven runs on seven hits, two walks and eight strikeouts in 4 2/3 innings. His line was a bit deceiving as all seven runs against him came on home runs (four total), many of which carried to right field on a hitter-friendly day and would not have left the yard under normal conditions... Pitched a career-high seven innings and racked up a career-high nine strikeouts while issuing no walks, scattering six hits and permitting one run to earn the win and help Valpo complete a road split at Murray State in the March 20 series finale... Was used out of the bullpen in Game 2 of a doubleheader on March 25 vs. St. Bonaventure and struck out seven while allowing two hits and walking none over four innings to earn his first collegiate save... Pitched Valpo to a 5-2 victory on April 3 at UIC, the rubber-match of a three-game series with the Flames. He tossed seven innings of two-run, six-hit ball, walking none while racking up a career-high 11 strikeouts... Took the defeat in his first MVC start in Game 1 of a doubleheader vs. Indiana State on April 10... Picked up the win on April 16 at Illinois State, allowing one run on three hits over 5 2/3 innings while walking two and striking out five... Struck out nine while allowing four runs on five hits in six innings in Game 2 of an April 23 doubleheader vs. Missouri State, receiving no decision. • #38 RHP Griffin McCluskey, So. (Normal, Ill. / Normal

• #38 RHP Griffin McCluskey, So. (Normal, III. / Normal Community) — Pitched in nine games and made two starts as a freshman in 2021... Made his first career start on April 27 at No. 8 Notre Dame... Also got the starting nod on May 11 vs. the No. 8 Fighting Irish and pitched a gem at Emory G. Bauer Field, holding the guests to no runs on one hit — a seeing-eye single through the left side — while walking just one and striking out four in six innings. He left in position for the win after becoming just the third pitcher to hold Notre Dame scoreless while pitching six or more innings all season, joining Duke's Jack Carey and Boston College's Emmett Sheehan... Posted the highest fielding percentage by a starting shortstop in program history in high

school... Finished in the top 10 in his high school's history in career 3-point field goals in basketball... Enjoys playing the guitar...
