Next Up in Crusader Basketball: With the stretch run of Horizon League play approaching, the Valparaiso men's basketball team looks to continue its recent run of form Saturday afternoon at Cleveland State. The Crusaders enter the contest against the Vikings having won eight of their last nine games, a stretch which started with Valpo's home victory over CSU.

Last Time Out: Valparaiso connected on a season-best 15 3-pointers in rolling to an 86-61 victory over UIC in Horizon League play on Tuesday evening at the ARC. Ryan Broekhoff scored 19 of his game-high 22 points in the first half, hitting six 3-pointers on the game, as six Crusaders in all connected on at least one shot from long range. Valpo led by as many as 35 points in the second half for the second straight game.

Head Coach Bryce Drew: Bryce Drew (40-18) is in his second season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2012-2013 after leading the Crusaders to the Horizon League regular season title in his first year as head coach. Drew was named the Horizon League Coach of the Year after guiding Valpo to a 22 -win campaign, including a 14-4 mark within the league to capture the title by two games. Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

Series History: Cleveland State holds a sizable 28-12 lead in the all-time series over the Crusaders and is 7-5 against Valpo since the latter joined the Horizon League. Valpo's five wins have come in the last seven meetings, however, including three victories in a row, most recently a $74-50$ win at the ARC on Jan. 4. Five Crusaders scored at least nine points in that game, with Matt Kenney posting a game-high 14 points.

## @ValpoBasketball...

- @ValpoBasketball has been picked to win the @HorizonLeague regular season title.
- The Crusaders received 40 of the 44 first-place votes in the \#HLMBB preseason poll.
- This marks the first season since 2002-03 (Mid-Con) that
@ ValpoBasketball has been preseason league favorites.
- The Crusaders were the only team to place two players on the
\#HLMBB preseason First Team All-League as well.


## ...nationally

- @ValpoBasketball has also been tabbed the preseason
@HorizonLeague favorite by @CBSSports and @AthlonSports,
among others.
- The Crusaders were ranked seventh in the preseason Mid-Major Power Rankings by NBC Sports College Basketball Talk (@CBTonNBC).
- @ValpoBasketball is currently ranked 12th in the Mid-Major

Top 25 poll, voted on by mid-major coaches and produced by @CollegeInsider.

- @ValpoBasketball earned 3 points in the preseason @AP_Top25 poll.
- The Crusaders had not received votes in a national poll since a 4week stretch near the end of the 2010-11 season in the coaches poll.


## ...looking back at last year

- @ValpoBasketball claimed its first @HorizonLeague regular season title in 2011-12, winning the crown by two games.
- The Crusaders earned the right to host the \#HLMBB postseason tournament by winning the regular season and advanced to the championship game.
- @ValpoBasketball played at Miami in the first round of the postseason NIT, the Crusaders' 11th postseason trip in the last 17 years.
- The Crusaders won 22 games overall in 2011-12, their 12th 20win season in the last 19 years.
-@ValpoBasketball boasted the \#HLMBB Coach of the Year (Drew), Player of the Year (Broekhoff) and a second First Team selection (Van Wijk).


## ...looking ahead

- @ValpoBasketball plays the next two on the road, starting with an ESPN2 game on Saturday afternoon at Cleveland State.
- The Crusaders then play at Wright State next Tuesday before returning home to face Detroit on ESPN2 on Saturday the 16th.


## Big League Wins

- @ValpoBasketball earned its largest league win since joining the Horizon League last Friday, beating Milwaukee by 31 points (71-40). - It marked Valpo's largest win within league play since defeating Oakland 95-64 on Jan. 2, 2006 when both were members of the Mid-Con.
- The Crusaders then followed that up last time out with a 25 -point win over UIC (86-61).
- It is the first time Valpo has won consecutive league games by 25+ since Jan. 16 (Southern Utah, 74-44) and 18 (Chicago St., 80-48), 2003.


## Bombs Away

- For the second time this year, the Crusaders have hit at least 10 3pointers and shot $>50 \%$ from beyond the arc in consecutive games. - Valpo went 11 -of-21 from deep in the win over UWM, led by a 4-of-6 effort from Will Bogan.
- Last time out, @ValpoBasketball was 15 -of-26 from downtown against UIC, led by 6 -of-9 shooting from Ryan Broekhoff.
- The 15 triples matched the most in a single game by the Crusaders since they hit 16 against Chicago State on Dec. 15, 2007.
- Valpo also shot better than $50 \%$ and knocked down at least 10 triples in its first two games of the season.


## Dominant Defense

- @ValpoBasketball posted one of its top defensive efforts in a long time in the victory over Milwaukee, surrendering just 40 points.
- It marked the fewest points given up by the Crusaders since a 6840 win over Grinnell on Dec. 9, 1987.
- The 40 points also was the fewest given up by Valpo to a D-I opponent since a $35-33$ win over Green Bay on Jan. 21, 1984.


## As Seen on TV

- @ValpoBasketball will play in front of a national television audience for the fifth of at least eight times this season on Saturday. - The Crusaders have already played once on ESPN, twice on ESPNU and once on the Big Ten Network.
- Valpo will play on either ESPN2 or ESPNU each of the next four Saturdays, including the just-announced BracketBusters game vs. EKU.


## Comeback Wins

- @ValpoBasketball rallied from a seven-point deficit in the final seven minutes for its win over Wright State.
- The Crusaders were coming off their largest comeback win in at least 20 years, a 22 -point second-half deficit in the win at Detroit. - The Crusaders still trailed by 11 ( $88-77$ ) with 3 minutes to play and had just a $0.5 \%$ chance to win (according to Ken Pomeroy) at that point. - Valpo ended the Detroit game on a 12-0 run to earn the one-point win. - Valpo did not lead until Broekhoff's FTs with 17 seconds left - only St. Mary's \& Arizona have won this year while leading for less time.


## Winning on the Road

- Valpo lost its last road game at Youngstown State, snapping its four-game road winning streak
- @ValpoBasketball is now $6-5$ on the road this year - the Crusaders have not finished .500 or better in road games since the 2001-

- The four straight true road wins were the first for Valpo since Jan. 23-Feb. 27, 2003, when it won six consecutive road games.


## Change in the Lineup

- Head coach Bryce Drew changed the starting lineup for @ValpoBasketball for the first time this season on Dec. 20 vs. IUPUI. - LaVonte Dority and Matt Kenney started for the Crusaders in place of Will Bogan and Erik Buggs.
- Then, vs. Purdue Calumet, Bobby Capobianco earned his first start as a Crusader as Ryan Broekhoff did not play.
- Both Bogan and Buggs were back in the starting lineup Jan. 4 vs. CSU, in place of Dority and Ben Boggs.
- With Kenney sidelined against Milwaukee, Boggs was re-inserted into the starting five.


## Gallimaufry

- Valpo is a perfect 14-0 this season when leading at halftime and 12-0 when scoring at least 70 points.
- This marks the third straight year that Valpo has held at least a share of the Horizon League lead at any point past the halfway mark. - Valpo had a six-game winning streak solely within league play earlier this year, its first since Jan. 15-31, 2004.
- The 24-point margin at UWM was the largest by a Valpo team in a road league game since a 74-42 win at Chicago State on Jan. 21, 1999.
- The Crusaders have not lost two straight games this season and haven't dropped back-to-back league games since Feb. 21/24, 2011. - @ValpoBasketball tallied 16 steals in the win over Purdue Calumet, its most in a single game in over 10 years.
- The Crusaders' 52 points in the paint vs. IUPUI are the most they've had in a single Division I game since at least 2005.
- The Crusaders won the Valparaiso Division of the Joe Cipriano Nebraska Classic with their victories Thanksgiving weekend over CSU and B-CU. - @ValpoBasketball has now claimed three in-season tournament titles over the last three seasons.
- With the win over Kent State, Valpo has now won three straight OT games and is 6-2 in extra time since the start of the 2010-2011 season.
- The Crusaders went 34 -for- 41 from the free throw line in the win over Kent State.
- Valpo had not hit 34 free throws in a single game since a Feb. 8, 1997 win over Northeastern Illinois.

-The 50 points scored by Nebraska was the fewest @ValpoBasketball has given up in a loss since Jan. 16, 1984 vs. Western Illinois (41-40). - Valpo defeated Georgia Southern by 31 points in its opener, its largest season-opening win over a D-I school since moving to D-I.


## @CSU_Athletics

- Cleveland State enters Saturday's game at an even 12-12 on the season, with a 4-6 mark within Horizon League play.
- The Vikings have won their last two league games, winning at UIC and at home against Youngstown State.
- Freshman Bryn Forbes leads the CSU regulars with 11.7 points per game.
- Charlie Lee adds 10.7 points per game and also leads the Horizon League with 5.1 assists per game.


## Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his second season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his eighth season overall on the coaching staff.
- Drew was named \#HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Drew led the Crusaders to 22 wins and the @HorizonLeague regular season title in his first year at the helm.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with @ValpoBasketball, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances. - Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over @OleMissMBB. - "The Shot" was just named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.


## \#DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.
- Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
- Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
- A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 24+ years. \#DrewFamilyDynasty
- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 431 victories and 11 postseason appearances. \#DrewFamilyDynasty
- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 869 collegiate victories over a combined $43+$ seasons of head coaching. \#DrewFamilyDynasty

## Ryan Broekhoff

Honors

- Ryan Broekhoff was named the \#HLMBB Player of the Year in 2011-12 after helping guide @ValpoBasketball to the regular season title.
- Broekhoff was also named an Honorable Mention All-American by the @AP.
- Broekhoff has been picked as a Preseason First Team All@HorizonLeague member entering his senior season.
- Broekhoff earned Lou Henson Award mid-season award honors from College Insider.
- Broekhoff was chosen as a preseason Third Team Mid Major All-American by NBC Sports College Basketball Talk (@CBTonNBC).
- Broekhoff appeared on @CBSSports lists by @jeffborzello of the nation's top-30 under-the-radar players (\#6) and top-50 wings (\#43).
- Broekhoff also was picked as the nation's \#28 shooter by @goodman_CBS on his list of top-50 shooters.


## Playing Overseas

- Broekhoff was selected to the Australian Boomers squad, Australia's senior national team, in the summer of 2012.
- Broekhoff was one of 25 players called into the 2012 @aussieboomers squad to try out for the Olympic team.
- Broekhoff was on the 12-man roster for the @aussieboomers

YouYi Games series against China, making his senior international debut.

- Broekhoff saw 23 minutes of action for @aussieboomers in the three-game series, scoring four points and grabbing a pair of rebounds.
- Broekhoff was one of 15 finalists for Australia's 12-man Olympic squad.
- Broekhoff previously represented Australia in the World University Games (2011) and the @FIBA U19 World Championships (2009).


## This Season

- Broekhoff has three times been named @HorizonLeague Player of the Week this season.
- Broekhoff hit five first-half 3-pointers and scored 19 of his gamehigh 22 in the opening period last time out against UIC.
- Broekhoff hit a career-best 14-15 from the free throw line, going for 19 points and nine rebounds in the win over Green Bay.
- Broekhoff scored 12 points in the final 2:17 of Valpo's come-
from-behind win over Wright State, ending with 18 pts/10 reb.
- Broekhoff hit the go-ahead free throws with 17 seconds left at Detroit, finishing a line of $18 \mathrm{pts} / 9 \mathrm{reb} / 5 \mathrm{ast} / 3 \mathrm{stl} / 2 \mathrm{blk}$.
- Broekhoff posted double-doubles in Valpo's first two HL road games
$-21 \mathrm{pts} / 10 \mathrm{reb}$ at UIC, $26 \mathrm{pts} / 10 \mathrm{reb}$ (career-high 7 3's) at Milwaukee.
- Broekhoff DNP for the first time in his career Dec. 22 vs. Purdue

Calumet, snapping streaks of 113 straight games and 50 straight starts.

- Broekhoff matched his career high in the first half alone in the win over Bethune-Cookman, scoring 26 points (7-8 FG, 3-3 3PT, 9-9 FT). - Broekhoff ended the win over the Wildcats with 30 points and seven rebounds.
- Broekhoff scored 16 of Valpo's 23 first-half points in the win over Northern Illinois, ending the game with 20 points and 13 rebounds. - Broekhoff leads the league in rebounding (8.3 rpg), $\mathrm{FT} \% ~(.896$ ) and 3PTM ( $2.7 / \mathrm{gm}$ ), and also ranks second in scoring and $3 \mathrm{PT} \%$. - Broekhoff is the only player ranked among the top-20 in the nation in both $\mathrm{FT} \%$ and $3 \mathrm{PT} \%$, and is among the top- 80 in three other stats. - Broekhoff moved into @ValpoBasketball's all-time top-20 in career points at Saint Louis and now ranks tenth with 1,461 career points. - Broekhoff also ranks 3rd in rebounds (791), 6th in blocks (89), 3rd in 3-pointers (232), 7th in 3PT\% (.417) and 7th in FT\% (.816).


## Last Season

- Broekhoff led@ValpoBasketball, averaging 14.9 points and 8.5 rebounds per game in 2011-12.
- Broekhoff led the @HorizonLeague in rebounding and finished fourth in the league in scoring.
- Broekhoff's total of 290 rebounds on the year was sixth-highest in a single season in program history.
- Broekhoff became the 31st player in @ValpoBasketball history to score 1,000 career points, surpassing the milestone Feb. 17 at @LMULions.


## Kevin Van Wijk

- Van Wijk was named a Preseason First Team All@HorizonLeague choice entering the 2012-13 season.
- Van Wijk was named HL Player of the Week after scoring 49 points on $79.2 \%$ shooting in Valpo's wins against WSU and Detroit.
- Van Wijk tied for team-high honors with 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the win over WSU, also tallying seven rebounds and four assists.
- Van Wijk had a career game in the comeback win at Detroit, going 13-of-15 from the floor for a career-high 31 points.

# Bryce Drew Head Coach 2nd Season 40-18 overall and at Valpo Valparaiso, 1998 

Head coach Bryce Drew returns for his second season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2012-2013 after leading the Crusaders to the Horizon League regular season title in his first year as head coach. Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the reins, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT as the program earned a postseason berth for the 11 th time in the last 17 seasons. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Kevin Van Wijk and Ryan Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Valparaiso University director of athletics Mark LaBarbera announced at a press conference on the Valparaiso campus on May 17, 2011 that Drew had been hired as the 21 st head coach in the history of the Crusader men's basketball program. Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

Over his tenure as a member of the Crusader coaching staff, Drew has coached 13 players who have gone on to play professional basketball overseas. He has helped coach Valparaiso as it has led the Horizon League in scoring twice, while the Crusaders paced the conference this past season in defensive field goal percentage in league play. Valparaiso also set the Horizon League single-season record for 3-pointers made (330) during the 2007-2008 season. Drew was recognized among the league's and nation's top assistant coaches by Hoop Scoop and Jeff Goodman of FoxSports.com and also has been named among the Top Recruiters of Chicago by the Chicago Sun-Times.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering MidContinent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

In addition to his individual accolades, Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points $(2,142)$, three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the Opening Round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Skyes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive threepoint attempts. Twice as a pro, he competed in the postseason, with Houston in 1999 and again in 2002 as a member of the Charlotte Hornets.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made $37 \%$ of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara currently reside in Valparaiso.
