**Next Up in Crusader Basketball:** Valparaiso plays its final home game of the 2013 calendar year Saturday afternoon as the Crusaders host Loyola Marymount with a special 1:05 p.m. tip time.

**Last Time Out:** Trailing nearly the entire game, Valparaiso fought back to tie last Saturday night's game at the ARC with Saint Louis on a LaVonte Dority layup with 3.8 seconds to play, but the Billikens got a put-back basket from Mike McCall Jr. just before the buzzer to come out with the 67-65 victory. Valpo never led, but rallied from down nine with 5:45 to play to come within a split-second of forcing overtime. Dority led the Crusaders with 21 points, 15 of which came in the second half.

**Head Coach Bryce Drew:** Bryce Drew (54-25) is in his third season at the helm of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in 2013-14. Over his first two-plus seasons, Drew has led the Crusaders to 53 victories, including a school-record 26 last season, as well as two Horizon League regular season titles and one tournament championship. The 2012 HL Coach of the Year, Drew ascended to the head coaching position on May 17, 2011 after spending six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach with the Crusaders.

**Series Notes:** This will be just the second all-time meeting on the hardwood between Valparaiso and Loyola Marymount, as the first came two seasons ago in BracketBuster action on Feb. 17, 2012 on ESPNU. The Lions led start-to-finsh in that contest, eventually coming out with a 61-53 win. Richie Edwards led the Crusaders in that game with 17 points, while Ryan Broekhoff scored 16 points of his own.

### @ValpoBasketball...

...and the @HorizonLeague

- @ValpoBasketball has won the #HLMBB regular season title each of the last two years and claimed the tournament title last year.

- The Crusaders were picked to finish in sixth place in the league standings in 2013-14 in preseason polling.

- After having a pair of All-League honorees the last two years, Valpo was one of just two teams not to have a preseason All-League choice.

#### ...looking back at last year

- @ValpoBasketball won its first #HLMBB tournament championship last year and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004.

- The Crusaders claimed their second straight Horizon League regular season title in 2012-13, going 13-3 in league play.

- Valpo earned a 14 seed in the Midwest Region of the NCAA Tournament, falling to Michigan State in second round action, 65-54.

- The Crusaders set new program records for total wins (26), home wins (16) and Division I true road wins (10) last year.

- Ryan Broekhoff was a First Team All-League and All-Region honoree, while Kevin Van Wijk earned Second Team honors both places. - LaVonte Dority was tabbed the Horizon League's Sixth Man of the Year.

#### ...looking ahead

- @ValpoBasketball has another week off before flying down to Orlando to participate in the UCF Holiday Classic.

The Crusaders will face NAIA foe Southeastern University Saturday evening before taking on the host Knights Sunday afternoon.
The game against UCF will conclude the same-season home-and-home series with the Knights.

#### ... at the ARC

- @ValpoBasketball has 16 regular season home games scheduled for the ARC in 2013-14. #ValpoGameday

- The Crusaders set a new record for home victories in 2012-13, going 16-2 at the ARC last season.

Valpo has opened the season 5-2 at home, with the losses coming in triple overtime to Mercer and on a buzzer-beater to Saint Louis.
Over the last 19+ years, @ValpoBasketball owns a 227-51 (.817) record on its home court.

### **BracketBusters Return**

- Saturday's @ValpoBasketball game against Loyola Marymount is a return trip from the BracketBusters matchup two seasons ago.

- While the BracketBusters concept has been shelved, the return trips from the last two years of matchups are still being honored.

- Valpo is 4-3 in the BracketBusters return games, including a 2-1 mark at the ARC.

- The Crusaders ended up 5-4 in games arranged by the BracketBusters pool, including 3-1 in nationally televised games.

### Last Chance This Year

- Saturday's game marks the last time @ValpoBasketball will play at the ARC in the 2013 calendar year.

- The Crusaders will be away from home for each of their final three games before returning home on January 2, 2014.

- Valpo owns 14 wins this calendar year on its home court, including a pair of wins in the Horizon League Championship.

### **Buzzer-Beating Heartbreak**

- Trailing the entire game, @ValpoBasketball rallied to tie the game vs. Saint Louis with 3.8 seconds left before falling on a buzzer-beating putback.

- It was the Crusaders' first loss on a buzzer-beater since losing to Oakland, 82-80, on Dec. 17, 2011 thanks to a Reggie Hamilton jumper at the horn.

- The Crusaders have also won a pair of games under Bryce Drew on buzzer-beaters, including last season's HL semifinal over Green Bay.

### **Triple-Overtime Classic**

@ValpoBasketball matched the longest game in program history, going triple-overtime earlier this year in its 117-108 loss to Mercer.
The Crusaders had two previous triple-overtime games in program history: 1/28/85 vs. SW Missouri St. and 3/7/94 vs. Western Illinois.
Valpo won both its previous 3OT games, with the win over WIU coming in the Mid-Con championship game.

### **High-Scoring Affair**

- The 117-108 loss to Mercer marked a number of scoring milestones @ValpoBasketball fans haven't seen for a while.

- It was the first time both teams have reached triple figures in a Valpo game since a 103-102 win at Oakland on 12/21/10.

- It marked the most points by the Crusaders against a D-I opponent since a 118-83 victory over Chicago State on 3/3/96.

- It matched the most combined points in a Valpo game since a 121-104 victory over Wheaton on 3/1/69.

- The 108 points was the most by the Crusaders in a loss since falling at Ball State, 117-116, on 2/19/64.

### **Power Conference Win**

- @ValpoBasketball led start-to-finish in its win over UCF, the Crusaders' first meeting against a school from the newly-formed American Athletic Conference.

- The American is currently ranked sixth in the KenPom rankings, ahead of the SEC.

- Valpo's last win over a power-conference team came at Washington in March of 2008 in the opening round of the CBI.

### Fastest to #50

- With the win over North Park, head coach Bryce Drew has won 50 games in his coaching career, needing just 70 games to get there.

- Drew is the ninth coach in @ValpoBasketball history to lead the Crusaders to at least 50 victories.

- Drew became the quickest Crusader coach to 50 wins, surpassing Loren Ellis and Gene Bartow, both of whom earned it in their 79th game.

### Change to the Lineup

For the first time this year, @ValpoBasketball ran out a different starting five against James Madison, which it has used the last six games.
Adekoya and Williams joined Peters, Dority and Gueye in the

Ineup.
It marked the first time the Crusaders had started three freshmen since Dec. 9, 2009 at Purdue (Broekhoff, Kenney, Kurth).

- The Crusaders had used a starting lineup of Dority, Coleman, Peters, Capobianco and Gueye in their first five games.

- That starting five had started just five games combined in a Valpo uniform prior to this season - Dority 4 and Capobianco 1.

## **Freshmen Getting Minutes**

- Valpo's five freshmen have combined for 45.7% of the Crusaders' total minutes played so far this season.

- Four of the five (Jubril Adekoya, Alec Peters, Lexus Williams, Clay Yeo) are averaging at least 16 minutes per game.

- The freshmen combined for just 75 minutes against Saint Louis last time out, their fewest combined minutes this season.

## **Connecting From Inside**

- @ValpoBasketball has ranked among the top-5 in the nation in 2point pct. each of the last 3 years, hitting above 55% all 3 years.

The Crusaders have ranked in the top-5 in the nation in 2-point pct. despite not having a starter taller than 6'8" during that stretch.
Valpo is shooting at a 56.4% clip from inside the arc through this season's first ten games, hitting less than 50% just three times.

## Looking to Reload

@ValpoBasketball enters this season with eight newcomers after losing seven players, including six seniors, from last year's team.
In all, only 22.8% of the scoring, 27.3% of the rebounding and 24.2% of the minutes played from last year's squad return in 2013-14.
Only four players on this year's roster have played for the Crusaders, all of whom started playing for Valpo just last year.

- The 8 newcomers include 5 freshmen and 3 transfers - one eligible immediately, one eligible after sitting out and one eligible in December. - This marks the first time in the last three seasons that the Crusaders have had a true freshman play for them.

### In the Crusaders' Future...

- Valpo inked a pair of Canadian guards to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period.

- Max Joseph and Tevonn Walker are currently teammates at Vanier College in the St. Laurent borough of Montreal, Quebec.

- Walker was a First Team All-RSEQ All-Star last season after averaging 16.4 ppg, while Joseph is in his first year at the school.

- Walker has been ranked among the top-10 nationally in his class by Hoopstars Canada and North Pole Hoops, while Joseph has been ranked 22nd by NPH.

### @LMUHoops

- Loyola Marymount enters Saturday at 6-4 this year, most recently falling at Pitt last Friday by an 85-68 final.

- LMU will close out a month-long, 15,000+ mile road trip with Saturday's game at the ARC.

- Anthony Ireland, a member of the Cousy Award watch list, leads the Lions, averaging 19.0 points and 5.1 assists/game.

### **Bryce Drew**

- Bryce Drew is in his third season as head coach of @ValpoBasketball and is in his ninth season overall on the coaching staff.

Last season, Drew guided Valpo to its second straight regular season title, its first tournament title and a school record 26 wins.
Drew was named #HLMBB Coach of the Year in 2011-12 in his first

season as head coach.

- Drew was the first Crusader men's basketball Coach of the Year since 2001-02, when dad Homer won the honor in the Mid-Con.

- Drew led the Crusaders to 22 wins and the Horizon League regular season title in his first year at the helm.

- Prior to coaching, Drew spent seven seasons playing professionally, including six seasons in the NBA.

- Drew was a two-time Mid-Con MVP in his playing days with Valparaiso, helping the team to three NCAA tournament appearances.

- Drew hit "The Shot", a buzzer-beating 3-pointer in the first round of the 1998 NCAA tournament, to lift the Crusaders over Ole Miss. - "The Shot" was named one of the top-35 All-Time Madness Moments

by the NCAA as part of the celebration of 75 Years of March Madness.

### **#DrewFamilyDynasty**

- Bryce is the third member of the Drew family to serve as head coach of @ValpoBasketball.

- Father Homer was head coach from 1988-2002, and then returned to lead Valpo from 2003-11.

Brother Scott (current head coach of @BaylorMBB) led the Crusaders during the 2002-03 season after nine seasons as an assistant under Homer.
A Drew has been at the helm of the Crusaders for the last 25 years.
#DrewFamilyDynasty

- The Drew family has combined to lead @ValpoBasketball to 445 victories and 11 postseason appearances. #DrewFamilyDynasty

- Overall, the trio of Drews owns 900 collegiate victories over a combined 45+ seasons of head coaching. #DrewFamilyDynasty

### #CoachesWhoCanPlay

@ValpoBasketball boasts one of the nation's highest-scoring staffs, as a trio of coaches combined for 4,211 points during their D-I careers.
The Crusaders' coaching staff ranks fifth in the nation for most

points scored on the Division I level as players.

- Head coach Bryce Drew scored 2,142 points during his four-year career with the Crusaders.

- Assistant coach Roger Powell Jr. tallied 1,178 points during his four-year career with Illinois.

- Assistant coach Matt Lottich poured in 891 points over his fouryear career at Stanford.

- Assistant coach Luke Gore also played collegiately at NAIA Bethel [Tenn.] College.

## LaVonte Dority

Dority was named the Horizon League Sixth Man of the Year last year.
Dority tied for game-high honors last time out vs. SLU with 21

points, including the game-tying layup with 3.8 seconds to play.

- Dority paced the Crusaders n the win at Ball State with 16 points.

- Dority played 52 minutes in the 3OT game vs. Mercer, setting new career highs with 31 points (7-14 FG; 14-15 FT), 5 rebounds and 6 assists.

- Dority scored a team-high 20 points at Ohio.

- Dority went 7-of-8 from the floor, including five 3-pointers, for a career-best 21 points against North Park.

- Dority appeared in each of Valpo's last 25 games after becoming eligible last season, averaging 8.6 ppg, third-most on the team.

- Dority scored in double figures nine times and led Valpo in scoring on three occasions.

- Dority was named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week following a 20-point game at Missouri State in his Crusader debut.

- Dority transferred to Valpo from South Florida, where he appeared in 35 games, at the semester break in 2011-12.

### **Bobby Capobianco**

- Capobianco tallied 14 points and eight rebounds last time out against Saint Louis.

- Capobianco played 38 minutes off the bench in the 3OT game vs. Mercer, posting his first double-double with a career-high 23 points and 10 rebounds.

- Capobianco totaled 14 points, 9 rebounds, 3 blocks and 3 steals in the Crusaders' win over UCF.

- Capobianco enters his senior year after averaging 5.9 points and

4.5 rebounds per game last year in his first season as a Crusader.

- Capobianco traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to Jamaica this past summer.

- Capobianco shot at a 55.1% clip from the field and scored in double figures six times last season.

- Capobianco was twice named Horizon League Newcomer of the Week.

- Capobianco approached a triple-double off the bench (10 pts/9 reb/9 ast) against UIC, becoming first player in NCAA to post that stat line off the bench in nearly 5 years.

- Capobianco played his first two seasons at Indiana and sat out the 2011-12 season after transferring to Valpo.

### Jordan Coleman

- Coleman returned to the lineup with nine points and seven rebounds in the win at Ball State.

- Coleman scored in double figures each of Valpo's first seven games, ending the streak with a 15-point effort in the win over UCF. - Coleman came off the bench for the first time this year vs. JMU and

went 6-of-7 from the floor, matching his career high with 16 points.

- Coleman led Valpo at Illinois with 15 points and eight rebounds. - Coleman set a new career high with 16 points in season-opening win over Murray State, including a perfect 8-of-8 effort from the foul line.

- Coleman appeared in 29 games off the bench in his first season as a Crusader, averaging 14.9 minutes and 4.4 points per game.

- Coleman scored a season-high 15 points in his Crusader debut against Georgia Southern.

- Coleman was an All-Conference selection for SWIC during the 2011-12 season, finishing second on the team with 10.2 ppg.

- Coleman started his collegiate career as a freshman at Hawai'i.

### **Vashil Fernandez**

- Fernandez posted his first career double-double in the win over CCU, tallying 11 points and a career-best 12 rebounds.

- Fernandez led Valpo with eight rebounds and matched his career high with four blocked shots against North Park.

Fernandez went 5-of-7 from the floor in a 14-point, 7-rebound effort off the bench in Valpo's season-opening victory over Murray State.
Fernandez played for Jamaica in its first-ever appearance at the FIBA Americas Championship in September.

- Fernandez appeared in four games, including a victory over Argentina, the world's third-ranked team.

- Fernandez also traveled with an Athletes in Action squad to New Zealand this past August.

- Fernandez made 27 appearances off the bench last season in his first season of action, totaling 30 points and 38 rebounds.

- Fernandez made his senior international debut in the summer of 2012 for Jamaica at the FIBA Centrobasket tournament.

- Fernandez helped Jamaica to a 3rd place finish, its best ever at Centrobasket.

### Moussa Gueye

- Gueye registered a career-high 13 rebounds to go with six points and four blocked shots last time out versus Saint Louis.

- Gueye scored in double figures for the first time in his career with 10 points in the win over Cincinnati Christian.

- Gueye ripped down 11 rebounds in Valpo's win over James Madison.

- Gueye chipped in six points, four rebounds and a season-best four blocked shots at Evansville.

- Gueye went 4-of-6 from the floor for nine points, four rebounds and three blocks in the win over North Park.

- Gueye is eligible to play immediately at Valpo as a fifth-year senior after earning his bachelor's degree from Alabama.

- Gueye started 27 games as a junior last season for the Crimson Tide, helping Alabama to 23 wins and a spot in the NIT quarterfinals.

- Gueye averaged 3.9 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game, and posted 1.9 blocks per game within SEC play, ranking third in the league.

- Gueye appeared in 12 games for Alabama as a sophomore in 2011-

12 after recovering from an offseason injury.

- Gueye, a consensus pick as one of the top JuCo centers in the nation, was Conference Freshman of the Year at Lake Land [III.] College in 2009-10.

### **David Chadwick**

- Chadwick paced the Crusaders in scoring after missing four games, scoring 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the win over CCU.

- Chadwick scored nine points off the bench in the win over North Park.

- Chadwick made his regular season Crusader debut against Murray State, picking up an assist in four minutes of play.

- Chadwick is eligible to play this season after sitting out last year as a transfer from Rice, and has two seasons of eligibility remaining.

- Chadwick traveled with an Athletes in Action squad on a tour of Lithuania this past summer.

- Chadwick appeared in 52 games over his two seasons at Rice.

- Chadwick was a starter at Hargrave Military Academy for a squad which reached the #1 ranking nationally.

### Jubril Adekoya

- Adekoya set a new career high with 12 points and also led the Crusaders with eight boards in the win at Ball State.

- Adekoya tallied seven points and eight rebounds in the win over Cincinnati Christian.

- Adekoya went hit all four of his field goal attempts from inside the arc in an eight-point effort in the win over UCF.

- Adekoya played 14 second-half minutes at Evansville, registering four points, three rebounds and a Valpo-season best six assists.

- Adekoya knocked down all four of his field goal attempts for 11 points in win over North Park.

- Adekoya was a Third Team All-State honoree as a senior at Andrew [III.] H.S.

- Adekoya finished his career with the Thunderbolts as the program's all-time leading scorer and rebounds.

### Nick Davidson

- Davidson tallied seven points, including his first career 3-pointer, and handed out five assists in the win over Cincinnati Christian.

- Davidson debuted for Valpo against North Park, scoring five points and grabbing three rebounds.

- Davidson was named Area Player of the Year by both the NWI Times and the Post-Tribune as a senior.

- Davidson helped Andrean [Ind.] H.S. to the regional title in 2013 as a senior.

### **Alec Peters**

- Peters hit all five of his field goal attempts vs. CCU for 13 points in just 16 minutes.

- Peters totaled 22 points, nine rebounds and five assists in 49 minutes in the triple-overtime game against Mercer.

- Peters scored a Valpo season-high 30 points at Evansville, including seven 3-pointers.

- The 30 points was the most by a Crusader freshman since Raitis Grafs scored 30 against Belmont in January of 2000.

- Peters earned his second #HLMBB Freshman of the Week honor

# Bryce Drew Head Coach 3rd Season 54-25 overall and at Valpo Valparaiso, 1998

Bryce Drew was named head coach of the Valparaiso men's basketball program in May of 2011.

Drew guided the Crusaders to their second straight Horizon League regular season title during the 2012-2013 season and also led Valpo to its first Horizon League Championship crown, returning the Crusaders to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2004 - the program's 12th postseason berth in the last 18 seasons. Along the way, Valpo won a school-record 26 games, including a

record 16 victories at the ARC and a Division I-best 10 true road victories. Drew guided four players this season who earned postseason honors from the Horizon League, including a pair of All-Region honorees in Ryan Broekhoff and Kevin Van Wijk.

Drew led Valpo to 22 victories in his rookie season at the helm of the program, including a 14-4 mark in Horizon League play to capture the league regular season title by two games. He also guided the Crusaders to the Postseason NIT. Drew was honored as the Horizon League Coach of the Year for his efforts on the bench, while he coached two First Team All-League selections in Van Wijk and Broekhoff, the latter of whom was named the league Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American.

Drew, the most decorated player in Crusader men's basketball history, spent the six seasons prior to his hiring as head coach as a member of the Valparaiso coaching staff, including the previous five years as associate head coach. Drew, who helped guide Valpo through their transition into a top-ten league in the Horizon League, became just the fourth new head coach of the Crusader men's basketball program in the last 31 years.

Drew joined the Valparaiso coaching staff prior to the 2005-2006 season, and over his six seasons on the bench as an assistant/associate helped lead the Crusaders to 102 victories. With Drew on the staff, Valpo moved into the Horizon League in 2007-2008 and returned to the postseason with a trip to the College Basketball Invitational, where it won its first-round game at Washington. In his final season as associate head coach, he helped guide the Crusaders to 23 wins and a postseason berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament while receiving votes in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll for four consecutive weeks.

Drew has coached 13 players who have gone on to play professional basketball overseas. He has helped coach Valparaiso as it has led the Horizon League in scoring twice, while the program also set the Horizon League single-season record for 3-pointers made (330) during the 2007-2008 season. Drew was recognized among the league's and nation's top assistant coaches by Hoop Scoop and Jeff Goodman of FoxSports.com and also has been named among the Top Recruiters of Chicago by the Chicago Sun-Times.

As a student-athlete, Drew cemented himself as the best player in Valparaiso men's basketball history. Drew, who arrived at Valpo after earning Indiana Mr. Basketball honors and being named Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year in 1994, began his career by garnering Mid-Continent Conference Newcomer of the Year and Mid-Con Tournament MVP honors as a freshman. Drew, a four time All-Conference honoree, shined during the conference tournaments, earning All-Tournament Team honors each of his four seasons and picking up three Mid-Continent Conference Tournament MVP awards. He was also twice decorated as Mid-Con Most Valuable Player, one of only four players to be so honored twice in their career. Drew's career culminated as a senior by being named a Third Team All-American by the Basketball Times.

Drew led the Crusaders to four Mid-Continent Conference regular season championships, four tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament. Drew, the career leader in points (2,142), three-point field goals (364) and assists (626) at Valpo, etched his name into the American consciousness in 1998 when he hit "The Shot" in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to beat Ole Miss. The play, in which Drew caught a tip pass from teammate Bill Jenkins off a full-court feed from Jamie Sykes, won Drew an ESPY award and gave Valpo its first NCAA Tournament win in school history, propelling the Crusaders to the Sweet Sixteen.

Drew also excelled internationally during his time on the court with the Crusaders, playing for the gold-medal winning Team USA at the World University Games in 1997. Following his collegiate career, Drew again made school history when the Houston Rockets drafted him with the 16th pick in the 1998 NBA Draft, the first time a Crusader had been chosen in the first round. Drew's NBA career lasted six seasons with the Rockets, Chicago Bulls, and Charlotte and New Orleans Hornets, with his best season coming in 2000-2001 when he started 41 games for the Bulls, averaging 6.3 points and 3.9 assists per game. A prolific shooter, Drew set a Hornet record when he connected on nine consecutive three-point attempts. He competed in the postseason twice as a pro, with Houston in 1999 and with Charlotte in 2002.

Over the course of his NBA career, Drew scored over 1,000 points and made 37% of his three-point attempts. In 1999, he was honored by the NBA with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship. Drew played alongside 12 NBA All-Stars during his time in the NBA, including three players who were named among the Top 50 NBA Players of All Time. He also played under a quintet of head coaches who have combined for five NBA Championship rings. Following his six seasons in the NBA, Drew played professionally overseas for a season, playing for Reggio Calabria (Italian Serie A) and Pamesa Valencia (Spanish Liga ACB) before returning to the States to join the Crusader coaching staff.

Drew is twice a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame, as he was inducted as an individual in 2003 and as part of the 1997-1998 Sweet Sixteen team in 2009. He also has been honored as one of the 150 most influential people in Valparaiso University's 150 years.

Drew graduated from Valparaiso in 1998 with a bachelor's degree in sports management and a minor in business. He and his wife Tara reside in Valparaiso.
