Next Up in Crusader Basketball: Valparaiso looks to get back on the winning track Sunday afternoon as it heads to Athens, Ohio to take on the Bobcats of Ohio University. The game is the first of four that the Crusaders will play as part of the Ohio Classic.

Last Time Out: The Valparaiso men's basketball team sliced a double-digit second-half deficit to just two points and were within one possession with less than five minutes to play, but Illinois scored 13 of the next 14 points to pull away late, as the Crusaders fell 64-52 Wednesday evening at the State Farm Center in Champaign, Ill. Jordan Coleman led Valpo with 15 points and eight rebounds.

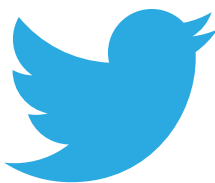

Head Coach Bryce Drew: Bryce Drew (50-21) is in his third season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2013-14. Over his first two-plus seasons, Drew has led the Crusaders to 50 victories, including a school-record 26 last season, as well as two Horizon League regular season titles and one tournament championship. The 2012 HL Coach of the Year, Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

Series Notes: Valpo and Ohio have met just twice previously in program history, with the Bobcats winning both prior matchups, both of which took place in Athens. In the most recent matchup, Valpo erased a 15-point first-half deficit with a 16-0 run before halftime on Nov. 23, 2010, but a back-and-forth second half eventually fell Ohio's way, as the Bobcats won 78-75. Ryan Broekhoff went for 24 points and seven rebounds in the losing effort.

@ValpoBasketball...

...and the @HorizonLeague

- @ValpoBasketball has won the #HLMBB regular season title each of the last two years and claimed the tournament title last year.
- The Crusaders were picked to finish in sixth place in the league standings in 2013-14 in preseason polling.
- After having a pair of All-League honorees the last two years, Valpo was one of just two teams not to have a preseason All-League choice.

...looking back at last year

- @ValpoBasketball won its first #HLMBB tournament championship last year and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004.
- The Crusaders claimed their second straight Horizon League regular season title in 2012-13, going 13-3 in league play.
- Valpo earned a 14 seed in the Midwest Region of the NCAA Tournament, falling to Michigan State in second round action, 65-54.
- The Crusaders set new program records for total wins (26), home wins (16) and Division I true road wins (10) last year.
- Ryan Broekhoff was a First Team All-League and All-Region honoree, while Kevin Van Wijk earned Second Team honors both places.
- LaVonte Dority was tabbed the Horizon League's Sixth Man of the Year.

....looking ahead

- @ValpoBasketball concludes its three-game road trip on Wednesday, as the Crusaders make the trip downstate to take on Evansville.
- The Crusaders then return home next Saturday, opening a stretch of four straight home games with an afternoon tip against James Madison.

...on the road

- @ValpoBasketball is coming off a season in which it went 10-5 in true road games - the program's first .500 season on the road since 2001-02.
- The Crusaders dropped their first true road game of the season at Illinois last time out.
- Four of Valpo's six true road games in the non-league slate are against teams which won at least 20 games a season ago.
- Three of the six are against programs which went to the postseason last year as well.

Defensive Intensity

- @ValpoBasketball limited North Park to 27.9% shooting in Sunday's win, including just five second-half field goals.
- The Crusaders registered 10 blocked shots against the Vikings - one off the program's single-game record.
- That effort came after Valpo totaled 20 blocked shots over its two exhibition victories.

- Then, on Wednesday, the Crusaders held Illinois to just 31.8% shooting from the field.
- It was Valpo's best back-to-back defensive efforts in terms of FG% since Feb. 4 (Wright St. - 29.6%) and 9 (Cleveland St. - 25.9%), 2012.

Fastest to #50

- With the win over North Park, head coach Bryce Drew has now won 50 games in his coaching career.
- Drew is the ninth coach in @ValpoBasketball history to lead the Crusaders to at least 50 victories.
- Drew, who is now 50-21, became the quickest Crusader coach to 50 wins, surpassing Loren Ellis and Gene Bartow, both of whom were 50-29.

Lopsided Win

- The 63-point win over North Park last Sunday was the fourth-largest margin of victory in @ValpoBasketball history.
- The Crusaders' only bigger win since moving to Division I came in November of 2005, a 70-point win over IU-South Bend.
- The 113 points was the most scored by a Crusader squad since a 118-83 win over Chicago State in March of 1996.
- Valpo shot 70.2% (40-of-57) from the floor in the win over the Vikings, the team's best single-game shooting pct. in at least 20 years.

Freshmen Getting Minutes

- Valpo's five freshmen have combined for 41.7% of the Crusaders' total minutes played so far this season.
- Three of the five (Peters, Williams, Yeo) are averaging at least 22 minutes per game through three games.
- The quintet played 76 minutes combined last time out at Illinois and combined to commit zero turnovers.

Brand New Lineup

- The Crusaders have used a starting lineup of Dority, Coleman, Peters, Capobianco and Gueye in their first three games.
- The three returnees had started just five games combined in a Valpo uniform prior to the Murray State game - Dority 4 and Capobianco 1.
- For comparison, last year's starting lineup in the season opener had totaled 245 starts in a Crusader uniform.

Debutants

- Six Crusaders in all made their first appearance for @ValpoBasketball against Murray State.
- Gueye (4 pts, 6 reb) and Peters (12 pts, 8 reb) both earned starting spots.

- Yeo (5 pts, 3 reb, 3 ast), Williams (8 pts), Chadwick (1 ast) and Adekoya all made their Crusader debuts off the bench on Friday.
- Davidson became the seventh new Crusader to play this season, playing 15 minutes in the win against North Park.

Connecting From Inside

- @ValpoBasketball has ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 2-point pct. each of the last 3 years, hitting above 55% all 3 years.
- The Crusaders have ranked in the top-5 in the nation in 2-point pct. despite not having a starter taller than 6'8" during that stretch.
- Valpo is shooting at a 51.3% clip from inside the arc through this season's first two games.

Looking to Reload

- @ValpoBasketball enters this season with eight newcomers after losing seven players, including six seniors, from last year's team.
- In all, only 22.8% of the scoring, 27.3% of the rebounding and 24.2% of the minutes played from last year's squad return in 2013-14.
- Among the losses were 2012 #HLMBB Player of the Year Ryan Broekhoff and two-time All-League honoree Kevin Van Wijk.
- Only four players on this year's roster have played for the Crusaders, all of whom started playing for Valpo just last year.
- The 8 newcomers include 5 freshmen and 3 transfers - one eligible immediately, one eligible after sitting out and one eligible in December.
- This marks the first time in the last three seasons that the Crusaders have had a true freshman play for them.

In the Crusaders' Future...

- Valpo inked a pair of Canadian guards to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period this week.
- Max Joseph and Tevonn Walker are currently teammates at Vanier College in the St. Laurent borough of Montreal, Quebec.
- Walker was a First Team All-RSEQ All-Star last season after averaging 16.4 ppg, while Joseph is in his first year at the school.
- Walker has been ranked among the top-10 nationally in his class by Hoopstars Canada and North Pole Hoops, while Joseph has been ranked 22nd by NPH.

@OhioBobcats

- Ohio owns a 1-1 record on the young season, beating Northern Iowa (75-64) while losing at #10/9 Ohio State (79-69).
- Nick Kellogg paces the Bobcats with 18.5 ppg, one of four Ohio players averaging in double figures.
- Ohio went 24-10 a season ago and earned a bid to the postseason NIT.

Bryce Drew

- Bryce Drew is in his third season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his ninth season overall on the coaching staff.
- Last season, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
- Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first season as head coach.
- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.
- Drew led the Crusaders to 22 wins and the Horizon League regular season title in his first year at the helm.
- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.
- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with Valparaiso, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.
- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over Ole Miss.
- "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.

#DrewFamilyDynasty

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.
- Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.
- Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.

- A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 25 years. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 441 victories and 11 postseason appearances. #DrewFamilyDynasty
- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 890 collegiate victories over a combined 45+ seasons of head coaching. #DrewFamilyDynasty

#CoachesWhoCanPlay

- @ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,211 points during their D-I careers.
- The Crusaders' coaching staff ranks fifth in the nation for most points scored on the Division I level as players.
- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.
- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.
- Assistant coach Matt Lottich poured in 891 points over his four-year career at Stanford.
- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.

LaVonte Dority

- Dority was named the Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year last season.
- Dority played through an injury to score 12 points last time out at Illinois.
- Dority went 7-of-8 from the floor, including five 3-pointers, for a career-best 21 points against North Park.
- Dority secured the Crusaders' season-opening win over Murray State with a layup with less than nine seconds to play.
- Dority appeared in each of Valpo's last 25 games after becoming eligible last season, averaging 8.6 ppg, third-most on the team.
- Dority earned Valpo's Homer W. Drew Sr. Memorial Award, honoring the program's most improved player.
- Dority scored in double figures nine times and led Valpo in scoring on three occasions.
- Dority was named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week following a 20-point game at Missouri State in his Crusader debut.
- Dority transferred to Valpo from South Florida, where he appeared in 35 games, at the semester break in 2011-12.

Bobby Capobianco

- Capobianco totaled 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting in just 17 minutes in Valpo's win over North Park.
- Capobianco enters his senior year after averaging 5.9 points and 4.5 rebounds per game last year in his first season as a Crusader.
- Capobianco traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to Jamaica this past summer.
- Capobianco shot at a 55.1% clip from the field and scored in

double figures six times last season.

- Capobianco became the first Crusader to debut with a double-double since 2005 (10 pts/11 reb vs. Chicago State).
- Capobianco was twice named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week.
- Capobianco approached a triple-double off the bench (10 pts/9 reb/9 ast) against UIC, becoming first player in NCAA to post that stat line off the bench in nearly 5 years.
- Capobianco played his first two seasons at Indiana and sat out the 2011-12 season after transferring to Valpo.

Jordan Coleman

- Coleman paced the Crusaders at Illinois with 15 points and eight rebounds.
- Coleman threw down a pair of fast-break dunks in 14-point performance vs. North Park.
- Coleman set a new career high with 16 points in season-opening win over Murray State, including a perfect 8-of-8 effort from the foul line.
- Coleman also tied for team-high honors with eight rebounds against the Racers.
- Coleman appeared in 29 games off the bench in his first season as a Crusader, averaging 14.9 minutes and 4.4 points per game.
- Coleman scored a season-high 15 points in his Crusader debut against Georgia Southern.
- Coleman was immediately eligible to play for Valpo last season after transferring from Southwestern Illinois College.
- Coleman was an All-Conference selection for SWIC during the 2011-12 season, finishing second on the team with 10.2 ppg.
- Coleman started his collegiate career as a freshman at Hawai'i.

Vashil Fernandez

- Fernandez led Valpo with a career-best eight rebounds and matched his career high with four blocked shots against North Park.
- Fernandez went 5-of-7 from the floor in a 14-point, 7-rebound effort off the bench in Valpo's season-opening victory.
- Fernandez set new career highs for points, field goals made and free throws made (4) in the win against Murray State.
- Fernandez played for Jamaica in its first-ever appearance at the FIBA Americas Championship in September.
- Fernandez appeared in four games, including a victory over Argentina, the world's third-ranked team.
- Fernandez also traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to New Zealand this past August.
- Fernandez made 27 appearances off the bench last season in his first season of action, totaling 30 points and 38 rebounds.
- Fernandez averaged one blocked shot per 11 minutes of playing time last season.
- Fernandez made his senior international debut in the summer of 2012 for Jamaica at the FIBA Centrobasket tournament.
- Fernandez helped Jamaica to a 3rd place finish, its best ever at Centrobasket.

Moussa Gueye

- Gueye blocked three shots for the second straight game and also picked up a pair of steals last time out at Illinois.
- Gueye went 4-of-6 from the floor for nine points, four rebounds and three blocks in the win over North Park.
- Gueye is eligible to play immediately at Valpo as a fifth-year senior after earning his bachelor's degree from Alabama.
- Gueye started 27 games as a junior last season for the Crimson Tide, helping Alabama to 23 wins and a spot in the NIT quarterfinals.
- Gueye averaged 3.9 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game, and posted 1.9 blocks per game within SEC play, ranking third in the league.
- Gueye appeared in 12 games for Alabama as a sophomore in 2011-12 after recovering from an offseason injury.
- Gueye, a consensus pick as one of the top JuCo centers in the nation, was Conference Freshman of the Year at Lake Land [Ill.] College in 2009-10.

David Chadwick

- Chadwick scored nine points off the bench in the win over North Park.
- Chadwick made his regular season Crusader debut against Murray State, picking up an assist in four minutes of play.
- Chadwick is eligible to play this season after sitting out last year as a transfer from Rice, and has two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- Chadwick traveled with an Athletes in Action squad on a tour of Lithuania this past summer.
- Chadwick appeared in 52 games over his two seasons at Rice.
- Chadwick was a starter at Hargrave Military Academy for a squad which reached the #1 ranking nationally.

Jubril Adekoya

- Adekoya knocked down all four of his field goal attempts for 11 points in win over North Park.
- Adekoya picked up three points and 10 rebounds off the bench in Valpo's pair of exhibition victories.
- Adekoya was a Third Team All-State honoree as a senior at Andrew [Ill.] H.S.
- Adekoya finished his career with the Thunderbolts as the program's all-time leading scorer and rebounds.

Nick Davidson

- Davidson debuted for Valpo last Sunday against North Park, scoring five points and grabbing three rebounds.
- Davidson was named Area Player of the Year by both the NWI Times and the Post-Tribune as a senior.
- Davidson helped Andrean [Ind.] H.S. to the regional title in 2013 as a senior.

Alec Peters

- Peters posted seven points and three rebounds while not committing a turnover in 30 minutes at Illinois.
- Peters was named #HLMBB Freshman of the Week for the opening weekend of play.
- Peters tallied nine points, four rebounds and three assists in the win over North Park.
- Peters went for 12 points and tied for team-high honors with eight rebounds in the win over Murray State to open the season.
- 12 points was the most by a Crusader freshman in their first game since 2008.
- Peters finished fifth in Illinois Mr. Basketball voting as a senior at Washington H.S.
- Peters was a two-time First Team All-State honoree and led the Panthers to a spot in the regional finals as a senior.

Lexus Williams

- Williams scored five points and grabbed four rebounds last time out at Illinois, while not turning the ball over for a second straight game.
- Williams dished out four assists without a turnover and also tallied a team-high four steals in the win over North Park.
- Williams scored eight points in his Crusader debut, the season-opening win over Murray State.
- Williams was an All-Conference honoree at Marist [Ill.] H.S. as a senior.
- Williams led Marist to regional final during his final season after helping program capture the regional championship as a junior.

Clay Yeo

- Yeo went 6-of-8 from the floor for 15 points and also handed out a team-best five assists in win over North Park.
- Yeo contributed five points, three rebounds and a team-best three assists in his debut against Murray State.
- Yeo was named an Indiana All-Star as a senior after earning Junior All-Star recognition the previous season.
- Yeo led Triton [Ind.] H.S. to the 1A state championship game as a senior.

Keith Carter

- Carter will be eligible to play Dec. 21 for the Crusaders and will have three seasons of eligibility at Valpo.
- Carter transferred to Valpo from Saint Louis at the semester break last season.

Bryce Drew was named head coach of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in May of 2011.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season title during the 2012-2013 season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 - the program's 12th postseason berth in the last 18 seasons. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I-best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players this season who earned postseason honors from the Horizon League, including a pair of All-Region honorees in Ryan Broekhoff and Kevin Van Wijk.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the helm of the program, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Van Wijk and Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

Drew has coached 13 players who have gone on to play professional basketball overseas. He has helped coach Valparaiso as it has led the Horizon League in scoring twice, while the program also set the Horizon League single-season record for 3-pointers made (330) during the 2007-2008 season. Drew was recognized among the league's and nation's top assistant coaches by Hoop Scoop and Jeff Goodman of FoxSports.com and also has been named among the Top Recruiters of Chicago by the Chicago Sun-Times.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. He competed in the postseason twice as a pro, with Houston in 1999 and with Charlotte in 2002.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made 37% of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara reside in Valparaiso.
