Next Up in Crusader Basketball: The Valparaiso men's basketball team looks to go into the 2014 Horizon League Championship on a winning note on Saturday afternoon as the Crusaders host Cleveland State in the regular season finale at 3 p.m. Saturday also is Senior Day at the ARC, as the four Crusader seniors will be honored prior to the game and will address the crowd following the game.

Last Time Out: 20 turnovers were too much for Valparaiso to overcome Tuesday evening in Dayton, Ohio, as the Crusaders fell by a 67-58 final to Wright State. The Crusaders trailed by as many as 12 points before rallying, but could only cut the deficit to four on a pair of occasions late in the second half. Alec Peters led Valpo with 11 points, while Vashil Fernandez added 10 points.

Head Coach Bryce Drew: Bryce Drew (65-33) is in his third season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2013-14. Over his first two-plus seasons, Drew has led the Crusaders to 65 victories, including a school-record 26 last season, as well as two Horizon League regular season titles and one tournament championship. The 2012 HL Coach of the Year, Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

Series Notes: Cleveland State holds a 29-13 advantage in the all-time series over Valpo, including an 8-6 edge over the Crusaders since they joined the Horizon League. The Crusaders have come out victorious in the last four meetings at the ARC, however. In their first meeting this season, the Vikings took a 69-50 win in Cleveland, as Valpo was held to just 35.6% shooting from the floor. Lavonte Dority and Alec Peters tied for team-high honors with 10 points each.

@ValpoBasketball...

...and the @HorizonLeague

- @ValpoBasketball has won the #HLMBB regular season title each of the last two years and claimed the tournament title last year.
- The Crusaders were picked to finish in sixth place in the league standings in 2013-14 in preseason polling.
- After having a pair of All-League honorees the last two years, Valpo was one of just two teams not to have a preseason All-League choice.

...looking back at last year

- @ValpoBasketball won its first #HLMBB tournament championship last year and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004.
- The Crusaders claimed their second straight Horizon League regular season title in 2012-13, going 13-3 in league play.
- Valpo earned a 14 seed in the Midwest Region of the NCAA Tournament, falling to Michigan State in second round action, 65-54.
- The Crusaders set new program records for total wins (26), home wins (16) and Division I true road wins (10) last year.
- Ryan Broekhoff was a First Team All-League and All-Region honoree, while Kevin Van Wijk earned Second Team honors both places.
- Lavonte Dority was tabbed the Horizon League's Sixth Man of the Year.

...at the ARC

- @ValpoBasketball has 16 regular season home games scheduled for the ARC in 2013-14. #ValpoGameday
- Valpo owns a 11-4 mark at home so far this season.
- The Crusaders set a new record for home victories in 2012-13, going 16-2 at the ARC last season.
- Over the last 19+ years, @ValpoBasketball owns a 232-53 (.814) record on its home court.

Senior Day

- Saturday marks the final regular season home game in the careers of four @ValpoBasketball seniors.
- Bobby Capobianco, Jordan Coleman, Lavonte Dority and Moussa Gueye will all be honored prior to the game and address the crowd post-game.
- Capobianco, Coleman and Dority have all played two seasons for the Crusaders, while Gueye has played one year.
- The Crusaders have a long tradition of success on Senior Day.
- Over the last 21 years, Valpo is 20-1 when celebrating Senior Day, with the lone loss coming in 2010.

What's on the Line

- While Saturday's game could prove critical for the Crusaders, it also might end up being meaningless in terms of tournament seeding.
- Valpo would need to win and have UIC beat Wright State Saturday to move into the third seed for the #HLMBB Championship.
- Any other combination of results and the Crusaders would be the fourth seed and host UIC in a first-round game Tuesday evening.
- With Wright State-UIC playing at 1 p.m., Valpo's fate could be locked prior to tipoff from the ARC.

Securing a Winning Season

- Valpo's win over YSU last Saturday secured a winning season for the Crusaders in 2013-2014.
- This marks the fourth consecutive season the Crusaders have finished above .500 and the 18th time in the last 22 years.
- Valpo also assured itself of finishing better than .500 in #HLMBB play for the fifth straight year - the league's longest active streak.

Dority in Wins vs. Losses

- Lavonte Dority's numbers have shown a significant difference in the Crusaders' #HLMBB wins versus their league losses.
- In Valpo's nine league wins, Dority scores 21.3 ppg on 51.4% shooting and is averaging 5.0 3-point attempts and 7.6 FT attempts per game.
- Meanwhile, in six league losses, he scores just 10.7 ppg on 34.5% shooting and is averaging just 3.5 3-point attempts and 2.8 FT attempts per game.

Block Party

- Thanks to the prowess of Moussa Gueye and Vashil Fernandez, @ValpoBasketball has set a program record for blocked shots in a season.
- The Crusaders broke the previous record at Green Bay and now own 158 blocks on the season.
- Both Fernandez (at UIC) and Gueye (Oakland) have matched the program's single-game blocks record of 7 in the past few weeks.
- Gueye has blocked 62 shots this year, good for second in the Horizon League and third on Valpo's single-season chart.
- Gueye became just the second player in program history to block 60+ shots in a season, joining Raitis Grafts, who did it twice.
- Fernandez is third in the league in blocks and seventh on Valpo's single-season chart with 53 rejections.
- Fernandez and Gueye are the first duo in program history to both block at least 50 shots in the same season.

Standout Freshman

- Alec Peters has put together one of the best rookie seasons by a @ValpoBasketball freshman in quite some time.
- Peters is on pace to become the first Crusader freshman to start every game since Lubos Barton and Milo Stovall did so in 1998-99.
- He is playing 28.9 minutes per game as well, right on pace with Barton (28.6 mpg) and Stovall (29.6 mpg).
- Peters has scored 363 points (12.1 ppg), the highest mark since Barton, who scored 441 points (13.8 ppg) during his freshman year.
- Peters has grabbed 145 rebounds (4.8 rpg), the most by a Crusader rookie since Raitis Grafts [1999-2000] grabbed 184 boards (5.8 rpg).

Going Advanced

- @ValpoBasketball ranks among the top-85 teams in the nation in three out of the offensive "four factors" in advanced stats.
- The Crusaders rank 58th in FT rate (45.8), 79th in effective FG pct. (51.6%) and 85th in offensive rebounding pct. (34.2%).
- However, Valpo is 343rd in turnover pct. (22.7%) and defensively ranks 320th in forced turnover pct. (15.6%).
- Individually, Moussa Gueye ranks ninth nationally in offensive rebounding pct. (16.0%), while both Gueye (12th) and Vashil Fernandez (52nd) rank among the best in block pct.

Drew Gets New Contract, Sees Jersey Retired

- @ValpoBasketball announced in December that it had reached an agreement with Bryce Drew on a new, 10-year contract.
- The deal would keep Drew as the Crusaders' head coach through the 2022-23 campaign.
- Drew is one of just three coaches in #HLMBB history to win regular season titles in each of their first two seasons as a head coach.
- Drew currently sits as the fourth-winningest coach in #HLMBB history in terms of career winning percentage as well.
- Then, in late January, the #24 jersey became the first in Crusader history to be retired, in honor of both Drew and Bruce Lindner.

Mixing and Matching Lineups

- @ValpoBasketball has started six different lineups this year.
- The Crusaders have used a starting lineup of Fernandez, Adekoya, Peters, Dority and Williams in each of the last 12 games.
- 10 of the 12 players on the Crusaders' roster have started at least one game this season, including four of five freshmen.
- Dority and Peters have started all 30 games to date for Valpo.
- This year's roster had just five combined starts in a Crusader uniform entering the season - Dority (4) and Capobianco (1).

Freshmen Getting Minutes

- Valpo's five freshmen have combined for 42.1% of the Crusaders' total minutes played so far this season.
- Three of the five (Jubril Adekoya, Alec Peters, Lexus Williams) have played every game and are averaging at least 19 mpg, while Clay Yeo is averaging 12.8 mpg in 25 games.

Reloading This Year

- @ValpoBasketball entered this season with eight newcomers after losing seven players, including six seniors, from last year's team.
- In all, only 22.8% of the scoring, 27.3% of the rebounding and 24.2% of the minutes played from last year's squad returned in 2013-14.
- Only four players on this year's roster played for the Crusaders prior to this season, and all played just last year at Valpo.
- The 8 newcomers include 5 freshmen and 3 transfers - one eligible immediately, one eligible after sitting out and one who became eligible in Dec.
- This marks the first time in the last three seasons that the Crusaders have had a true freshman play for them.

In the Crusaders' Future...

- Valpo inked a pair of Canadian guards to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period.
- Max Joseph and Tevonn Walker are currently teammates at Vanier College in the St. Laurent borough of Montreal, Quebec.
- Walker was a First Team All-RSEQ All-Star last season after averaging 16.4 ppg, while Joseph is in his first year at the school.
- Walker has been ranked among the top-10 nationally in his class by Hoopstars Canada and North Pole Hoops, while Joseph has been ranked 22nd by NPH.

@CSU_Basketball

- Cleveland State enters Saturday's game at 20-10 overall and 11-4 in #HLMBB play, securing the number two seed for the tournament.
- The Vikings have won their last two games, including a thrilling 70-69 overtime win over Youngstown State last time out.
- Four CSU players are averaging in double figures, paced by 15.9 ppg on 42.2% 3-point shooting from Bryn Forbes.

Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his third season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his ninth season overall on the coaching staff.

- Last season, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
- Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Drew led the Crusaders to 22 wins and the Horizon League regular season title in his first year at the helm.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with Valparaiso, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.
- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over Ole Miss.
- "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.

#DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.
 - Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
 - Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
 - A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 25 years.
- ## #DrewFamilyDynasty
- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 456 victories and 11 postseason appearances. #DrewFamilyDynasty
 - Overall, the trio of Drews owns 921 collegiate victories over a combined 45+ seasons of head coaching. #DrewFamilyDynasty

#CoachesWhoCanPlay

- @ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,211 points during their D-I careers.
- The Crusaders' coaching staff ranks fifth in the nation for most points scored on the Division I level as players.
- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.
- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.
- Assistant coach Matt Lottich poured in 891 points over his four-year career at Stanford.
- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.

Lavonte Dority

- Dority led the Crusaders in scoring for the 15th time this season at Milwaukee, scoring 19 points in the winning effort.
- Dority set a new career best in the win at UIC, scoring 33 points (10-15 FG, 5-6 3PT, 8-10 FT), including 22 in the first half.
- Dority continued his strong play in the win over Green Bay, scoring 26 points on 9-12 FG (2-3 3PT) and 6-6 FT.
- Dority earned his second #HLMBB Player of the Week award in a three-week span for his games against GB and UIC.
- Dority made it back-to-back 27-point efforts in the win at YSU, going 8-12 FG (3-4 3PT) and 8-8 FT.
- Dority earned #HLMBB Player of the Week honors for his efforts in Valpo's two wins at Detroit and against Milwaukee.
- Dority scored 19 of his 27 points in the first half of Valpo's win over Milwaukee, helping the Crusaders to a 10-point halftime lead.

- Dority scored 20 points, including 13-of-16 shooting from the foul line, in the win at Detroit.
- Dority tied for game-high honors against Saint Louis with 21 points, including the game-tying layup with 3.8 seconds to play.
- Dority played 52 minutes in the 3OT game vs. Mercer, setting a then career-high with 31 points (7-14 FG; 14-15 FT) to go with 5 rebounds and 6 assists.
- Dority was named the Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year last year.
- Dority appeared in each of Valpo's last 25 games after becoming eligible last season, averaging 8.6 ppg, third-most on the team.
- Dority was named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week following a 20-point game at Missouri State in his Crusader debut.
- Dority transferred to Valpo from South Florida, where he appeared in 35 games, at the semester break in 2011-12.

Bobby Capobianco

- Capobianco hit two late 3-pointers, including the eventual game-winner inside the final minute, against Youngstown St.
- Capobianco narrowly missed a double-double in the home win over Oakland, tallying 10 points and nine rebounds (six offensive).
- Capobianco scored 10 points, including 8-of-10 from the foul line, in 21 minutes off the bench in the Crusaders' win at Detroit.
- Capobianco tallied 14 points and eight rebounds Dec. 7 against Saint Louis.
- Capobianco played 38 minutes off the bench in the 3OT game vs. Mercer, posting a double-double with a career-high 23 points and 10 rebounds.
- Capobianco totaled 14 points, 9 rebounds, 3 blocks and 3 steals in the Crusaders' home win over UCF.
- Capobianco enters his senior year after averaging 5.9 points and 4.5 rebounds per game last year in his first season as a Crusader.
- Capobianco traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to Jamaica this past summer.
- Capobianco shot at a 55.1% clip from the field and scored in double figures six times last season.
- Capobianco was twice named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week.
- Capobianco played his first two seasons at Indiana and sat out the 2011-12 season after transferring to Valpo.

Jordan Coleman

- Coleman posted his first career double-double in the win at Milwaukee, scoring 14 points and grabbing a career-high 11 rebounds.
- Coleman led the Crusaders in scoring for the fourth time this year with 10 points against Wright State.
- Coleman returned to the starting lineup with 13 points, six rebounds and three assists in the win over UIC.
- Coleman scored in double figures each of Valpo's first seven games, ending the streak with a 15-point effort in the win over UCF.
- Coleman came off the bench against James Madison and went 6-of-7 from the floor, matching his career high with 16 points.
- Coleman led Valpo at Illinois with 15 points and eight rebounds.
- Coleman set a new career high with 16 points in season-opening win over Murray State, including a perfect 8-of-8 effort from the foul line.
- Coleman appeared in 29 games off the bench in his first season as a Crusader, averaging 14.9 minutes and 4.4 points per game.
- Coleman scored a season-high 15 points in his Crusader debut against Georgia Southern.
- Coleman was an All-Conference selection for SWIC during the 2011-12 season, finishing second on the team with 10.2 ppg.
- Coleman started his collegiate career as a freshman at Hawai'i.

Vashil Fernandez

- Fernandez was a perfect 4-of-4 from the field, scoring 10 points to go with five rebounds and three blocks last time out at Wright State.

- Fernandez tallied seven points and eight rebounds last time out in the win over Youngstown State.
- Fernandez matched a Crusader single-game record with seven blocks and also led Valpo with seven rebounds at UIC.
- Fernandez tallied his second career double-double at ETSU, scoring 10 points and grabbing a career-high 14 rebounds.
- Fernandez posted his first career double-double in the win over Cincinnati Christian, tallying 11 points and 12 rebounds.
- Fernandez went 5-of-7 from the floor in a 14-point, 7-rebound effort off the bench in Valpo's season-opening victory over Murray State.
- Fernandez played for Jamaica in its first-ever appearance at the FIBA Americas Championship in September.
- Fernandez appeared in four games, including a victory over Argentina, the world's third-ranked team.
- Fernandez also traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to New Zealand this past August.
- Fernandez made 27 appearances off the bench last season in his first season of action, totaling 30 points and 38 rebounds.
- Fernandez made his senior international debut in the summer of 2012 for Jamaica at the FIBA Centrobasket tournament.
- Fernandez helped Jamaica to a 3rd place finish, its best ever at Centrobasket.

Moussa Gueye

- Gueye went for five points, five rebounds and five blocks at Green Bay.
- Gueye set a new career high, matching the Crusader program record with seven blocked shots in the home win over Oakland.
- Gueye also scored nine points on perfect 4-of-4 shooting and grabbed five rebounds in the victory over the Grizzlies.
- Gueye scored a career-high 11 points in the win at YSU, hitting all five of his free throw attempts and also grabbing six boards.
- Gueye registered a career-high 13 rebounds to go with six points and four blocked shots Dec. 7 against Saint Louis.
- Gueye scored in double figures for the first time in his career with 10 points in the win over Cincinnati Christian.
- Gueye is eligible to play immediately at Valpo as a fifth-year senior after earning his bachelor's degree from Alabama.
- Gueye started 27 games as a junior last season for the Crimson Tide, helping Alabama to 23 wins and a spot in the NIT quarterfinals.
- Gueye averaged 3.9 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game, and posted 1.9 blocks per game within SEC play, ranking third in the league.
- Gueye appeared in 12 games for Alabama as a sophomore in 2011-12 after recovering from an offseason injury.
- Gueye, a consensus pick as one of the top JuCo centers in the nation, was Conference Freshman of the Year at Lake Land [III.] College in 2009-10.

David Chadwick

- Chadwick started the second half at ETSU and played eight minutes, finishing with two points and three rebounds.
- Chadwick tallied seven points and five rebounds in just 13 minutes in the win over Southeastern.
- Chadwick paced the Crusaders in scoring after missing four games, scoring 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the win over CCU.
- Chadwick scored nine points off the bench in the win over North Park.
- Chadwick is eligible to play this season after sitting out last year as a transfer from Rice, and has two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- Chadwick traveled with an Athletes in Action squad on a tour of Lithuania this past summer.
- Chadwick appeared in 52 games over his two seasons at Rice.
- Chadwick was a starter at Hargrave Military Academy for a squad which reached the #1 ranking nationally.

Jubril Adekoya

Bryce Drew **Head Coach** **3rd Season** **65-33 overall and at Valpo** **Valparaiso, 1998**

Bryce Drew was named head coach of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in May of 2011.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season title during the 2012-2013 season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 - the program's 12th postseason berth in the last 18 seasons. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I-best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players this season who earned postseason honors from the Horizon League, including a pair of All-Region honorees in Ryan Broekhoff and Kevin Van Wijk.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the helm of the program, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Van Wijk and Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

Drew has coached 13 players who have gone on to play professional basketball overseas. He has helped coach Valparaiso as it has led the Horizon League in scoring twice, while the program also set the Horizon League single-season record for 3-pointers made (330) during the 2007-2008 season. Drew was recognized among the league's and nation's top assistant coaches by Hoop Scoop and Jeff Goodman of FoxSports.com and also has been named among the Top Recruiters of Chicago by the Chicago Sun-Times.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. He competed in the postseason twice as a pro, with Houston in 1999 and with Charlotte in 2002.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made 37% of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara reside in Valparaiso.
