Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The final weekend of the regular season is here for the Valparaiso University baseball team. The Beacons will look to play the role of spoiler as host Evansville enters the series just one game back of Southern Illinois for the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title, which is up for grabs over the season's final weekend. Furthermore, Valpo has its sights set on building up momentum going into next week's MVC Tournament and still has an opportunity to improve its tournament seeding by overtaking Illinois State in the league standings with a successful weekend.

Recently in Valpo Baseball: Valpo dropped a one-run affair in last weekend's series opener vs. Bradley as a late rally fell short in a 7-6 defeat on Friday. However, the Beacons bounced back in a big way with an 8-2 victory on Saturday before Bradley took Sunday's rubber match by winning a 2-0 pitchers' duel. Ryan Maka hit four home runs over the weekend including three on Friday, while Jake Miller and Griffin McCluskey turned in solid starts on Saturday and Sunday, respectively. The Valpo bullpen did its job over the course of the weekend as well.

Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (167-265), the 17th head baseball coach in Valparaiso University history, is in his ninth season in charge of the program. This year, he moves into sole possession of third in program history for number of seasons coached with nine, surpassing Donald Warnke (1946-1953). Entering the season, Schmack's win total ranks fourth in program history after he surpassed Rick Ferchen (1982-1987, 147) during the 2021 campaign. Also in 2021, Schmack joined Paul Twenge (1988-2006), Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981) and Tracy Woodson (2007-2013) as the only head coaches to reach the 150-win threshold. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 39-24 record in an all-time series with Evansville that dates back to 1948. The Beacons dropped three of four between the two teams last season and two of three in 2019. Their last series win over the Aces was also their last trip to Evansville, a 2018 series that marked the first MVC contests between the two squads.

Maka Earns National Player of the Week: Valpo freshman Ryan Maka was named a National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball newspaper on Monday, May 16 after a breakout series against Bradley that featured four home runs. He enjoyed the first three-homer game by a Missouri Valley Conference player in league play in the May 13 series opener against the Braves. In addition, Maka became the first Valpo player since 2018 (Blake Billinger) and just the second since 2008 to achieve that feat. That came as a part of a four-hit game to begin a three-game set that saw him record five extra-base knocks. Maka went 7-for-13 (.538) over the three games with six RBIs, six runs scored, 20 total bases and a 1.538 slugging percentage. The rookie outfielder followed his career-high four hits in the series opener with three hits in Valpo's 8-2 victory on May 14.

Maka was second on D1Baseball.com's list of the top 30 hitting performances in the nation on Friday, May 13. He became just the 50th player nationally with a three-homer game this season. Maka became the first Valpo player to earn national Player of the Week honors since Colin Fields did so on March 15, 2021 following his no-hitter against Middle Tennessee State.

Miller Tabbed MVC Pitcher of the Week: Valpo starting pitcher Jake Miller earned the Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week nod on May 16 after his strong start on May 14 vs. Bradley. The left-hander earned his team-leading fifth victory of 2022 by turning in seven shutout innings of dazzling three-hit, one-walk ball while recording nine strikeouts in an 8-2 triumph over the Braves. He racked up nine or more strikeouts in a game for the fourth time this season. Over his last two starts, the Valpo southpaw has combined for 16 strikeouts and just one walk. Miller became the second Valpo player to earn an MVC weekly award this season, joining Nolan Tucker, and the first Beacon to receive MVC Pitcher of the Week laurels this year. He joins Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse as the only Valpo players to earn MVC Pitcher of the Week honors since the program joined the Missouri Valley Conference.

A Look at the Leaderboards: Valpo ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference in strikeouts per nine innings at 9.7 and leads the league in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 2.55. Bobby Nowak ranks 42nd nationally and tied for first in The Valley with eight saves. Colin Fields leads the MVC and ranks ninth in the nation with 108 strikeouts. He leads the MVC and ranks third nationally with 14.16 strikeouts per nine innings. Jake Miller ranks fourth in the MVC in strikeouts with 74 and fourth in strikeouts per nine innings at 11.42. Nolan Tucker ranks seventh in the league in hitting at .357 and 11th in on-base percentage at .424. Alex Ryan is tied for second in the league with four triples. Kyle Schmack is tied for seventh in The Valley with eight stolen bases.

Fields on the Single-Season Strikeout List: Colin Fields struck out nine on May 13 vs. Bradley, his 12th time in 13 starts with seven strikeouts or more this season. That lifted his season strikeout total to 108. He became the first Valpo hurler to rack up 100 strikeouts in a single season since Bryce Shafer in 2010. In addition, he climbed into the top 5 in program history in single-season strikeouts by surpassing Richard Scheub's 103 in 1949. Fields is just the second player since 1972 to crack the program record book in single-season strikeouts. He is 19 strikeouts away from tying the program's single-season strikeout record.

Fields on the Career Strikeout List: After becoming the 12th player in program history to reach 200 career strikeouts on March 25 at St. Bonaventure, Valpo starting pitcher Colin Fields unlocked another achievement on April 1 at UIC, cracking the program's career top 10. He did so in resounding fashion, fanning a career-high 13 to usurp Chuck Donley (212, 1991-1995) for 10th in program history. Furthermore, the 13 strikeouts marked the most by a Valpo pitcher in a single game since April 12, 2011, when Jon Gulbransen reached that same number in a game against Chicago State. He now has 258 career strikeouts, a number that ranks fifth in program history. During Valpo's May 7 game vs. DBU, Fields passed his former teammate Jon Tieman on the career strikeout list. He surpassed Bryce Schafer (2008-2010, 250) and Shawn Barker (1987-1990, 253), who was Valpo teammates with Fields' father Timm, in the May 13 start vs. Bradley.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Bradley: L 7-6, W 8-2, L 2-0

- Valpo dropped the series opener despite outhitting the opponent for a third straight weekend as the Beacons fell on Friday while outhitting the Braves 14-11.
- Valpo dropped to 3-3 in one-run games on Friday and fell to 6-8 in games decided by two runs or fewer with a pair of those losses in the series.
- The Beacons permitted just four hits in Saturday's victory, the fewest allowed by Valpo in league play this season and fewest since a three-hitter on April 1 at UIC.
- The Beacon bullpen was excellent all weekend, allowing just six hits and three walks over 10 innings of two-run ball, with both runs coming on a two-run homer.

In the Other Dugout: Evansville

- Coming off a 3-2 loss to Murray State in a midweek game, their third consecutive setback after dropping the final two games of a weekend series at DBU.
- Have exceeded expectations as they enter the final weekend in the mix for the league title after being picked seventh in the preseason poll.
- Prior to the series loss at DBU, had won eight straight MVC games including back-to-back home sweeps of Bradley and Illinois State.
- Led offensively by Mark Shallenberger, who is hitting .352 with 11 home runs, 53 RBIs and a .612 slugging percentage.

Nowak Nailing It Down: Bobby Nowak nailed down his eighth save of the season in the 11-10 victory at Southern Illinois on May 1, moving to within one save of cracking the single-season Top 5 in the program record book. Nowak now owns Valpo's highest single-season save total since 2014, when Karch Kowalczyk had 11. In addition, Nowak now ranks tied for ninth in program history in career saves despite being in his first season at Valpo. Entering this weekend at Evansville, Nowak is tied for the MVC lead with eight saves, joining DBU's Chandler Arnold.

A Look Back at 2021

- For the first time since joining the prestigious Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 season, Valpo won two games in the league tournament last year.
- The two victories helped the Beacons finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers in Indiana State and DBU plus a Southern Illinois team that enjoyed a 40-win season.
- Valpo finished the 2021 season with its highest league winning percentage since joining The Valley.
- The team enjoyed a quality stretch of baseball from April 23 to May 8, going 8-4 in MVC play and incurring a one-run loss to No. 8 Notre Dame.
- Valpo started the league slate with an 0-8 record after playing the top two teams in the league on the road, but played nearly .500 ball the rest of the way.
- Compared to the most recently-completed season of 2019, the team improved its batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and fielding percentage in addition to increasing its number of home runs, doubles, hits and runs scored.
- The team stole 33 bases, its highest total since 2017.
- Pitchers racked up 410 strikeouts, the team's highest total since 2010 (421). The staff also issued fewer walks and permitted fewer home runs than the 2019 campaign.
- Valpo posted a .969 fielding percentage, the third-best in program history. The team's top three fielding percentages have all come since 2017.
- The team played in 15 one-run games including 10 in MVC action. The 15 one-run games were the team's most in a single season since 2018 and the 10 in league play marked the program's most since playing 16 one-run games in Horizon League action in 2012.
- On May 1 vs. Illinois State, Valpo had seven doubles in a single game, the most by any MVC team all season. The squad totaled 42 bases in that game, also the most by an MVC team all season. The May 1 game against the Redbirds saw the two teams combine for the most runs scored (30), hits (35), doubles (9), home runs (9) and strikeouts (25) for any MVC game all season. The 17 runs marked the team's highest run total since 2018, the 18 hits were the program's highest total since 2018, the 42 total bases were the team's highest since 2006 and the five home runs were the most by Valpo in a single game since 2006.
- Valpo accomplished the rare feat of two walk-off wins in the same day during the April 23 doubleheader sweep of SIU. Jonathan Temple hit a walk-off homer in the opener and Riley Dent had a walk-off single in Game 2 for Valpo's 10th walk-off victory of the Brian Schmack Era. Temple's walk-off home run, which came in the first game on the program's new field turf, was Valpo's first since Zack Leone on March 30, 2018 vs. Bradley.

Emory G. Bauer Field Upgrades

- Valpo debuted its new infield during the 2021 season as the program now has synthetic turf on the infield and down the foul lines.
- The field renovation project was made possible by lead gifts from Valpo alumni Lynn Scheutzow '74 Young and Carl Young '73 and the Deetjen family. The Young and Deetjen families both had sons who played baseball at Valpo.
- Upgrades have continued in 2022 as the team will debut a new press box, a new scoreboard and have ESPN3/ \pm broadcast streaming capabilities for the first time.
- Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the New Turf: "In the time that we've been able to use the turf, it has given our players an opportunity to take ground balls and work to hone their skills whenever they choose. We've had fewer disruptions to our game and practice schedules due to rain and field conditions. As soon as the rain stops, we're out there playing or practicing. Another tremendous benefit is freeing up our players to not have to stay after to do field work or arrive early in the morning to pull the tarp. Instead, they are able to focus on the game. The turf creates a cleaner game with fewer bad hops, and that's been awesome to see. Our players can't get enough of it."

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- Valpo features 11 returning position players and 22 total returners who saw action during the 2021 season. A total of 25 players are back counting three who sat out all of last year.
- Three of the top four ERAs on the team have departed, including longtime pitching staff mainstays Jon Tieman and Easton Rhodehouse. Rhodehouse (11, fifth) and Tieman (10, t-sixth) both finished in the top 10 on the program's all-time saves list, while Tieman also ranked among the program's career strikeout leaders (244, seventh).
- However, 38 of the 51 games started by Valpo pitchers last season were by hurlers who return this season, while six of the nine position players who started the 2021 finale are back in 2022. The outfield was hit the hardest by graduation with the departure of veterans Steven Fitzsimmons and Riley Dent.
- The 2022 Valpo roster includes seven true freshmen and three transfers for a total of 10 newcomers.
- In an era where transferring has become commonplace in intercollegiate athletics, no players left the program to transfer to other college baseball programs following the 2021 season, attesting the program's tight-knit culture.

Pitching Profiles - Projected Starters

• #25 RHP Colin Fields (Jr. / Libertyville, Ill. / Libertyville) – Father Timm is a 1990 Valpo graduate and played baseball for the Brown & Gold... Favorite MLB team is the Cubs and favorite current player is Kyle Hendricks... Finished 2021 season with 81 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher since Dalton Lundeen in 2015... Threw the eighth no-hitter in Valpo history and first since 1992 on March 13, 2021 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Middle Tennessee, a seven-inning contest. His no-hit bid featured an immaculate inning (nine pitches, nine strikes, three strikeouts) in the third. He struck out 10 in his no-no, an effort that earned him Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper National Player of the Week recognition. He earned the victory as Valpo topped Middle Tennessee 5-0. That outing earned Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year at the end-of-season ARC Awards... Named MVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks after tying a career high with 11 strikeouts while yielding just two hits in seven shutout innings of a victory at Butler on March 27, 2021... Rated the No. 15 2022 draft prospect in the MVC by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2022 season... Struck out eight while permitting four hits over six shutout innings in his first start of the season on Feb. 19 at Memphis, exiting in position for the win... Limited Alabama A&M to two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out seven over

five innings to earn the victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Feb. 25... Posted his fifth career double-figure strikeout total by fanning 10 in five innings of Valpo's 7-5 win at Omaha on March 5. He gave up five hits and allowed three runs in 4 1/3 innings to take no decision... Struck out eight batters over just 3 1/3 innings while allowing six runs (four earned) on five hits and walking five in Game 1 of the March 13 doubleheader at SEMO. That marked his fourth straight start with seven or more strikeouts... Earned the victory in Game 1 of a doubleheader on March 19 at Murray State, ending the Racers' longest home winning streak since 1958 by handing them their first home loss of the season. He recovered after walking five in the first two innings – four of which came on full counts - and did not permit a walk for the remainder of his outing while sending down 11 straight from the second to the sixth. He totaled nine strikeouts, his fifth straight start with seven or more, and allowed two runs on just two hits in five frames... Became the 12th pitcher in program history to reach the 200-strikeout milestone on March 25 in Game 2 of a doubleheader vs. St. Bonaventure, doing so by fanning 10 over five shutout innings of two-hit, two-walk baseball to earn the win and improve to 3-0... Logged seven dazzling innings of tworun, two-hit ball while striking out a career-high 13 and walking three to improve to 4-0 in an 8-3 victory at UIC in Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 1. He became the first Valpo hurler to strike out 13 in a game since 2011 and climbed into the program's all-time top-10 in career strikeouts... Logged six scoreless innings of five-hit ball while striking out eight in the MVC opener on April 9 vs. Indiana State. That outing came against a team that entered the game leading the MVC and ranking 16th nationally in batting average. He jumped two more places on the program's career strikeout list, advancing to eighth in program history... Took his first loss of the season on April 15 at Illinois State as he was touched for seven runs on 10 hits in five innings, his first rough outing of the year... Struck out seven over five innings of six-hit, three-run ball on April 23 in Game 1 of a doubleheader vs. Missouri State. He surpassed his season strikeout total from last season in that game, already notching the program's highest single-season strikeout total since 2015 with five projected starts remaining... Received a tough-luck loss on April 29 at SIU, striking out nine while scattering five hits and walking three during his six innings of two-run ball, a quality start... Allowed five runs (four earned) on four hits while walking three and striking out eight to pass his former teammate Jon Tieman (2017-2021, 244) for seventh on Valpo's career strikeout list on May 7 vs. DBU... Reached the 250-career strikeout milestone and the 100-season strikeout milestone as part of a nine-strikeout performance on May 13 vs. Bradley, when he climbed into fifth in single-season program history and fifth in career program history in strikeouts. • #29 LHP Jake Miller, So. (Chester, N.Y. / Don Bosco Prep) – Was a 2018 Rawlings Perfect Game Preseason All-American... Is just the second Valpo player to hail from the state of New York since 2005, joining Zack Leone... Redshirted in 2020 before seeing action in 11 games out of the Valpo bullpen in 2021... Earned a well-deserved win on a hitter-friendly day in his season debut on Feb. 20 at Memphis, bouncing back from a rough first

inning to log five innings of three-run ball while scattering seven hits, walking one and striking out six... Had back-to-back scheduled starts canceled due to weather on Feb. 27 at Alabama A&M and March 6 at Omaha... Finally returned to the rubber on March 13 at SEMO and allowed seven runs on seven hits, two walks and eight strikeouts in 4 2/3 innings. His line was a bit deceiving as all seven runs against him came on home runs (four total), many of which carried to right field on a hitter-friendly day and would not have left the yard under normal conditions... Pitched a career-high seven innings and racked up a career-high nine strikeouts while issuing no walks, scattering six hits and permitting one run to earn the win and help Valpo complete a road split at Murray State in the March 20 series finale... They all fit the profile of what we're looking for to keep the team rolling. We're excited about this class as a whole. They are pumped to compete in the MVC and continue to take us to the next level. I would like to thank our assistant coaches who have played a vital role in finding these players. Inside the Assistants: Top assistant Kory Winter returns to head coach Brian Schmack's staff this season, while assistant coach Mitchell Boe has joined the fold.
