**Next Up in Crusader Basketball:** Valparaiso makes its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2004, as the Crusaders are the 14th seed in the Midwest Region and will face third-seeded Michigan State Thursday at 11:15 a.m. CT in Auburn Hills, Mich. The game will be televised live nationwide on CBS and is the first game of the Second Round to tip off.

**Last Time Out:** The Valparaiso men's basketball team is going back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 after completing a thrilling 62-54 victory over Wright State to earn the Horizon League tournament championship at the ARC on March 12. The Crusaders were led by the standout play of fifth-year senior and tournament MVP Erik Buggs. Not to be denied in Valpo's second consecutive league tournament title game, Buggs drove to the basket time after time, finishing the night with a career-high 22 points on 9-of-13 shooting from the floor to go along with four steals.

**Head Coach Bryce Drew:** Bryce Drew (48-19) is in his second season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2012-2013. Over his first two seasons, Drew has led the Crusaders to 48 victories, including a school-record 26 this season, as well as two Horizon League regular season titles and one tournament championship. Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

**Series Notes:** Valpo and Michigan State have played just twice previously in program history. The first meeting between the two squads came in the 2000 NCAA Tournament in Cleveland, a 65-38 Michigan State win. The Spartans also earned a home win over the Crusaders in November of 2009, 90-60. Two current Crusaders - Ryan Broekhoff and Matt Kenney - played in that contest.

## Storylines

- Valparaiso is back in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 and for the eighth time overall
- The trip to Auburn Hills is the closest to campus that the Crusaders have ever played their opening game in the tournament.
- This marks the second time that Valparaiso has been given a 14 seed for the NCAA Tournament.
- Valparaiso enters the NCAA Tournament featuring the nation's most experienced team.
- Valpo earned the Horizon League's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament after capturing the league tournament championship.
- Valpo earned the Horizon League Championship for the first time since joining the league prior to the 2007-2008 campaign.
- The Crusaders were regular season league champions for the second straight year.
- Valparaiso is looking to win its first Horizon League Championship title and earn its first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2004.
- The win in the HL title game gave the Crusaders their 26th win of the season, setting a new program record for single-season victories.

## @ValpoBasketball...

*...and the @HorizonLeague*

- @ValpoBasketball was picked to win the @HorizonLeague regular season title.
- The Crusaders received 40 of the 44 first-place votes in the #HLMBB preseason poll.
- This marks the first season since 2002-03 (Mid-Con) that @ValpoBasketball has been preseason league favorites.
- The Crusaders were the only team to place two players on the #HLMBB preseason First Team All-League as well.

*...nationally*

- @ValpoBasketball was tabbed the preseason @HorizonLeague favorite by @CBSSports and @AthlonSports, among others.
- @ValpoBasketball is currently ranked 10th in the Mid-Major Top 25 poll, voted on by mid-major coaches and produced by @CollegeInsider.

*...looking back at last year*

- @ValpoBasketball claimed its first @HorizonLeague regular season title in 2011-12, winning the crown by two games.
- @ValpoBasketball played at Miami in the first round of the postseason NIT, the Crusaders' 11th postseason trip in the last 17 years.
- @ValpoBasketball boasted the #HLMBB Coach of the Year (Drew), Player of the Year (Broekhoff) and a second First Team selection (Van Wijk).

## Back to the NCAA

- Valpo is making its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2004.
- The Crusaders were a 15 seed that season, falling to Gonzaga in first round action, after winning the Mid-Continent Conference title.
- This is Valpo's eighth all-time appearance in the NCAA Tournament at the D-I level - it owns a 2-7 record in tournament play.
- Both of the Crusaders' previous NCAA Tournament wins came on their run to the Sweet 16 in 1998.

## Winning the Title

- Valpo needed a pair of comeback victories to capture the Horizon League tournament crown last week.
- The Crusaders were down by six points with under six minutes to play against Wright State in the title game.
- Valpo put together a 16-0 run over a five-minute span to secure the win over the Raiders.
- In the semifinal against Green Bay, the Crusaders were down four within the last 10 seconds and down two with the ball late.
- Erik Buggs was Tournament MVP after scoring a career-best 22 points in the win over Wright State.
- Buggs' previous career high had come in his third career game, 1,573 days prior to the win over Wright State.
- Ryan Broekhoff also made the All-Tournament Team after a 25-point performance against Green Bay.

## So Much Drama in the ARC

- Ryan Broekhoff's buzzer-beating 3-pointer vs. GB invoked memories of "The Shot" by head coach Bryce Drew in the 1998 NCAA Tournament.
- Both game-winning triples came from the right wing and resulted in 70-69 victories by the Crusaders.
- Drew's shot was also the last buzzer-beater by a Crusader in postseason play.
- The last game-winning buzzer-beater by a Valpo player came at Detroit in Jan. of 2012 on a coast-to-coast layup by Erik Buggs.
- The last game-winner at home came courtesy of Brandon McPherson against UWM in Dec. of 2009 on a steal and layup with 0.9 seconds left.
- The last buzzer-beating 3-pointer was a 65-footer by Greg Tonagel to beat Belmont in January of 1999.
- Broekhoff's triple placed #2 on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays, the second time Valpo has made Top 10 this season.

## An Experienced Squad

- The Crusaders do not lack for experience, entering the NCAA Tournament with the nation's most experienced team.
- Valpo averages 2.72 years of experience according to KenPom, #1 in the nation - the metric is weighted for minutes played.

- Of the Crusaders' eight main rotation players, six are seniors (two fifth-year) and two are juniors (one fourth-year).
- All five of Valpo's probable starters are seniors.
- For the second straight season, the Crusaders have not had a freshman play a single minute.

## Winning the League Crown

- The win for @ValpoBasketball over Youngstown State Feb. 26 gave the Crusaders at least a share of the Horizon League title.
- Valpo then secured the outright crown with a definitive victory at Green Bay on Mar. 2.
- This marks Valpo's first back-to-back regular season titles since the 2002-03 and 2003-04 seasons (Mid-Continent Conference).
- Valpo has gone 27-7 in Horizon League play over the last two years after going 36-36 in its first four seasons.
- Valpo has now claimed its conference regular season title in 11 of the last 19 seasons.
- With the regular season crown, the Crusaders are assured of no worse than a berth in the postseason NIT.

## Record-Setting Win Totals

- The win over Wright State in the HL tournament championship was the program record 26th of the 2012-2013 season.
- Valpo previously won 25 games in the 2001-02 season - a year in which they won the Mid-Con regular season and tournament titles.
- The Crusaders won 24 regular-season games, the most in the team's D-I era and matching the 1923-24 team for most regular season wins overall.
- The regular season finale at GB was Valpo's tenth road win of the year, the most true road wins in a single season in the program's D-I era.
- Valpo also set a D-I record last Tuesday with the HL title game win over Green Bay with its 16th home win of the year at the ARC.

## Milestone Night

- A number of individual milestones were reached in the regular season finale at Green Bay.
- Matt Kenney matched the Valpo record for most 3-pointers in a game without a miss, going 6-of-6 from downtown.

- Jared Nuness (Belmont, Dec. 1997) and Ryan Broekhoff (Detroit, Feb. 2012) had previously gone 6-of-6 from deep in a Crusader uniform.
- Kevin Van Wijk scored his 1,000th career point with 18:03 to play, making him the 32nd player in Crusader history to reach the mark.
- Van Wijk also set a new Horizon League record for FG% within league-only play, hitting at a 69.5% clip during league games.

## League Honorees

- Four Crusaders earned awards as the Horizon League announced its postseason awards earlier this week.
- Senior Ryan Broekhoff was named to the All-League First Team for a second straight season.
- Senior Kevin Van Wijk earned Second Team honors after earning First Team recognition as a junior.
- Senior Erik Buggs was named to the All-Defensive Team, Valpo's first All-Defensive selection in six years as a league member.
- Junior LaVonte Dority was tabbed the Sixth Man of the Year, the second Valpo player to be so honored (Jarryd Loyd, 2007-08).

## Offense Clicking on All Cylinders

- Valparaiso ranks among the nation's most productive teams on the offensive side of the ball.
- The Crusaders rank sixth in the nation in FG% (48.9%), third in 2PT% (56.1%) and 38th in 3PT% (37.6%).
- Valpo also goes to the free throw line often, ranking 33rd nationally in FT Rate (42.3).
- The Crusaders' adjusted offensive efficiency ranks 44th in the nation as well (109.8).
- Valpo failed to score at least one point per possession in the win over Wright State for the first time in 18 games.
- The Crusaders have scored at least 1.25 points per possession in four of their last 10 games.

## Winning Away From Home

- While Valpo has not played a neutral-site game this season, the Crusaders have had no problem winning games away from the ARC.
- The Crusaders won a D-I school record 10 true road games this season and own a 10-5 record on the road.
- This will be the first year Valpo has finished at least .500 on the road since 2001-02.
- Valpo won its last road game of the regular season at Green Bay and has won eight of its last nine road games.
- Valpo had two separate streaks of four consecutive road victories this season.
- The four straight true road wins were the first for Valpo since Jan. 23-Feb. 27, 2003, when it won six consecutive road games.
- The Crusaders owned a 7-1 mark in Horizon League road games this season, only falling at Youngstown State.

## Gallimaufry

- Valpo lost for the only time this year against Detroit when leading at halftime (21-1) and when scoring at least 70 points (18-1).
- This marks the third straight year that Valpo has held at least a share of the Horizon League lead at any point past the halfway mark.
- Valpo had a six-game winning streak solely within league play earlier this year, its first since Jan. 15-31, 2004.
- The Crusaders have hit at least 10 3-pointers and shot >50% from beyond the arc in consecutive games twice this year.
- The 15 triples against UIC matched the most in a single game by the Crusaders since they hit 16 against Chicago State on Dec. 15, 2007.
- Valpo earned its largest league win since joining the Horizon League with a 31-point win (71-40) over Milwaukee.
- It marked Valpo's largest win within league play since defeating Oakland 95-64 on Jan. 2, 2006 when both were members of the Mid-Con.
- Valpo posted one of its top defensive efforts in a long time in the victory over Milwaukee, surrendering just 40 points.
- The 40 points also was the fewest given up by Valpo to a D-I opponent since a 35-33 win over Green Bay on Jan. 21, 1984.
- The 24-point margin at UWM was the largest by a Valpo team in a road league game since a 74-42 win at Chicago State on Jan. 21, 1999.
- The Crusaders have not lost two straight games this season and haven't dropped back-to-back league games since Feb. 21/24, 2011.
- @ValpoBasketball tallied 16 steals in the win over Purdue Calumet, its most in a single game in over 10 years.
- The Crusaders' 52 points in the paint vs. IUPUI are the most they've had in a single Division I game since at least 2005.
- With the win over Kent State, Valpo has now won three straight OT games and is 6-2 in extra time since the start of the 2010-2011 season.
- The Crusaders went 34-for-41 from the free throw line in the win over Kent State.
- Valpo had not hit 34 free throws in a single game since a Feb. 8, 1997 win over Northeastern Illinois.
- Valpo allowed 50 points or less in back-to-back games for the first time since Jan. 2003 (NIU 46, Nebraska 50).
- The 50 points scored by Nebraska was the fewest @ValpoBasketball has given up in a loss since Jan. 16, 1984 vs. Western Illinois (41-40).
- Valpo defeated Georgia Southern by 31 points in its opener, its largest season-opening win over a D-I school since moving to D-I.

## @MSU\_Basketball

- Michigan State earned an at-large bid and a 3 seed after finishing 25-8 overall and 13-5 in Big Ten play.
- The Spartans had a pair of close decisions in the Big Ten Tournament, beating Iowa 59-56 and falling to Ohio State 61-58.
- Michigan State is a strong defensive squad, allowing just 59.3 ppg while opponents shoot under 40% from the floor.
- Offensively, Keith Appling leads the way with 13.6 points per game on the year.

- Gary Harris adds 12.5 points per game, while Adreian Payne chips in 10.4 points and 7.5 rebounds per contest.

## Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his second season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his eighth season overall on the coaching staff.
- Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Drew led the Crusaders to 22 wins and the Horizon League regular season title in his first year at the helm.
- This season, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with @ValpoBasketball, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.
- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over @OleMissMBB.
- "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.

## #DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.
- Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
- Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
- A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 24+ years. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 439 victories and 11 postseason appearances. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 881 collegiate victories over a combined 43+ seasons of head coaching. #DrewFamilyDynasty

## #CoachesWhoCanPlay

- @ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,146 points during their D-I careers.
- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.
- Assistant coach Jake Diebler also suited up for four years at Valpo, scoring 826 points.
- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.
- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.

## Ryan Broekhoff

### Honors

- Ryan Broekhoff earned First Team All-Horizon League honors for the second straight season in 2012-13.
- Broekhoff was honored four times as the league's Player of the Week, the second-most in a single year in the last decade.
- Broekhoff was named the #HLMBB Player of the Year in 2011-12 after helping guide @ValpoBasketball to the regular season title.
- Broekhoff was also named an Honorable Mention All-American by the @AP.
- Broekhoff was picked as a Preseason First Team All-@HorizonLeague member entering his senior season.
- Broekhoff was recently named one of 25 finalists for the Lou Henson Award for mid-major player of the year.
- Broekhoff earned Lou Henson Award mid-season award honors from College Insider.
- Broekhoff was chosen as a preseason Third Team Mid Major All-American by NBC Sports College Basketball Talk (@CBTonNBC).
- Broekhoff appeared on @CBSSports lists by @jeffborzello of the nation's top-30 under-the-radar players (#6) and top-50 wings (#43).
- Broekhoff also was picked as the nation's #28 shooter by @goodman\_CBS on his list of top-50 shooters.

### Playing Overseas

- Broekhoff was selected to the Australian Boomers squad, Australia's senior national team, in the summer of 2012.
- Broekhoff was one of 25 players called into the 2012 @aussieboomers squad to try out for the Olympic team.
- Broekhoff was on the 12-man roster for the @aussieboomers YouYi Games series against China, making his senior international debut.
- Broekhoff saw 23 minutes of action for @aussieboomers in the three-game series, scoring four points and grabbing a pair of rebounds.
- Broekhoff was one of 15 finalists for Australia's 12-man Olympic squad.
- Broekhoff previously represented Australia in the World University Games (2011) and the @FIBA U19 World Championships (2009).

### This Season

## **Bryce Drew** **Head Coach** **2nd Season** **48-19 overall and at Valpo** **Valparaiso, 1998**

Head coach Bryce Drew has been nothing but successful in his two seasons at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season championship this season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players this season who have earned honors from the Horizon League.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the reins, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT as the program earned a postseason berth for the 11th time in the last 17 seasons. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Kevin Van Wijk and Ryan Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Valparaiso University director of athletics Mark LaBarbera announced at a press conference on the Valparaiso campus on May 17, 2011 that Drew had been hired as the 21st head coach in the history of the Crusader men's basketball program. Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

Over his tenure as a member of the Crusader coaching staff, Drew has coached 13 players who have gone on to play professional basketball overseas. He has helped coach Valparaiso as it has led the Horizon League in scoring twice, while the Crusaders paced the conference this past season in defensive field goal percentage in league play. Valparaiso also set the Horizon League single-season record for 3-pointers made (330) during the 2007-2008 season. Drew was recognized among the league's and nation's top assistant coaches by Hoop Scoop and Jeff Goodman of FoxSports.com and also has been named among the Top Recruiters of Chicago by the Chicago Sun-Times.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

In addition to his individual accolades, Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the Opening Round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. Twice as a pro, he competed in the postseason, with Houston in 1999 and again in 2002 as a member of the Charlotte Hornets.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made 37% of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara currently reside in Valparaiso.
